**THE FACTS...**

The Hurricanes are looking to rebound quickly from their first loss in 15 matches dating back to their last loss ... Nov. 16, 2007 at Georgia Tech. UM's loss at Wake Forest was the second time ever they had fallen in Winston-Salem to the Demon Deacons, and just their third loss ever to the Deacs. However, Miami's hard-fought win over perennial power Duke was just their second-ever win over the Blue Devils, and the first in Durham.

There will be little time to heal, however, as the next two opponents for the 'Canes own a combined 11-3 record against the Orange and Green all-time. Clemson holds a commanding 6-1 lead over UM, while Georgia Tech leads the series, 5-2. The last time Miami defeated the Tigers was Sept. 30, 2005. Since that time, Clemson has used a set-advantage of 15-4, including 3-0 sweeps in the last two outings. The Hurricanes have never won in *Death Valley*.

Against the Yellow Jackets of Georgia Tech, the Hurricanes have felt their struggles as well, falling in the last three matches consecutively. The last UM win came back on Sept. 30, 2006 where the Orange and Green collected a 3-1 win in Atlanta, Ga.

Though falling out of the ranks of the unbeatens, Miami still picked up several other votes this week in the AVCA polls. Penn State still holds a commanding lead as the top-ranked team in the country after collecting all 60 first place votes with an unblemished 14-0 mark. Behind them is Nebraska (12-0) at No. 2. The only two other remaining unbeaten teams in the country are Wichita State (14) and Pepperdine (15).

**ON CLEMSON...**

Though starting the year slow at 9-5 (1-2 ACC), the Clemson Tigers are still the preseason favorites to win the Atlantic Coast Conference. The Tigers are led by a dynamic duo of hitters in the form of Lia Proctor and Danielle Hepburn. Proctor holds 195 kills while Hepburn is right behind her with 190. The setter for the Tigers is Kelsey Murphy, currently fourth in the league is assists with 545. The libero/defensive specialist duties for the Tigers fall on Didem Ege with a league fourth-best 226 digs.

**ON GEORGIA TECH...**

Attacking power and precise blocking is fundamental points of the game in "HOT"lanta, and Georgia Tech proves that year-in and year-out. The Yellow Jackets are 10-3 (2-1 ACC) so far and have a fantastic player in the form of Alison Campbell. Campbell, selected as the ACC Player of the Week (Sept. 1-8) sits third on the team in kills with 118, and fifth in blocks (18). Leading the charge for the Jackets, however, is Callie Miller with 131 kills and a team second-best 45 blocks. Talisa Kellogg holds 129 kills, while Mary Ashley Tippins (335) and Allie Niekamp (237) share time at the setter position. The defense falls on Michelle Kandell who leads the squad with 108 digs.

**MIAMI VS. CLEMSON SERIES...**

The Clemson Tigers hold a commanding 6-1 advantage in the series with Miami, winning all five of the last five meetings. The last victory for the Hurricanes was back on Sept. 30, 2005 in Coral Gables. The 'Canes have yet to taste victory in Death Valley where they hold an 0-4 all-time record. All meetings between these two teams have taken place since UM joined the league back in 2004.

## Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

**HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY****KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

**MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES**

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

**MEDIA SERVICES**

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

**WEBSITES**

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

**INTERVIEWS**

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

**TELEPHONES**

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/Media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

Hurricanes and winning three of the last five contests. UM lost two straight when they entered the league in 2004; bounced back to win back-to-back matches; with Georgia Tech taking the last three.

**FALL SEASON. SPLIT DECISION...**

With the arrival of the fall season, and the beginning of October, Miami is 8-8 overall in the first match of October dating back to the program's inception (1973), followed by the resurgence (2001). UM is just 2-2 in their month-opening matches since joining the league in 2004, with both losses coming to their opponents for this weekend--Clemson and Georgia Tech.

**SPOTLIGHT ON THE STATS...**

Miami is ranked in several statistical categories in the latest national polls. The 'Canes are 34th nationally in blocks per set (2.55); 42nd in aces per set (1.67); 39th in digs per set (15.78); 21st in hitting percentage (.268); and ultimately 6th in winning percentage at 13-1 (.929). Junior Cassie Loessberg is ranked 33rd in the nation for digs per set (4.67).

Seeking to tie or break the school record for wins to start the year (15-0, 2002), the 2008 Hurricane squad went 13-0 before falling last Friday night at Wake Forest. It was, however, the second-best start for any Miami volleyball team in school history. Only one other time had the 'Canes held an undefeated record entering the month of October.

**SWEEPING UP AFTER THE HURRICANE...**

It's been a sweeping adventure for the Miami Hurricanes as they have swept (3-0) through opponents in straight-sets in 11 of their last 15 victories dating back to Nov. 3, 2007 when they defeated Wake Forest on the road. The sweep for WFU against the 'Canes was the first time UM had been swept since Nov. 15, 2007 at Clemson.

**TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...**

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 229 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,099. That sets Loessberg at second place all-time in UM history behind Jamie Grass (2001-04) with 1,621 digs under her belt. Throughout the year, we will continue to track Loessberg in her goal to become the all-time leading digs collector at UM.

**HURRICANES SWEEPING TO YOUR TOWN...**

Miami has never been afraid of taking the "show" on the road, and that's exactly where the Hurricanes will have to go through five consecutive contests beginning Saturday, Sept. 20 at nearby Florida Atlantic. In fact, UM will travel to ACC foes Duke, Wake Forest, Clemson and Georgia Tech in straight road matches.

**MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...**

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

**CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...**

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.

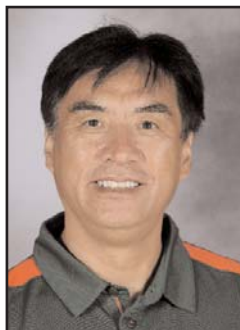
