THE SERIES

- Thursday's meeting marks the 33rd of all-time between the two programs with Miami owning the 23-9 edge in the series.
- The two teams have each won six meetings in games held in Pittsburgh.
- The Hurricanes have won six straight in the series with Pitt's last win coming on Feb. 1, 2015 at the Pete.

A WIN WOULD...

- Be the Panthers' 10th win against Miami all-time.
- Give Pitt their 27th ACC victory in program history.
- Give Pitt a 2-2 ACC start for the second time in program history (2014-15).

STORYLINES

- Junior **Jayla Everett** has been great for the Panthers early on as she leads the team and tied for second in the ACC in scoring (17.7 ppg). The St. Louis, MO native has also connected on 23 three-pointers and ranks first in the ACC in three-point shooting percentage (47.9%).
- Rebounding has always been an emphasis for head coach **Lance White** and the Panthers are starting to take it to heart. Pitt is averaging 43.8 rpg so far this season, +4.1 rpg margin from a season ago and a +8.3 rpg margin since White took over the program prior to the 2018-19 season.

THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt returns to action Thursday, Jan. 21 against Miami at the Petersen Events Center after a 32-day hiatus. Tip is set for 6:00 pm with the game airing on ACC Network.
- The Pitt backcourt duo of **Jayla Everett** and **Dayshanette Harris** are the highest scoring backcourt in the ACC overall this season (33.7 ppg) and the highest scoring backcourt in ACC games only (35.3 ppg - min. 2 GP).
- The Pitt offense is off to a great start this season as they have netted 70+ points in five of their first six games of the season, marking the first time they've done so since 2007-08 when they advanced to the Sweet 16.

BY THE NUMBERS

10+

Sophomore **Dayshanette Harris** has scored in double figures in all six games this season. She is the first Panther to score in double figures in the first six games of the season since Yacine Diop in 2017-18 (seven straight).

23

Junior guard **Jayla Everett** is off to a great start from behind the arc as she has connected on 23-for-48 from three-point range. The 23 triples are the most through the first six games of a season for a Pitt player in program history.

42

As a team, the Panthers have made huge strides shooting the ball as they have connected on 42 three-pointers through six games this season. The 42 threes are the most in the first six games of a season for Pitt since 2014-15.

TEAM NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - AT FLORIDA STATE

- » The Panthers struggled offensively against Florida State as they shot a season-low 30.4% from the floor in a 67-53 road loss.
- » The Panthers were led offensively by **Dayshanette Harris** who netted a team-high 18 points while **Gabbie Green** added 11 points in the loss.
- » Pitt struggled to take care of the ball as they committed 23 turnovers while also missing multiple layups and easy shots in the lane.
- » For the game, Pitt held the 47-38 edge in rebounds including a 19-8 edge in offensive boards.

THE DAY AND JAY SHOW

- » Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, the Panthers knew they would be relying on their talented guards to produce at a high level and through six games they haven't disappointed.
- » In the loss at Florida State, **Dayshanette Harris** and **Jayla Everett** combined for a season-low 26 points, eight rebounds, five assists and one steal. It marked the first time this season that both players didn't score in double figures.
- » The starting backcourt for Pitt is the highest scoring guard duo overall in the ACC (33.7 ppg) as well as being the highest scoring guard duo in conference games (min. 2 GP) netting 35.3 ppg combined through three conference games.
- » Everett and Harris have each led the team in scoring three times with Everett doing so in the first three games and Harris in the last three. Harris has scored in double digits in all six games and in 14 straight games dating back to last year while Everett has 10+ points in five of the six games this season.
- » Everett has three 20+ scoring games so far this season while Harris has two. For their careers, Everett has 10 games with 20+ points and 37 with 10+ points while Harris has eight games of 20+ and 22 in double figures.

SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

- » The Pitt offense is off to its best start to a season since joining the ACC as they have connected on 43.9% from the floor and 37.0% from behind the arc through six games.
- » The Panthers have shot at least 40% from the floor in five of their first six games this season, the first time they have done so since 2001-02 when they

did it in each of the first six games of the season.

- » The 41.4 field goal percentage through the first six games of the season is the best for Pitt since shooting 47.2% through the first six games in 2010-11.
- » The three-point shooting has been the biggest area of improvement as the Panthers went from 13th in the conference last season in three-point field goal percentage (29.1%) to eighth in the ACC this season (33.9%).
- » As a team, Pitt has connected on 42 three-pointers through the first six games, the most through the first six games since 2014-15 when they netted 46 triples.
- » The Panthers have shot a better percentage from the floor than five of their six opponents this season. Under coach White, Pitt owns a 17-6 record when they shoot a higher percentage than their opponent and just a 2-43 record when being outshot by their opponent.

PANTHERS RACKING UP THE POINTS

- » The Panthers have scored 70+ points in five of their six games this season, marking the first time Pitt has done so to start a season since the 2007-08 campaign when they opened the season with seven straight games with 70+ points scored. The 2007-08 Pitt team advanced to the Sweet 16 for the first time in school history.
- » Pitt scored 70+ points in each of their first two ACC games for the first time in program history.
- » In the win over Clemson, the Panthers netted 80 points for just the fifth time in an ACC game in program history. The Panthers are 5-0 when they score at least 80 points in a conference game.
- » The offense has also put together two of the best scoring quarters since the NCAA switched to the four quarter format in 2015-16. Pitt netted 32 points in the 1st quarter vs. Virginia Tech and 31 points in the 4th quarter vs. Clemson.

ABOUT MIAMI

- The Miami Hurricanes enter Thursday's game with a 6-5 overall record and a 3-5 ACC mark. Miami is coming off of a 35-point loss at Syracuse on Sunday, 99-64.
- The Hurricanes are being led offensively by Kelsey Marshall who is averaging 13.5 ppg and 3.3 rpg while connecting on a team-best 27 three-pointers.
- Endia Banks is enjoying a strong start to her season as she is averaging 10.0 ppg, 3.7 rpg and a team-best 3.6 apg while shooting 45.5% from the floor. Taylor Mason is a do-it-all type player who is averaging 8.4 ppg, a team-high 5.8 rpg, a team-high 1.5 spg and a team-best 30.2 minutes/game.
- As a team, Miami is averaging 66.6 ppg while allowing 66.5 ppg.

HEY DAY DAY

- » Sophomore **Dayshanette Harris** made her 30th career start last time out at Florida State and she responded with a team-high 18 points, three assists and three rebounds in 32 minutes of work. Harris finished the game going 7-for-14 from the floor. It marked the first time in her career she has shot at least 50% from the floor in back-to-back games.
- » Harris has now led the Panthers in scoring in three straight games and she has done so 16 times in her career. She has also scored in double figures in all six games this season and in 14 straight games dating back to last season.
- » She is the first Panther since Yacine Diop in 2017-18 to score 10+ points in six straight games to start the season.
- » Harris is enjoying a career year so far as she is averaging 28.3 minutes, 16.0 points, 5.8 rebounds and 5.3 assists. Her 5.3 apg ranks second in the ACC and 26th in the NCAA.
- » She is one of two players in the NCAA this season to average at least 16.0 ppg, 5.8 rpg and 5.3 apg while shooting at least 41% from the floor (Caitlin Clark, Iowa).
- » In ACC play, Harris currently ranks second in scoring (20.3 ppg), second in assists (5.7 apg), T-6th in field goal percentage (50%), T-6th in steals (1.7 spg) and 11th in free throw percentage (76.9%)

EVERETT EXCELLING IN NEW HOME

- » After earning immediate eligibility following her transfer from New Mexico, **Jayla Everett** has been one of the best players in the ACC so far this season.
- » The St. Louis, MO product is enjoying a great start to her Pitt career as she is averaging 31.0 mpg, 17.7 ppg, 3.0 rpg and 2.3 apg while shooting 47.9% from behind the arc through six games.
- » Everett is currently tied for second in the ACC in scoring (17.7 ppg), first in three-pointers made/game (3.8), first in three-point field goal percentage (47.9%) and second in free throw percentage (95.0%).
- » Last time out at Florida State, Everett had her worst game of the season as she failed to score in double figures for the first time. She finished with eight points, five rebounds and two assists while going 3-for-14 from the floor in the loss.
- » Everett currently ranks second in the NCAA in three-pointers made/game (3.8) while becoming the first Panther in program to net at least two triples in each of the first six games of the season. She is also 18th in the NCAA in three-point field goal percentage (47.9%).
- » Her 23 three-pointers made are the most through the first six games of the season by a Pitt player in program history.
- » Everett is one of two Power 5 players (Katie Benzan, Maryland) shooting at least 47.9% from three-point range while taking at least 48 three-point attempts.

TEAM NOTES...

- » Everett is the first Pitt player in over 20 seasons to net at least 16 points in each of the first five games of the season.
- » Her 106 points scored through six games are the most by a Pitt player since Shavonte Zellous netted 124 points through the first six games of the 2008-09 season, a season in which Zellous was named AP All-American.
- » For her career, Everett has 37 games scoring in double figures including 10 games with 20+ points scored.
- » She has made three or more three-pointers in five games this season and in 17 games over her career.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU

- » Sophomore forward **Amber Brown** has started all 37 career games for the Panthers and does a little bit of everything to help Pitt succeed.
- » Brown has continued to grow into her role in the starting lineup and she posted her second straight game with double digit rebounds in the road loss at Florida State. She finished the game with three points and 10 rebounds across 34 minutes of work.
- » On the season, Brown is averaging 7.0 points, a team-high 6.8 rebounds and 2.0 assists while shooting a team-best 52% from the floor.
- » She has 18 career double digit scoring games and 11 career games with 10 or more rebounds.
- » Brown has posted 20+ minutes played in all 37 career games while leading the Panthers in rebounding a team-best 18 times over her career.
- » Through her first 37 career games, Brown has played 1,158 minutes, the most by a Pitt player in their first 37 career games since Pitt joined the ACC in 2013-14.

EZEJA BECOMING A FORCE ON THE GLASS

- » Redshirt freshman forward Cynthia Ezeja has come on strong of late and forced her way into the Panthers' starting lineup.
- » The talented, Ezeja made her first career start in the road loss to Florida State and finished the game with four points, a career-high 11 rebounds and two blocks in a career-high 25 minutes of action.
- » The Greek forward has two straight games with 10+ rebounds, grabbing at least five offensive rebounds in each contest.
- » In ACC games, Ezeja ranks second in offensive rebounds (4.7 orpg) and 11th in rebounding (8.3 rpg).

MUCH IMPROVED REBOUNDING

- » One of the biggest points of emphasis for the Panthers since Lance White became head coach was rebounding the ball.
- » The Panthers have taken that to heart as they are averaging 8.3 rpg more this season (43.8 rpg) than the season before White took over the program (2017-18 - 35.5 rpg).
- » So far this season, Pitt has won the rebounding battle five times while grabbing 40+ boards in each of those contests.
- » Pitt is averaging 43.8 rpg so far this season, a +4.1 margin from a season ago and seventh best in the ACC. Pitt's 15.3 offensive rebounds/game also rank seventh in the ACC.
- » So far this season, Pitt ranks 31st in the NCAA in rebounding (43.8 rpg).
- » Pitt went from 238th in the NCAA in 2018-19 to 58th in the NCAA last season in total rebounds (1,231) and from 250th in 2018-19 to 75th in the NCAA in rebounds/game (39.7) last season.

2019-20 HIGHLIGHTS

- » The Panthers had a strong close to their 2019-20 campaign as they collected just the second ACC Tournament win in program history as they downed Notre Dame, 67-65, in the first round behind a **Dayshanette Harris** game-winning runner in the lane.
- » One of the brightest spots for the Panthers a season ago was the play of coach White's first recruiting class, **Dayshanette Harris, Amber Brown, Rita Igbokwe** and **Emy Hayford**.
- » The freshman quartet etched their names in the Pitt record book as they became the highest scoring freshman class in program history (948 points combined). The 948 points combined also ranked third amongst Power 5 conference freshman classes in scoring, trailing only USC (1,308 points) and South Carolina (1,047; #1 recruiting class in the NCAA).
- » Pitt was one of two Power 5 conference teams a season ago to have four freshman average at least 19.5 minutes/game (Cal).
- » Guard **Dayshanette Harris** burst onto the scene for the Panthers down the stretch and she finished the year as the only freshman from a Power 5 conference school to lead her team in scoring, assists and steals. Harris was the lone Power 5 conference freshman to average at least 12.5 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 1.8 spg a season ago.
- » Harris earned a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team following her strong first season as a Panther. She is just the second Pitt player in program history (Brenna Wise, 2016) to earn a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- » The dynamic freshman rebounding duo of **Amber Brown** (7.7 rpg - led all ACC freshman) and **Rita Igbokwe** (6.8 rpg) were the third best rebounding freshman duo in the NCAA (14.5 rpg combined). Brown and Igbokwe were one of only two freshman duos in the NCAA (Oregon State) to average at least 6.8 rpg each.
- » Brown earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors twice during her first season as she is just the second Panther in program history to earn that recognition twice in a season (Jasmine Whitney 2016-17).
- » Brown was also the only Power 5 conference freshman to lead her team in minutes played (31.9 mpg) while averaging at least 9.1 ppg and 7.7 rpg.
- » Igbokwe burst onto the scene for the Panthers as a presence down low during her first season. The athletically-gifted Igbokwe set a Pitt freshman record for blocks in a season with 60, breaking the previous record that stood for 43 years.
- » Igbokwe was one of six Power 5 conference freshman a season ago to shoot at least 46.2% from the floor while averaging 6.8 rpg and notch at least 60 blocked shots.
- » Igbokwe had a monster game against Ohio during her freshman season in which she grabbed 18 rebounds which were the most rebounds in a game by a Pitt player since 2010 and the most by a Panther freshman since 2005 when Mercedes Walker snagged 19 boards.
- » Junior sharpshooter **Gabbie Green** exploded onto the scene for Pitt a season ago after transferring in from South Plains College in Texas. Green finished off her first season connecting on 60 three-pointers, the most triples by a junior in program history. The 60 trey's are also the fourth most in a single season in program history.
- » At the conclusion of the season, Pitt placed two student-athletes (**Aysia Bugg** and **Dayshanette Harris**) on the All-ACC Academic Team. It marked the second straight season with two representatives and the ninth and tenth in program history.

LAST MEETING WITH MIAMI

CORAL GABLES, FL – The Pitt women's basketball team closed out their regular season on Sunday afternoon with a road loss to the Miami Hurricanes, 73-54. With the loss, Pitt will be the #15 seed in the ACC Tournament and they will play #10 Notre Dame on Wednesday afternoon.

Dayshanette Harris continued her scoring tear for the Panthers on Sunday as she netted a game-high 22 points to go along with five rebounds and a steal across 30 minutes of action. For Harris, it marked her fourth 20+ point scoring outing during her freshman season, the most since Brianna Kiesel had seven as a freshman in 2011-12. Amber Brown finished off her afternoon with 14 points and five rebounds while Jahsyni Knight came off the bench and grabbed six rebounds.

Harris got out to a nice start for the Panthers as she made a free throw and a mid-range jumper to give Pitt the early 3-2 lead before the Hurricanes used a 5-0 run to take the 7-3 lead into the first media timeout of the game. Out of the timeout, Harris cut the Hurricanes lead down to two, 10-8 but Miami responded with an 8-0 run to close out the first quarter with the 18-8 lead.

Pitt opened the scoring in the second with a triple from Harris but the Hurricanes answered with a layup to make it 20-11 in favor of the home side. The Panthers were able to go on a 6-0 run over the next four minutes as Ismini Prapa knocked down a triple and Harris netted a highlight reel jumper after a great crossover dribble, cutting the Pitt deficit to three, 20-17. After the media timeout, the Hurricanes took control of the game as they went on a 17-4 run to close out the half with the 37-21 lead.

The third quarter was a back-and-forth affair as the Hurricanes held the slim 11-10 edge in scoring through the first five minutes of play. Brown scored six of the Panthers first 10 points in the quarter as she capped it with a rebound and went coast-to-coast to finish off a layup. The Canes pushed their lead out to 62-36 at the end of the third as they closed the quarter on a 14-5 run.

The Pitt freshmen took over the scoring load in the final quarter on Sunday as Harris, Brown and Emy Hayford scored 11 points in the quarter as Pitt outscored Miami 18-11 in the final frame.

Hayford finished her afternoon with five points, four boards and two steals while Rita Igbokwe finished with six rebounds and three blocks in the loss.

As a team, the Hurricanes outrebounded Pitt 49-39 while forcing 17 Panther turnovers that they turned into 23 points. The Miami bench had a strong game as they finished with 32 points while the Pitt bench had nine points.

LANCE WHITE

HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON | TEXAS TECH '96

Lance White enters his third season at the helm of the Panthers in 2020-21 after being named as the ninth head coach in Pitt women's basketball history on April 19, 2018.

In White's second season in charge, the Panthers showed growth in every part of the program and it was capped with an ACC Tournament victory over the defending ACC Champions, Notre Dame. The win over the Irish marked just the Panthers second ACC Tournament win in program history as freshman sensation Dayshannette Harris knocked down the game-winning jumper with just 2.7 seconds left in the game. With the win, Pitt handed Notre Dame just their second loss in ACC Tournament history.

The foundation for the Pitt program was laid in season two as White's "First Class" of seven student-athletes made huge impacts that will shape the program for years to come. The Pitt freshman class of Harris, Amber Brown, Emy Hayford and Rita Igbokwe was not only the best freshman class in the ACC but they were one of the best in the NCAA. The quartet averaged 31.0 points/game combined, the most ever by a Pitt freshman class.

The youthful Panthers roster during the 2019-20 campaign was able to get loads of experience that will help down the road as Pitt was the only team in the ACC to start five newcomers, doing so in the final seven games of the season.

White signed his highest ranking recruiting class for the 2020-21 campaign as he will have five newcomers to the lineup, three freshman and two transfer student-athletes. The three freshman joining the program are Tracey Hueston, the 73rd ranked recruit in the 2020 class, Liatu King and Taisha Exanor. Hueston is the highest rated recruit for the Panthers since joining the ACC while King and Exanor are both three-star prospects with winning pedigrees.

Also joining the 2020 class will be New Mexico transfer Jayla Everett who earned the Mountain West Freshman of the Year accolades in 2018-19 after coming out of Kirkwood High School ranked as the 94th best player in the 2018 class. Sophomore Destiny Strother also transferred to Pitt after one year at Marquette, helping the Eagles to a 24-8 record while coming off the bench.

Off the court, the 2019-20 Panthers posted their best semester in the classroom since joining the ACC as they posted a team cumulative GPA of 3.481. Pitt also saw two student-athletes, Aysia Bugg and Harris, earn ACC All-Academic Team honors for the second straight season.

White notched his first career head coaching victory in the Panthers second game of the season on Nov. 9, 2018 as he led Pitt to the dominant 90-38 victory over New Orleans, their seventh largest defeat in program history and their largest in over a decade.

White collected his first ACC victory on Feb. 14, 2019 when the Panthers knocked off the North Carolina Tar Heels inside the Petersen Events Center, 91-78. The 91 points scored for the Panthers were their most scored in a game since 2014 and their most ever in an ACC contest. Another historic win for the Panthers during White's first season was the road victory over Duquesne in the City Game as they downed the Dukes by the score of 66-58.

With White at the helm, Pitt upped its offensive efficiency as they had four players average over 9.5 points/game including leading scorer Danielle Garven who finished off her impressive senior campaign averaging a career-high 11.8 points and 4.3 rebounds. Fellow senior Cassidy Walsh also had a great season under White's watchful eye as she quadrupled her scoring production from her junior season, averaging a career-high 9.7 points/game for the Panthers. Pitt also posted the fourth best season in school history from behind the arc as they connected on 32.7% from behind the arc while also bumping up their rebounding average to 35.5 rebounds/game.

Off the court, White had a pair of student-athletes, Jasmine Whitney and Cassidy Walsh, named to the All-ACC Academic Team, the most for Pitt since 2015 when they placed three on the team.

White came to Pitt after spending 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons of 20+ wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Seminoles reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in each of its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters. Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to FSU, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

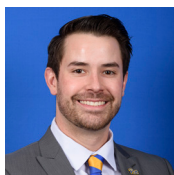

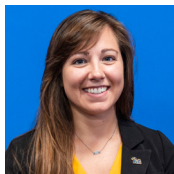

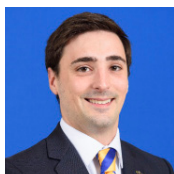
