CHICAGO - Two cherished traditions emblematic of the DePaul women's basketball program come together at 11 a.m. Friday in McGrath-Phillips Arena.

The No. 19/20 Blue Demons open up the Maggie Dixon Classic against Arkansas State with the unwavering partisan support of 2,000 screaming schoolchildren unleashing their enthusiasm for coach Doug Bruno and his team.

The Maggie Dixon Classic is a revered, annual celebration of the former DePaul assistant coach who was named head coach at Army just 11 days before the start of the 2005-06 season and went on to lead Army West Point's women's basketball program to its first Patriot League title and berth in the NCAA tournament.

That dramatic turnaround almost paled in comparison to the culture change Dixon ignited at the military male bastion. The U.S. Military Academy at West Point had never before seen anything like Maggie Dixon. She galvanized this male-dominated culture with the force of her will and her gift for bringing out the best in others.

You never would have known women's sports was a mere blip on the West Point sports landscape after several hundred cadets stormed the Christl Arena court and carried Dixon off---a memorable scene telecast to a national audience on ESPN's "SportsCenter."

"I was in the stands, and you could see how Maggie had electrified West Point," said former DePaul associate head coach Nicci Hays Fort. "All the top officers were at the game, and the cadets had painted their faces.

"The next day, the team was formally presented the Patriot League trophy. When Maggie got up to speak, 4,000 cadets gave her a standing ovation."

Many of those same cadets and members of the women's basketball community nationwide would be in mourning a month later when this 28-year-old shining beacon of hope and optimism passed away from heart arrhythmia.

DEPAUL STORY LINES

- DePaul competed in the NCAA tournament for the 17th year in a row after winning its fourth BIG EAST Tournament crown in the last six years.
- The women's program is shooting for its first conference threepeat since winning a North Star title and back-to-back Great Midwest titles 1990-93.
- Under coach Doug Bruno, the Blue Demons have won 20 or more in 23 seasons including the last 12 in a row and 16 of 17. From 2013-14 to 2019-20, DePaul is 164-48 for a .772 winning percentage
- DePaul faces another tough schedule this season with games against 2019 NCAA Final Four powers Notre Dame and Connecticut, NCAA second-rounder Miami and Sweet 16 Oregon State.
- Bruno's team plays six regular-season games at Wintrust Arena including the Preseason WNIT opener Nov. 8 against Miami (Ohio) and a marquee matchup vs. Connecticut on Dec. 16.
- In addition, DePaul is hosting the 2019 BIG EAST women's tournament March 6-9 at Wintrust Arena in the final year of a three-year contract.
- The emphasis on strong guard play will be evident this season as the Blue Demons have nine backcourt players on their roster.
- Keke Rimmer (Proviso East), Kayla Caudle (Vernon Hills) and Nadège Jean (Rich South) are Chicago-area products.
- The Blue Demons will be integrating seven new players (two transfers, four incoming freshmen, one redshirt freshman) with seven returnees.

Milestones: Kelly Campbell needs 126 points to reach the 1,000-point plateau for her career... Campbell is fifth all-time in career assists with 489... Jessica January is No. 4 with 554... Campbell is 10th in career rebounds with 737 and approaching 2011 WNBA Draft pick Felicia Chester (751)... Campbell's career seven rebounds per game is No. 10 all-time... Doug Bruno needs four more wins to reach 700 for his illustrious college career... he would become only the third active coach in Division I to win 700 at one school for his entire collegiate career along with Connecticut's Geno Auriemma and Villanova's Harry Perretta.

17 Straight NCAA Appearances: DePaul is one of just five teams to advance to the NCAA Tournament for the last 17 seasons... joining DePaul on this distinguished list are Connecticut, Notre Dame, Stanford and Tennessee... the 17-straight appearances is a program record for consecutive NCAAs... DePaul earned four consecutive NCAA berths from 1990-93 followed by a three-year run from 1995-97.

Sweet 16: DePaul made the program's fourth trip to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2016... DePaul has reached the Sweet 16 in 2016, 2014, 2011 and 2006.

What is Back: Chante Stonewall was a All-BIG EAST Second Team selection who averaged 14.3 points, 6.6 rebounds---both second on the team. She led the Blue Demons in field goal percentage and blocked shots and was second in steals. Scored a career-high 28 points including the game-winning threepoint play with five seconds left to top Marquette 74-73 in the BIG EAST title game. BIG EAST tournament Most Outstanding Player.... Campbell averaged 7.5 points, 7.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists, was No. 5 in the nation in assist-turnover ratio and a Top 10 finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Award... Lexi Held was named to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team after winning the conference's Freshman of the Week award four times. Led the team in three-point shooting percentage... Sonya Morris started six games and was a valuable all-around performer off the bench... Maya Stovall played her best basketball in the second half of the season, starting in 14 of the final 15 games when team was 12-2... Dee Bekelja poised for breakout year after averaging nearly five points a game off the bench... Jolene Daninger is a dangerous long-dis-

tance threat who connected on 50 percent of her three-pointers last season.

What is New: Deja Church started all 34 games last season averaging nearly nine points a game in 26.8 minutes. Helped lead the Wolverines to the NCAA Second Round where they lost to NCAA Elite Eight power Louisville. Second on Michigan in assists, blocks and free throw percentage... Kiara Dallmann is a 6-2 forward and junior college All-American who averaged nearly 14 points along with 7.5 rebounds and was fifth-best in the country in field goal percentage at 61.2 percent at Iowa Western. As a freshman, set the school record shooting 70.9 percent from the field---No. 1 in the nation... Nadège Jean returns after missing last season with an injury, and this 6-2 athletic big provides quality front-court depth to a Blue Demon program that will feature its most length in quite some time... Keke Rimmer dominated the high school game averaging 17.3 points, 9.1 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 3.1 steals for Proviso East. McDonald's Game nominee and IBCA All-State... The 6-1 Kayla Caudle built a reputation for being tenacious inside and became Vernon Hills' all-time leading rebounder after just three seasons. IBCA All-State selection averaged nearly 13 points and 13 rebounds as a senior after 15.3 points and 14.4 rebounds as a junior... Dynamic guard Marisa Warren led the Incarnate Word to a three-peat state championship as a senior, racking up game highs of 17 points, 10 rebounds and five assists in the state semifinals. The St. Louis Post Dispatch All-Metro Player of the Year averaged 14.1 points, 5.3 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 2.8 steals... played in the same backcourt with Sonya Morris as a junior... Hannah Purcell was a coaches association All-State selection after averaging 16 points and 10 rebounds. She helped lead Annandale (Minn.) High School to the state quarterfinals in 2015 and to the state tournament in 2016.

National Acclaim: Coach Doug Bruno's program is a consensus Top 20 team, ranking No. 18 in the AP preseason poll and No. 20 in the coaches preseason poll... DePaul entered the season ranked No. 17 by Lindy's Sports magazine, No. 18 in the ESPNW early poll and No. 19 in Street & Smith's Basketball magazine.

Preseason Accolades: Campbell was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team and to the Nancy Lieberman Award watch list for top 20 point guards in the country... Stonewall joined Campbell on the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team and was also selected to the Cheryl Miller Award watch list for the nation's top 20 small forwards... Stonewall was named to the Citizen Naismith Trophy watch list for the nation's top 50 players... she was an All-BIG EAST Second Team honoree in 2018-19.

BIG EAST Player of the Year: DePaul has won the top award three times in the last five years (Brooke Schulte in 2017, Chanise Jenkins in 2016 and Brittany Hrynko in 2015)... Marquette's Allazia Blockton snapped that streak winning the award in 2017-18.

National Stage: The Blue Demons led the nation in three-point attempts last season and were third in total three-pointers and threes per game... they finished No. 6 in the country assists per game, No. 7 in total assists, No. 8 in scoring offense and No. 9 in free throw percentage... Campbell was No. 5 in the nation in assist-turnover ratio and No. 34 in assists.

Life At the Top: Since the BIG EAST realignment in 2013-14, DePaul is the league's winningest team going into 2019-20 with an impressive six-year record of 91-17 which translates to an .843 winning percentage... The BIG EAST Digital Network will air both first-round games on March 6.

Doug Bruno's powerful impact on the game he loves resonates across the entire spectrum of women's basketball as not only a highly successful college coach and staunch advocate of aca-

demics, but a passionate and undaunted promoter of the sport itself.

The former DePaul basketball player is heading into his 33rd season as the head coach at his alma mater. Born and raised in Chicago and a product of Quigley South High School, Bruno has transformed DePaul women's basketball into a perennial national power.

He has guided the Blue Demons to 16 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances after making the postseason in 2018---a feat only the NCAA elite of Connecticut, Notre Dame, Stanford, Tennessee and Oklahoma can also claim. Since his return in 1988, DePaul has won 641 games entering the 2018-19 season, competed in 23 NCAA Tournaments and four Sweet 16s (2006, 2011, 2014, 2016). Win No. 600 made Bruno the fourth active Division I coach to do so at the same school. Bruno has won 708 games as a head coach going into the 2018-19 season, 668 as DePaul's leader.

Bruno has worked with athletes at the highest level through his involvement with USA Basketball. Since 2009, Bruno has been an assistant coach for the USA Women's Basketball National Team. He has helped lead the USA to FIBA World Championships in 2010 and 2014, and to its fifth and sixth straight Olympic gold medals in London in 2012 and again in Rio in 2016. Bruno is the only coach to be recognized twice as USA Basketball's Developmental Coach of the Year after leading the U18 team in 2006 and the U19 team in 2007 to gold medals at the FIBA Americas and World Championships.

Bruno's influence on the game extends to the WNBA as a consultant to the Chicago Sky pro franchise. The WNBA has drafted 14 DePaul players including Allie Quigley (Chicago Sky).

WBCA Academic Top 25 since 2006--No. 2 in 2013. DePaul won the BIG EAST Team Academic Award nine of the last 10 seasons. Bruno has been conference Coach of the Year numerous times. In 2005, Bruno was selected as Conference USA's Coach of the Decade. The IBCA has named him coach of the Year 22 times. He has been inducted into the DePaul Athletics Hall of Fame, Chicagoland Sports Hall of Fame, IBCA Hall of Fame Italian-American Sports Hall of Fame. Bruno was also awarded the Leonardo Da Vinci Outstanding Achievement in Education Award by the Sons of Italy.

He completed a two-year term as president of the WBCA beginning in the summer of 2007. He was chairman of the WBCA/ State Farm All-American Committee and is the East Regional representative for the NCAA Division I Tournament selection. He serves on the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Committee. He has grown the women's game through his Doug Bruno Girls Basketball Camps and mentored over 75 000 young athletes.

He was associate head coach under Gene Sullivan at Loyola and won three conference titles, reaching the NCAA Sweet 16 in 1985. Bruno also spent two seasons as coach and player personnel director of the WBL's Chicago Hustle and won a division title in 1979.

He began his coaching career as an assistant coach in 1973 with Francis Parker boys team and coached St. Vincent de Paul's boys team in 1974-75.

He was a three-year letter winner for DePaul and Hall of Fame coach Ray Meyer after playing high school basketball at Quigley South for the legendary Dick Flaiz. Bruno was a two-year starter at DePaul and led the 1971-72 squad in assists. He received his B.A. in English in 1973, and later returned to earn his M.A. in English in 1988.

Doug and his wife Patty have six sons---Bryan, Kevin, David, Brendan, Patrick and Bradley and are proud grandparents of 10.

No. 18/20 DePaul Signs Two Dynamic Recruits

CHICAGO – One of the nation's top women's basketball programs added two dynamic recruits Wednesday on the first day of the National Letter of Intent signing period that will help sustain a top 25 stature.

Coach Doug Bruno announced that No. 18/20 DePaul has received signed letters of intent from dominant Lake Park West guard Darrione Rogers and the driving force behind perennial state contender Benet---guard Kendall Holmes.

Just yesterday, Rogers was recognized among the top 50 high school players in the country with her selection to the Jersey Mike's Naismith High School Girls Trophy watch list.

The 5-foot, 11-inch guard was an IBCA All-State First Team selection that has 1,258 points in her sophomore and junior years. For her Lancer career, she is averaging 26.6 points, 11.4 rebounds, four steals and 3.3 three-pointers per game.

She is the No. 51-ranked prospect in the country by ESPN and her junior-year highlights include 49 points against Hinsdale South and a 45-point, 21-rebound effort against Batavia.

Scouts describe the DuKane Conference Co-Player of the Year as among the elite scoring guards in the class of 2020 and a shot-maker off the dribble with a scorer's mentality and green-light range beyond the arc. She plays for the Mac Irvin Lady Fire in the AAU season.

"Darrione Rogers has been recognized as one of the best players in the state of Illinois and in the nation," said DePaul coach Doug Bruno. "While we are definitely excited about her talent, we are even more excited about her work ethic.

"She is a throwback in her beliefs and commitment to getting in the gym when no one is watching. Darrione can score the ball in a variety of different ways but is also an unselfish, great passer that plays right into our DePaulBall system.

"For helping to develop all those outstanding qualities, I'd like to thank Lake Park West head coach Brian Rupp and head coach Mac Irvin of the Mac Irvin Fire, her AAU team."

That same Puritan work ethic is evident in the relentless 5-11 Holmes who led the Redwings to the Class 4A Final Four last season. She is the latest success story in a Benet program that won back-to-back 4A state titles in 2015 and 2016 and was ranked No. 15 in the nation by MaxPreps early in the 2018-19 season.

Holmes was an Associated Press and IBCA Class 4A second-team All-State selection as a junior after

leading the state semifinalist in scoring at 11 points per game and also in three-point shooting with 50-of-125 (.400) along with converting 80 percent of her free throws.

As a sophomore, Holmes was a state finalist in the Class 4A Queen of the Hill three-point shooting contest.

She was named to the All-East Suburban Catholic Conference Team as a junior and the DuPage County, Naperville Sun and My Suburban Life All-Area teams. She was equally competitive in the classroom with a 3.89/4.00 grade-point average and a 27 score on the ACT.

"Kendall Holmes has been the best player on one of the best programs in the state after winning back-to-back titles in 2015 and 2016," Bruno said. "She is simply a tough, all-purpose guard who can score the ball deep, get to the rim, facilitate and do all the little things that make players special.

"Kendall also brings a work ethic and a drive to improve that is still so necessary in today's highly successful, modern student-athlete. For helping Kendall develop and take her game to the next level, I'd like to thank Benet head coach Joe Kilbride and head coach Ryan Haun of M14 Hoops, her AAU program."
