KEY STORYLINES

LAST TIME

- **LEADING EARLY:** Behind a strong shooting performance in the first 10 minutes of action, the Demon Deacons held a 22-21 lead over the nationally-ranked Cardinals entering the second quarter of play.
- **SPEAR:** Spear ended the afternoon with a team-high 22 points, crossing over the 650-point barrier for her career in just 45 games played. Her 14.8 point average to start her career in Winston-Salem is tied for fifth in program history and is the highest since Tracy Conner's 17.0 from 1994-97.
- **WILLIAMS:** Freshman guard Elise Williams, who finished with 14 points on Sunday, ended the day going 8-of-11 from the free throw line. This marked the most free throw attempts made by a Louisville opponent this season.

FEAR THE SPEAR

- **TOP-25 NATIONALLY:** Spear currently ranks inside of the top 25 nationally in total points, points per game, field goals made, field goal attempts, three-point attempts and three pointers made.
- **SCORING THE ROCK:** Spear currently is first in the ACC in scoring average (19.6 PPG), leading the next closest ACC player by 0.9 points and is 28th nationally.
- **HISTORIC NIGHT:** She had a historic night against ETSU, finishing the victory over the Bucs with a career-best 40 points. It tied the second-most points scored by a Demon Deacon and her 10 three-point makes broke the school record.

SERIES HISTORY

- **ALL-TIME VS MIAMI:** Miami holds a slim 15-11 advantage in the series. Wake Forest has won two of the last three including the only matchup this season.
- **LAST TIME:** The Deacs held their seventh team this season under 50 points, limiting the Hurricanes to 28.1 percent shooting from the field and 22.2 percent from behind the arc. Spear finished the night with a game-high 15 points while also adding a pair of rebounds and a block shot to her statline as Wake won, 47-46.
- **A WIN WOULD:** Give the Demon Deacons their 10th home win of the season and their first season with multiple wins over the Canes since 2010.

Jewel Spear's 19.6 points per game this season currently ranks fourth in program history and first in the ACC by 0.9 points per game.

Jewel Spear is six three point makes away from entering the top 10 in program history. She enters Sunday with 121 in her career.

FAST BREAK

FEAR THE SPEAR

- **Jewel Spear** has become the premier scorer in the ACC this season averaging 19.6 points per game, 0.9 points better than the next closest in the conference.
- She had one of the great performances in program history against ETSU on Dec. 13, netting 40 points, the second best mark in school history while also breaking the program record with 10 three-point makes.
- Spear has gone for 30-plus three times this season and 20-plus eight times.
- Spear made a name for herself in Greensboro, dropping a career-best 29 points while tying the tournament record with seven three pointers. Her 29 points is the highest total by a freshman in the Hoover era.
- Her rookie campaign was the best in program history from behind the arc. Spear holds the Wake Forest freshman record with 2.32 three-point makes per game. Additionally, her career mark of 40.0 percent shooting from behind the line is the best mark in program history.
- During her freshman campaign, Spear was named to the 2021 ACC All-Freshman Team, ACC All-Academic Team and ACC All-Tournament Team.
- During the summer, Spear earned a spot on the 2021 USA Basketball U19 World Championship Team. She helped Team USA capture the gold medal including leading the team with 14 points in their victory over Italy in the opening game of the tournament.

HOLDING DOWN OPPONENTS

- The Demon Deacons have held all but five opponents to under 40 percent shooting from the field and four times under 35 percent shooting from behind the arc.
- The Deacs rank nationally in multiple defensive categories including No. 47 in three-point field goal defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 27.0 percent from range. This also ranks second among all ACC schools through this point in the season.
- Additionally, the Deacs scoring defense is currently 98th in the country, allowing just 59.6 points per game as just 10 of the 19 Demon Deacon opponents have scored more than 50 points this season.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

- Getting on the glass has been a point of emphasis for head coach Jen Hoover since she arrived on campus. In the last seven seasons, Wake Forest has averaged better than 38 rebounds per game including averaging 40 or more during the 2013-14 season (40.5 rebounds per game) and the 2016-17 season (41.1 rebounds per game).
- This season the Demon Deacons are off to another impressive start on the glass, totaling 813 rebounds which ranks seventh while also having the second-best mark in the Hoover era with 40.5 rebounds per game.
- Wake Forest finished the 2020-21 season ranked 134th in the country in total rebounds with with 879 in 25 games including a season-best 48 vs Pitt.
- The Demon Deacons' 1,271 total rebounds ranked 27th nationally while ranking 74th with 39.72 rebounds/game in the 2019-20 season.

MALAYA MAKES THEM ALL

- Freshman **Malaya Cowles** had a career afternoon against ETSU on Monday, finishing a perfect 9-of-9 from the field with a career-best 20 points to go along with a career-best 11 rebounds. It was the

second double-double for a Deac this season.

- With her finishing 9-for-9 it marks the most field goals made in a game without a miss in program history, topping the previous mark of 7-for-7 held by Lisa Dodd (Jan. 11, 1989).
- Cowles heads into the game at Florida State shooting an astounding 56.3 percent from the field on 27-of-48 shooting.

ELISE CONTINUES TO GROW

- In her first full season at Wake Forest, **Elise Williams** has been an key to the Deacs success this season contributing in nearly every area.
- She currently ranks leads the team in assists (60), steals (23) and blocks (10) while ranking second for the Deacs in scoring (9.3 PPG) and three-point makes (16).
- Williams ended non-conference strong against SC State with a career-best 18 points and a career-best eight assists. The eight assists mark the most by a Wake Forest player this season.

90-PLUS SCORING

- The victory over South Carolina State marked the fourth 90-plus point game of the season for the Demon Deacons, the first season to do so since 2005-06.
- All four have come in the last six games including three-consecutive games against Troy, ETSU and South Carolina State.

DOUBLE-DOUBLING THE COMPETITION

- For the first time in the Hoover era, three Demon Deacons finished a game with a double-double, coming against South Carolina State.
- **Jewel Spear** ended the SC State game with a game-high 25 points while also pulling down 10 rebounds. **Alyssa Andrews** was right behind her in the score column with 19 points and 11 boards. **Raegyn Conley** pulled down a game-best 12 rebounds while also contributing 13 points.

A HISTORIC 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

- Wake Forest made the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and the first time since 1988 (33 years ago).
- Head Coach **Jen Hoover** was a freshman on the team and helped lift Demon Deacons to the NCAA Second Round with a game winning basket on March 16, 1988 over Villanova.
- The Demon Deacons grabbed six wins over top-50 NET teams this season in the first year the women's game used the system, this included a top-25 victory over No. 24 Missouri State in the opening weekend of the season and two wins over in-state rival North Carolina.
- Jen Hoover became just the eighth person to lead her alma mater to the NCAA Tournament as both a player and as a coach.

HOOVER MAKING HISTORY

- Wake Forest head coach Jen Hoover became the program's all-time wins leader against North Carolina on March 4, 2021 with victory 126.

MORE NOTES

FREE THROW LINE

- A key reason the Demon Deacons have been successful this season has been their ability to get to the free throw line with ease. Their attempts rank 33rd in the country and their 240 makes this season ranks 48th in the nation.
- In the win over ECU on Nov. 21, the Deacs finished 28-for-36 (77.8 percent) at the free throw line, tying the most made free throws in the Jen Hoover era.
- Last season, the Demon Deacons' 317 free throw makes rank 72nd nationally while their 428 attempts rank 98th in the country.
- The Demon Deacons finished the 2020 season with a free throw percentage of 74.1 pct., ranking 65th nationally and fifth in the ACC.

GIVE ME MORRA THAT

- In 25 games as a junior, **Christina Morra** continued to be a vital presence on the low block for the Demon Deacons. Against Miami, the Toronto, Ont. native tied her career-high with 19 points on 9-of-11 shooting to go along with seven rebounds.
- As a senior, she has been a reliable scorer for the Deacs on the low block with 8.3 points and 4.7 rebounds. This includes a career-high tying 19 points in the season opener against Mercer.
- She also was the leading scorer for the Demon Deacons in their first round game against Oklahoma State. Morra ended the game with 18 points on 8-of-14 shooting while also adding three rebounds.
- Morra enjoyed a breakout season for the Demon Deacons as a sophomore, averaging 8.7 points and 4.8 rebounds while shooting 55.3 percent from the field.
- In games that she started as a sophomore, she was even better. Morra averaged 9.8 points per game and 5.5 rebounds per game.

RACA DRAFTED BY LA SPARKS

- Ivana Raca** was selected by the Los Angeles Sparks in the third round (28th overall) of the WNBA Draft.
- She became the first Demon Deacon to be selected since 2015 when the then San Antonio Star chose Dearica Hamby with the sixth overall selection.
- Additionally, Raca became just the fifth player ever from Serbia to be chosen in the WNBA Draft (Jelena Milovanovic, 2009, 24th overall; Sonja Petrovic, 2009, 26th overall; Sarah Krnjic, 2011, 35th overall; Dragana Stankovic, 2015, 30th overall). Raca is also the first player selected in the draft to be born in the country of Cyprus.

FRESH FACES

- The Demon Deacons officially added freshmen **Raegyn Conley** and **Alyssa Andrews** to the roster this summer and **Marta Morales** in December. Conley and Andrews provide the Deacs the ability to play multiple positions on the court and have the ability to score at all three levels..
- Andrews earned a 90 overall rating and three-star status from ESPNW while being rated as the No. 14 wing player nationally by ESPNW. She was named as a McDonald's All-American Game nominee and finished her high school career as her school's all-time leading scorer (1,784 points) and rebounder (1,067).
- Conley earned a 91 overall rating and four-star status from ESPNW while being rated the No. 60 recruit in the country and the No. 11 wing player nationally by ESPNW. She was also McDonald's All-American nominee as a senior. She captured the Chattanooga Times Free Press Jackson Lacy Girls' Basketball Award as the best player in the area as a senior and was a finalist for for 2020 Miss Basketball in Tennessee.
- Morales helped her home country of Spain reach the finals of the 2021 U18 3v3 Basketball World Cup, taking home the silver medal in September. She also won the three-point contest held at the event. She averaged 4.1 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game in the 2021 FIBA U19 Women's World Cup for Spain.

YEAR TEN IN WINSTON-SALEM

Jen Hoover enters her 10th season at the helm of the Wake Forest women's basketball program in 2021-22. She was named the school's 10th coach in program history in May of 2012. Hoover came to Wake Forest after one season as the head women's basketball coach at High Point.

Hoover returned to Wake Forest to lead the program after starting for the Demon Deacons from 1987-91. She was a three-time All-ACC selection and is second on the school's career record charts for points (1,728) and rebounds (1,006). Hoover was a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll and a member of the South team that won the bronze medal at the 1989 Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. She also led the Deacs to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1988. Hoover was inducted to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002.

2020-21 - NCAA Tournament

The ninth season at Wake Forest for Hoover issued in a return to the national stage as she led the Demon Deacons to their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1987-88 and just the second time in program history. Hoover and the Deacs played one of the most challenging schedules in the country. In the first year of the NET, Wake Forest recorded six victories over top-50 NET ranked teams while also playing having the No. 2 average opponent NET ranking in the nation. It helped the Demon Deacons earn a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

In the midst of the postseason push, Hoover became the program's all-time wins leader with win No. 126 tenure at her alumna mater. In the second round, the Deacs eliminated North Carolina from the ACC Tournament for the second consecutive season with an 82-71 victory. Over the last two seasons, Wake Forest is 4-1 against the Tar Heels.

The Deacs reached the ACC Tournament quarterfinals for the second consecutive season, marking the first time the Demon Deacons have accomplished this feat in back-to-back seasons since 2012 and 2013.

Three Demon Deacons earned All-ACC honors with Ivana Raca named to the First Team, Gina Conti to the Second Team and Jewel Spear to the All-Freshman Team. It is just the third time in program history the Demon Deacons have had multiple players selected to the top two All-ACC teams and is just the second time three members of the squad were honored in the same season by the league.

Ivana Raca ended her illustrious Wake Forest career ninth on the all-time scoring list with 1,482 points. She was one of just four players to finish her career in the top 10 in scoring and rebounding. Raca ended her four seasons with 715 rebounds, 10th in Demon Deacon history.

She went on to be taken in the 2021 WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks, becoming the second player in the Hoover era to be taken in the annual draft.

Equally as impressive, Hoover helped guide Gina Conti to the second spot on Wake Forest's all-time assist list with 494 in her career. She also became the 29th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point barrier during her senior campaign.

Additionally, a program record four student-athletes were named to Academic All-ACC Team: Jewel Spear earned her first Academic All-ACC honors this season while Ivana Raca, Gina Conti and Christina Morra were honored for the second time in their career.

2019-20

During the 2019-20 season, the Demon Deacons got off to one of the best starts in ACC play with a 3-1 start to conference play, the fastest start since the 1987-88 season. Wake went on to earn seven victories in ACC play, the most in the Hoover era. This included key victories over in-state foes Duke and North Carolina.

The Deacs seemed destined for postseason play after an impressive run in the ACC Tournament. Wake Forest defeated North Carolina for the second time in season in the opening round while knocking off Virginia Tech in the second round to reach the ACC Tournament Quarterfinal.

After earning second team All-ACC honors at the end of the regular season, junior Ivana Raca was even better in the tournament, averaging 20.33 points per game en route to first team All-ACC Tournament honors.

During the season, Alex Sharp and Raca became the 27th and 28th members of the 1,000-point club. Sharp rose to third in

program history with 921 career rebounds and Gina Conti sat seventh with 379 career assists.

2018-19

Wake Forest started the 2018-19 season with a stellar 9-4 record in the non-conference portion of the schedule. The Demon Deacons would face a number of critical injuries, including the loss of leading scorers Elisa Penna and Alex Sharp who each played just 15 games. However, their absence allowed the accelerated development of a number of younger players who shined in 2019-20.

2017-18

In the 2017-18 season, the Deacs advanced to the second round of the ACC Tournament for the ninth time in the last 10 seasons. In the opening round victory over Pittsburgh, Hoover's Demon Deacons held the Panthers to just 38 points, the fewest points allowed in ACC Tournament and Wake Forest postseason history. The team's 34-point margin of victory is a Wake Forest postseason record and the second-largest margin of victory over an ACC foe in program history. During the season, the team had three active 1,000 point scorers in Amber Campbell, Elisa Penna and Ariel Stephenson. Penna and Stephenson reached the 1,000-point mark during the season, marking the first time in program history that the team had three 1,000-point scorers on its roster. Penna was named All-ACC Second Team at the end of the year while Campbell was named to the All-Defensive Team, the first All-Defensive honor for the Deacs since 2004.

2016-17 - WNIT

Hoover guided the Demon Deacons to the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2017, as Wake Forest advanced to the second round of the WNIT. The postseason berth marked just the second time in program history in which the team advanced to postseason play in back-to-back seasons. Hoover led the Deacs to a road victory over No. 15/18 NC State on Feb. 19, the first road win over a ranked opponent since the 2012 season. Additionally, the Demon Deacons earned their highest ACC Tournament seed (No. 9) since 2012 while Alex Sharp was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

2015-16 - WNIT

Under Hoover's guidance, the Demon Deacons have continued their successful run in ACC Tournament play. In 2015-16, Wake Forest won an ACC Tournament game for the eighth-straight year, the longest stream in the ACC at the time. The Deacs won one game in 2016 and earned two victories as the No. 13 seed in the 2015 ACC Tournament, marking just the second time in program history Wake Forest had two wins in the league championship.

In 2015-16, Hoover helped guide the Demon Deacons to new heights as they won 17 games overall and six ACC regular-season contests. Both totals are highest since Hoover took over as head coach in 2012 and the six ACC victories tie for the third-most in a single season in program history. Wake Forest finished 10th in the ACC after being picked 14th in the preseason polls by both the Blue Ribbon Panel and the ACC's Head Coaches.

At season's end, Wake Forest earned its first postseason tournament berth since the 2011-12 campaign in earning an at-large bid to the WNIT. The Demon Deacons went on the road to top Charlotte in the first round before being eliminated by Florida Gulf Coast in the second round.

2014-15

Hoover had the rare opportunity to coach a player that broke her own program records. In 2014-15, Dearica Hamby broke her coach's records for career points and rebounds. Hamby went on to become the first Demon Deacon to ever be selected in the WNBA Draft when she was taken sixth overall by the San Antonio Stars.

2012-14

In Hoover's first two seasons leading the program, Wake Forest went 13-19 in year No. 1 in 2012-13, but she did guide the Deacs to an upset road victory over No. 18 Florida State. The win marked the school's first victory on the road over a ranked team since 1996. In 2013-14, the Deacs finished with an overall record of 15-16 with five ACC wins, including another victory over a ranked Florida State team. This time, the Deacs knocked off No. 23 FSU in Winston-Salem in convincing fashion, beating the Seminoles 78-54.

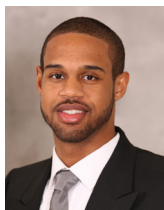
