COMING UP

- The Hurricanes are on the road for the second-straight weekend.
- The Canes will face host school, Texas A&M - Corpus Christi on Sept. 7 at 6:30 p.m., and conclude the trip against Texas Southern on Sept. 8 at 12:30 p.m.

COACHING MILESTONE

- Head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara won his 100th match at Miami after defeating FAU, 3-1, in the season opener.
- Gandara sits third on the all-time wins list in Miami volleyball history, and is just 15 wins behind Cheryl Holt (1978-81) for second place.

DOMINATING NEWCOMERS

- The Hurricanes welcome seven freshmen to the 2018 roster: Chloe Brown, Taylor Burrell, Emily Damon, Priscilla Hernandez, Maddie Naumann, Maya Sullivan and Sophie Walls.
- Miami also welcomes transfer Bridget Wallenberger to Coral Gables. The junior middle blocker enrolled at Miami in January after spending her first two seasons at Milwaukee.
- Brown continues to roll on offense and is second to Elizaveta Lukianova (59) with 58 kills this season.
- Damon's defensive efforts shined this weekend and she has tallied 60 digs after five matches. Damon also leads the Canes with eight service aces, producing four-straight aces against Towson (Aug. 31).
- Wallenberger has produced big numbers on both offense and defense, posting a team-high .366 hitting percentage and a team-leading 22 blocks.

INTERNATIONAL CANES

- Two of Miami's 15 players on the 2018 roster come from outside the United States: redshirt sophomore outside hitter Elizaveta Lukianova (Russia) and senior middle blocker Lucia Pampana (Italy).
- Head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara is a Puerto Rico native and came to the United States to attend UCSB, where he played volleyball.

HALEY'S SENIOR CAMPAIGN

- Haley Templeton enters her senior season after garnering her fourth-straight Preseason All-ACC Team selection.
- Templeton continues to set her teammates up and has recorded 183 assists in five matches, including 13 kills and five service aces.
- Templeton competed with the U.S. Collegiate National Team over the summer, participating in competition in Detroit and representing the U.S. in Croatia at the Pula Global Challenge.
- The standout setter is a three-time All-ACC selection. Most recently in 2017 she also was named AVCA All-America honorable mention and AVCA All-East Coast Region.
- Templeton was one of the best freshmen in the country in 2014, being named the ACC Freshman of the Year and the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.
- Templeton was also named to the 2014 ACC All-Freshman Team after winning five ACC Freshman of the Week awards.
- Templeton sits third in program history with 3,782 career assists, trailing Jill Robinson for second place by 1,155 assists.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- Miami is scheduled to play two matches against two opponents for the first-time in program history while in Corpus Christi, Texas.
- The 0-7 Islanders host Miami and Texas Southern this weekend after a 0-3 weekend at the LSU Tournament. The Islanders are also 0-2 against ACC opponents this season with losses to Clemson and Duke.
- The Texas Southern Tigers are 1-6 entering the weekend, securing their first win last weekend in a 3-1 win against Southern.



JOSE "KENO" GANDARA

Head Coach
Sixth Season
UC Santa Barbara, 1990

Jose "Keno" Gandara accepted the position of head volleyball coach at the University of Miami on March 20, 2013, becoming the second head coach since the program returned in 2001.

The Hurricanes returned the NCAA Championship in 2017 for the fourth time in five seasons under Gandara's leadership. Miami won its first postseason match since 2014, defeating the College of Charleston in the opening round of the tournament in a Gainesville, Fla. The Canes fell to No. 2 Florida in four sets in an exciting second round matchup to close the season 22-6 and finish with their best winning percentage since 2012.

Senior outside hitter Olga Strantzali was named ACC Player of the Year and AVCA East Coast Region Player of the Year. Strantzali was joined by redshirt junior setter Haley Templeton on the All-ACC First Team and AVCA All-East Coast Region team. Strantzali and Templeton topped off a memorable season with AVCA All-America Honorable Mention recognition. The Canes both started and finished the campaign strong, winning the first nine matches and the seven contests prior to falling to second-seeded Florida. Miami topped the ACC in service aces with 1.71 per set and finished the season in the top three of two additional categories – hitting percentage (second with .246) and kills (tied for third with 13.64 per set).

In 2016, Gandara led a resilient Miami squad that proved to rise to the occasion when it stepped into an opponent's gym. The 2016 Hurricanes won 11 matches away from Coral Gables, picking up big road wins at Notre Dame and Louisville. Junior outside hitter Olga Strantzali developed into one of the best players in the country, receiving AVCA All-America honorable mention and earned AVCA All-East Coast Region and First Team All-ACC honors. Strantzali and freshman setter Hannah Sorensen were named to the All-ACC Academic Team in recognition of their success on the court and in the classroom.

Gandara led the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments in his first three seasons at the helm of the Miami volleyball program. The Canes were selected to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, where they faced Iowa State in a first round match in Madison, Wis. The Canes finished the season 21-10 and 14-6 in the ACC, while Miami's 21 wins marked the second consecutive 20-win season under Gandara's leadership. The Hurricanes saw seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott, as well as sophomores Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton, named to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team with Strantzali and Templeton also earning AVCA All-East Coast Region Honorable Mention.

Miami reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach. Miami's 22 wins also gave Gandara his first 20-win season at the helm of the program.

The Canes reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Gandara helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savannah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selec-

tions and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

The 2013 season was filled with firsts for Gandara. He secured his first win as a NCAA head coach on Aug. 30, when Miami defeated Austin Peay, 3-1. Gandara collected his first home win when Miami beat LSU in five sets on Sept. 14. The first-year head coach tallied his first ACC win when the Canes defeated Boston College in five sets on Sept. 28. Gandara also guided the Canes to their fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance and first under his tutelage.

The Hurricanes dropped their first round match against Oregon in three sets, but 2013 was still a successful first season under Gandara. Miami had four players earn All-ACC distinction, including Savannah Leaf and Emani Sims (first team), Alexis Mourning (second team) and Ryan Shaffer (third team). The Canes defeated No. 12 North Carolina at home and earned one of the coveted 64 spots in the NCAA Tournament.

Gandara came to Miami after spending eight years as an assistant at the University of Washington. He previously served as an assistant at UNLV and his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

Gandara is a highly-respected teacher who has played and coached at the top levels of college and professional volleyball. Keno assisted former Washington head coach Jim McLaughlin with all aspects of coaching, including opponent scouting and contributing to the Huskies' defensive package.

Gandara began his coaching career at UCSB in 1992 as an assistant with the men's team and was an assistant with the women's team in 1994. He also spent one season as a head coach/player with the San Juan Volleyball club in the Puerto Rico Professional League.

A San Juan, Puerto Rico, native, Gandara graduated from UC Santa Barbara in 1990 after a successful volleyball career with the Gauchos as a middle blocker. Gandara was a first team All-America selection in 1989 and second team selection in 1988 after leading UCSB to the national title match. He was also a two-time all-conference honoree. Gandara has also been inducted into the UCSB Hall of Fame. He also represented both the United States and Puerto Rico in international competition as a member of their respective national volleyball teams.

Gandara is married to Stephanie Cox who was a standout setter at UCSB and played on the AVP Tour. The couple welcomed their first child, a son named Lucas, in April 2011.

2018 (Senior): Produced 11 kills in the first match of her senior campaign and adding one assist and one service ace against FAU (Aug. 24)... Came back the following match recording 11 more kills along with two block assists and two digs against FGCU (Aug. 25), recorded seven more kills, one service ace and five digs in the final match of the Sunshine State Challenge, against UCF (Aug. 25)... Was named to the Puerto Rico Classic All-Tournament Team after finishing the tournament with 21 kills, four digs and one block (Aug. 31 - Sept. 1).

2017 (Junior): Had eight of her 11 kills, eight of her nine digs, as well as her only block in the Southern Miss Invitational, against Nicholls State (Aug. 26), hitting .386 against the Colonels ... Had one of the best matches in her career in the Sunshine State Classic opener, notching career-high 17 kills, tying her career-best with three assists, in addition to notching season-best five blocks against FAU (Sept. 1) ... capped off the tournament with another double-figures performance at FGCU (Sept. 2) - 12 kills on .321 hitting and six digs on the defensive end ... Repeated career-high of 17 kills and recorded seven digs, a block and an assist in ACC opener against Virginia Tech (Sept. 22), earning a start in the five-set victory over Virginia (Sept. 24) ... Recorded a double-double with career-best 17 kills and 14 digs in the 3-1 win at Notre Dame (Sept. 29), adding two assists in the process ... picked up two kills and three digs in Miami's first defeat of the season, 3-0 at Louisville (Oct. 1) ... Contributed three kills and two digs against Florida State (Oct. 4) and tallied 11 kills on .409 hitting display against Pittsburgh (Oct. 8), while also picking up four digs against the Panthers ... Recorded 13 kills and seven digs at Duke (Oct. 13), then added 11 kills, seven digs and an assist in sweep over Wake Forest (Oct. 15) ... combined for five blocks against the Blue Devils and the Demon Deacons, including a solo block in each contest ... Recorded a career-high of 21 kills against Notre Dame (Oct. 22), a performance complemented by seven digs and a service ace. Two days earlier, Bird picked up 13 kills, nine digs and four blocks in conference victory over Louisville (Oct. 20) ... Picked up 11 kills, two aces and eight digs in a win against NC State (Oct. 27) ... Tied a career high of three assists along with 11 kills, two aces and eight digs in a sweep against defending champion North Carolina (Oct. 29) ... Recorded 11 kills, five digs and two blocks in sweep over Florida State (Nov. 1) before picking up 18 kills, two digs and an assist at Pittsburgh (Nov. 3) ... Contributed 11 kills, five digs, an assist and a block in a win over Boston College (Nov. 9) before recording 11 kills, seven digs, two service aces, two blocks and an assist in a victory over Syracuse (Nov. 12) ... Combined for 20 kills and 10 digs in road victories over Virginia (Nov. 17) and Virginia Tech (Nov. 19), tallying an assist in each match and a solo block - her sixth of the season - against the Cavaliers ... Recorded a career-high three service aces along with 15 kills and seven digs in a win over Georgia Tech (Nov. 22), then added a season-high three assists, seven kills, two digs and a block in a win over Clemson (Nov. 24) ... Recorded eight kills, five digs, two assists and two blocks in a four set win over Charleston (Nov. 30) in the NCAA Championship ... Contributed five digs, two kills and a block in an NCAA Championship game against Florida (Dec. 1).

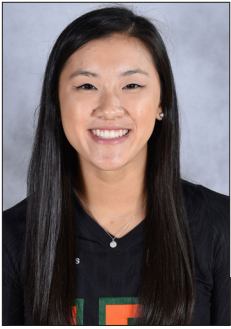

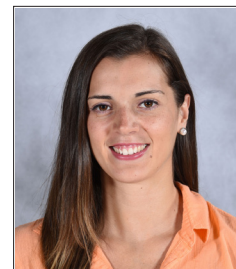
