#### WE'RE BACK!

After opting out of the 2020-2021 season, Bethune-Cookman women's basketball returns in full force eager to make a return to the NCAA tournament with a new coaching staff and in a new conference -- the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

### **BLENDING**

Five returning players from 2020 are on the roster, including two who played in the 2019 NCAA tournament -- Camary Harris and Tania White. Three players -- Morgan Beacham, Tatum Hayes and Imani Reid -- joined Harris and White on the 2020 team that won 15 games in a row en route to a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference championship.

### **BACK HOME**

The Miami game will be a home-coming for freshman Kayla Clark, who prepped at Central HS. She averaged 14.2 points and 9.8 rebounds her junior season at Central. She shot 48 percent from the field and was considered among the best post players in Dade County.

### A NEW HOME

After 40 years in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, the Wildcats made the move to the Southwestern Athletic Conference this year. B-CU was picked to finish eighth in the 12 team league in the preseason poll.

### THE NEW BOSS

Janell Crayton is the seventh Head Coach in the Lady Wildcat program history since its 1976 restoration. She succeeds Vanessa Blair-Lewis, who is the now the coach at George Mason.

Bethune-Cookman University Department of Intercollegiate Athletics anounced on July 1, 2021 the appointment of Coach Janell Crayton as head coach of the Women's Basketball program.

Coach Crayton has an extensive resume of leadership on and off the court and comes from Kennesaw State University where she served two years as assistant coach/recruiting coordinator. Prior to Kennesaw State, she worked under Coach David Six at Hampton University where she was a part of three straight winning seasons which included a place in the NCAA tournament in 2016-17. Prior to Hampton, Coach Crayton also served a well-respected list of other fine institutions including UNC Asheville, the College of William and Mary, Colgate University, Oberlin College, and Oglethorpe.

Off the court, Coach Crayton served as a Campaign Associate for The United Way of Greater Atlanta where she led multiple fundraising campaigns and coordinated with large corporate partners to help raise tens of thousands of dollars for the organization.

An amazing athlete, Coach Crayton boasts international playing experience that include stops throughout the Czech Republic and Izmir, Turkey, where she also ran youth camps. Coach Crayton also had the opportunity to teach basketball fundamentals to high school students at Wesley Girls School in Ghana West Africa.

A native of Atlanta, Georgia, Coach Crayton recently obtained her Master's Degree from Ohio University where she completed the prestigious Sports Administration program. She is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), as well as the Black Coaches Association and has also graduated from the NCAA Women's Coaches Academy.

Crayton is a 2006 graduate of Davidson College, where she was a four-year letter winner for the Wildcats. A two-year captain, Crayton was named First-Team All-Southern Conference and All-Tournament Team in 2006. In addition, she was named to the North Carolina All-State team in 2006. On top of her court performances, she was also a standout in the classroom. She was twice named to Academic All-Conference.

"I am honored to be given this awesome opportunity as well as responsibility. Bethune-Cookman is a prestigious institution and the chance to lead the women's basketball program is a lifelong dream come true. I am so excited to work with the young women of this team as well as the entire Wildcat family. I look forward to embarking on this journey as we move into the SWAC conference and continue to build a successful program on and off of the court." said Coach Crayton.
