#### THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue heads to the Sunshine State for the second time this season as it travels to Miami to face the Hurricanes in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge on Tuesday night. Purdue will be making its 20th appearance in the Challenge, owning a Big Ten-best 11-8 record in the event.
- Purdue is coming off a tough 68-61 victory over Valparaiso on Friday night after rallying from an 11-point halftime deficit to earn its third win of the season. The Boilermakers now enter the teeth of their schedule, facing Miami, Indiana State, Ohio State in the Big Ten opener, Notre Dame in the Crossroads Classic, at Iowa and Maryland all before Christmas Day.

#### THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- Purdue has started at least 3-1 in 13 of the 16 seasons that Matt Painter has been in charge of the Boilermakers (2005-06, 2012-13, 2019-20).
- Purdue owns a league-best 11-8 record in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. The Boilermakers have won nine of their last 11 Challenge games.
- Purdue is one of the top 3-point shooting teams in America, ranking 17th in 3-point percentage (.436) and 29th in 3-pointers per game (10.3).
- The Boilermakers have dominant rebounders on the both ends of the floor. Trevion Williams ranks fourth nationally in defensive rebounding percentage (.430), while Zach Edey is eighth nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (.202).
- Emmanuel Dowuona will return to where he played his high school ball this week. Dowuona played at Westwood Christian High School, graduating in 2018. Dowuona is originally from Accra, Ghana.
- Zach Edey (13.8 PPG) and Brandon Newman (12.0 PPG) rank 4th and 5th among Big Ten freshmen in scoring average. Jaden Ivey is also 5th.
- Purdue has held its opponents to just 25 offensive rebounds and 18 second-chance points in four games this year.
- Purdue's junior class is averaging 39.0 points per game over the last two games, shooting 26-of-58 (.448) from the field in that span.
- After averaging 19.0 turnovers per game in the first two outings of the season, Purdue has averaged just 10.5 turnovers over the last two games and owns an assist / turnover ratio of 1.90 (40 / 21) in that span.
- Purdue is 43-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).
- Trevion Williams has had at least 11 rebounds in three of four games this year.
- Sasha Stefanovic has made at least four 3-pointers nine times during his career. Purdue is 7-2 when he reaches that mark.
- When Aaron Wheeler scores at least 10 points in his career, Purdue is 8-1. When Stefanovic reaches 10 points, Purdue is 11-4.

## A PURDUE WIN WOULD...

- be Purdue's second straight win in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. The Boilermakers defeated No. 5-ranked and defending National Champion Virginia last year 69-40.
- improve Purdue to 12-8 in the Challenge.
- improve Purdue to 4-0 all-time against Miami, including 2-0 in the Challenge (Nov. 29, 2011; 76-65 victory ... Hummel scored 17 points in that contest for Purdue).
- be Purdue's second straight road victory dating to last year (def. No. 18-ranked Iowa on March 3; 77-68).
- improve Purdue to 19-9 all-time against teams from state of Florida.
- improve **Matt Painter** to 11-5 in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge.
- improve **Matt Painter** to 14-14 at Purdue against ACC opposition.

## UP NEXT

- Indiana State visits Mackey Arena on Saturday, Dec. 12, in what will be the final tune-up before Big Ten play starts Dec. 16.
- The Sycamores open their season Tuesday night against Truman State after posting an 18-12 record a year ago and an 11-7 mark in the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Purdue will then host Ohio State in the Big Ten opener on Wednesday, Dec. 16, in Mackey Arena.

## INSIDE THE MATCHUP

- Purdue enters Tuesday's contest with a 3-0 series advantage against the Hurricanes, but this will be the first meeting since the 2011 ACC / Big Ten Challenge, won by Purdue in Mackey Arena.
- Miami is the second of three ACC opponents that Purdue will face in the first month of the season. Clemson topped the Boilermakers 81-70 on Nov. 26, in Melbourne, Florida. The Boilermakers will face Notre Dame on Dec. 19, in the Crossroads Classic.

## MEETING THE CHALLENGE

- No Big Ten team has been better than Purdue in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge, as the Boilermakers boast the league's best record with an 11-8 mark. Nebraska (5-4) and Penn State (10-9) have the league's only other winning records in the event.
- From 2009 to 2015, Purdue won seven straight Challenge games, which is the third-longest win streak in Challenge history (Duke has the top-two streaks; 10 and a current streak of 8 straight wins).
- Thanks to the 7-game streak, Purdue has won nine of the last 11 games in the Challenge. The losses have come at Louisville (2016) and Florida State (2018).

**HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER**

► Record at Purdue: 340-175 (.660) / 16th year | Career Record: 365-180 (.670) / 17th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2020-21 season third on the school's all-time wins list (337) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 15 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 14 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 16 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 12 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2021 – Painter is 50 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 13 years.
- Has had 63 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 15 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
