THE FACTS...

The University of Miami volleyball team has a two-fold story breaking this weekend as they host two of the league's most-respected teams in the form of Georgia Tech and Clemson. The Hurricanes have a chance to possibly tie for the lead in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) race if they can accumulate back-to-back wins against two teams that have posed as tricky antagonists for the 'Canes in recent years. The other story line, the Senior Day celebration for Bridget Bomhack, Angelica Ellis and Ashley Woods on Sunday afternoon.

UM will have to keep their composure this weekend as they were able to come away from Atlanta with a win last month over the Yellow Jackets, but were unable to solve a powerful Clemson offense a night prior. The ACC regular season title, since there is no post-season tournament, is alive and well with the 'Canes as they are in a deadlock in second place with Georgia Tech. Above the Orange and Green by a game are Duke, Clemson and UNC.

Miami swept the Blue Devils this year for the first time in school history, and they have already defeated North Carolina once this year in Coral Gables. UM needs a little help, however, as Duke still needs to drop a match, and UM needs to stay the course and defeat both opponents this weekend. Miami is seeking their second NCAA Tournament appearance all-time, and their first since the 2002 season when they advanced to the Sweet 16 before falling to Nebraska.

The Hurricanes don't exactly have history on their side this weekend as they have only beaten the Tigers of Clemson once in history (W, 3-2 in Coral Gables on Sept. 30, 2005), and earned just their third victory all-time against the Yellow Jackets of Georgia Tech earlier this year. But with the Hurricanes playing incredible volleyball this year, earning just their third 20-win season since bringing the program back in 2001--as well as their best overall season since joining the ACC in 2004, the 'Canes could be on their way to a historical run.

ON GEORGIA TECH...

Georgia Tech comes into this weekend's matches against UM and FSU after dropping a match with Duke last weekend to bring them into a tie for second place alongside the Hurricanes in the ACC standings. The Yellow Jackets are charged by Talisa Kellogg who's on the cusp of 300 kills as she now stands with 299. Beside her are Callie Miller (263) and Chrissy DeMichelis (180). The setters for the Rambling Wreck are two-fold, something that has caused the Hurricanes problems throughout the season. They look towards Allie Niekamp (658 assists) before leaning on Mary Ashley Tippins (430 assists) to quarterback the offensive attack.

The defensive efforts of the Yellow Jackets are led by Michelle Kandell with a team-high 420 digs, while Callie Miller supplies the blocking power with 107 blocks (96 assisted).

ON CLEMSON...

Clemson comes into this weekend sporting a 19-7 record (11-4 ACC) after winning four of their last five matches. That includes wins over Virginia, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest, respectively. The Tigers are currently a part of the three-way dance atop the ACC standings with Duke and North Carolina. The preseason ACC champions started off the year in unusual waters with a few tough losses, but have turned it on since earning a 10-2 record since Sept. 27.

They are sparked by the play of two players in the form of Danielle Hepburn (356 kills) and Lia Proctor (333 kills), as well as Kelsey Murphy (980 assists) setting up the offense. The blocks are recorded primarily by Hepburn (136 blocks) and Murphy (104 blocks). The defense is anchored by three players as the Tigers don't use a "libero" of sorts. The digs are collected by Proctor (250 digs), Murphy (248 digs) and Jeannette Abbott (207 digs). Abbott also has 267 kills on offense to be the third player on

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

The matches to be shown on ACC Select include home stands against Duke (Oct. 31) and a match at home against Clemson (Nov. 16).

EMERGING AS A LEADER ON AND OFF THE COURT...

The Hurricanes' senior right side hitter Ashley Woods has certainly emerged as a leader in the past five years with the program. Commonly referred to as "Woods" around the UM family, the Round Rock, Texas native has served in several varieties in and around the UM campus, as well as assisting with basketball and community service areas. She owns to date, 649 kills, 208 blocks and 149 digs, proving she's an all-around player. She has been awarded several team honors at UM, including the 100% Award in 2006 for dedication 100 percent day-in and day-out. For her efforts, she was named as a Team Captain in 2008, and earned the 2007 Hurricane Invitational MVP award. She has seen more action than any other player at UM this year while suiting up in 112 matches and seeing time in 348 sets, also a team-high.

FAMILIAR FACE ALONG THE SIDELINES...

First-year UM assistant coach Laura Kuhn is no stranger to the Georgia Tech program as she was a standout performer for head coach Bond Shymansky as a hitter. She produced more than 800 kills and 225 blocks throughout her four-year career at GT. She also held a .272 clip throughout her career. Kuhn served as an outside hitter for the Yellow Jackets from 2001-04 before graduating in 2005.

HURRICANES SAY GOOD-BYE TO SENIORS...

On Sunday, the University of Miami family will say "Good Bye" to three volleyball seniors who have been with the Hurricanes family for four or more years. Bridget Bomhack, Angelica Ellis and Ashley Woods will all play in their final home volleyball match-up inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex when they host the Tigers of Clemson University on Nov. 16. They will also be saying good-bye to senior manager Kelley Schoonover.

MIAMI VS. GEORGIA TECH SERIES...

With a win earlier this year in Atlanta, the Hurricanes brought the series down to a manageable distance of 5-3 in favor of the Yellow Jackets. Miami's win also snapped a three-match losing streak to the Rambling Wreck dating back to Nov. 2, 2006. The 'Canes have only been swept once in the series as two matches have been 3-2 losses. The only sweep occurred on Oct. 30, 2004 in the first-ever meeting between the two teams.

MIAMI VS. CLEMSON SERIES...

The Clemson Tigers hold a commanding 7-1 advantage in the series with Miami, winning the previous six meetings in a row dating back to 2005. The last victory for the Hurricanes was back on Sept. 30, 2005 in Coral Gables. The 'Canes have yet to taste victory in Death Valley where they hold a 0-5 all-time record. All meetings between these two teams have taken place since UM joined the league back in 2004.

LOESSBERG MAKES ACES INTO SCHOOL HISTORY...

Against North Carolina on Oct. 18, junior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg registered six service aces in the match. That last ace moved the Sacramento, California native into a tie for second place all-time in UM history for aces in a single match. She is now tied with Kristi Sprenkel who set the original second-place mark back on Oct. 24, 2001 against Nova Southeastern.

GALLAGHER, MAYHEW HAVE HISTORICAL NIGHTS...

In the loss to the Virginia Cavaliers on Oct. 24, sophomore setter Katie Gallagher had 51 assists to give her sole possession of second place all-time in

school history for assists. Gallagher passed Mallory James (2001-04) with 2,202 assists to her credit in just two years in the Orange and Green. She trails all-time leader Jill Robinson (2003-06) by 2,735. Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew's 17 digs added her name to an elite group of athletes in UM volleyball history as she moved into the "500 Club", now holding more than 500 kills and 500 digs in a career.

MIAMI IN THE ACC RANKINGS...

Miami may have split two matches last weekend, but the Hurricanes are still ranked in several categories in the top 10 of the ACC. Currently, as a team, UM is fourth in hitting percentage (.248) and assists (1,086), second in kills (1,205), second in service aces (146), third in digs (1,487) and seventh in blocks (207.5). Individually, UM has senior Angelica Ellis at eighth place in the ACC in hitting percentage (.330), Lane Carico sixth in kills (286) and Genny Mayhew seventh (275), as well as Katie Gallagher fifth in assists (887). Also ranked is Gallagher seventh in service aces (28) and Carico 10th (26), as well as Lici McGee fourth in blocks (60). In the digs category, Cassie Loessberg is second overall (432).

ON THESE DATES IN HISTORY...

On these dates in history, the Hurricanes hold an impeccable record on Nov. 14, but an even mark on Nov. 16. In matches played on Nov. 14, the Orange and Green is 4-1 all-time with their only loss coming against FIU back in 1974. Some of their big wins have come against Florida and USF back in 1975. In matches played on Nov. 16, the 'Canes are 3-3 all-time. They last lost on Nov. 16 when they visited Georgia Tech in 2007.

20-WIN SEASON IN THE BAG FOR FIRST TIME IN ACC...

After defeating ACC power Duke last Friday night in Coral Gables, the University of Miami volleyball team assured themselves their first 20-win season since joining the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). The 'Canes are now 20-5 overall, and have a chance to record their best record in NCAA Division I history. The current record (27-6) was set during their magical NCAA Sweet 16 run in 2002. The school record, however, is a 49-14-1 season back in 1980 when the Hurricanes were members of the old AIAW league, not associated with the NCAA.

MIAMI LOOKING FOR 11 WINS...

If Miami can amass just one more win, then they will tie for the most amount of wins in league play since arriving in the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2004. The Hurricanes have never had 12 wins in league play, but have a great chance at that this year with five matches still left to be played on the cam-

paign.

HOME IS WHERE THE HITS ARE...

At home this year in the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex, the 'Canes have yet to hit below a .200 clip. In fact, they are averaging a .263 hitting percentage (528-166-1375) at home. Meanwhile, opponents are being held to a .180 clip (461-207-1409) at "The Knight."

SHUTTING THE DOOR...

Miami has shutout 13 opponents this season in 27 matches on the campaign. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. This is now the most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC back in 2004.

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 457 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,327. The Sacramento, Calif. junior is just 294 digs behind the all-time leader, Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the top place in school history. With an average of 4.86 digs per set, and at least 15 sets to play, the junior All-ACC Candidate could break the record by the 10th match of the 2009 season.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.

'CANES STUMBLE IN RECORD SEEKING...

Seeking to tie or break the school record for wins to start the year (15-0, 2002), the 2008 Hurricane squad went 13-0 before

falling at Wake Forest. It was, however, the second-best start for any Miami volleyball team in school history. Only one other time had the 'Canes held an undefeated record entering the month of October.

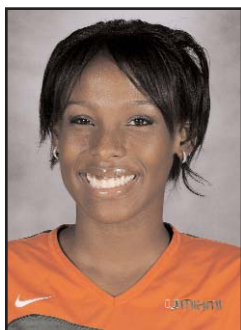

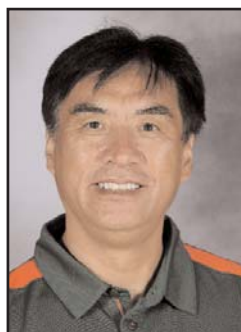
