No. 20 Miami Returns Home to Host Wake Forest and Duke...

After a tough three-match Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) road stretch at Florida State, Virginia Tech and Virginia, the No. 20 University of Miami Hurricanes return home to host the Wake Forest Demon Deacons and Duke Blue Devils this weekend.

Miami (11-1, 2-1 ACC) enters the weekend with an eight-match home win streak intact dating back to last year versus Duke. The Blue Devils were predicted as the preseason champion by the ACC head coaches prior to the season.

Head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch and the Hurricanes will look towards a strong front line with Ali Becker, Emani Sims and Alex Johnson. Sims, a redshirt freshman, leads all players with 40 blocks, while senior Becker is just behind her with 37.

Johnson leads the team in kills (131) and Carico sits just behind her with 116 (3.05 per set). Carico is also second on the team in digs with 164 (4.32). Setter Katie Gallagher leads the team in assists with 430 (10.75 a/s). Sophomore libero Ryan Shaffer tops the team in digs with 184 (4.60 d/s).

As a team, Miami ranks second in the ACC for kills per set (14.35). In their 11 wins on the season, the Canes have claimed eight sweeps of its opponents.

Scouting Wake Forest...

Wake Forest enters Friday's contest with a 4-8 overall record and a 1-2 mark in the ACC. The Demon Deacons are 0-2 on the road this season.

Wake Forest is led by Kadija Fornah with 130 kills (3.17 k/s) and Carlin Salmon with 115 (2.80 k/s). Salmon leads the team in blocks (46) and Dani Thompson is the team's leader in digs with 134 (3.44 d/s). Right behind her in digs is Fornah with 115 (2.80 d/s).

Series Against the Demon Deacons...

Miami leads the all-time series against Wake Forest by an 8-4 count. The Hurricanes have won the last three consecutive meetings against the Demon Deacons.

Scouting Duke...

ACC preseason favorite Duke comes into the weekend with a 9-4 overall record, but an unblemished 3-0 mark in the conference. The Blue Devils are coming off of a gutsy five-set win over Clemson last Saturday in a match

that featured the second lost fifth set during the NCAA's rally scoring era. The Blue Devils fought off six match points in that final frame to eventually claim a 25-23 fifth-set victory after trailing two sets to one in the fourth set.

Junior middle blocker Christiana Gray was named ACC Player of the Week for her performance last weekend. Gray hit .457 with 24 kills in the two victories and hoisted Duke to the win over Clemson by connecting on nine of her final 11 attacks without committing an error. Gray has hit .438 or better in three straight matches, all of which are Duke victories. The 6-5 middle blocker is part of a balanced Duke attack that features four players with at least 100 kills.

Series Against the Blue Devils...

Duke holds a commanding 10-3 advantage in the all-time series against UMiami. The Blue Devils have won the previous three meetings against the Hurricanes. However, Miami won both match-ups in 2008, including the school's first-ever win in Durham.

The Blue Devils gave UM its last home loss a season ago on the strength of an action-packed 3-2 come-from-behind decision.

Miami on the National Stage...

When Miami travelled to Florida State for a nationally televised game on ESPNU on Sept. 14, and that was the first nationally televised contest for the Hurricanes in school history. UMiami will host Virginia Tech in another televised match on Oct. 30.

Carico Approaching School Record...

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico needs just 23 kills to pass Karla Johnson (2002-05) on the school's all-time list for career kills. Currently, Carico has 1,462 career kills.

Miami Storms Through Commonwealth State...

Last weekend, the No. 21 Hurricanes swept through the state of Virginia defeating both Virginia Tech and Virginia with 3-0 decisions. For UMiami, it was the first time since 2007 it had beaten the Cavaliers of UVa on the road.

Canes Stumble in Conference Opener...

Playing in its first match ever as a ranked team, Miami fell to homestanding Florida State in the league-opener for both teams Wednesday, Sept. 14 at Tully Gym in Tallahassee.

The Canes had their 14-match regular season

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Sports Media Relations at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

UMiami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch collected her 200th career win following the Hurricanes 3-0 win over Auburn. Lantagne Welch is already the winningest coach in UM volleyball history, and has served as the only coach since the program was brought back in 2001.

Miami Takes Hurricane Invitational Title...

With wins against FAMU, Auburn and nationally ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes collected their second consecutive Hurricane Invite title inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. Overall, the Canes have won four of the last five Hurricane Invitational titles. The win over No. 18 Oklahoma was the first win for the Hurricanes over a ranked team since Dec. 7, 2002 when they defeated No. 15 Wisconsin in the Madison [Wis.] Regional of the NCAA Tournament.

Carico Repeats as ACC Player of the Week...

University of Miami senior outside hitter Lane Carico was once again selected as ACC Player of the Week (Sept. 12-18). This marked the second straight week Carico picked up conference player of the week accolades.

The Manhattan Beach, Calif. native compiled 30 kills on a .258 hitting percentage for 3.75 kills per set and had 32 digs in eight sets. She also had five blocks and four service aces. Carico came up huge in the win over No. 18 Oklahoma with 19 kills and 16 digs to help pull off the come-from-behind upset. It was the first victory over a ranked opponent for the Hurricanes since December 7, 2002, when Miami beat No. 15 Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament.

Carico, Gallagher, Johnson All-Tournament...

Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Alex Johnson were all named to the Hurricane Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping UMiami to the tournament title. Carico picked up Hurricane Invitational MVP honors in staking a season-high 19 kills and posting 16 digs in the championship match win over the Sooners.

Gallagher Moves Into Record Books...

During the Hurricane Invitational, redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher became just the second player in UMiami volleyball history to post at least 4,000 assists and 1,000 digs in a career. She joins Jill Robinson (2003-06) as the only other Hurricanes player to do so.

Lane Carico Wins ACC Player of the Week...

Lane Carico was named as the Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week (Sept. 4-10) after turning in 3.10 kills per set and 5.00 digs per set in three matches at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic* in Malibu, Calif. The Canes won the tournament with a 3-1 decision against the host Pepperdine Waves.

Carico Takes Top Honors...

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico finished as the top offensive performer at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic*. She was named the Tournament MVP after helping Miami to the tournament title.

UMiami redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher handed out 39 assists and sophomore outside hitter Alex Johnson raked in 10 digs to go along with eight kills. Lizzie Hale and Taylor Hollins each recorded two service aces as UM finished with six as a team.

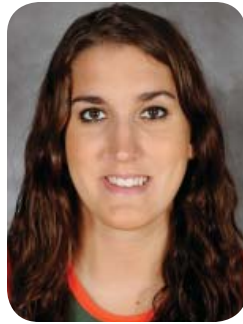

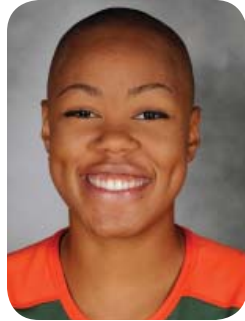
