### WAKE FOREST AT MIAMI

#### DEACS FLY SOUTH FOR SATURDAY MATCHUP WITH THE HURRICANES

- Wake Forest looks for its second straight win and its second ACC road win of the season
- The game marks the final time the Deacs are scheduled to play outside of the state of North Carolina this season (last five regular season games and ACC Tournament all in NC)
- Only meeting this season between the Demon Deacons and Hurricanes

#### SERIES HISTORY

- Wake Forest leads 12-11 (Miami leads 8-2 in Coral Gables, all at Watsco Center)
- The home team has won the last nine regular season meetings and 16 of 19 since Miami joined the ACC
- Each team won at home last year before the Hurricanes won the ACC Tournament matchup
- Wake's last win in Coral Gables came in 2007

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Wake Forest never trailed on Tuesday as it downed North Carolina 74-57 at LJV Coliseum
- The Deacs led by as many as 26 early in the second half, their largest lead of the season
- The Tar Heels shot 6.3% (1-16) from three, the lowest percentage by a Wake Forest opponent since 2004-05 when Virginia did not make a three against the Deacs (0-12)
- Brandon Childress had 14 points and a career-high 10 assists for his first career double-double

#### BROWN VS. THE STATE OF FLORIDA

- Orlando native Chaundee Brown has loved playing against teams from his home state of Florida, especially on the road
- He has scored at least 20 points in all three previous games in Florida (20 at Miami in '18, 22 at Miami in '19, 20 at Florida State in '19)
- Last year he had a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Miami in the game in Winston-Salem

## INTERVIEW POLICIES

### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

**HEAD COACHES:** Both head coaches will appear in the media room following brief cool-down periods. In most cases, the visiting head coach will appear first, followed by Wake Forest coach Danny Manning.

**WAKE FOREST PLAYERS:** Requested players will be available in the media room following both head coaches' press conferences. The Wake Forest locker room is closed to the media.

**OPPONENT PLAYERS:** Please see the visiting SID. If that team's locker room is closed to the media, interviews are usually held outside in the hallway near the entrance to the visitors' locker room.

### PRE-PRACTICE INTERVIEWS

All interviews with head coach Danny Manning and/or Demon Deacon players should be arranged through Steve Kirkland in the Athletic Communications Office. Interview requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Interviews will be arranged to accommodate players' academic and basketball schedules. Players will not do interviews on gameday, except for postgame interviews. At the conclusion of select practices, Coach Manning and players will be available for interviews after media is permitted to watch the end of practice. Contact Steve Kirkland for the schedule of practices with media availability.

### ACC TELECONFERENCE

The 15 ACC basketball head coaches will be featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday. The teleconferences will begin on Jan. 6, 2020 and conclude on Mar. 2, 2020. Each coach will have 10 minutes to answer questions.

## PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Wake Forest home games should be requested by contacting Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. Please make your requests at least 48 hours prior to tip-off.

Credential requests are contingent on available space. Priority is given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis, in addition to national print and electronic media.

Credentials will not be mailed if the credential request is received one week or less prior to the game. Credentials can be shipped overnight if a FedEx or UPS shipping number is provided.

## PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are restricted to either baseline area and are not permitted along the sidelines during game activity. Photographers will be assigned areas on the baseline.

The facility is lighted by 42 LED lamps with a vertical illumination of 102 footcandles and a horizontal illumination of 139 footcandles.

## MEDIA WILL CALL/MEDIA ENTRANCE

The media entrance to the Coliseum is located at the rear of the facility in close proximity to the media parking area. Media members can enter there and follow the hallway to the media workroom. This also serves as the primary exit for media staying to file stories.

The main media parking lot is located off of Deacon Boulevard in the McCreary Tower Lot. The secondary media lot is located off Deacon Boulevard in the BB&T Field Gold Lot. Only media with valid parking passes or who are on the media parking list will be allowed to park in these areas. Address for the lot is 459 Deacon Blvd.

There is a media will call desk for credentials located at the media entrance.

## MEDIA BAG POLICY

Wake Forest has instituted a clear bag policy for fans at LJVM Coliseum. There are no bag restrictions for credentialed media who enter through the media entrance, but bags will be subject to search.

## MEDIA SEATING

Media will be assigned seats at the press row tables along the baselines or in the five rows of seating in Section 113. Please check the media seating assignments posted in the media workroom.

## MEDIA SERVICES

Pre-game statistics, game notes and roster cards are provided prior to tip-off. Final stats, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be available in the media workroom.

Statistical monitors will be provided for live TV and the home and visiting team radio crews.

Wireless internet access is available in the media workroom and on press row. For user name and password information, check the posted signs in the workroom or ask a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff.

## DEACON NOTES

### NEXT MAN UP

• Wake Forest has been hit with more injuries and illness this season than in recent years

• The Deacs have

had 61 man-games lost due to injury/illness in 2019-20, more than the last four years combined, with seven different players missing time

• Tariq Ingraham has missed all 24 games this season after an achilles tendon injury suffered in preseason practice, Sunday Okeke has missed the last 22 games after an achilles tendon injury suffered in the home opener vs. Columbia, while Chaundee Brown (8), Sharone Wright, Jr. (4), Brandon Childress (1), Isaiah Mucius (1) and Olivier Sarr (1) have also missed time this season due to injury or illness

• Only four Deacons (Torry Johnson, Andrien White, Ismael Massoud and Ody Oguama) have played in every game this season

### GET TO THE LINE

• Wake Forest leads the ACC in free throw attempts (23.3 per game) and is third in free throw percentage (75.2 percent)

• The Deacs' free throw rate of 41.1% (FTA/FGA) ranks 14th nationally and is the highest for a Wake Forest team since 2014-15 (50.1)

• Olivier Sarr ranks second in the ACC with 142 free throw attempts, already more than the 106 he had in his first two seasons combined

• Sarr's 6.2 FTA/game is the highest rate of getting to the line by a Deacon since 2017 when John Collins averaged 6.7 FTA/game

• Olivier Sarr (111) and Brandon Childress (102) rank first and third in the ACC in free throws made this season

• 24.4% of Wake Forest's points this season have come from the line, the fifth highest percentage nationally

• Wake Forest went 24-of-25 from the free throw line against Long Beach State in the semi-finals of the Wooden Legacy, as the 96% was the second-best single-game average in school history (min. 20 attempts), trailing only the ACC record 32-of-32 Wake had against North Carolina in 2005

• Wake has recorded the season-high opponent free throw attempts for five teams (Columbia, Notre Dame, Pitt, UNC Asheville, Virginia)

• The Demon Deacons have drawn a league-high 492 fouls this season

• Wake Forest has had 19 opponents foul out this season, its most since 27 in 2017-18

### DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

• Wake Forest has had four games this season with a pair of players posting a double-double, its most since 2010 when the Deacs had seven games with two players posting a double-double

• Three different pairs have accomplished the feat (Olivier Sarr/Isaiah Mucius -2, Sarr/Chaundee Brown-1, Sarr/Ody Oguama-1), Wake's most since 2010 when four different combinations did so (Al-Farouq Aminu/Chas McFarland-3, Aminu/Ish Smith-2, Aminu/L.D. Williams-1, McFarland/Williams-1)

### IMPROVED D

• Wake Forest has posted its best defensive numbers of the Manning era this season

• The Deacs have

a KenPom adjusted defensive rating of 99.5 their best since 2013

• Wake has forced opponents to shoot under 40% from the floor in nine games this season while only allowing three opponents to shoot at least 50%, its best ratio of the last six seasons

### TAMING THE TIGERS

• Wake Forest used a strong defensive effort in the 56-44 victory over Clemson on Feb. 1

• The Tigers' 44 points were the fewest scored by an ACC opponent in the 30-year history of the LJV Coliseum and were the fewest points allowed by the Deacs to an ACC opponent in the shot clock era

• Clemson's 44 points were the fewest allowed by the Deacs in any game since a 62-31 win over Winston-Salem State in 2008-09

• Clemson's 19 first-half points were the fewest scored by a Wake Forest opponent at halftime since 2016 (14 by Boston College)

• The Tigers shot 30.5% from the floor, the lowest a Wake opponent has shot since Quinnipiac (28.8%) in 2017-18 and the lowest for an ACC opponent since Pitt (30.2) in 2016-17

### SHARP-SHOOTING VS. UNC ASHEVILLE

• In the 98-79 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 13, the Deacs shot 70.2% from the floor (33-47), the second-highest field goal percentage in program history

• The game only trailed a 73.5% (36-49) shooting night against Fairleigh Dickinson in 1979-80

• Against UNCA, the Deacs shot 70.4 percent in the first half and 70.0% in the second half, the first time in school history that Wake shot at least 70% in both halves of a game

• The 70.2% from the floor is the second highest FG% against a Division I team this season

## DEACON NOTES

### THE BIG FRENCHMAN

• Olivier Sarr has established himself as arguably the most improved player in the ACC this year

• Sarr is averaging 12.8 points per game this season, more than double of last year (6.2)

• With 207 boards, Sarr is closing in on his total from his first two seasons combined (226)
