**QUICK HITS**

- The Hurricanes will play four matches in the state of North Carolina over the next two weekends
- Taylor Hollins became the fourth different Cane to win ACC Player of the Week on Monday (25 kills, .548 hitting percentage)
- Miami is 5-3 on the road this season
- UM defeated North Carolina and North Carolina State at home in four sets earlier this season
- The Wolfpack have won the most home matches in the nation (14) and the Tar Heels are 10-0 at home
- All-time, Miami is 44-24 (.647) against teams from the state of North Carolina
- Miami has won its last 16 at home and 27 of the last 28 at the Knight Sports Complex, being one of 25 teams in nation to be undefeated at home this year (11-0)
- Emani Sims (27 kills, 23 blocks) was named ACC Player of the Week for the second time this season and Collegiate Volleyball Update National Player of the Week on Oct. 23
- The Hurricanes are the only team to defeat all 11 opposing ACC teams
- Miami also started off 20-3 last year, going all the way to 23-3 - the team finished 26-5
- UM has won its last 21 Friday matches dating back to Dec. 3, 2010 and the last 23 in the regular season
- The Hurricanes moved up one spot in the AVCA Coaches Poll to No. 23 (No. 16 in NCAA RPI)
- The Canes are 14-5 as a ranked team since entering the polls in 2002
- UM defeated Clemson in five sets behind a UM record-setting 16 block performance by Emani Sims, as the team also set a school record with 23 total blocks
- The 10-straight ACC wins are the most consecutive in school history
- It was the first time Miami has ever swept the Clemson-Georgia Tech road trip in program history
- Earlier in the year, UM beat Maryland which was the 100th career ACC win for Nicole Lantagne Welch
- Alexis Mourning was named ACC Co-Player of the Week and a Collegiate Volleyball Update Top Performer after posting 22 kills and 16 total blocks against NC State and North Carolina
- Miami ranks in the top 20 nationally in blocks (10th, 2.99/set), kills (15th, 14.42/set), and assists (16th, 13.46/set)
- UM is ranked first in the ACC in assists (13.46/set) and blocks (2.99/set), while being second in opponent hitting percentage (.161) and third in digs (16.53/set)
- This is the seventh of 10 straight weekends in conference play, as the team went 8-2 against non-conference opponents
- Emani Sims was named ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 1 after recording 32 kills on a .500 hitting percentage against Duke and Wake Forest
- The Canes started ACC play with arguably the best regular season win in program history over then-No. 6 Florida State, the highest ranked team ever defeated - the match set a new attendance record (1,129) at the Knight Sports Complex and was televised nationally on ESPNU
- The win over FSU was the 400th in program history
- Alex Johnson was named the ACC Player of the Week on Sept. 10 after posting 16 kills and 16 digs in the 3-1 win over FSU - she was also honored nationally as a Top Performer by the Collegiate Volleyball Update
- Taylor Hollins has 15 double-doubles in 23 matches this season
- The Hurricanes have won their last 14 neutral site contests, and are 5-3 in true road contests this season (UM went 10-4 on the road in 2011)
- Miami started the season winning all four matches at the Hurricane Invitational, including coming back to defeat Ole Miss after trailing 2-0
- Alex Johnson won MVP at the Hurricane Invitational after racking up 48 kills on a .421 hitting percentage; Taylor Hollins and Alexis Mourning were named all-tournament
- Miami was predicted to finish fifth by the ACC coaches in a preseason poll
- Alex Johnson and Emani Sims were selected Preseason All-ACC
- The recruiting class was ranked No. 27 in the nation according to PrepVolleyball.com

**THE LAST TIME**

**OCT 7, 2012: UM 3, UNC 1**

**CORAL GABLES, Fla.** - Behind a balanced attack and the third-most total blocks in school history, the University of Miami volleyball team defeated North Carolina, 3-1, on Sunday at the Knight Sports Complex. The Canes won their 14th straight at home and are currently riding a four-match winning streak.

UM won by set scores of 25-18, 27-25, 23-25 and 25-14 to improve to 14-3 on the year and 6-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference, while UNC dropped to 13-4 and 4-3. Miami sits in a tie for first in the standings with Florida State, a team the Canes defeated earlier in the season.

"A critical point in the match today was coming back in the second set after UNC took a lead," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "We showed a lot of resiliency there to take a 2-0 advantage, which was important. They put together a strong set in the third, but we were able to regroup with strong blocking and serving to win the fourth."

After winning the first handily, Miami fell behind 23-20 in the second. The Tar Heels then committed an attack error and sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning and junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins each put down kills to even the score at 23. Junior right side Alex Johnson recorded a service ace to give UM set point, but UNC won the next two exchanges to put themselves a point from evening the match. However, the Hurricanes fought back with a kill by Mourning, an attack error and a kill by Johnson to take a commanding 2-0 lead. The set included 12 ties and seven lead changes.

Up against the wall, North Carolina jumped out to a 16-10 advantage in the third and held off a furious UM rally to take a set. The visiting momentum

would not carry over, as Miami took a 10-4 lead and registered six blocks in the fourth to take the match.

Mourning registered a career-high 10 block assists in the match, one off the school record set by Cira Michel at Virginia Tech in 2004. As a team, the Canes had 18.0 total blocks, tied for the third-most in a match in program history. Senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman (seven) matched her career high and sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims set a new season best (eight) at the net.

Johnson and Sims led Miami with 10 kills on the day, while Hollins and Mourning had nine each. Hollins also led the team with 10 digs and Sundararaman registered 40 assists. Twelve different players saw action for the Canes.

"We had some little adjustments throughout the match that we wanted to throw out there to spark a run," Lantagne Welch said. "Our bench played great today and they have continued to lift us."

Chaniel Nelson had a match-high 12 kills for UNC, while Cora Harms recorded 40 assists, 13 digs and six kills.

**OCT. 5, 2012: UM 3, NCSU 1**

**CORAL GABLES, Fla.** - The University of Miami volleyball team defeated North Carolina State, 3-1, on Friday at the Knight Sports Complex to move into a tie for first place in the Atlantic Coast Conference standings. The Canes won their 13th straight at home to snap the Wolfpack's 10-match winning streak.

UM won by set scores of 25-23, 25-17, 20-25 and 25-15 to improve to 13-3 on the year and 5-1 in the ACC, while NCSU dropped to 15-2 and 5-1.

"We just beat a great team that was on a huge winning streak and knows how to win," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "I thought we played some nice volleyball and put together a nice defensive effort."

Sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning had a match-high 13 kills to lead the Hurricanes, while junior Taylor Hollins recorded her 12th double-double of the season with 12 kills and 10 digs. Senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman had 36 assists.

Defensively, junior libero Ryan Shaffer notched a season-high 30 digs in the back row to help hold the Wolfpack to a .089 hitting percentage. Miami hit at a .214 clip for the match.

In the first set, NC State went up 23-20 and seemed poised to take the opener, but the Canes rallied to win the next five points to go up 1-0 in the match. That momentum continued in the second, as Miami went on a 16-6 run to take a commanding advantage that would not be relinquished.

NC State, who had played their previous 13 matches at home, responded after the intermission to win the third set to cut the deficit to 2-1. The Wolfpack then evened the score at 10 in the fourth with sights set on forcing a deciding fifth frame. However, the Hurricanes reeled in 11 of the next 13 points to go up 21-12. UM sealed the win on an attack error from NCSU.

Brie Merriwether led the visitors with 10 kills, while Alston Kearns had 21 digs.

ALMA MATER: MARYLAND '94

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 12th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in nine of the last 11 seasons, including ending the 2011 campaign ranked No. 15 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-4 league mark to finish second in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The Canes spent several weeks in the AVCA Top 25. UM qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the third-straight year, defeating Northern Illinois to advance to the Second Round of the Ames [Iowa] Regional. At the end of the campaign, numerous players earned recognition, including Lane Carico becoming the first Hurricane to win ACC Player of the Year. The senior also earned AVCA All-America honors to cap one of the best careers in Miami history.

This past summer, Lantagne Welch traveled to Ohio to work with the A2 program as part of development for Team USA. In addition, two players associated with the program - Ciara Michel and Savannah Leaf - both competed in the Olympic Games for Team GB.

In 2010, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina. At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles - and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign. Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship. She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Hon-

orable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team. During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002.

During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama. The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif. For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team. Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

### PIONEERING THE FIRST SEASON

On Feb. 28, 2000, then University of Miami Athletic Director Paul Dee proclaimed the return of women's volleyball as the Hurricanes newest fully funded varsity sport at UM. On Sept. 12, 2000, Dee took the next major step in the evolution of the program by announcing the hiring of Lantagne Welch as head coach of the Hurricanes.

### A WINNING HISTORY

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever At-

lantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans. Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking. Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

**HOLLINS EARNS ACC CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**GREENSBORO, N.C.** - Junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins of the nationally-ranked University of Miami volleyball team has been named Atlantic Coast Conference Co-Player of the Week, the league office announced Monday. She becomes the fourth different Hurricane to earn the honor this season.

"It's exciting to have our fourth player honored by the conference and it just shows how balanced we are and that our contributions are coming from all over the court," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "Taylor had an exceptional weekend - she's been taking really great swings on the outside, particularly in the last couple of weeks that has helped us with our continued success. She has such a great all-around game with her passing, defense and attacking."

Hollins, a native of Long Beach, Calif., averaged 4.14 kills per set (25 overall) on an efficient .548 hitting percentage to help Miami pick up two home sweeps over the weekend. She committed just two errors in 42 attempts as an outside hitter and collected 16 digs.

The junior nearly had a double-double in three sets against Virginia Tech on Friday with 14 kills and nine digs. Three of her kills against the Hokies fended off set point, with UM eventually coming back to win the set. Against Virginia, she had 11 kills in 17 attempts with no errors for a career-high .647 match hitting percentage.

For the season, Hollins, who played in the back row as an underclassman, leads the Canes and is eighth in the ACC with 274 kills (3.22/set). She also has a team-high 15 double-doubles.

Hollins joins sophomore Emani Sims (Oct. 1, Oct. 22), sophomore Alexis Mourning (Oct. 8) and junior Alex Johnson (Sept. 10) as Hurricanes to win ACC Player of the Week this year. Miami has had a player recognized by the league in four of the last five weeks.

The junior shares this week's honor with Sareea Freeman of Florida State, the team the Canes are tied with in the league standings. North Carolina's Paige Neuenfeldt won ACC Freshman of the Week.

**ACC-LEADING CANES MOVE TO NO. 23**

**LEXINGTON, Ky.** - Currently tied atop the Atlantic Coast Conference standings, the University of Miami volleyball team improved to No. 23 in the latest American Volleyball Coaches Association Coaches Poll released Monday. The Canes had been at No. 24 the previous two weeks.

UM (20-3, 12-1 ACC) has won its last 10 matches, including home sweeps over Virginia Tech and Virginia over the weekend. The Hurricanes are the only team to have defeated all 11 ACC opponents.

The highest AVCA Coaches Poll ranking in school history is No. 20, reached on Sept. 20 and Sept. 26 of 2011.

In the NCAA RPI, Miami also moved up to No. 16 after being No. 17 last week.

**CANES TAKE DOWN VIRGINIA**

**CORAL GABLES, FLA.** - No. 24 Miami volleyball picked up its third straight sweep with a 3-0 victory over Virginia on Sunday at the Knight Sports Complex. The Canes have now won their last 10 matches over Atlantic Coast Conference opponents, setting a new program-best ACC winning streak.

UM won by the scores of 25-20, 25-21 and 25-18 to improve to 20-3 overall and 12-1 in the conference. It is the sixth 20-win season under head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch.

"It's always great to pick up a conference sweep, they are hard to get," Lantagne Welch said. "Every match is a

challenge and we are pleased to be able to pick up two home wins this weekend."

The Hurricanes continued their balanced play with three players recording double-digit kills, led by 13 by sophomore outside hitter Savannah Leaf. Junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins notched 11 kills on a .647 hitting percentage and sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims hit .600 with 10 slammers.

Junior libero Ryan Shaffer had a match-high 11 digs to anchor the back row, while senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman collected 31 assists.

Miami controlled the match throughout the afternoon, as there were only four lead changes in the three sets. A total of 13 players saw action for the Canes in the win.

Virginia (7-17, 1-12) was led by a match-high 15 kills from Natalie Bausback. UM also defeated UVA in three sets on Sept. 21 in Charlottesville, Va.

**MIAMI ROLLS PAST VIRGINIA TECH**

**CORAL GABLES, FLA.** - After fending off three set points in the first set, No. 24 Miami volleyball took down Virginia Tech in three sets on Friday at the Knight Sports Complex to avenge an earlier season loss to the Hokies. With the sweep, the Canes have now won their last 15 at home and 26 of the last 27 dating back to last season.

UM won by the scores of 28-26, 25-14 and 26-24 to extend its season-long winning streak to nine matches, and improve to 19-3 overall and 11-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The Canes become the first team in the league to defeat all 11 ACC opponents.

Junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins totaled match-highs with 14 kills and nine digs, with senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman picking up 36 assists. Sophomores Savannah Leaf (13) and Alexis Mourning (10) also recorded double-digit slammers.

Sundararaman, the lone senior on the roster, became the fourth player in program history to surpass 2,000 career assists.

Down 23-20 in the opener, Miami won the next three points to even the set. Following a UM service error to make it 24-23 in favor of the visitors, Virginia Tech committed a service error of its own to tie the score. The Hokies then had two more chances, but Hollins knocked in kills each time to continue the frame. VT made another service error and Mourning came through with a successful kill off an assist from Hollins to give the Canes the 1-0 advantage. The set featured 14 ties and three lead changes.

"We are a team that clearly doesn't panic when down in a set," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "We are just going to embrace the situation that we are in and try to get the next point to the best of our ability. I felt like our team has been able to grind it out at the end of sets and that was the case tonight."

Miami then led the next set from start to finish to take a commanding 2-0 lead.

The Hokies fought back in the third with a chance to win at 24-23, but once again Hollins put in a kill to extend into extra points. Following a VT attack error, Mourning ended the match with a kill right down the middle of the court.

Virginia Tech (13-9, 6-6) was led by 11 kills from Jennifer Wiker.

Both teams sported pink shirts during warm-ups in support of the Dig Pink initiative, with donations being accepted throughout the night to benefit breast cancer research.
