- 3 The Hurricanes were picked to finish third in the annual preseason ACC Predicted Order of Finish tabulated by a vote of the league's head coaches.
- 4 The 2016 Canes have no seniors on the roster. Miami has six juniors, four sophomores and five freshmen.
- 5 Miami returns four of seven starters from the 2015 team: outside hitter Olga Strantzali, setter Haley Templeton and middle blockers Sakile Simmons and Lucia Pampana.

The Canes bring back four starters from the 2015 team: juniors Sakile Simmons, Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton and sophomore Lucia Pampana.

Olga Strantzali's 4.25 kills per set rank second in the ACC. The junior is hitting .380 on the season, recording 41 kills through nine sets.

Miami has been selected to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments. In 2015, they faced off against Iowa State in the First Round in Madison, Wis.

Haley Templeton's 10.56 assists per set rank fifth in the ACC.

## AMONG THE BEST IN THE ACC

- Miami leads the ACC in hitting percentage at .278.
- The Hurricanes rank second in the ACC in service aces per set (1.89) and third in assists per set (12.89).
- Haley Templeton leads the ACC with 0.89 service aces per set and ranks fifth in assists per set (10.56).
- Olga Strantzali is second in the ACC with 4.56 kills per set.
- Lucia Pampana ranks seventh in the ACC with 1.50 blocks per set.

## AWARD-WINNING CANES

- Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton were among the 18 student-athletes named to the 2016 Preseason All-ACC Team.
- Templeton and Strantzali were among the four Hurricanes selected second team All-ACC following the 2015 season, joined by seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott.
- Strantzali and Templeton joined Scott to form a trio of Hurricanes named All-ACC Academic in 2015.
- The duo of Templeton and Strantzali were named AVCA all-region honorable mention for the East Coast Region following the 2015 season.
- Miami had three athletes combine for four ACC weekly awards in 2015. Strantzali was a two-time ACC Player of the Week, while Scott earned ACC Player of the Week once. Anna Haak was selected ACC Freshman of the Week following the final weekend of ACC regular season play.

## INTERNATIONAL CANES

- Four of Miami's 15 players on the 2016 roster come from outside the United States: Anna Haak (Sweden), Elizaveta Lukianova (Russia), Lucia Pampana (Italy) and Olga Strantzali (Greece).
- Haak and Strantzali are members of their home country's national team. Haak competed for her native Sweden over the summer, while Strantzali represented Greece.

## TEMPLETON'S AMERICAN DREAM

- Haley Templeton was invited to participate at the 2016 U.S. Women's National Team Open Tryouts, held at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo., on Feb. 19-21.
- Templeton was among the 231 athletes from 88 colleges and universities invited to the tryouts.

## #WELCOMETOHEU

- The Hurricanes have six new players in 2016: junior Alyssa Basdavanos and freshmen Carly Davey, Sara Duque, Madison Dill, Elizaveta Lukianova and Hannah Sorensen.
- Of Miami's six new additions to the 2016 roster, three are defensive specialists (Basdavanos, Davey, Duque), one is an outside hitter (Lukianova), one is a middle blocker (Dill) and one is a setter (Sorensen).
- The Canes also welcome new assistant coach Jillian Hadder to Coral Gables. Hadder came to Miami after coaching indoor and beach volleyball at Mercer University.

## KASEY CRIDER NAMED TOP 30 UNDER 30

- Assistant coach Kasey Crider was selected as a recipient of the American Volleyball Coaches Association 2016 Thirty Under 30 Awards.
- The 26-year-old earned the award following his first season coaching at Miami, helping the Hurricanes reach the NCAA Tournament for the third time under head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara and seventh consecutive time.



## COACHING STAFF



### JOSE "KENO" GANDARA

**Head Coach**

Jose "Keno" Gandara accepted the position of head volleyball coach at the University of Miami in March 2013, becoming the second head coach since the program returned in 2001.

Gandara has led the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments in his time at the helm of the Miami volleyball program. The Canes were selected to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, where they faced Iowa State in a first round match in Madison, Wisc. The Canes finished the season 21-10 and 14-6 in the ACC, while Miami's 21 wins marked the second consecutive 20-win season under Gandara's leadership. The Hurricanes had saw seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott, as well as sophomores Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton, named to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team with Strantzali and Templeton also earning AVCA All-East Coast Region Honorable Mention.

Miami reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach. Miami's 22 wins also gave Gandara his first 20-win season at the helm of the program.

The Canes reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Gandara helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savannah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selections and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

The 2013 season was filled with firsts for Gandara. He secured his first win as a NCAA head coach on Aug. 30, when Miami defeated Austin Peay, 3-1. Gandara collected his first home win when Miami beat LSU in five sets on Sept. 14. The first-year head coach tallied his first ACC win when the Canes defeated Boston College in five sets on Sept. 28. Gandara also guided the Canes to their fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance and first under his tutelage.

The Hurricanes dropped their first round match against Oregon in three sets, but 2013 was still a successful first season under Gandara. Miami had four players earn All-ACC distinction, including Savannah Leaf and Emani Sims (first team), Alexis Mourning (second team) and Ryan Shaffer (third team). The Canes defeated No. 12 North Carolina at home and earned one of the coveted 64 spots in the NCAA Tournament.

Gandara comes to Miami after spending eight years as an assistant at the University of Washington. He previously served as an assistant at UNLV and his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

Gandara is a highly-respected teacher who has played and coached at the top levels of college and professional volleyball. Keno assisted Washington head coach Jim McLaughlin with all aspects of coaching, including opponent scouting and contributing to the Huskies' defensive package.

Gandara began his coaching career at UCSB in 1992 as an assistant with the men's team and was an assistant with the women's team in 1994. He also spent one season as a head coach/player with the San Juan Volleyball club in the Puerto Rico Professional League.

A San Juan, Puerto Rico native, Gandara graduated from UC Santa Barbara in 1990 after a successful volleyball career with the Gauchos as a middle blocker. Gandara was a first team All-America selection in 1989 and second team selection in 1988 after leading UCSB to the national title match. He was also a two-time all-conference honoree. Gandara has also been inducted into the UCSB Hall of Fame. He also represented both the United States and Puerto Rico in international competition as a member of their respective national volleyball teams.

Gandara is married to Stephanie Cox who was a standout setter at UCSB and played on the AVP Tour. The couple welcomed their first child, a son named Lucas, in April 2011.

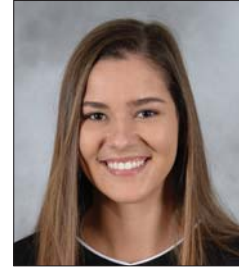

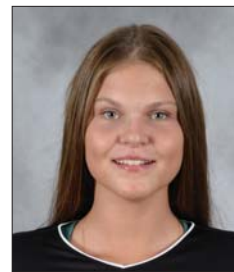
