## TERRIFIC TENURE

In his first nine seasons, Jim Larrañaga has led Miami to 20 more wins (190) than it had in any prior nine-year stretch (170 from 1958-59 to 1966-67). The six 20-win campaigns in Coach L's tenure are over half of the program's previous total (11) and match the full prior total since the rebirth (1985-86). Miami's four NCAA Tournament trips under Coach L are two shy of its previous total, including just one short of its combined total after the rebirth. The Hurricanes' six postseason trips in their first seven campaigns under Coach L match the program record for any seven-year span.

In addition, Larrañaga enters the 2020-21 season with 660 career victories, good for No. 37 all-time among head coaches with at least 10 years of Division I experience. He is No. 10 on that list among active coaches at Division I schools. Larrañaga is also one of 17 coaches with 100-plus victories at three Division I schools, just four of whom are active.

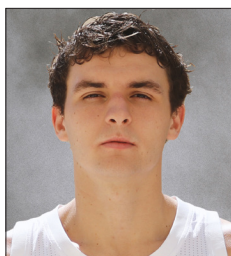

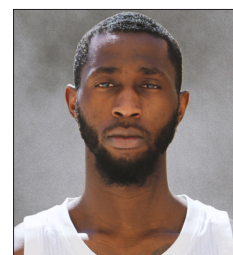

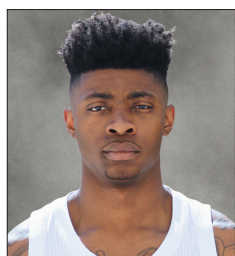
