Miam has six players with at least 10 aces on the year, led by ACC leader Olga Strantzali.

QUICK HITS

- Head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara beat Clemson 3-0 on Oct. 4 to earn his 50th head coaching win.
- Taylor Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Sept. 14, Miami's first weekly award winner in 2015. Olga Strantzali is a two-time ACC Player of the Week and Anna Haak won Freshman of the Week.
- Senior Alexis Mourning ranks ninth in the ACC with a .344 hitting percentage.
- . Sophomore setter Haley Templeton ranks fourth in the ACC with 10.72 assists per set. She has tallied a career-high 56 assists twice in 2015 (Oct. 11 at Duke and Oct. 16 at NC State)
- . Miami ranks second in the ACC with 1.41 service aces/set and fourth with a .241 attack percentage. The Hurricanes are also seventh with 12.46 assists/set and seventh with 13.33 kills/set.
- Junior Kelsie Groot recorded double-digit kills in 13 consecutive matches, beginning with a then careerhigh 19 in Miami's five-set victory over Kansas State and ending in the Canes' win at Wake Forest.
- Two Canes have tallied a season-high eight blocks in a match this season: Sakile Simmons (vs. Kansas State, 8/29) and Lucia Pampana (vs. Marquette, 9/5)
- Senior Alexis Mourning has earned two All-Tournament selections: Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational and the LSU Tournament.
- The Canes advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the third time in program history when they beat UCF in five sets on Dec. 5, 2014. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach and Miami's first NCAA Tournament win since they beat Northern Illinois in four sets in the first round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament.

Gandara has led the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments in his time at the helm of the Miami volleyball program. The Canes were selected to the 2015 NCAA Tournament after a regular season that saw them finish 21-9 overall and 14-6 in the ACC. The 21 wins marked the second consecutive 20-win season under Gandara's leadership and Miami saw seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott, as well as sophomores Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton, named to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team.

Miami reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach. Miami's 22 wins also gave Gandara his first 20-win season at the helm of the program.

The Canes reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Gandara helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savanah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selections and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

The 2013 season was filled with firsts for Gandara. He secured his first win as a NCAA head coach on Aug. 30, when Miami defeated Austin Peay, 3-1. Gandara collected his first home win when Miami beat LSU in five sets on Sept. 14. The first-year head coach tallied his first ACC win when the Canes defeated Boston College in five sets on Sept. 28. Gandara also guided the Canes to their fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance and first under his tutelage.

The Hurricanes dropped their first round match against Oregon in three sets, but 2013 was still a successful first season under Gandara. Miami had four players earn All-ACC distinction, including Savanah Leaf and Emani Sims (first team), Alexis Mourning (second team) and Ryan Shaffer (third team). The Canes defeated No. 12 North Carolina at home and earned one of the coveted 64 spots in the NCAA Tournament.

Gandara comes to Miami after spending the past eight years as an assistant at the University of Washington. He previously served as an assistant at UNLV and his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

"I feel like I've been working for this moment for a long time," Gandara said. "It's a tough job and I wanted to be in the right situation

with good support and good people around me. I was confident in my abilities and I think Miami fit that match."

Gandara is a highly-respected teacher who has played and coached at the top levels of college and professional volleyball. Keno assisted Washington head coach Jim McLaughlin with all aspects of coaching, including opponent scouting and contributing to the Huskies' defensive package.

"We are excited for Jose to join the UM family," said Jennifer Strawley, Miami's senior women's administrator. "He brings a wealth of volleyball

experience, has been a part of a top volleyball program and has tremendous recruiting connections."

Gandara began his coaching career at UCSB in 1992 as an assistant with the men's team and was an assistant with the women's team in 1994. He also spent one season as a head coach/player with the San Juan Volleyball club in the Puerto Rico Professional League.

"Jose is well respected by his peers in the volleyball community and is committed to developing our student-athletes both on and off the volleyball court," Strawley said. "Most importantly, he will be an asset to the athletic department and the university community."

A San Juan, Puerto Rico native, Gandara graduated from UC Santa Barbara in 1990 after a successful volleyball career with the Gauchos as a middle blocker. Gandara was a first team All-America selection in 1989 and second team selection in 1988 after leading UCSB to the national title match. He was also a two-time all-conference honoree. Gandara has also been inducted into the UCSB Hall of Fame. He also represented both the United States and Puerto Rico in international competition as a member of their respective national volleyball teams.

Gandara is married to Stephanie Cox who was a standout setter at UCSB and played on the AVP Tour. The couple welcomed their first child, a son named Lucas, in April 2011.



Assistant Sanja Tomasevic

Second Season | Washington, 2006

Sanja Tomasevic joined the Miami volleyball staff on February 17, 2014, accepting an assistant coaching position.

In her first season at Miami, Tomasevic helped the Canes reach the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Miami reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Tomasevic helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savanah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selections and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

Tomasevic came to Miami from Texas-San Antonio (UTSA). She spent two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the Roadrunners after successful professional and collegiate volleyball careers.

Miami head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara coached Tomasevic in his first season as an assistant coach at the University of Washington and helped develop her into one of the greatest players in Huskies volleyhall history.

A two-time All-American and the 2005 Asics and CVU.com National Player of the Year at Washington, Tomasevic led the Huskies to four NCAA tournament appearances, including the 2005 National Championship, and a pair of Pac-10 Conference titles.

The former outside hitter ended her collegiate career as Washington's all-time leader in points

(2,159.5), kills (1,795) and service aces (156). She is one of only three players in Huskies history to record 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs.

While she was a standout on the court, she has also excelled in her two seasons as a coach.

In 2013, UTSA finished 24-8 overall and 13-1 in Conference USA. The Roadrunners were the C-USA champions and earned the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, where they dropped their first round match to Texas A&M in three sets. Tomasevic helped develop McKenzie Adams into the 2013 Conference USA Player of the Year and a third team AVCA All-American. Under Tomasevic's tutelage, Adams earned All —Southwest Region honors, All Conference USA accolades and she was also the NCAA Division I statistical champion for kills per set with a nation-best 5.78.

In 2012, Tomasevic helped the Roadrunners to a 21-9 overall record and a 13-5 mark in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC). UTSA, which tied for second in the league standings, advanced to the WAC Tournament semifinals.

UTSA capitalized on Tomasevic's attacking tutelage en route to leading the league with 14.35 kills per set. Outside hitter McKenzie Adams ranked second in the WAC with 4.33 kills per set and was named an AVCA honorable-mention All-American and the league's Player of the Year. Three other Roadrunners gained postseason honors, including Annie Kunes who was named the WAC Libero of the Year.

The Serbia native played seven years professionally, including the last two as a co-captain of POMI Casalmaggiore in Italy. She was named to four All-Star Games and was named the Best Server at the 2010 European Challenge Cup. She won three league championships, including back-to-back Greek titles with Panathinaikos in 2009 and 2010.

Tomasevic graduated from Washington in 2006 with a bachelor's degree in communications.



Assistant Kasey Crider

First Season | Pepperdine, 2011

Kasey Crider accepted a position as assistant coach on the Miami volleyball coaching staff in March 2015, joining assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Sanja Tomasevic on the Hurricanes' bench.

Crider comes to Miami after spending two seasons as a volunteer assistant with the Stanford women's volleyball program. A year ago, Crider helped the Cardinal win the Pac-12 Championships and earn the No. 1 overall seed in the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Stanford went 33-2 last season, reaching the semifinals of the 2014 NCAA Tournament before falling to eventual national champion Penn State.

Prior to his time at Stanford, Crider spent the 2012-13 season as a volunteer assistant coach for the men's volleyball team at Pepperdine. Crider played for the Waves from 2008-11 and was a two-time All-American, ending his career ranked second in program history in assists (3,989).

Following his collegiate career, Crider played professionally overseas during the 2011-12 season for Boldklubben Marienlyst, located in Denmark. There, he led the squad to first-place finishes in both the Nordic Cup and Danish Pokal Cup Championships. He was named the Danish Super League Player of the Year, while also earning the Best Setter Award and was picked as MVP of the Danish Pokal Cup Championship.

In addition to being an asset coaching the current crop of Hurricanes, Gandara believes Crider will be an asset in recruiting.

A native of Granite Bay, Calif., Crider graduated from Pepperdine with a degree in journalism in
