#### NOTING THE WOLFPACK (7-0, 2-0)

- One of two remaining unbeaten teams in the conference and currently riding the ACC's longest winning streak of 12 games that started last season on Feb. 27, 2020
- Streak includes seven-straight victories over ACC opponents
- · No. 18 nationally and first in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.39)
- No. 15 in fewest personal fouls per game (13.3)
- No. 18 in defensive rebounds per game (32.9)
- No. 19 in scoring margin (+25.0)
- Four members of the squad with scoring averages in double digits -Elissa Cunane (15.6), Kayla Jones (13.9), Jakia Brown-Turner (13.6) and Raina Perez (10.3)
- Three players on the team with 50+ attempts from the field who have compiled shooting marks of at least 50 percent - Jones (.569), **Cunane** (.536), **Perez** (.500)
- Cunane and Jones both ranked in the top 20 in the conference in scoring and in the top 10 in field-goal percentage

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- After a history of slow starts this season, NC State came out hot in the first quarter against Wake Forest and never looked back on its way to beating the Demon Deacons 79-65 on Thursday night.
- The Pack shot lights out in the first quarter, going 13-of-15 (.867) from the floor and a perfect 6-of-6 from three-point range. That tied as the Wolfpack's best single-quarter shooting percentage of the still-early 2020-21 campaign.
- NC State hit its first 10 shots of the game, with each starter contributing two buckets to the streak. The Pack also hit eight threes in a row before missing one from beyond the arc, and it went on to put together its best three-point shooting percentage (10-of-18, .556) of the season.
- The Wolfpack starters put on a show, combining for 70 of the Pack's 79 points. Jakia Brown-Turner led all players on the floor with a career-high 23 points while shooting 4-of-5 from long range and adding four assists.

#### LAST MEETING - NC State vs. Miami

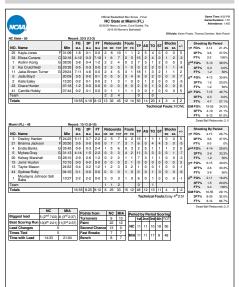

CORAL GABLES, Fla. - The 10th-ranked NC State women's basketball team (23-3, 12-3 ACC) overcame a seven-point fourth-quarter deficit to pick up a 50-48 road win against the Miami Hurricanes (13-13, 5-10 ACC) on Thursday evening.

After trailing by seven (32-39) headed into the fourth quarter, NC State outscored Miami 18-9 in the final period. The Pack's come-from-behind win was aided by 10 unanswered points scored by the team from 5:04 to 1:23 in the fourth quarter. The Hurricanes missed 13-straight attempts from the floor from the 2:37 mark of the third period to the 1:24 mark of the fourth period.

NC State's run built its lead up to five points (46-41), but a threepointer by Miami's Kelsey Marshall tied the game at 48 with 22 seconds remaining. The Wolfpack inbounded the ball, took it the length of the floor and Jakia Brown-Turner knocked down a jumper from the corner with two seconds remaining to give NC State its final lead of the game at 50-48.

Brown-Turner led the Wolfpack in scoring, as she tied her career high of 18 points. The freshman shot 7-of-11 from the floor, including a 4-of-6 clip from long range. Elissa Cunane joined her in double figures with 15 points.

#### **FAMILIAR HEIGHTS**

The Wolfpack maintained its spot at No. 4 in Monday's edition of the Associated Press Top-25 Poll. It marks the 38th week in program history that NC State has been featured in the top five.

NC State opened the year with its best AP preseason ranking (No. 8) since 1990-91, and its current ranking matches its best from last season when it was also tabbed No. 4 on Feb. 10. It also marks the first time since the 1999-2000 campaign that the Pack has been in the national top five multiple weeks in a row.

The Pack has already established itself as a mainstay in the Top 25. The program has spent 397 total weeks ranked in the AP poll in its history and has been ranked every week since Feb. 5, 2018. In 2019-20, the Pack spent the entire year in the AP Top 15 and was featured inside the Top 10 for the last 15 weeks of the campaign.

#### **SCOUTING THE HURRICANES (4-1, 1-1 ACC)**

- Picked to finish 10th in the ACC this season by the league's head coaches and 11th by the Blue Ribbon Panel
- Leads the conference in three-point field-goal defense (.221) and ranked second in the league in overall scoring defense (58.0)
- Kelsey Marshall leads the Canes in scoring with 14.6 points per game (ranks 16th in the ACC), and Destiny Harden also averages double figures with 13.2 points per game
- Set to play its first game since Monday, Dec. 14 after having its Thursday contest against Georgia Tech canceled due to positive COVID tests within the Yellow Jacket program
- Coming off of first ACC victory of the year, a 67-63 win it picked up at home against UNC behind 20 points and 12 rebounds from Harden

#### SERIES HISTORY (NC State leads 12-11)

- Sunday marks the 24th meeting between NC State and Miami.
   After last season's game, the Wolfpack took the narrow 12-11 edge in the all-time series between the squads.
- NC State has hosted Miami a total of 11 times ahead of Sunday's matchup. The Pack is 8-3 against the Hurricanes when playing in Raleigh, and it won its last home matchup with Miami at the end of the 2018-19 regular season.
- The squads last faced each other on Feb. 20, 2020 in Coral Gables. NC State overcame a fourth-quarter deficit, and then-freshman Jakia Brown-Turner his what was the game-winning shot with two seconds remaining to lead the Pack to the 50-48 victory. It was the Wolfpack's first victory in Coral Gables since 2007.

#### **CLUTCH KJ**

The versatility and reliability of **Kayla Jones** continues to shine bright in her senior season. She is currently the only player in the ACC to average at least 13 points, seven rebounds and three assists per game.

After tallying just five points in the Pack's season opener, Jones has scored 12+ in each of the six games since. In that stretch, she is shooting 35-of-62 (.565) for 15.3 points per game, and she has stuffed the stat sheet with four games with 7+ rebounds and five

games with 3+ assists.

Her best scoring output this season came on the road at Boston College where she posted acareer-high 25 points, nine more than her previous career high of 17 points. That outing marked the first 25+ point performance for a member of the Pack since Elissa Cunane posted 27 points at Duke on Feb. 2, 2020.

#### **EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS**

NC State has met ACC coaches' preseason expectations in all seven seasons under Coach Moore and has exceeded expectations in five of those years.

In head coach Wes Moore's eight seasons in Raleigh, the Wolfpack has posted an impressive 79-37 (.681) record in league games that includes a 41-17 (.707) mark in Raleigh.

#### **MAKING IT RAINA**

Raina Perez came to NC State after averaging nearly 20 points per game at Cal State Fullerton last season, and she has shown her ability to be both a prolific scorer and a consistent play facilitator.

She is the best in the league and among the best in the nation as a ball handler. Perez owns the nation's sixth-ranked assist-to-turnover ratio (7.3) with 29 assists and just four turnovers through seven games. The Goodyear, Ariz., native has four games this season with zero turnovers.

Despite her small size, Perez has a knack for making plays inside the perimeter. She is 8-of-19 (421) from three-point range this season and 17-of-31 (.548) from two.

#### STRENGTH IN THE PACK

Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State has put together a 65-9 mark when playing on Kay Yow Court. That record includes 40 consecutive victories over non-conference opponents and 25 out of 34 possible league wins. The Pack's non-conference streak dates back to the old Reynolds Coliseum days and excludes the 2015-16 season that was played at Broughton High School during renovations. NC State's last non-conference defeat on Kay Yow Court coming at the hands of Minnesota on Dec. 3, 2014.

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE CLUB**

Four Wolfpack players have posted double-doubles this season - Elissa Cunane (2), Kayla Jones (2), Jakia Brown-Turner (1) and Jada Boyd (1). That number ranks second in the league behind

North Carolina with six different players posting double-doubles.

Kayla Jones came within striking distance of a rare triple-double on Thursday with 12 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists. Only one Wolfpack player in the program's history (Tynesha Lewis) has posted a triple-double. She posted two within a month of each other during the 2001 season.

Cunane is currently riding a three-game double-double streak after games against Elon (22 points, 13 rebounds), Boston College (23 points, 15 rebounds) and Wake Forest (17 points, 10 rebounds). It marks the second-longest double-double streak of her career, as she posted four in a row between Nov. 30 (Hawaii) and Dec. 15 (Elon) last season.

#### **DISHING IT OUT**

Three Wolfpack starters average three or more assists per game this season - Raina Perez (29, 4.1 average), Jakia Brown-Turner (26, 3.7 average), and Kayla Jones (22, 3.1 average). The Wolfpack is one of three programs (Duke, Miami) that has three players averaging 3+ assists. Those three players also take great care of the ball and all rank in the top five in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio.

As a team, NC State has dished out 20 or more assists in four of seven games, which includes a season-high 28 assists in the Pack's win over Coastal Carolina. That number marks the most in a single game for NC State in the Wes Moore era (previous high was 27 against Elon in 2013, Moore's first season with the Wolfpack). It is also the most for the Pack in a single game since at least the 2000-01 campaign.

#### WE WIN

In what was one of the most highly-anticipated matchups of non-conference collegiate women's basketball, NC State came away with the 54-46 victory over No. 1 South Carolina on the road on Dec. 3. The victory marked the Wolfpack's first over a top-ranked team since March 3, 2007 when it defeated No. 1 Duke in the ACC Tournament. It was also just the third win over a top-ranked team in a total of 20 tries in program history.

#### PACK EFFORT

During its five non-conference games, NC State had six players score in double figures twice - against NC Central on Nov. 29 and again versus Coastal Carolina on Dec. 6. The Wolfpack also accomplished this feat twice during the 2019-20 campaign - at Saint Mary's and at Boston College. Prior to last year, the last time the Wolfpack had more than five players score 10+ points was when it had eight in double figures against Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012.

#### **COMEBACK PACK**

The Pack overcame a 16-point deficit that it faced with 6:15 remaining in the game to defeat Boston College on Dec. 13. The victory marked the largest fourth-quarter comeback for the Pack since NCAA women's basketball switched from halves to quarters at the start of the 2015-16 campaign. It was also the second-largest second-half comeback in the Wes Moore era, as NC State previously overcame a 20-point second-half deficit to Miami in February 2015.

#### TAKING CARE OF ROAD BUSINESS

Through seven completed seasons under head coach Wes Moore, the Wolfpack has earned 52 true road wins (averaging 7.1 per completed season) since the start of the 2013-14 season. In the prior eight seasons from 2005-06 to 2012-13, the Wolfpack earned 32 true road wins (4.0 per season).

#### **RANKED WINS UNDER MOORE**

Under the leadership of head coach Wes Moore, NC State has defeated a total of 21 nationally-ranked opponents. The Wolfpack has hosted a total of 11 opponents ranked in the AP Top 25

since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum (start of the 2016-17 season), and NC State has won seven of those 11 home games.

#### STATEMENT SHOOTING NIGHT

On Nov. 29, NC State picked up a 108-70 victory over NC Central during which the team posted its highest field-goal percentage since Nov. 23, 1990. The team shot 41-of-60 from the floor for its second-highest shooting percentage in 46 completed seasons of Wolfpack women's basketball.

The team's performance was its first time exceeding 100 points in a single game in the Wes Moore era. The last time NC State had done so was with 102 points in a win over Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012. The Pack's 108 points also marked the most in a contest since the 1996-97 campaign.

#### **1K CUNANE**

With a backdoor layup off of an assist from **Raina Perez**, center **Elissa Cunane** reached the 1,000 career point milestone in the first game of her junior campaign. After the 2019-20 season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cunane needed just 12 points to reach 1,000 and hit that exact number in the first half of the Wolfpack's win over North Florida.

Cunane became the ninth active ACC player, the only active junior in the conference and the 35th player in program history to reach the milestone. It took the Summerfield, N.C., native just 67 career games and 43 career starts.

#### THEN AND NOW

After the 2018-19 Wolfpack team was plagued by injuries, multiple players were called upon to step up to the plate, including then-sophomores **Kayla Jones** and **Kai Crutchfield**. The season prepared both of them for even better junior campaigns during which each player saw her statistical output increase drastically.

#### OPPONENT OUTLOOK

NC State announced a 25-game slate for the 2020-21 season that includes five non-conference matchups and 20 games against ACC foes. Nine opponents qualified for the NCAA Tournament and four were featured in the top 35 of the final 2020 RPI.

#### 2019-20 ACC REWIND

NC State capped off one of the best seasons in its 46-year history by winning the 2020 ACC Tournament on March 8. The title was the first for NC State in 29 years (since 1991) and the fifth in program history. The Wolfpack ended the championship game against Florida State with a 13-3 run to take home the 71-66 victory.

#### During ACC play in 2019-20:

- $\bullet$  NC State won a program-best 14 ACC games, bettering its previous record of 13 ACC wins set during the 1984-85 campaign
- The Wolfpack went 8-1 in ACC road games and 6-3 at home
- The Pack finished second in the league following regular season play, marking its best ACC Tournament seed since 1990 when it was the top-seeded squad

#### **SENIOR CLASS**

The four-year members of NC State's senior class - **Kai Crutchfield** and **Kayla Jones** - will look to continue making their mark on the Pack. Since they arrived at the start of the 2017-18 campaign, Crutchfield and Jones have helped the Wolfpack go 89-19 (.824) overall, 51-7 (.879) at home and 39-13 (.750) in conference play in three seasons.

The class needs 16 victories to tie for the most by a four-year group in program history (105).

#### **SOPHOMORE SENSATION**

Center **Elissa Cunane**'s breakout sophomore campaign was highlighted by All-America Third Team honors from the Associated Press and USBWA and Honorable Mention All-America honors from the WBCA. Cunane's status as an AP All-America honoree made her the first player in program history to earn a spot on one of the three teams after six honorable mention recognitions in program history.

Cunane is one of five returning All-ACC selections from last season, joining Louisville's Dana Evans, Syracuse's Kiara Lewis, Virginia Tech's Aisha Sheppard and Wake Forest's Ivana Raca. Cunane received three ACC Preseason Player of the Year votes from the league's head coaches and 11 from the Blue Ribbon Panel.

#### **WEST RETURNS**

Over the offseason, Wes Moore rounded out and bolstered his staff with the announcement of **Nikki West**'s return to the Wolfpack bench. West previously spent five seasons (2013-14 through 2017-18) on the NC State staff and rejoined the Pack after spending the 2019-20 campaign as an assistant coach for the Charlotte 49ers.

In her previous five seasons with the Wolfpack, West helped Moore and the Pack post a 112-52 (.683) overall record and a 51-29 (.638) mark in ACC games. She helped lead NC State to postseason invitations each year, including a Sweet 16 berth in 2018, in addition to four 20+ win campaigns, two top-four ACC finishes and three top-25

national finishes.

#### THREEEEEEEEEE

At the end of last season, NC State set the NCAA Division I women's college basketball record for most consecutive made three pointers by a team. The Wolfpack started its March 1, 2020 game at Virginia shooting a perfect 13-of-13 from downtown before missing its first three of the game early in the third quarter. Additionally impressive, seven different members of the NC State roster contributed to the streak.

The 13 consecutive threes surpassed the previous record of 11, which was set by both Bowling Green (Feb. 6, 2016) and TCU (March 3, 1996).

#### POSTSEASON PROGRESS

During the 2019 postseason, NC State participated in NCAA Tournament games in Raleigh for the second consecutive year. The Wolfpack is 16-2 in NCAA Tournament games played in Raleigh and has not lost a home game in the tournament since 1983.

NC State made its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance during head coach Wes Moore's sixth season in Raleigh. This marked the first time that the Wolfpack has made three consecutive NCAA Tournaments since the program did so in 2005, 2006, and 2007. With its first-round victory over Maine on March 23, 2019, NC State has won at least one game in three straight tournaments played for the first time since the program did so in 1989, 1990, and 1991.

The Wolfpack concluded the 2018-19 season in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, making its second consecutive appearance in this round for the first time since 1990 and 1991.
