NOTABLE NUMBERS

The Gators shot 22-for-24 from the free throw line against Gonzaga, a .917 clip. Only twice in the past 20 years has UF shot a higher percentage in a game the team made at least 20 free throws (.926, 25-27, 2/20/10 vs. Ole Mlss; .923, 24-26, 12/6/05 vs. Providence).

One night after playing 11 minutes before fouling out, Devin Robinson played a season-high 34 minutes without picking up a foul and scored a career-best 18 points.

Three of the six Gators with at least 15 free throw attempts are shooting better than 80% from the charity stripe -- KeVaughn Allen has sunk all 15 of his attempts, while Canyon Barry leads UF in makes and attempts at 26-for-31 (.839) and Devin Robinson checks in a shade below 90 percent at 17-for-19 (.895). Of the remaining three, Kasey Hill and Chris Chiozza are both on the good side of 70 percent while John Egbunu's .655 clip is more than 12 percentage points ahead of last season's number.

- Florida meets Miami for the third straight season following the teams' home-and-home series. Though UM took the two most recent meetings, UF still holds a 45-24 all-time series edge.
- UF looks to bounce back from its first loss of the season after coming up short against 11th-ranked Gonzaga. Devin Robinson's career-best 18 points and a 16-8 turnover advantage gave the Gators a chance, but they could not overcome a 2-for-19 night from 3-point range.
- The Gators posted a hard-fought 81-76 win vs. Seton Hall, with KeVaughn Allen (21) and Canyon Barry (20) both topping 20 points. Barry scored six points during a 10-0 second-half run that turned a five-point UF deficit into a five-point lead.
- UF jumped out to a 15-0 lead against Belmont, eventually going up 20-2 in the early goings. The Gators used a 16-0 second-half run to put the Bruins away for good.
- After seeing a 15-point lead erased vs. St. Bonaventure, the Gators went on a 7-0 run in the final minute of the game to claim a 73-66 win in Lakeland.
- Florida's defense stifled Mercer in the first half, allowing 14 points before the break, the fewest of any half under head coach Mike White.
- The Gators closed strong in the season-opening win vs. FGCU on Friday, going on a 15-0 run to sieze control of the game. Over the final 16 minutes of the game, UF outscored the Eagles, 35-9.
- While the Gators' home is renovated, their first seven games and nine of their first 11 will be neutral-site contests this season, along with road games at Florida State and North Florida.
- The \$64.5 million renovation of Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center will be complete in December, with the Gators slated for their home opener on Dec. 21 vs. Little Rock.
- Preseason All-SEC guard KeVaughn Allen is UF's top returning scorer, averaging 11.6 points per game last season and posting 12.3 per game in SEC action.
 The lone underclassman starter, Allen is plenty experienced in his own right, starting 34 of 36 games his freshman campaign.
- Preseason All-SEC center John Egbunu led the Gators in blocked shots (48), ranked second in rebounds (6.5) and third in scoring (11.5) last season.
- Senior point guard Kasey Hill returns with a chance to join the 1,000-point club and reach UF's top five list in career assists. Hill also led the Gators in steals (53) last season.
- Junior wing man Devin Robinson started fast and led UF in scoring in the season opener, tallying 14 points after knocking down a pair of 3-pointers in the first two minutes of the game.
- Backup center Kevarrius Hayes started strong this season, blocking a careerbest five shots vs. FGCU in just 14 minutes.
- Graduate transfer wing Canyon Barry comes to Florida from College of Charleston, where he averaged 12.8 points per game, including 19.7 last season

- The Gators were within one point, 25-24, with two minutes left in the first half, but Miami went on an 8-0 run to close out the half and never led by fewer than five points the rest of the game.
- Miami held a 21-3 scoring advantage from the 3-point line, shooting 7-for-17 (.412) from long range compared to Florida's 1-for-12 (.083).
- Florida also suffered a 42-31 rebounding deficit, as the Gators were limited to nine offensive rebounds.

The University of Florida hired Mike White as head men's basketball coach, on Thursday, May 7 2015

In his first season at the helm, White guided Florida to a 21-15 record, one of three active SEC coaches to post a 20-win season in their first year on the job. It also matched a Florida record for most wins by a first-year head coach.

Under White, the Gators returned to the postseason, advancing to the quarterfinals of the NIT before falling to eventual tournament winner George Washington.



The Gators enter the second year under White's leadership with a unique challenge in front of them, playing the first 11 games of the season away from home as the renovation of Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center finishes. Florida has a total of just 10 home games this season and is scheduled to re-open the building following the \$64.5 million project on Dec. 21.

White, the 2014-15 Conference USA Coach of the Year, came to the Gators after leading Louisiana Tech to a 101-40 record (.716) over past four seasons, including three straight conference championships. Born in Dunedin, Fla., White brought a wealth of SEC experience to the Gators, as a four-year starter at Ole Miss and later an assistant coach for seven seasons under two different head coaches on the Rebels' bench.

QUOTABLE WHITE

On Justin Leon (10/19, SEC Media Day):

"Justin Leon plays as hard as anyone I've ever coached. He's our hardest playing guy, he leads by example, not overly vocal [but gives] effort on a daily basis. You know exactly what you're getting from him daily."

On the team's strengths this season (10/6, UF Media Day):

"I think this team has good experience. We've got really good depth. In my opinion, we've got really good length. And those would be three of the biggest strengths that stick out with this team, so I think we can be really good defensively and that will be the challenge to this team just like it was last year. Just like it was last year, but I think we can be better this year defensively."

On the team's experience and using it properly (10/19, SEC Media Day):

"When you have the number of upperclassmen that this team has, we bring back a lot of these older guys and then you bring in a guy like Canyon Barry, and not that we have three or four first-team all-American caliber guys, we have five or six that on certain nights may have an argument to start or be the second-leading scorer on that night and I think it's easier for agendas to creep in when you're a junior or senior as compare to our freshman and sophomores, because these guys, the rest of their life is right in front of them. Like Kasey Hill, he's seven months from the next chapter in his life and these guys need to be thinking about the right things, like what they can do for each other and what they can do for Florida as a team, that's our message on a daily basis; if we win, we all win."

MEDIA INFORMATION

The University of Florida appreciates the media coverage from all local, regional and national outlets. The Communications Office believes in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the media and we emphasize a positive and professional working environment with all entities. The ultimate goal of the Communications Office is to provide accurate and timely information about our athletic teams and to ensure that we assist the media to the best of our abilities while they cover our program.

GAME COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Denver Parler. To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystems.com/florida. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision on your request is made, you will receive an email with further information. Requests must be made by the day prior to a game (noon for afternoon games or 4:30 p.m. for evening games).

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: Credentials will be mailed up until 10 days prior to the event or held at the Press Will Call window at Gate One of the O'Connell Center, which opens for pick-up 90 minutes prior to each game. Credentials can be overnighted at the expense of the media organization within 10 days of the event (by request).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces exist and can be requested online with your credential application. Please note that if you request to pick up your credentials at Press Will Call, we will be unable to provide a parking pass as you will have to park before visiting Press Will Call. Free parking is available in the deck next to the O'Connell Center and is generally still available 75-90 minutes before the game.

MEDIA ROOM/INTERVIEW AREA: Located between Gates 1 & 4 in the Martial Arts room near the loading dock, the media room includes work space, necessary electrical outlets, a television and wireless internet. A pre-game meal, snacks and soft drinks are also available in the media room. The pre-game meal begins 1:15 before tip. Post-game coach and player press conferences are also conducted in this area.

FLORIDA LOCKER ROOM: The Gator locker room is closed to the media with the exception of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments. Coach White and selected players will be available to the media following games in the media room/interview area. At Florida home games, players are available first while Coach White will follow with a post-game press conference in the Martial Arts/Media Room. If the visiting team chooses to utilize the media room, they will do so either directly before or after Florida players. Coach White will typically go last.

VISITOR LOCKER ROOM: Interview policies and procedures will be determined by visiting Sports Information Directors and coaches. Those procedures will be announced on game days.

GENERAL GAME DAY MEDIA SERVICES: Game program/scorecard, game notes, play-by-play, complete halftime and final statistics, coaches' & player quote sheets and post-game notes are all regular services on game days.

SEATING: Press seating is assigned, and all media members are asked to utilize their assigned seat. A limited number of front-row courtside press seats are available and will be provided to national publications, major daily newspapers and/or those who cover Florida basketball regularly. Additional seating will be at the front row table in the baseline bleachers near Gate 2 and in the second row courtside behind the press table. Photographers are restricted to two baseline locations closest to the team benches.
