Second Team All-BIG EAST, 1997 Co-Team MVP, 1997 Magna Cum Laude, 1998 Atlantic 10 Regular Season Title, 2015 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, 2015 The University of Miami announced Feb. 27, 2018 the hiring of Sarah Barnes as the new head coach of the Hurricanes soccer program.

Barnes enters her fourth season at Miami after spending six seasons as the head coach at George Washington University, where she was named the 2015 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year.

Over her six seasons at GW, Barnes led the Colonials to a 60-41-14 (.583) mark, including a 48-23-8 (.658) record the last four years.

In 2013, her second season at GW, Barnes guided the Colonials to their first A-10 Championship berth since 2002, beginning a streak of five consecutive years in the conference tournament.

The following year, Barnes turned in the first of four straight seasons with double-digit victories, as the Colonials finished 12-6-1 (4-3-1).

In 2015, Barnes led GW to a 15-5-0 (10-0-0) mark and the program's first A-10 regular season titles since 1995. It was the first time in school history the team finished with a perfect conference record. After tallying an 11-7-3 (4-3-3) record in 2016, Barnes concluded her GW tenure with a 10-5-4 (5-2-3) campaign.

Prior to joining the Colonials, Barnes spent four seasons as an assistant at the University of Texas. The Longhorns went 47-30-12 (.596), both reaching the NCAA Championship and notching 12-plus victories three times.

Barnes started her coaching career at her alma mater, the University of Connecticut, from 1998-2007. She spent two years as a volunteer assistant, seven as an assistant coach and one as the associate head coach.

In her decade on the UConn staff, the Huskies went 167-57-17 (.728), winning six BIG EAST regular season title and two conference tournament crowns. UConn made the NCAA Championship all 10 years, advancing to the Sweet 16 eight times, the Elite Eight six times and the national championship once, in 2003.

Barnes holds multiple United Soccer Coaches certifications and a U.S. Soccer Federation "D" license. She spent two years with the Olympic Development (ODP) Region I staff, working with the U-14 and U-16 age groups.

Additionally, Barnes served as a Connecticut ODP head and assistant coach from the U-13 to U-17 age groups. In 2006, she earned the Thomas E. Krusewski Memorial Young Coach of the Year from the Connecticut Junior Soccer Association.

During her collegiate playing career, Barnes led UConn to a dazzling 83-14-2 (.848) record, including a school record 23 wins her final season. The Huskies made the NCAA Elite Eight every year, reaching the College Cup in 1994 and 1997, advancing to the national final the latter year.

In 1997, her last season, Barnes was a co-captain, co-team MVP and a Second Team All-BIG EAST honoree. She graduated magna cum laude from UConn in 1998 with a degree in sociology. The next year, Barnes earned a master's degree with a dual emphasis on social psychology and women in sports.

A native of Snohomish, Wash., Barnes made the NCAA Championship 17 of 18 years as a player or coach from 1994 through 2011.

• Miami opens conference play, hosting the Louisville Cardinals at Cobb Stadium. Friday's match is set for 7 p.m. EST, and will air on ACC Network Extra with Joe Zagacki and Juan Arango on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on WVUM 90.5 FM.

• The Canes and Cards have gone head-to-head seven times, last squaring off on Sept. 17, 2020. Friday's contest will mark the eighth straight year the two sides have played, including the third consecutive meeting in Coral Gables. Louisville holds a 5-1-1 advantage in the series.

SCOUTING THE CARDINALS

• Louisville finished 4-1-1 across its non-conference slate. The Cardinals are coming off a 1-1 draw against No. 16 Michigan. Louisville has posted a +8 goal differential over the first six matches.

• Sixth-year goalie Gabby Kouzelos recorded back-to-back shutouts in wins over NKU and Saint Louis, the 27th and 28th of her career at Louisville, which is a program record. Kouzelos, who was named All-ACC third team last fall, has allowed just two goals in the last four matches.

NOTABLE NON-CONFERENCE

• Miami posted three shutouts in non-conference play, the most since 2017. The trio of clean sheets matches the total of the last two seasons combined.

• Taylor Shell's overtime goal against Florida on Aug. 29 secured the Hurricanes first victory over the rival Gators since 2012.

Senior captain Selena Fortich has been a fixture on the backline since she stepped on campus in 2018, notching 47 career starts in 49 games. Sophomore Delaney Brown was the lone Hurricane to start all 13 matches last season. Brown logged a team-high 1,029 minutes in her first collegiate season.


