ABOUT THE HURRICANES

Miami coming off a 2-1 weekend at its own Thanksgiving classic with a loss to No. 5/7 Oregon State and a win over Miami (Ohio). They are led by All-American redshirt senior center Beatrice Mompremier (18.1 ppg., 8.6 rpg.). Three other starters average double figures for the Hurricanes including 11.4 ppg. from guard Kelsey Marshall and 10 points each from junior guards Edina Banks and Mykea Gray. UM is shooting 45.5 percent from the floor through seven games and is averaging 74.1 points per game.

IN THE CHALLENGE

The Hoosiers are 7-5 all-time in the ACC/B1G Challenge since it began in the 2007-08 season. IU won its matchup at Wake Forest in the 2018-19 season in a 87-73 win in Winston-Salem. IU has matched up with Miami before in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge in the series' second year where IU won in Coral Gables, 69-54.

PARADISE WAS NICE

Indiana picked up a signature win over No. 5/6 South Carolina and made a run at the defending national champions over a three-day span at the Paradise Jam over Thanksgiving. The Hoosiers were victorious in game one over the Gamecocks, putting together a 14-point win over a Top 5 opponent, the first win over a foe in the Top 5 since 2010 when Indiana defeated No. 4/6 Ohio State at home. It marks the first Top 5 win over a non-conference foe in school history as well. The Hoosiers came up short against Baylor in game two but bounced back with a 34 point win over Washington State to go 2-1 in the event.

IN THE POLLS

Indiana continues to make its own history in the national polls. It moved up three spots again this week in the Associated Press Top 25 to No. 14 and moved up seven spots in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches poll at No. 16. The Hoosiers are holding steady at four-straight weeks in the national polls, the first ever in school history.

TOUGH FOES

Indiana plays its third ranked team in four outings on Wednesday night in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. It's arguably the toughest stretch the Hoosiers have faced in their non-conference in program history. It will be the first time since 2009-10 that it will face three ranked teams in four games. IU

played then ranked No. 15/18 Virginia, No. 12/9 Florida State, unranked Charlotte and No. 22/21 Michigan State all in a row. They also faced three-straight ranked opponents during Big Ten play in 2017-18 (No. 23/20 Michigan, No. 10/10 Ohio State and No. 14/15 Maryland). IU is set to face six of the AP Top 25, having faced two Top 10 foes in Baylor and South Carolina. They are also scheduled to face UCLA (at home on Dec. 22) and against conference opponents Maryland, Michigan State and Michigan.

THAT'S WHAT SHE DOES

Redshirt junior guard Ali Patberg took over for the Hoosiers in the Virgin Islands as she averaged 15.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists while shooting 60 percent from the floor. Her performance earned her a spot on the Paradise Jam All-Tournament team as well. She's now averaging 12.4 points per game and a team-high 5.4 assists per game.

BRENNA BUCKETS

Senior forward Brenna Wise turned on the heat in the last four games, scoring in double figures three times. She has bumped her season average up to 10.7 points per game and shot at least 54 percent from the floor in the three games she scored in double figures. She added 16 points each in wins over Florida and South Carolina while also tying a team-high 15 points in the win over Washington State.

MACK'S ATTACK

Freshman forward Mackenzie Holmes has proven to be efficient for the Hoosiers in her first seven games. The Gorham, Maine product is shooting 73.0 percent from the floor while averaging 13.0 points per game. She scored a season-high 22 points against Nicholls State and had back-to-back double figure scoring games against Baylor and Washington State, where she made her first career start. She's also pulling down a team-high 6.3 rebounds per ballgame.

BERGER BALLS

Offseason work is showing for sophomore guard Grace Berger who's had a monster second season thus far for Indiana. The team's leading scorer with 14.9 points per game this season, the Louisville, Ky. native is also shooting 60 percent from the floor and 53 percent from the 3-point line. She's also adding 3.4 rebounds to go along with 3.2 assists per game. She's notched two 20-plus point scoring games and has led IU in scoring three times.

OFFENSE ROLLING

The Hoosiers continue to put up great numbers from the field through the first seven games this season. They are shooting nearly 50 percent from the floor at 49.7 percent heading in to Wednesday's game. It's the fifth-best percentage in the NCAA currently and leading the Big Ten. They have scored at least 71 points in six of seven games this season and are outscoring their opponents by a margin of 26.3 points.

DEFENSE LOCKING

On the flip side, IU is locking up its opponents who are struggling to score. They are holding the opposition to just 51.3 points and shooting a combined 33.6 percent from the floor in seven games this season. Four opponents have scored 52 points or less including a season-low of 44 points scored by Washington State on Saturday.

HOOSIERS PICK UP WEEKLY HONORS

For their performances in respective weeks, Indiana has placed sophomore guard Grace Berger as the Big Ten Player of the Week (Nov. 25) and freshman forward Mackenzie Holmes as the Big Ten Freshman of the Week. Berger was honored for her 23 point performance at Florida while Holmes notched a 22 point game against Nicholls State and 15 points against Mount St. Mary's in the opener to earn honors. Holmes also earned a spot on the weekly honor roll in the same week while redshirt junior guard Ali Patberg also landed on the honor roll after her stellar performances at the Paradise Jam.

BIG WIN

Indiana's 64 point win over Nicholls State goes down as the second-largest win in school history. It's only second behind their 75 point victory against Gardner Webb in Nov. 2014 and their 111 points are tied for second most in a victory with the 4OT game against Michigan State in 2018.

HOOSIERS PICKED THIRD, PATBERG ALL-B1G

Indiana was selected to finish the Big Ten in third (coaches) and fourth (media) in the league's annual preseason polls. Redshirt junior guard Ali Patberg was selected to the 10-person All-Big Ten preseason teams by both the coaches and media.

ALMOST ALL BACK

IU features four of its five starters from a season ago along with 91 percent of its scoring and 72 percent of its rebounding from the 2018-19 season. The team's four leading scorers all return from last year behind redshirt junior guard Ali Patberg's 15.8 points per game.

MORE PATBERG PLEASE

In July, redshirt junior guard Ali Patberg was granted a sixth year of eligibility from the NCAA, making her eligible to play for IU through the

2020-21 season. She will be listed as a redshirt junior on the roster again this season. The Columbus, Ind. native was an All-Big Ten first team selection, 2019 CoSIDA Academic All-District and Academic All-Big Ten last season.

PATBERG PRESEASON HONORS

In addition to All-Big Ten preseason honors, redshirt junior Ali Patberg has been named to the Nancy Lieberman Award preseason watch list and to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 30. The Nancy Lieberman award honors the nation's top point guard while the Wooden Award is given to the nation's best player. Patberg is the only representative from the Big Ten on the Lieberman Award and one of two league nominees.

LAST GO AROUND

Senior forward Brenna Wise is the program's only senior in 2019-20 and looks to continue to add to her numbers from a strong junior campaign. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native was the team's third leading scorer in 2018-19 and averaged a team-best 6.9 rebounds per game. She was an All-Big Ten honorable mention selection as junior and was a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and Academic All-Big Ten honoree.

WHEN'S BENDU BACK?

After suffering an Achilles heel tear in the NCAA Tournament against Oregon, junior guard Bendu Yeane's status of return is still to-be-determined. The Portland, Ore. native has played in 70 games in her career at IU and averaged 9.7 points and led the team in steals with 51 last season.

SPENT THE SUMMER AT HOME

Sophomore forward Aleksa Gulbe gained more valuable experience with her national team as she spent the summer training in Latvia with the Latvian U20 team that competed in the FIBA U20 European Championships in the Czech Republic where she averaged 13.4 points and 6.7 rebounds per game in seven games played.

WHO'S NEW

Indiana has seven new faces on its roster this season, including six freshmen. It's the largest freshmen class in six years. The class is headlined by freshman forward and 2019 Indiana Miss Basketball Jorie Allen, who hails from nearby Bedford, Indiana. Two other Indiana All-Stars join Allen in Hannah Noveroske and Shaila Beeler. Maine Gatorade Player of the Year Mackenzie Holmes also looks to make an immediate impact for the Hoosiers this season. Junior transfer Danielle Patterson was also added to the roster in the offseason, but will sit this year out due to NCAA transfer rules.

HEAD COACH

SIXTH YEAR AT INDIANA • 17TH YEAR OVERALL AS COLLEGE HEAD COACH

Indiana native Teri Moren is in her sixth season leading the Indiana Women's Basketball program in 2019-20.

It was another historical year for the Hoosiers in 2018-19, as Moren guided her team to its fourth-straight postseason appearance with an at-large bid in to the NCAA Tournament. IU won its first-round game over Texas and made its second appearance in four seasons in the Big Dance. They won 23 games, its fourth-straight 20-win season where three players earned All-Big Ten honors in Ali Patberg, Jaelynn Penn and Brenna Wise. The Hoosiers got off to a hot start, opening up the 2018-19 season 10-0 overall and had five Top 50 RPI wins and two AP Top 15 victories for the first time since 2001-02. In the classroom, seven players earned All-Big Ten honors, the most in a single season in program history while Patberg and Wise were honored as CoSIDA Academic All-District honorees.

The Hoosiers made history in 2017-18, claiming the WNIT Championship and guiding the program to a 23-14 overall record. IU won 15 of its final 17 games en route to hanging a banner inside Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. Tyra Buss repeated for the third-straight time as a All-Big Ten First Team selection and second-straight WBCA All-American honorable mention while Amanda Cahill was a All-Big Ten Second Team honoree and CoSIDA Academic All-American for the second-consecutive season. The program's 23 wins marked the eighth time in program history the Hoosiers have reached 20 wins or more, including in three-straight seasons for the first time ever.

A record number of fans came out in Moren's fourth year in 2017-18, with four of the top 10 attended games in school history coming during the historic WNIT run. The Hoosiers averaged over 4,000 fans per game and set a new program attendance record during the WNIT Championship game where 13,007 fans saw IU defeat Virginia Tech, 65-57.

In 2016-17, Moren guided IU to 23 wins and an appearance in the WNIT Quarterfinals. The program also featured its first All-American in 31 years, as Tyra Buss was named a WBCA All-American Honorable Mention. For the first time since 2008-09, Indiana featured three players on All-Big Ten teams highlighted by a repeat All-Big Ten First Team selection Tyra Buss, Junior forward Amanda Cahill (second team) and senior guard Alexis Gassion (honorable mention) were also honored, as Gassion was selected to the league's All-Defensive team, also the first selection since 2008-09. In addition, Cahill earned CoSIDA Academic All-American honors, the first for the program since 1989 and the fifth player ever in school history.

In her second season 2015-16, Moren was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year after leading Indiana to a 21-12 overall record and the program's to its first NCAA Tournament berth in 14 years. Moren led the Hoosiers to the most regular season wins (20) in program history while also tying for overall wins (21) in a single season. Indiana had the school's second-most Big Ten victories (12) ever on her way to being named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She became just the second IU coach to earn the award (Maryalyce Jeremiah, 1983) while leading the Hoosiers won their first NCAA Tournament game since 1983 with a 62-58 triumph over eighth-seeded Georgia in the first round at Notre Dame as the No. 9 seed in the Lexington Region.

IU's 12 Big Ten victories were the school's most since 1982-83. Moren's 2015-16 Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and earned a No. 4 seed in the Big Ten Tournament, tying for the program's highest seed ever in conference tournament play. That season, Buss was named First Team All-Big Ten, becoming the first IU player to earn first team honors since 2006. Cahill earned Second Team All-Big Ten accolades. Buss and Cahill become the first IU duo to earn all-conference recognition in the same season since 2010.

During her first year in Bloomington in 2014-15, Moren led the Hoosiers to the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96, the best team free throw percentage (74.3 percent) since 2003-04 and the most steals (284) since 2010-11. IU nailed 236 3-point field goals, the second best total in school history, and also cracked the top five in program history in free throw percentage (4th), points scored (5th, 2,229), points per game (5th) and 3-point field goal percentage (5th, 33.1 percent)

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Fred Glass announced the hiring of Seymour, Ind., native as head coach of the IU women's basketball program on August 9, 2014. Prior to Indiana, Moren won a Missouri Valley Conference championship during her four seasons with Indiana State. She led the Sycamores to two WNIT appearances and had six players named All-MVC. ISU finished with a 20-12 record in 2013-14, the program's first 20-win season in eight years and just the fifth 20-win campaign in school history. With a 14-4 record in conference games, Moren's Sycamores won a share of the regular season MVC title and earned the No. 1 overall seed in the MVC Tournament.

Prior to ISU, Moren was associate head coach at Georgia Tech. In each of her three years there, the Yellow Jackets made an NCAA Tournament appearance and won 22 or more games each season.

Moren began her head coaching career at the University of Indianapolis (2000-07). The 2003 WBCA Region 4 Coach of the Year in NCAA Division II, her teams went to three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournaments and earned Great Lakes Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2003.

Moren began her coaching career in 1992-93 at Butler (1992-1998), leading the Bulldogs to three 20-win seasons. Moren then spent two years as an assistant at Northwestern (1998-2000).

A 1992 graduate of Purdue University, Moren earned her bachelor's degree in therapeutic recreation. She was a four-year basketball letterwinner and two-year starter for the Boilermakers under Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Coach Lin Dunn. She was part of three NCAA Tournament teams and Purdue's first Big Ten championship.

Moren graduated from Seymour High School in 1987 and was named an Indiana All Star. She led the Owls to four sectional titles, two regional championships, a semi-state win and a 1987 state finals appearance. She was inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame on April 26, 2014 and will be part of the inaugural class of the Seymour Athletics Hall of Fame in December 2017.
