## STORYLINES

• The Yellow Jackets are back in action this Thursday, traveling to Miami for the first of two meetings against the Hurricanes this season. Tech and Miami are set to tip at 6 p.m. in Coral Gables, Fla., on the ACC Network with Pam Ward and LaChina Robinson on the call. Fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call live from Atlanta.

• The Yellow Jackets pushed its win streak to four games in a strong home win over Florida State last Sunday to pick up their sixth ACC win of the season. Tech was led by three players in double-figures, paced by a game-high 18 points from Kierra Fletcher. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen followed with her third-straight 17-point performance, while Loyal McQueen added 12 points off the bench. Tech finished 13-of-16 from the free throw line to FSU's 3-of-5 effort in a key difference in the win.

• Lotta-Maj Lahtinen posted her eighth consecutive game scoring in double-figures, finishing with 17 points in Tech's win over Florida State. Lahtinen has contributed double-figure scoring numbers in every ACC game this season. She currently ranks fifth in the ACC in scoring.

• Lorela Cubaj continues to be a strong presence on the glass and owns seven games this season with double-figure rebounds. The senior forward from Terni, Italy posted her third consecutive double-double (11 points, 15 rebounds) and 15th of her career at Wake Forest. She continues to pace Tech on the glass, leading the Jackets with an 11.9 rebounds per game average, and averages a double-double on the season behind 12.6 points per game.

• Georgia Tech has won the rebounding battle in eight contests this season, and most recently cleared up the boards against Florida State, 48-26. The Jackets hold the rebounding edge against its opponents on the season and are led on the glass by senior Lorela Cubaj, who boasts an 11.9 rebounds per game average.

• Senior forward Lorela Cubaj currently leads the ACC in rebounding, pacing Tech on the glass with an 11.9 rebounds per game average. Cubaj ranks 9th in the nation in rebounds per game as of Jan. 25. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen is currently second the conference in steals, averaging 2.5 per game and ranks 47th nationally.

• Miami narrowly leads the all-time series against Georgia Tech, 17-15, after the teams split the regular season matchups last season. The Yellow Jackets captured a 61-54 decision in McCamish Pavilion to open January and held a comfortable halftime lead in Coral Gables to close the month, but the Hurricanes rallied back and won in the Watsco Center in overtime. Miami holds the 11-5 edge in the series when competing in Coral Gables. The Jackets and Hurricanes have split the last four meetings, with each team taking their respective home game, dating back to 2018.

## ON A ROLL

Entering the Miami game on Jan. 28, Georgia Tech has won the last four ACC games dating back to Tech's game at Clemson on Jan. 7. The last time the Jackets won four consecutive ACC games was during the 2018-19 season with wins over Pittsburgh, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech and Clemson from 2/7-2/21.

The last time Tech won five-straight ACC games dates back to the 2015-16 season when the Jackets defeated Clemson, Duke, Pittsburgh and Wake Forest twice, extending into the first game of the ACC Tournament. Tech finished that season with a 20-13 overall record and 8-8 in league play.

In regular season action, Tech last won five consecutive ACC games in the 2011-12 season when the Jackets reached the NCAA Sweet 16. Tech posted a win streak of seven ACC wins from 2/12-3/4, extending into two games of the ACC Tournament.

## HERMOSA ON THE INSIDE

At Wake Forest, sophomore Nerea Hermosa was dominant on the inside, scoring Tech's first six points of the game and finishing with 16 to tie her career-high. She posted 10 points in the opening half, helping Tech hold a 10-point halftime lead.

Combined with Lorela Cubaj, the pair finished with 27 points and 18 rebounds. On the season, they are averaging a combined 21.0 points and 16.8 rebounds per game.

## SCORING STREAK

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen has scored in double-figures in eight consecutive contests dating back to Tech's ACC opener against Boston College (Dec. 9). In conference play, Lahtinen is averaging 19.1 points per game to rank fourth in scoring in the league in conference games only. Lahtinen has scored in double-figures in all but two games this season, and has led the Jackets in scoring in seven games thus far.

## TAKING A BREAK

Covid-19 has caused several teams extended breaks during the season, and Tech is no exception. The Yellow Jackets just came off a 10-day break before playing at Wake Forest due to opponents remaining in Covid-19 protocol, having played on Jan. 10 against Virginia Tech before traveling to Wake Forest on Jan. 21. The Jackets took a 10-day break in the 2018-19 season, playing Dec. 5 and not again until Dec. 16 due to final exams.

During the 2010-11 season, the Jackets took a 16-day break from competition, playing Dec. 5 and Dec. 21. Tech finished 24-11 overall and 9-5 in ACC play, and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament that season.

Tech took a longer break during the 1997-98 season, playing Dec. 6 and not again until Dec. 29, marking a 22-day break from competition.

## CUBAJ ON THE BOARDS

Lorela Cubaj put together an impressive performance on the boards at Clemson (1/7) - securing a career-high 20 rebounds in the win. For the game, Tech pulled down 38 rebounds, led by Cubaj's 20. Cubaj was the first player in the ACC to record a 20-rebound performance this season. Only Cubaj and Elizabeth Kitty (Virginia Tech) have secured 20 or more rebounds in a game so far.

Nationally, through Jan. 25 games, Cubaj is one of only 20 players to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. Four players hold the national individual game high record in rebounds this season with 23 in a game.

Cubaj becomes the sixth Yellow Jacket in program history to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. The last Tech player to reach the feat was Kisha Ford who secured 21 rebounds on Nov. 26, 1996.

## LAST WIN VS. RANKED OPPONENT

Tech picked up its fourth win over a ranked opponent in the 2019-20 season, sweeping No. 17/18 Florida State on Feb. 23, 2020. Francesca Pan dropped 23 points in her final regular season home game on The Flats.

## FLETCHER'S RETURN

Senior guard Kierra Fletcher made her first appearance this season against No. 3/3 NC State (Dec. 31) after being sidelined due to injury in the beginning of the season. Fletcher has taken the floor in six contests and made immediate impact for the Jackets. The Warren, Mich., native has averaged 30.9 minutes, 13.3 points and 5.2 rebounds per game in the six outings. Fletcher led all scorers in Tech's second visit to Notre Dame (Jan. 3), scoring 19 points, while finishing with seven rebounds, four assists, three blocks and two steals in 31 minutes.

## BENCH SUPPORT

Georgia Tech's bench has given a helping hand in every contest this season, contributing double-figures in almost every game - Tech's game against Virginia Tech being the exception. Tech saw its greatest bench contribution at Notre Dame (1/3), collecting 35 points between Kierra Fletcher and Nerea Hermosa. Through 11 games, Georgia Tech's bench has averaged 16.6 points per game.

Coming off the bench, Nerea Hermosa finished with 12 points, eight rebounds, an assist and a steal at Notre Dame. Hermosa was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line to help contribute to her highest offensive output of the season. In games coming off the bench, Hermosa is shooting 52.2 percent from the field and contributing 6.6 points and 4.4 rebounds per game.

## WEEKLY AWARD SWEEP

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Loyal McQueen swept the ACC weekly awards the week of Dec. 14, winning Player and Freshman of the Week, respectively. Lahtinen became the first Yellow Jacket since 2017 to earn player of the week accolades. She earned the honor after posting then-career highs in scoring (27), field goals made (11), 3-point field goals made (5), assists (8) and steals (8) during the two-game week. Lahtinen led the Jackets offensively in both games.

McQueen picked up freshman of the week honors after she averaged 12.0 points per game and shot 56.3 percent from the field. In the win over Boston College, McQueen recorded a pair of career bests with 13 points and five assists.

The respective awards marked the first for both Lahtinen and McQueen.

## FROM DOWNTOWN

Georgia Tech opened ACC play shooting 40.8 percent (29-71) from three-point range through the first three ACC games (BC, ND, NCSU), hitting 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games against Boston College and at Notre Dame, before connecting on nine against NC State. In each game, four or more different Jackets connected on a bucket from long distance.

The last time Tech hit 10-plus three-pointers in consecutive games dates back to the 2016-17 season when the Jackets had a streak of three games with 10 or more 3-pointers. Tech capped the streak hitting 14 3-pointers against Appalachian State (12/11/16) to set the single-game record for three-pointers made.

## DOMINATING CUBAJ

Senior Lorela Cubaj has been a strong presence early on this season, recording six double-doubles to average a double-double on the season (12.6 pts, 11.9 rebs). She has led the Jackets on the glass in 10 contests, pulling down double-figure rebounds in seven outings. At Clemson, Cubaj became the first Yellow Jacket since 1996 to secure 20 or more rebounds, pulling down a career-high 20 against the Tigers to lead the Jackets.

In the ACC, Cubaj is first in rebounding, fourth in steals and sixth in blocks.

Nationally, - as of Jan. 25 - Cubaj is 5th in defensive rebounds per game and 9th in rebounds per game.

## POINTING TO LAHTINEN

After dishing out a career best eight assists at Notre Dame, Lotta-Maj Lahtinen owns a team-leading 39 total assists on the season (3.5 apg). The junior is 12th in the ACC in assists and has led the Jackets in assists in five games this season.

She became the first Yellow Jacket since 2012 to record eight assists in a single game - Dawn Maye recorded five games during the 2012-13 season with eight-plus assists.

Lahtinen currently is second in the ACC in steals, averaging 2.55 per game, and is 47th in the nation in steals per game. Boston College's Marnelle Garraud leads the league, averaging 2.58 steals per game.

### APPROACHING A MILESTONE

The team's leading returning scorer from last season, senior Kierra Fletcher is quickly approaching the 1,000-career point plateau, currently sitting with 894 career points. The Warren, Mich., native needs to score 106 points to become the 32nd member of the Georgia Tech women's basketball 1,000-career point club.

### UNSTOPPABLE LAHTINEN

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen continued her dominating presence on the hardwood against No. 3 NC State on Dec. 31, scoring a career-high 30 points against the Wolfpack. Behind hitting a career-high seven free throws, Lahtinen finished the game with 10 field goals, three 3-pointers, three steals and an assist. She also led the Jackets on the glass, securing 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and third of her career.

She opened ACC play against Boston College with an impressive performance on Dec. 9. The junior dropped a then-career-high 27 points to lead all scorers in the win. Lahtinen reached 27 points, shooting 11-of-16 from the field, including a 5-for-8 performance from three-point range. The 11 field goals and five three-pointers each marked personal-bests. Additionally, Lahtinen recorded a career-high eight steals in the win. The 20-plus point outing marked the first of her collegiate career.

The eight steals marked the most by a Yellow Jacket in a single game since Dawnn Maye recorded 10 steals against Marquette on Nov. 18, 2012. Lahtinen currently ranks seventh in scoring in the ACC.

### MCQUEEN JUMPS RIGHT IN

Tech freshman guard Loyal McQueen has quickly filled a starting role with the Yellow Jackets, earning the start in six games thus far. The freshman has also contributed double-figure scoring numbers in six outings, and currently is fourth on the team in scoring, averaging 9.1 points per game. The Florence, S.C., native is averaging 26.3 minutes per game.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES ANYONE?

In Tech's first 11 games of the 2020-21 season, two different Yellow Jackets recorded double-doubles: Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (2) and Lorela Cubaj (6). Lahtinen helped lead the Jackets to a victory over Georgia State (Nov. 25) with her second career double-double (14 pts, 10 rebs) and then posted her second against NC State (Dec. 31) with 30 points and 11 rebounds.

Teammate Cubaj posted her 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th career double-doubles against Georgia (20 pts, 13 rebs), Tulane (18 pts, 16 rebs), Notre Dame (16 pts, 13 rebs), at Clemson (14 pts, 20 rebs), against Virginia Tech (10 pts, 13 rebs) and at Wake Forest (11 pts, 15 rebs). Cubaj recorded three consecutive double-doubles from Clemson-Wake Forest. The last Yellow Jacket to record double-doubles in three consecutive games dates back to Elo Edeferioka to close out the 2016-17 season. The last time a Jacket recorded six or more double-doubles in a season was Roddreka Rogers in 2015-16.

Cubaj is one of nine players in the ACC to have recorded three or more double-doubles this season so far. Elizabeth Kitley of Virginia Tech leads the league with 10 double-doubles - Cubaj is second with six.

### MORE ACC ALL AROUND

With the women's basketball schedule adjustments due to Covid-19, the ACC women's basketball schedule was extended to 20 games for the 2020-21 season. Due to the extended conference schedule, the Yellow Jackets visit Notre Dame twice and will play a home-and-home with Boston College. In addition, Tech will have home-and-home series against Clemson, Florida State, Miami and Wake Forest.

### CONTINUING MOMENTUM

Under second-year head coach Nell Fortner, the Yellow Jackets look to carry momentum from an impressive 2019-20 campaign

into 2020-21. Tech finished last season with a 20-11 overall record, finished seventh in the ACC behind a 10-8 league record and reached the ACC Tournament quarterfinals before the season was suspended due to Covid-19. Fortner was tabbed the 2020 Whack Hyder Georgia Women's College Coach of the Year following the conclusion of the 2019-20 season. Francesca Pan led the Yellow Jackets offensively last season, averaging 13.4 points per game. She earned All-ACC honors, ACC All-Tournament Team accolades and All-ACC Academic Team recognition to close out her collegiate career.

At the collegiate level, Fortner enters her 11th season as a head coach having led the helm at Purdue (one season), Auburn (eight seasons) and Georgia Tech (one season). In her collegiate head coaching career, Fortner has compiled a 190-131 (.587) record.

### WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returns seven letterwinners from last season's squad and welcomes six newcomers. The Jackets return 59.4 percent of its scoring from last season and 60.7 percent of its rebounding.

Tech will look for leadership from its two seniors this season: Lorela Cubaj and Kierra Fletcher. Cubaj, the team's leading rebounder in 2019-20, averaged a 7.7 rebounds per game. Fletcher enters the 2020-21 season as the team's leading returning scorer having averaged 10.2 points per game. With 814 career points, Fletcher needs to score 186 points her senior season to surpass the 1,000-career point mark.

## HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

2nd Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 333-201 (.621) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 10 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and one at Georgia Tech (2019-20) – and has compiled a 190-131 (.587) overall record in the college ranks.

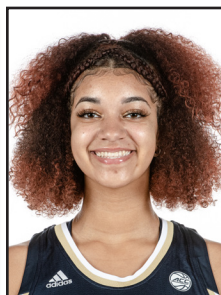
