**THE HATTERS NICKNAME**

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### All-Time Series - 24th Meeting

Miami leads the all-time series 19-4. The two teams last met in the 2014 WNIT First Round, a 70-63 Stetson victory in Miami. It was the Hatters' first-ever NCAA postseason win.

### Season Opener Recap

Stetson opened its 2021-22 season with a bang, setting the school record for most points in a game in a 127-36 victory over Johnson University Florida Tuesday night at the Edmunds Center. The Hatters (1-0) also set team records for most field goals (54), highest field goal pct. (.659), and most assists (36) in a game. The 91-point win was the program's second-largest-ever margin of victory, and the team's 32 steals also ranked as the second-highest total all-time. Graduate transfers Ayanna Dublin and Tatiana Streun led the way with 22 points apiece, while freshman Alyssa Hargrove dropped in 21 in her collegiate debut.

Other highlights from the opener:

- ▶ Six different Hatters scored in double figures
- ▶ Dublin went 11-for-12 from the floor for a .917 field goal pct.
- ▶ Streun pulled down 13 rebounds for her first double-double as a Hatter.
- ▶ Jamiya Turner (7-for-7 FG) and Mali Morgan-Elliott each scored 16 points.
- ▶ Khamya McNeal approached a triple double with 12 points, nine assists, eight rebounds and six steals.
- ▶ Stetson led by 27 after 1, by 49 at the break, and by 74 after 3

### Story Lines

- ▶ The Hatters return five letterwinners while seven newcomers join the program.
- ▶ Of the 12 players on the roster, 9 have already turned 20.
- ▶ The 20-21 ASUN leader in steals, Yazz Wazeerud-Din was named the ASUN Preseason all-conference team
- ▶ Jamiya Turner looks to build upon a strong finish from last season
- ▶ Graduate transfers Ayanna Dublin (Northeastern) and Tatiana Streun (Portland State) are each on "year six" of their NCAA eligibility. They each start the season as 23-year-olds and will turn 24 during the season
- ▶ Mali Morgan-Elliott transfer to Stetson from Toledo and Khamya McNeal transfers to Stetson from Syracuse.
- ▶ True freshmen Alyssa Hargrove, Landyn Owens, and Haley Steinbrickner look to make their collegiate debuts.
- ▶ Stetson has ranked eighth in the ASUN in scoring in each of the past two seasons (62.0 ppg in 20-21).
- ▶ Stetson ranked ninth (last) in the league in rebounding in 20-21 (33.7)
- ▶ Stetson averaged a school-record 6.9 3-pointers per game last season
- ▶ Dublin, Streun and Morgan-Elliott have over 1300 career rebounds combined
- ▶ The ASUN has added EKU, Central Arkansas and Jacksonville State

### 11-Year Success

In the past 11 seasons (since the start of 2010-11), the Stetson women's basketball team has:

- ▶ Won 219 games (219-132, .619)
- ▶ Posted seven 20+ win seasons
- ▶ Made 10 postseason appearances (NCAA-2, WNIT-5, WBI-3)
- ▶ Won three ASUN Championships (2011, 2013, 2017-regular season)
- ▶ Broke the school record for most wins in a season three times (2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14).

### Wazeerud-Din Named Preseason All-Conference

Senior guard Yazz Wazeerud-Din was selected to the ASUN Preseason All-Conference team. Wazeerud-Din, a second-team all-conference performer in 2020-21, averaged 15.6 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.4 steals-per-game. She led the team and ranked fourth in the ASUN in scoring, and she led the league in steals (59) and free throws made (97). The ASUN Player of the Week and two-time ASUN Newcomer of the Week scored in double figures in 21 of 25 games, including all four postseason contests. Her game-winning buzzer beater in overtime lifted Stetson to a 78-76 win at North Florida on Jan. 3.

### Year Six

Graduate transfers Ayanna Dublin (Northeastern) and Tatiana Streun (Portland State) are each on "year six" of their NCAA eligibility. Each played for four seasons, beginning in 2016-17 and including the free COVID year of 2020-21, and had one medical redshirt season. They are each pursuing an MBA degree at Stetson. They each start the season as 23-year-olds and will turn 24 during the season. Their teammates call them "Grannies".

### Magic Number 74

Stetson has won 88 consecutive games when scoring 74 points or more, dating back to the 2012-13 season opener (lost 77-75 vs. Hofstra).

### From the Arc

- ▶ Maddie Novak's is the team's active career leader in 3-pointers with 78
- ▶ Yazz Wazeerud-Din hit at least one 3-pointer in 16 of her last 17 games (went 0-for-5 in '21 season finale)
- ▶ Overall, Stetson averaged a school-record 6.9 3-pointers per game last season
