UCFACTS

SETTING THE SCENE

- The UCF men's basketball team returned to action after its best season in program history by winning the 2019-20 season opener, 73-69, over Prairie View A&M.
- Last year, the Knights went 24-9, earned their first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament and picked up their first NCAA Tournament win, a 73-58 first-round triumph over VCU.
- As a nine seed, it was the highest seed in program history and UCF nearly took down top overall seed Duke, before falling in the final moments on a missed tip-in that rolled around the rim.

HISTORIC SEASON

- UCF made its first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2005 and set the program's Division I era record with 23 regular season victories.
- The Knights defeated multiple ranked teams in 2018-19, the first time doing so in program history. UCF defeated no. 6 Houston on the road and then returned home to top no. 19 Cincinnati in back-to-back games.
- UCF made the Top 25 itself in the penultimate week of the regular season, earning a national ranking the furthest into a season in program history.
- The team's 13 American Athletic Conference wins were the most since joining the league and the most in any conference since going 13-7 in the Atlantic Sun back in 2004-05.

THREE YEARS OF UNPRECEDENTED SUCCESS

- Johnny Dawkins has led the Knights to the second-winningest three-year stretch in UCF history, holding a 67-34 overall record since taking over the Knights.
- The only better run during UCF's Division I era was when the Knights went 70-26 from 2002-05 as members of the Atlantic Sun.
- Dawkins' 67-34 mark is the best first three seasons by a UCF head coach in program history.

NEARLY A WHOLE NEW SQUAD

- The 2019-20 squad has a look a whole different look for fans of the Knights, as BJ Taylor, Tacko Fall, Chad Brow, Aubrey Dawkins and others are gone from last year's team.
- The only returning players with experience as Knights are Collin Smith, Frank Bertz and Ceasar Delesus.
- UCF returns the fourth least percentage of scoring in the nation, bringing back just 19.7 percent from last year's squad, led by Smith's 264 points from a season ago.
 - Tulane 12.2%; South Dakota State 16.9%; Virginia Tech 18.1 %; UCF 19.7%
- In fact, UCF brings back just 22 percent of minutes played, 20 percent of rebounds and 19
 percent of three-pointers made from the 2018-19 team.

- There are 11 players on UCF's 2019-20 roster who have never suited up as a Knight.
- 2 Grad Transfers: Matt Milon (William & Mary), Dazon Ingram (Alabama)
- 2 JUCO Transfers: Moses Bol (Colby Community College), Avery Diggs (SW Mississippi)
- 2 First-Year Transfers: Brandon Mahan (Texas A&M), Sean Mobley (VCU)
- 2 Second-Year Transfers: Ibrahim Famouke Doumbia (South Carolina), Yuat Alok (TCU)
- 2 True Freshmen: Darin Green Jr. (Charlotte, N.C.), Tony Johnson Jr. (Eufala, Ala.)
- 1 Redshirt Freshman: Dre Fuller Jr. (Fayetteville, N.C.)

SEASON-OPENER SUCCESS

- The fresh faces did well considering it was the first game at UCF for so many, coming back from a second-half deficit to win the first outing of the year.
- Dazon Ingram led the Knights with 16 points and seven rebounds, while Collin Smith had 14,
 Brandon Mahan scored 12 and Ceasar DeJesus added 11.
- The Knights shared the ball, recording 17 assists on just 23 field goals, which led to 42.6
 percent shooting from the floor.

DOMINATING DEFENSE

- In its three seasons with Johnny Dawkins at the helm, the UCF men's basketball team has been one of the best defensive teams in the nation.
- The Knights are one of only two teams (UC Irvine) to be ranked in the Top 11 in defensive field goal percentage in each of the last three years.
- UCF led the nation in the category in 2016-17 and ranked 10th and 11th the last two years
- In all, the Knights are holding their opponents to just 38.5 percent shooting combined over the course of the last three seasons
- Additionally, under Dawkins, UCF has not allowed more than 64.5 points per game in a season, holding opponents to just 61.2 ppg in 2016-17, 61.7 ppg in 2017-18 and 64.5 ppg in 2018-19.

TALKIN' DAWKINS

- In his first game of the 2018-19 season, Dawkins earned his 200th career victory and now has 224 victories in his career.
- Dawkins spent eight seasons at the helm of the Stanford Cardinal before arriving in Orlando.
- The former Naismith Player of the Year at Duke also coached under his former Coach, Mike Krzyzewski, from 1998 to 2008.
- After his first season at UCF, Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Ben Jobe and Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year awards.

MATT MILON FIRE

- Graduate transfer Matt Milon is back home. The Oviedo native went to school just down the
 road from UCF and grew up coming to Knight games, watching former stars like Keith Clanton,
 Jermaine Taylor and Mike O'Donnell.
- Milon spent his freshman season at Boston College before transferring to William & Mary for his sophomore and junior campaigns.
- A three-point shooter, Milon has shot 42.6 percent from beyond the arc for his career.
- He has knocked down 205 career threes, including 89 last season for the Tribe.
- Milon averaged 13.0 points per game in both seasons at William & Mary.

NO DAYS OFF FOR DAZON

- The other graduate transfer on UCF's roster is Dazon Ingram, who came to Orlando from Alabama, where he spent four seasons with the Crimson Tide.
- Ingram started 93 games at Alabama, averaging 9.1 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.
- The point guard has also dished out 310 career assists, recorded 85 steals and knocked down 314 free throws.
- Ingram has previous history with the Knights having lost to UCF each of the past two years as a member of the Alabama squad.

COUPLE KNIGHTS CLOSING IN ON 1,000

- Both Dazon Ingram and Matt Milon are closing in on 1,000 points for their respective careers.
- Ingram totaled 981 points in his four seasons with Alabama, and now needs just three points to eclipse the 1,000-point mark for his career.
- Milon, meanwhile, scored 955 points in his three seasons at Boston College and William & Mary, needing 45 more points to pass 1,000 for his career.

KNIGHT NOTES

SMITH STARTS SEASON NUMBER TWO WITH KNIGHTS

- After transferring from George Washington and sitting out a season, Collin Smith saw his first action with UCF in 2018-19, starting 32 of 33 games at the forward position.
- Smith averaged 8.0 points and 5.2 rebounds in 22.1 minutes per game, playing alongside Tacko Fall down low.
- With Fall gone, Smith will look to take on a larger role on both sides of the floor.
- Last season, Smith's biggest moment was scoring 21 points on 8-of-15 shooting and grabbing seven rebounds in a road win at no. 6 Houston.
- He also had 18 points and 10 rebounds at SMU and additional double-doubles against Georgia Southern and Rider.

HAIL CEASAR

(407) 823-1000

- Ceasar DeJesus returns to action for his junior season in 2019-20, having played in 60 games over the course of two seasons with the Knights.
- The crafty guard started all 32 games as a redshirt freshman, before moving to a reserve role in the 2018-19 season.
- DeJesus has averaged 6.2 points during his career, shooting 73.8 percent from the free throw line and dishing out 78 assists.

BERTZ IS BACK

- After a successful first season in Orlando, Frank Bertz comes into his season campaign with experience under his belt.
- Bertz played in all 33 games last season, averaging 3.1 points and 1.4 rebounds per game.
- Not afraid to shoot it, the Californian knocked down 34 three-pointers on 35.1 percent shooting from beyond the arc.
- He also hit on 77.8 percent of his free throw attempts as a junior.
- Bertz scored in double figures twice in 2018-19 vs. Saint Joseph's and Western Kentucky, but also had nine in the NCAA Tournament win over VCU.

BEATING RANKED OPPONENTS

- Prior to Johnny Dawkins' arrival at UCF, the program had won three games against ranked opponents from 1984-2016. Since Dawkins has taken over, the Knights have won four games against ranked opponents in just three seasons.
- UCF had never won two games against ranked opponents in a single season, and the Knights did
 it in a span of five days, taking down no. 6/8 Houston and no. 19/20 Cincinnati late last season.
- The Knights are now 7-46 all-time against ranked opponents, with the other two wins under Dawkins coming at home to no. 15 Cincinnati in 2016-17 and on the road at no. 24 Alabama in 2017-18.

OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

- Known for their defense the last few years under Johnny Dawkins, the Knights were extremely
 efficient offensively in 2018-19.
- UCF led the league in field goal percentage, shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, up from 42.4 percent in 2017-18.
- The Knights shot over 50 percent 10 times and under 40 percent just four times.
- In the win over Temple on Jan. 2, the Knights shot a season-high 60.4 percent from the field.
- In 2017-18, UCF held a 0.8 assist-to-turnover ratio, but in 2018-19, the Knights had a 1.1 assist-to-turnover ratio.



Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016 and in just three seasons he has led the program to new heights, including the Knights' first NCAA Tournament victory in 2018-19.

Dawkins also earned UCF its first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2018-19. The Knights were a nine seed in the tourney, their highest seed in five NCAA Tournament appearances, and defeated eighth seeded VCU, 73-58 in first-round action.

UCF then came inches away from upsetting top overall seed Duke in the second round, ultimately falling 77-76 to Mike Krzyzewski, Zion Williamson, RJ Barrett and company as BJ Taylor's floater rimmed out and Aubrey Dawkins'

tip-in barely missed at the buzzer.

The Knights were stellar down the stretch to secure their at-large NCAA Tournament berth winning on the road at No. 6/8 Houston to snap the Cougars' 33-game home win streak, and then topping No. 19/20 Cincinnati in Orlando on Senior Knight. It marked the first time UCF had earned multiple victories over ranked opponents in the same season, and the Knights did it in back-to-back games.

UCF finished the year 24-9, tied for the fourth most wins in a single season in program history. The Knights' 23 regular season wins marked a new record in UCF's Division I era. The team went 13-5 in American Athletic Conference play, the team's most league wins since joining The American, and earned the four seed in the conference tournament for the second time in three seasons.

Known for their defense under Dawkins, the Knights ranked 11th in the nation in defensive field goal percentage, holding opponents to just 39.4 percent from the floor in 2018-19. UCF was also 27th in scoring defense, allowing 64.5 points per game.

UCF cracked the Associated Press Top 25 Poll for the first time since 2011, earning a ranking of 25th late in the regular season. It was the latest into a season that the Knights have ever been ranked. The home finale against Cincinnati marked the first matchup of ranked teams at Addition Financial Arena.

Dawkins led UCF back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005, and the first time as an at-large selection. The previous four NCAA Tournaments were as champions of the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament in 1994, 1996, 2004 and 2005.

He helped three individuals earn all-conference accolades from The American in 2018-19, as UCF led the league with three honorees. B.J. Taylor became the first Knight to earn first team honors from The American, while Aubrev Dawkins was named second team and Tacko Fall added third team honors.

Following the end of the regular season, Dawkins was named a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

In three years, Johnny Dawkins has led UCF to new heights on the basketball court, but he has done an even better job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team GPA over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history. They then did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 last spring.

Dawkins took over at UCF after the Knights had gone 12-18 and hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13. He led the Black and Gold to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever – in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion SMU in the semifinals.

It was a season full of firsts in 2016-17, as UCF hosted its first NIT game, defeating Colorado for the program's first win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first sell-out crowd at Addition Financial Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all NCAA Division I teams in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year. Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards his first season at UCF.

In year two at the helm. Dawkins had to deal with significant injuries to his three best players. His son, Aubrey Dawkins, missed the entire season with a shoulder injury, B.J. Taylor missed the first half of the season, and Tacko Fall missed the second half of the year. Taylor and Fall only played one game together.

Through the injuries, Dawkins led the Knights to a 19-13 record, at that point second only to his first season record in the last five years of UCF Basketball. The team also had a number of firsts in year two under Dawkins.

And the defense was as good as ever in Dawkins' second year coaching the Black and Gold.

STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.

DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. 
