- NC State dropped its third consecutive with an 84-70 loss to Wright State on Dec. 21. The loss snapped NC State's 29-game home winning streak over non-conference regular season opponents.
- Freshman guard Terquavion Smith led the Pack with 27 points on 12-of-24 shooting. The 27 points are a season-best for the Greenville, N.C. native and the 24 field goal attempts are the most in a single game by an ACC player this season.
- Smith has been on a scoring tear in the month of December. He has scored in double figures in five consecutive games and is averaging 19.4 points per game over that stretch. His 27 points are the second-most by an ACC freshman this season and his three 20-point performances this season and the second-most for an ACC freshman.
- Senior forward Jericole Hellems added 14 points, a season-high tying seven rebounds and two steals against Wright State. Hellems has now scored in double figures in nine consecutive games and ranks second on the team in scoring at 14.4 points per game.
- Redshirt sophomore guard Dereon Seabron is leading NC State in scoring (19.0 ppg.), rebounding (10.3), assists (3.1 apg) and steals (1.8 spg). His 50.9 percent field goal shooting is also the best on the team. Seabron is the only player in the ACC to lead his team in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals.



#### **NOTING NC STATE**

■ Between COVID pauses and injuries, Kevin Keatts was constantly juggling the lineup last season. In 25 games, eight players started at least eight games. Five of those eight players return this season.

- Kevin Keatts is entering his fifth season as head coach of NC State and for the fifth consecutive season he will have to replace the previous season's leading scorer. Devon Daniels led the team in scoring last season at 16.5 points per game. Jericole Hellems is the leading returning scorer at 12.9 points per game.
- North Carolina's team? Nine of NC State's 14 players are from the state of North Carolina. That's the most of the four ACC programs based in North Carolina. UNC has six of its 17 players from the state. Duke has five of its 14 players from the state and Wake Forest has four of its 19 players from the state.
- NC State only has two players (Thomas Allen and Jericole Hellems) who will complete their eligibility this season. Allen is a redshirt senior, who played his first two seasons at Nebraska before transfering home to NC State. Hellems is the only four-year senior on the team. He and redshirt junior Manny Bates have each been in the program four years. Nine of NC State's 14 players are either in their first or second seasons with the program.
- After not adding any transfers last season for the first time since he became head coach, Kevin Keatts added two transfers this offseason in Providence transfer Greg Gantt and Virginia transfer Casey Morsell. Keatts has now added 13 transfers to the program in his five seasons as head coach.

#### NOTING MIAMI

- Miami returns three starters from last season's 10-17 squad.
- Third-year sophomore guard Isaiah Wong was a preseason first-team All-ACC selection and is currently averaging 15.6 points per game. Sixth-year senior Kameron McGusty leads the Hurricanes in scoring at 18.4 points per game.

#### **WEDNESDAY STORYLINES**

- Pack is looking for its sixth consecutive ACC road win. NC State ended the 2021-22 regular season winning its last five conference road games. The current five-game road winning streak is the longest for NC State since an 11-game road ACC win streak from 1972-1974.
- NC State is seeking to avoid just its second four-game losing streak of the Kevin Keatts era on Wednesday. Last season, NC State lost its first four games of January (including a 10-day COVID pause in the middle of the losing streak) before beating Wake Forest on Jan. 27 to end its skid.
- Senior forward Jericole Hellems enters Wednesday's game needing just 20 points to become the 55th player in NC State history to score 1,000 career points. He'd be the third player under head coach Kevin Keatts to go over 1,000 career points (Markell Johnson and Braxton Beverly).
- Terquavion Smith continues to have a breakout December. Smith scored 20 points in his collegiate debut against Bucknell on 11/9 and scored in double figures in the next two games for NC State to start the season, but then went four straight games without a double figure scoring game. In the last five games, Smith is averaging 19.4 points per game and has hit 13 three-pointers (2.6 per game) during this stretch. Smith has been named ACC Freshman of the Week in back-to-back weeks and scored a then career-high 21 points in the loss to top-ranked Purdue on Dec. 12. In his most recent outing, the Greenville, N.C. native scored a season-high 27 points against Wright State.
- Two of the best teams in the nation at valuing the basketball face-off on Wednesday night. NC State has had single digit turnovers in eight of 12 games this season and rank third in the ACC and 16th in the NCAA with an average of 10.1 turnovers per game. Miami has had single digit turnovers in six of 12 games this season and ranks second in the ACC and 12th in the NCAA with an average of 9.9 per game. The Pack has had less turnovers than its opponents in 10 of 12 games this season and Miami has had less turnovers than its opponents in 11 of 12 games this season. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 71-28 (71.7%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent, but just 6-4 this season. Sophomore point guard Cam Hayes has had one turnover or less in eight of 12 games this season and is averaging just one turnover for every 28.8 minutes played.
- Get Casey Morsell back on track. Through the first seven games of the season, junior guard Casey Morsell was averaging 12.3 points per game. The Ft. Washington, Md., native was injured towards the end of the Pack's four overtime win over Nebraska on Dec. 1. Morsell missed the Pack's games against Louisville and Bethune-Cookman before returning to the lineup for NC State's game against Purdue. In the three games since returning to the lineup, Morsell is averaging 3.0 points per game and shooting 14.3% (2-of-14 from the field
- The Pack leads the ACC in offensive rebounding with an average of 12.8 per game. Dereon Seabron averages 3.5 offensive rebounds per game to lead the ACC and rank 18th in the NCAA. Miami is last in the ACC in offensive rebounding and ranks 14th in the ACC in rebounding margin at -2.8 per game.
- Experience vs. Youth: Miami is one of the most veteran teams in the country, with three sixth-year seniors in their starting lineup. Out of the 10 players that play regularly this season for Miami, only two are in their first or second season of playing college basketball. NC State has grizzled veteran Jericole Hellems (105th career game on Wednesday), but six of NC State's regular rotation players are freshmen or sophomores. Redshirt sophomore Dereon Seabron has the second-most appearances in an NC State uniform this season and he'll be playing his 37th collegiate game on Wednesday.

#### NC STATE - MIAMI SERIES

- Wednesday is the 27th meeting between the two programs. NC State leads the all-time series, 14-12.
- Kevin Kearts has a 3-2 record against Miami as head coach of NC State, including a 2-0 record in games played at the Watsco Center.
- Miami won last season's only meeting, 64-59, inside PNC Arena. The Pack led 51-45 with 6:45 to play, but Miami outscored NC State 19-8 the rest of the way to win. Thomas Allen led NC State with 14 points while Isaiah Wong had 24 points and nine rebounds for the Hurricanes.

#### **DEREON SEABRON BREAKING OUT**

- Redshirt sophomore guard Dereon Seabron has broken out as one of the ACC's best players in the first month of the season.
- Seabron leads the ACC with seven double-doubles this season and is currently atop of the ACC individual rankings in rebounding (10.3) and offensive rebounding (3.5). He ranks third in the league in scoring (19.0), sixth in steals (1.8) and eighth in field goal percentage (50.9).
- The ACC doesn't give out player of the month honors, but if it did it would be hard to find a better candidate than Seabron for the month of November. The Norfolk, Va., ended the month, leading the ACC in steals (2.67), tied for first in rebounding (9.83), second in offensive rebounding (3.0), third in field goal percentage (60.3%) and fourth in scoring (18.8). Seabron also had four double-doubles in November, the most of any player in the ACC.
- Seabron averaged 5.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game last season as a redshirt freshman. He saw limited time in the first two months of the season as minutes were hard to find with Devon Daniels playing ahead of him. Daniels was injured in the Pack's win over Wake Forest on Jan. 27. At that point in the season Seabron was averaging 3.8 points and 2.4 rebounds per game and had only played more than 15 minutes in a game two times. After Daniels went down, Seabron's minutes went up and he started to show flashes of what was to come this season. He averaging 8.4 points per game over last eight outings of the season and had all three double-digit scoring games of the season during that stretch. He ended the regular season by being named ACC Freshman of the Week on March 8 after posting then career-highs in points (17), rebounds (13) and blocks (3) in a win at Notre Dame

#### HELLEMS HAS SHOWN SUSTAINED IMPROVEMENT

- NC State senior forward Jericole Hellems has improved his numbers every season of his collegiate career. After making a jump in every statistical category as a sophomore, Hellems made another jump as a junior as he has increased his output in every category.
- The Saint Louis, Mo., native was the only NC State player last season to lead the team in at least one game in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks.

#### WHAT THE PACK IS MISSING IN MANNY BATES

- Redshirt junior forward Manny Bates suffered a right shoulder dislocation just 57 seconds into the Pack's season-opener and will miss the rest of the regular season.
- The Fayetteville, N.C. native had led the ACC in blocked shots in his freshman and sophomore seasons and was aiming to be the first ACC player since Duke's Shelden Williams (2004-06) to lead the conference in blocked shots in three consecutive seasons.
- Bates registered his 100th career block in just his 34th career game. He is the fastest player in program history to 100 blocks and is the fastest ACC player to 100 career blocks in over 20 seasons. Since 1985-86, Wake Forest's Tim Duncan and Georgia's Tech Alvin Jones are the only ACC players to get to 100 blocks in less games than Bates.
- Bates ranks third (83 freshman season) and sixth (64 sophomore season) on NC State's single-season blocked shot chart and is fourth on the program's career blocked shot list.
- Bates has also been an efficient scorer for the Pack. Last season, Bates set the program's single-season field goal percentage record by shooting 64.1 percent (100-of-156) from the field. He also shot 68.6 percent from the free throw line, improving over 20 percentage points from his freshman campaign at the stripe.
- For his career, Bates is shooting 64.7 percent (165-of-255) from the field. He needs 200 made field goals to qualify for the career field goals chart. His current shooting pace would shatter the current leader in career field goal percentage (Kevin Thompson, 1990-93 58.8%).

#### **EXPERIENCE LACKING BEHIND MANNY BATES**

- The Pack does not have very much experience in the frontcourt with Bates out for the season. Bates injury means the Pack only has three players on its team that are 6'9" or taller available. Prior to this season, that trio (Ebenezer Dowuona, Jaylon Gibson and Ernest Ross) had played a combined 128 minutes of college basketball with zero starts.
- Ebenezer Dowuona has stepped into the starting lineup to replace Bates. As a freshman last season, Dowuona appeared in 9 of NC State's 25 games and played a total of 48 minutes. The Ghana native played 25 minutes in each of the Pack's first two games this season to surpass last season's total minutes played. For the season, Dowuona is averaging 4.2 points, 5.1 rebounds and 2.7 blocks per game. He ranks fourth in the ACC in blocked shots per game and has 26 blocks in the last seven games.
- Jaylon Gibson appeared in 17 games last season as a freshman and averaged 0.8 points and 0.9 rebounds in 4.7 minutes of action a game. He is averaging 12.5 minutes per game this season and has shown a knack for offensive rebounding, 17 of his 27 rebounds this season are offensive.

#### **IMPORTANCE OF A DEEP BENCH**

- Since Kevin Keatts arrival at NC State, the Pack has had one of the best benches in the country.
- In 138 games with Keatts as head coach, NC State's bench has averaged 22.5 points per game and has outscored the opponent's bench by 718 points (3,101 bench points for NC State and 2,364 for its opponents).
- Kevin Keatts teams have accounted for 11 of top-21 NC State bench scoring performances since 1999-2000 season, including the top-3. (see chart to left for best bench performances under Keatts).

#### PACK HAS BEEN ONE OF ACC'S BEST UNDER KEATTS IN TURNOVER MARGIN

■ In four seasons with Kevin Keatts, NC State has finished second twice, third place once fourth place once in the ACC in turnover margin. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin in 2018-19. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 71-28 (71.7%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 15-24 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

#### **DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS**

■ In the first two seasons under Kevin Keatts, the Pack led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers. After ranking fifth in the ACC in his third season, the Pack was back towards the top, finishing in second place. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. In 2018-19, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 49-15 (76.6%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.






