Miami swept Virginia Tech on Oct. 24 in Blacksburg, Va.

- Angela Grieve and Janet Kalaniuvalu recorded double-digit kills. Grieve tallied a match-best 18, while Kalaniuvalu finished with 10.
- Savannah Vach led the match with 32 assists.
- Priscilla Hernandez notched a match-best 20 digs.

HISTORICALLY AGAINST SYRACUSE

- Miami has won four of the last five meetings.
- The two teams last met in Oct. 2020, after last year's match was canceled.
- The Canes took the last meeting, 3-1.
- Janet Kalaniuvalu led Miami in that win with 17 kills on a .405 attacking percentage. She added a game-high four aces, two blocks and four digs.
- Janice Leao posted a match-high five blocks and 12 kills.
- Savannah Vach notched a match-best 47 assists. The setter added six digs, two kills and an ace.
- Priscilla Hernandez tallied seven digs, while Emily Damon finished with four.

SCOUTING THE ORANGE

- Syracuse has won just one of its last five matches, a sweep over Clemson in its last match on Oct. 24.
- The Cuse lead the ACC with 200 total blocks, while sitting third with an attacking percentage in the conference, .280.
- Syracuse is fifth in the ACC with a mark of 12.42 assists per set.
- The Orange's 1,070 kills are third in the conference.
- As a team, the Cuse have the third fewest digs (989) and digs per set (12.68) in the ACC.
- Marina Markova leads the conference with 328 kills and is second with 4.21 kills

Polina Shemanova's 32 aces leads the ACC.

- The Hurricanes are receiving votes in the AVCA poll for the third straight week.
- UM has been ranked in the AVCA Poll 15 times, the highest ranking, in a non-COVID year, being 20th on Sept. 12, 2011.
- The Canes are currently 15th in the RPI, on track to be the highest final RPI in a season for the program.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS

- Miami has earned sweeps in 13 of its 17 wins this year. The four non-sweeps include four set wins over USF on Sept. 3 and FSU on Oct. 6, and a pair of five set wins over North Carolina on Oct. 1 and Wake Forest on Oct. 22.
- The Canes 13 sweeps are the most in a season since 2014 when they recorded 14 sweeps.

DEFENDING THE ATTACK

 Miami held Virginia Tech (Oct. 26) to just a .019 attacking percentage, the lowest for a Cane's opponent this season.

MAKING THEM PEY(MAN)

 Freshman Peyman Yardimci's 19 kills, 43 attacks and 14 digs at Wake Forest marked new career-highs.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME

 Miami's reverse sweep against Wake Forest, Oct. 22, is the first since Aug. 25, 2017, against Southern Miss.

- Peyman Yardimci notched her second career double-double against Wake Forest with career-best marks of 19 kills and 14 digs.
- Savannah Vach leads the team with six double-doubles this year. She has 22 in her career.
- She registered four-straight from Sept. 26 to Oct. 6.

MOVIN' ON UP

 Savannah Vach's season-high 89 combined assists against Wake Forest and Virginia Tech to move into fourth in program history with 2,444 career assists.

SEASON HIGH OUTING

- Miami tallied season-best marks in kills (65), assists (61) and points (77.0) in last weekend's match at Wake Forest.
- This marks the first match this year with 60 or more kills and assists.

NATIONALLY RANKED

- Janice Leao's 1.49 blocks per set is fifth in the entire NCAA. She is 14th with 103 total blocks.
- Miami is 21st in the nation with a blocks per set mark of 2.62.
- Savannah Vach is one of 22 players in the country with at least one triple-double this season.
- Vach's 10.71 assists per game is 28th best in all of Division I.
- Vach is ranked 14th among active players with 10.42 assists per set in her career.

SET UP FOR SUCCESS

 Miami has won 54 of its 66 sets played this season, posting a set win percentage of .818.

EXTRA VOLLEYBALL

- The Canes have played extra volleyball four times this season, all in the first sets of matches.
- Miami took its first set against North Carolina (29-27), NC State (32-30), and Duke (26-24). It fell, 27-25, to Florida State.

YET TO LOSE

- UM holds a 15-0 record when it wins the first two sets this season.
- The Hurricanes are 6-0 in matches played on a Sunday this year.
- UM is 13-0 in matches where it has recorded more blocks than the opponent.
- When Miami posts more kills, it is 13-0 this season.
- The Canes are 12-0 when tallying more service aces than their opponents in 2021.

BLOCK PARTY

- In their outing against NC State, on Oct. 3, the Hurricanes posted a season-high 15 blocks off 30 assisted blocks.
- Janice Leao led the way with nine total blocks, while Peyman Yardimci and Aristea Tontai each posted six.
- Miami has eight games this season with double-digit blocks, including four-straight from Sept. 26 to Oct. 6.

- Savannah Vach notched her first career triple-double at the Sunshine State Classic against UCF (Sept. 16) with 16 kills, 28 assists, and 11 digs.
- The triple-double is the first to be recorded since head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara took the helm in 2013.

CAREER FIRST

• Freshman setter Alanys Viera earned her first career double-double after recording 17 assists and 10 digs against UCF.

TOP OF THE CONFERENCE

- Miami has been strong on the receiving end of attacks this season, posting the second-highest digs per set mark in the ACC at 15.36.
- At the net, the Canes have been a force with the second-lowest marks for opponent hitting percentage (.168) and fifth-fewest opponent kills (836).
- The Hurricanes mark of 2.68 blocks per set is the third-most in the ACC. Their 181 blocks rank seventh.
- Miami is averaging 12.39 assists per set, which is the sixth best in the conference.

CANES IN THE ACC

- Janice Leao is second in the conference with 1.49 blocks per game and 103 total blocks this year. She is sixth with a .356 hitting percent-
- Savannah Vach is fifth in assists (707), while sitting third with 10.71 assists per set.
- Priscilla Hernandez sits fifth with a season-mark of 294 digs. She is second with 4.26 digs per set.
- Angela Grieve is 10th in the ACC in kills (250) and sixth in kills per set (3.73).

NEW FACES IN THE CROWD

- The Hurricanes welcomed nine new players to this year's squad, including seven freshman and two graduate transfers.
- Tyanna Omazic joins the Canes from Missouri and Aristea Tontai was previously at North Carolina.
- Miami's seven freshman include -- Hanna Bissler, Ashley Carr, Yaidaliz Rosado, Alanys Viera, Nyah Anderson, Peyman Yardimci, and McKayla Vincent.
- Tontai, Bissler, Carr, Rosado, Viera, Anderson, Yardimci, and Vincent have all seen action in at least one set this season.

Jose "Keno" Gandara accepted the position of head volleyball coach at the University of Miami on March 20, 2013, becoming the second head coach since the program returned in 2001.

The Hurricanes returned the NCAA Championship in 2017 for the fourth time in five seasons under Gandara's leadership. Miami won its first postseason match since 2014, defeating the College of Charleston in the opening round of the tournament in a Gainesville, Fla. The Canes fell to No. 2 Florida in four sets in an exciting second round matchup to close the season 22-6 and finish with their best winning percentage since 2012

Senior outside hitter Olga Strantzali was named ACC Player of the Year and AVCA East Coast Region Player of the Year. Strantzali was joined by redshirt junior setter Haley Templeton on the All-ACC First Team and AVCA All-East Coast Region team. Strantzali and Templeton topped off a memorable season with AVCA All-America Honorable Mention recognition. The Canes both started and finished the campaign strong, winning the first nine matches and the seven contests prior to falling to second-seeded Florida. Miami topped the ACC in service aces with 1.71 per set and finished the season in the top three of two additional categories – hitting percentage (second with .246) and kills (tied for third with 13.64 per set).

In 2016, Gandara led a resilient Miami squad that proved to rise to the occasion when it stepped into an opponent's gym. The 2016 Hurricanes won 11 matches away from Coral Gables, picking up big road wins at Notre Dame and Louisville. Junior outside hitter Olga Strantzali developed into one of the best players in the country, receiving AVCA All-America honorable mention and earned AVCA All-East Coast Region and First Team All-ACC honors. Strantzali and freshman setter Hannah Sorensen were named to the All-ACC Academic Team in recognition of their success on the court and in the classroom.

Gandara led the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments in his first three seasons at the helm of the Miami volleyball program. The Canes were selected to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, where they faced lowa State in a first round match in Madison, Wis. The Canes finished the season 21-10 and 14-6 in the ACC, while Miami's 21 wins marked the second consecutive 20-win season under Gandara's leadership. The Hurricanes saw seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott, as well as sophomores Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton, named to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team with Strantzali and Templeton also earning AVCA All-East Coast Region Honorable Mention.

Miami reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach. Miami's 22 wins also gave Gandara his first 20-win season at the helm of the program.

The Canes reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Gandara helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savanah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selections and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

The 2013 season was filled with firsts for Gandara. He secured his first win as a NCAA head coach on Aug. 30, when Miami defeated Austin Peay, 3-1. Gandara collected his first home win when Miami beat LSU in five sets on Sept. 14. The first-year head coach tallied his first ACC win when the Canes defeated Boston College in five sets on Sept. 28. Gandara also guided the Canes to their fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance and first under his tutelage.

The Hurricanes dropped their first-round match against Oregon in three sets, but 2013 was still a successful first season under Gandara. Miami had four players earn All-ACC distinction, including Savanah Leaf and Emani Sims (first team), Alexis Mourning (second team) and Ryan Shaffer (third team). The Canes defeated No. 12 North Carolina at home and earned one of the coveted 64 spots in the NCAA Tournament.

Gandara came to Miami after spending eight years as an assistant at the University of Washington. He previously served as an assistant at UNLV and his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

Gandara is a highly respected teacher who has played and coached at the top levels of college and professional volleyball. Keno assisted former Washington head coach Jim McLaughlin with all aspects of coaching, including opponent scouting and contributing to the Huskies' defensive package. The Huskies won a National Championship in Keno's first year on staff, 2005, and reached the 2006 Final Four.

Gandara began his coaching career at UCSB in 1992 as an assistant with the men's team and was an assistant with the women's team in 1994. He also spent one season as a head coach/player with the San Juan Volleyball club in the Puerto Rico Professional League.

A San Juan, Puerto Rico, native, Gandara graduated from UC Santa Barbara in 1990 after a successful volleyball career with the Gauchos as a middle blocker. Gandara was a first team All-America selection in 1989 and second team selection in 1988 after leading UCSB to the national title match. He was also a two-time all-conference honoree. Gandara has also been inducted into the UCSB Hall of Fame. He also represented both the United States and Puerto Rico in international competition as a member of their respective national volleyball teams.

Gandara is married to Stephanie Cox who was a standout setter at UCSB and played on the AVP Tour. The couple welcomed their first child, a son named Lucas. in April 2011.
