Quentin Hillsman has transformed the Orange women's basketball program into a national championship contender. In his 14 seasons at the helm, Syracuse boasts an impressive résumé, which includes 12 consecutive postseason appearances, eighth trips to the NCAA Tournament, 18 all-conference selections, five All-Americans, and four WNBA Draft picks.

Hillsman won his 300th game as Syracuse's head coach on Feb. 9, 2020 in an upset win over No. 6 Louisville. Under his direction, the Orange own a 306-160 overall record, averaging nearly 20 victories per season. He is the all-time winningest coach in school history.

The 2015-16 campaign put Syracuse on the national map. The Orange advanced to its first Sweet 16, Elite Eight, Final Four, and national final in their history. Syracuse set program records with five wins against nationally-ranked foes, 13 conference victories, 23 regular-season wins, and 30 overall victories. Following its run to the national final, Syracuse was ranked third in the final USA Today Coaches Poll.

In only his second season in 2007-08, he guided Syracuse to a 22-9 overall record and its fourth trip to the NCAA Tournament in school history. SU climbed into the national rankings for the first time in history, checking in as high as No. 21 in the country in the Associated Press Poll.

Hillsman has built a strong reputation as one of the top recruiters in women's collegiate basketball. Eleven of the past 12 recruiting classes have been touted as top-25 classes nationally. In addition, the school's first six McDonald's All-Americans have all been recruited and played under Hillsman.

Prior to being elevated to the position of head coach of the Orange program on Oct. 17, 2006, Hillsman spent one year as an assistant coach on the staff. His collegiate coaching tenure also includes stops at Alabama, American, Siena, and St. Mary's (Md.). Hillsman has also coached at the international level.

A native of Suitland, Md., Hillsman graduated from St. Mary's College (Md.) in 1993 after a standout playing career with the Seahawks. He led the squad to two Capital Athletic Conference championships and one conference tournament title, earning all-conference accolades and setting the school's single-game and single-season assist records. Hillsman studied sport management at the United States Sports Academy in Daphne, Ala. from 1994-96, as well.

He, his wife, Shandrist, and their sons, Kyan and Harlem, reside in Jamesville.

TOP-25 ORANGE

'Cuse moved up one spot in this week's Associated Press Top-25 Poll to No. 20. The Orange received 169 points in the poll, 49 more than the Preseason Poll.

CONTINUED DOME-INATION

Syracuse has a 166-51 overall record in the Dome under Hillsman's watch, including an 97-5 record against non-conference opponents.

Syracuse has defeated 14 nationally-ranked opponents inside the Dome since Hillsman took over the program and has hosted the NCAA First and Second Rounds twice (2016 & 2019).

300-WIN QUENTIN

Hillsman earned his 300th career win on Feb. 9, 2020 after the team beat #5 ranked Louisville 59-51. He's led the Orange to 11 20+ win seasons in the last 12 years and seven-straight NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure.

#TOUGH4T -

Tiana Mangakahia missed the 2019-20 season due to a battle with Stage 2 breast cancer. The two-time Nancy Lieberman Award finalist was granted an Extension of Eligibility Waiver by the NCAA last month. She made her return to the court on Sunday, Nov. 29 against Stony Brook in her first competitive basketball game in 615 days. She totaled a game-high 16 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists and 4 steals.

Mangakahia is a two-time All-ACC First Team selection, a Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-American, a two-time top-10 finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award and holds the

Syracuse and ACC record for assists in a season. She is the all-time leader in career assists at Syracuse with 610, surpassing former Syracuse All-American Alexis Peterson (590). She is the first player in program history to reach 600 assists.

BEST FRESHMAN CLASS IN HISTORY

Syracuse welcomes the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history this season.

Hillsman signed five players in the Class of 2020 including the No. 5 overall player, Kamilla Cardoso, and No. 11, Priscilla Williams. Faith Blackstone (No. 91 overall), Khayma McNeal (No. 29 guard) and Kiara Fisher (No. 47 point guard), Ava Irvin and Maud Huijbens round out the class.

Four of the seven (Cardoso, Williams, Blackstone, McNeal) were named McDonald's All-America Nominees, while Cardoso and Williams were both

inited to the All-America Game and the Jordan Brand Classic. Last time the Orange had a signee in the JBC was Emily Engstler in 2018. Engstler was named MVP of the game. The 2020 JBC and McDonald's All-America Game were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Additionally, Cardoso was named a top-5 finalist for Naismith High School Player of the Year.

THE BEST BACKCOURT

Syracuse's backcourt tandem of Kiara Lewis and Tiana Mangakahia could very well be America's best. They've drawn similar comparisons to the iconic Syracuse duo of Brittney Sykes '17 and Alexis Peterson '17, who led the Orange to their first NCAA Championship Game appearance in program history in 2016.

Lewis and Mangakahia's names are plastered all over national watch lists including the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award Watch Lists. Mangakahia is also on the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List for the third time in her career and the Wade Trophy Watch List, while Lewis is on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List for the nation's best shooting guard.

The duo, whom have both been selected to the All-ACC First Team in past seasons (Lewis in 2020 and Mangakahia in 2018 & 2019) were on the 2020-21 Preseason All-ACC Team.

In their first game starting together for Coach Hillsman, they combined for 24 of Syracuse's 50 points in an 11-point win over Stony Brook to begin the season.

KAMILLA THE SHOT KILLA

Cardoso is fifth in the nation and first in the ACC with 3.3 blocked shots per game this season. She blocked a game-high 7 shots against Lincoln on Dec. 2.

HOT HANDS

Syracuse is 19th in the nation and first in the ACC in steals per game with 12.7 steals per game.

Kiara Lewis leads the conference in steals per game (3.0) She tied a season high 5 steals against Penn State in Sunday's contest.

INTERNATIONAL FLARE

Syracuse boasts a roster that includes five international players this season: Maeva Djladji-Tabdi (France), Tiana Mangakahia (Australia), Maud Huijbens (Netherlands), Kamilla Cardoso (Brazil) and Digna Strautmene (Latvia).

Syracuse has two players currently on their respective senior national team rosters, Mangakahia (Australia) and Strautmene (Latvia).

THE 'CILLA AND 'MILLA SHOW

Hillsman started two freshman on Dec. 2 against Lincoln when Cardoso and Williams earned their first career starts. It was the first time since the 2018 NCAA Tournament when Digna Strautmene and Amaya Finklea-Guity earned the start against Oklahoma State on March 17. Strautmene and Finklea-Guity started 31-straight games together that season.

In her first career start, Cardoso led all scorers with 25 points, 9 rebounds, 7 blocks and three assists. She was the first Syracuse freshman to score 25 points in a game since Digna Strautmene did against Boston College during the 2017-18 season.

Williams was lights out from three-point range in her first start. She shot 8-for-11 from downtown tying a program record for three-pointers in a game and became the first freshman to do so since Gabrielle Cooper '20 against Iowa State on March 18, 2017.

TOP-15 RECRUITING CLASS SECURED

Hillsman secured another top-15 recruiting class when he signed the No. 11 recruiting class according to ESPN HoopGurlz earlier this month. It's the fourth top-15 recruiting class in the last five years for Hillsman.

The 2021 class features four players ranked in ESPN's Top-100 and the Washington state scoring leader for the last three years.

EM BALLER

Junior guard Emily Engstler had a breakout sophomore season in which she led the Orange in rebounds (8.8 rpg) and had a team-best nine double doubles. In the offseason, Engstler worked on her strength and physique shedding 40 pounds and building muscle while working out with her siblings in the family's NYC apartment during the COVID-19 pandemic.

GOLD MEDAL WINNER

In October 2019, Maeva Djaldji-Tabdi won a gold medal at the ANOC World Beach Games in 3x3 basketball with France. She's no stranger to the international stage, having been a member of the U18 and U20 National Teams for France. As a member of the U20 team, she helped France to a quarterfinal appearance in the 2018 FIBA European Championship.

She averaged 12.0 points and 12.1 rebounds per game en route to a fourth-place finish at the 2017 FIBA European Championship, where she ranked second among European Championship competitors in rebounding.

THE MOVE TO MELO

The Orange's home opener was moved to the Carmelo K. Anthony Center, the basketball practice facility, after a few drops of water were noticed on the playing surface. It was later determined that the moisture was the result of condensation, not a leak from the roof.

This is the first winter with the new roof, part of a \$118 million renovation project, as well as a new heating and cooling system, and Syracuse is still fine-tuning the management of this system.
