- Amari Robinson led the Tigers with 14 points on the night, while Kobi Thornton finished with 11 and a team-high six rebounds.
- In conference play, Thornton leads the Tigers with 12.7 points per game, while Kendall Spray is averaging 11.9.
- The Tigers are looking to snap a seven-game losing streak, with their last win coming at home against Duke on January 19.
- Clemson rallied from a 22-point deficit at Miami on January 23 to tie the game, but the Hurricanes used a three and free throw with under 1:00 to go to take the victory.
- Amanda Butler was a member of Katie Meier's staff when Meier was the Head Coach at Charlotte from 2001-2005 (Assistant, 2001-03; Associate Head Coach, 2003-05).

AMANDA BUTLER

2nd Season at Clemson (13th Overall) • 257-190



With 20-plus years of coaching experience under her belt, including 13 seasons as a Division I head coach, Amanda Butler proved she was the right person to lead Clemson women's basketball, leading the Tigers in an unprecedented first year at Clemson.

A Successful Career

With an overall head coaching record of 251-173, Butler is no stranger to success, having led her teams to 11 postseason berths in 13 years. Five of those 11 postseason appearances came in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Second Round in four out of five years.

In 13 years at the Division I level, Butler has coached her teams to eight 20-win seasons, including a 20-win campaign in her first year at Clemson, marking the first time that the Tigers reached 20 wins since 2001.

Restore the Roar

In her first year at Clemson, the Tigers climbed to historical heights, highlighted by their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2002. Clemson finished the season at 20-13, the most wins in a season since 2001.

Brining in just two players of her own, Butler faced the task of coaching a team that was picked to finish last in the ACC by the Blue Ribbon Panel. Undaunted by the task ahead, the Tennessee native pulled together a gritty, hard-working group of women, uniting them through the tenants of trust, loyalty and commitment.

The TLC factor paid off as three Tigers were honored with ACC awards: Kobi Thornton – ACC All-Second Team, Danielle Edwards – ACC All-Defensive Team, and Simone Westbrook – ACC All-Defensive Team. Senior Aliyah Collier also became the first Tiger to earn a spot on the ACC All-Tournament Team since 2002.

As the season progressed, the wins began to accumulate, including a few signature wins over rv/23 Miami and 21/19 Florida State. The Tigers through ACC play to finish the conference slate at 9-7 and in seventh place in the ACC. After winning just one ACC game a season ago, Clemson's nine wins under Butler marked the largest turnaround by a first-year ACC head coach in conference history. Her success in her first year

in the ACC earned Butler ACC Coach of the Year on March 6, two years to the day of her firing at Florida. It was also her birthday.

Time with the Gators

Prior to Clemson, Butler spent 10 seasons at the head of the Florida Gators women's basketball program, posting a 190-137 record in that span with eight postseason berths. She averaged 19.0 wins per season in her 10 years at Florida and was responsible for six of the program's 15 total 20-win seasons.

Butler's mentorship led to 10 All-SEC selections and eight All-SEC Freshman Team honorees during her 10 years at Florida. Following the spectacular 2008-09 season, Sha Brooks received WBCA and AP All-America Honorable Mention status. As a coach, Butler was a United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I National Coach of the Year finalist in 2016.

Head Coach Debut

Butler began her head coaching career at Charlotte, where the 49ers posted a 40-22 record in two seasons. She led the 49ers to two WNIT berths and the team's first-ever share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular-season championship. In her debut season, Butler's team posted a 21-9 mark and a WNIT appearance, earning her Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors.

Stops Along the Way

After graduating from Florida in 1994, Butler transitioned into an assistant coach role with the team under then-Florida coach Carol Ross. In two seasons as an assistant coach, Butler mentored

the team to two NCAA Tournament berths, including an Elite Eight appearance.

She spent the next phase of her coaching career as an assistant coach at Austin Peay State University before joining the Charlotte women's basketball staff as an assistant coach. Butler earned a promotion to associate head coach following the 2002-03 season and continued her success in recruiting, bringing to Charlotte four All-Atlantic 10 selections, four Conference USA All-Freshman team members and one All-Conference USA honoree. The following season, Butler received the nod as head coach of the 49ers.

The Early Days

A native of Mt. Juliet, Tenn., Butler enjoyed a stellar prep career at Mt. Juliet High School, where she tallied over 1,400 points. Butler went on to a standout playing career at the University of Florida. During her junior and senior seasons, she led the Gators to the first two NCAA Tournament appearances in program history.

A three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll, she was voted a finalist on the CoSIDA Academic All-America District Team. Butler completed her Gator career ranked second on the program's all-time assists list with 401. During her tenure with the Gators, Butler helped the team to 73 victories and 21 SEC wins, in addition to serving as captain during her senior season.

Personal

Butler earned a bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science from the University of Florida ('95) and a master's in 1997.

GAME PREVIEW

- Clemson and Wake Forest meet for the 20th time in school history, and second time this season, on Sunday afternoon on ACC Network.
- Earlier this year, Miami downed Clemson, 68-64, inside the Watsco Center in Coral Gables, Fla. The Tigers rallied from a 22-point deficit to tie the game with just over a minute to go, but Miami got a clutch three from Kelsey Marshall and a late-game free throw to take it, 68-64.

SCOUTING THE HURRICANES

- Miami is coming off a 69-64 loss at Virginia on Thursday night. The Hurricanes led by 21 at halftime, led by 20 points from Kelsey Marshall, but the Cavaliers mounted a huge second-half comeback to take the ACC win.
- Miami is still lookin for its first road win of the season, sitting at 0-7 away from the Watsco Center this year.
- In conference play, Mykea Gray leads the Hurricanes with 14.8 points per game, while Kelsey Marshall is averaging 11.2.

THAT NEW NEW

- Five of the nine Tigers that have put on a Clemson jersey for the first time are in the team's top-six in scoring in ACC play.
- Kendall Spray, in her first year of action after sitting out due to transfer rules, is second on the team in scoring in conference games with 12.9 points per game. Freshmen Amari Robinson and Hannah Hank are third and fourth with 10.9 and 7.1 ppg respectively, followed by transfers Shania Meertens (4.5 ppg) and Mikayla Hayes (3.3).

THREEEEEE

- In 13 ACC games this season, Kendall Spray is 44-117 (.376) from beyond the arc, including eight made threes against Notre Dame, tying the school single-game record.
- Spray was named the ACC Player of the Week on December 30.
- As the 2016-17 OVC Freshman of the Year at UT Martin, Spray shot 38.4 percent from beyond the arc and broke UT Martin's freshman three-point record with 89 while ranking sixth on the program's single-season list. As a sophomore, Spray set the school single-season record for three-pointers made (125). She sits fourth on UT Martin's career three-point list, despite only playing two seasons with the Hawks.

THORNTON CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- Senior Kobi Thornton scored her 1,000th career point in March of 2019. She now has 1,350 career points and passed former teammate Danielle Edwards for 14th on Clemson's all-time points scored list.
- Thornton has also amassed 741 career rebounds, passing Debra Buford for 7th on Clemson's all-time rebound list. The Shellman, Ga., native also has 139 career blocks, passing Jackie Farmer for #3 in school history.
- Thornton was named to the preseason All-ACC team, the Tigers' first selection since Nikki Dixon in 2014.

WITH A CHERRY ON TOP

- Transfer Nique Cherry has provided the Tigers a rebounding spark after gaining NCAA eligibility following the first semester.
- In 13 ACC games this season, Cherry is averaging 4.5 rebounds per game, including 11 rebounds at Notre Dame (in 14 minutes of action) and nine against Louisville.

LET ME ASSIST YOU

- Destiny Thomas dished out a career-high 12 assists in the Tigers' win at Notre Dame, tying Marta Sniezek and Nicki Ekhomu for most assists this season by an ACC player.
- The 12 assists are the most by a Tiger in a single game since Tasha Taylor turned in 13 on December 12, 2005.
- Thomas turned in eight assists against Boston College on Sunday, February 9.

BASKETBALL FAMILY

- Amari Robinson has started all 24 games for the Tigers this season, averaging 11.3 points and 6.6 rebounds in her freshman campaign.
- Robinson was named the ACC Freshman of the Week, as well as the USBWA Tamkia Catchings National Freshman of the Week on Jan. 20 and Jan. 21, respectively.
- Robinson's father, Keith Robinson, was a starter for Digger Phelps at Notre Dame from 1987-90. He averaged 14.7 points a game in 1989-90 for Coach Phelps' last NCAA Tournament team.
- Robinson's mother, Andrea (Mangum) Robinson, was a two-time All-American at Providence, led the Friars in rebounds four years in a row, was a first-team All-Big East selection and MVP of the 1990 Big East Tournament. She is one of three players in program history to score 1,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds. She was inducted into the Providence College Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003 and her jersey was retired in 2015.



2018-19 REVIEW

- The Tigers finished the 2018-19 season with a 20-13 record (9-7 ACC). Clemson reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2002, ending a 17-year drought. The Tigers tallied their first NCAA victory since 2001 with a win over South Dakota in the first round.
- In her first season as head coach at Clemson, Amanda Butler led the Tigers to nine ACC wins, eight games over the 2017-18 mark. That was the largest turnaround in wins by a first-year head coach in ACC history and earned her ACC Coach of the Year honors, the first Clemson coach to receive the honor since Jim Davis in 1994.
- The Tigers were originally picked to finish 14th and 15th in the ACC in 2018-19, before finishing 7th. The Tigers tied the 2014-15 Pitt team for the highest finish above predicted place in ACC history.
- Clemson earned three wins over Top-25 teams in '18-19, a first since 2000-01. The 20-13 finish gave Clemson its first winning season since 2003-04 and Kobi Thornton was the Tigers' first All-ACC selection since 2009-10.
