STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech caps this four-games-in-eight-days stretch with a visit to Miami on Sunday. Tip is slated for 2 p.m. on ACC Network or fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call on the GT Gameday App.
- Georgia Tech and Miami are playing to reclaim the lead in the all-time series history as it stands knotted at 17-17 currently. The Yellow Jackets have won two straight against the Hurricanes and four of the past six. Miami was last victorious in the series winning an overtime contest on Jan. 30, 2020 in Miami.
- The Yellow Jackets played their first road game since a 55-54 win at Georgia on Dec. 5 at Pitt just this past Tuesday in a rescheduled contest. Tech took the decision, 63-52, to push its road record to 4-1 this season, and capture its first ACC road win of the season. Tech is outscoring its opponents by a +13.6 margin on the road.
- Georgia Tech owns a NET ranking of No. 20. The ACC has nine teams in the top 64 NET rankings through Jan. 13 games, including three in the top five.
- Known as a strong defensive team, Georgia Tech is starting strong on the defensive end. The Jackets top the ACC in scoring defense (46.31) and field goal percentage defense (.321), and is third in rebounding defense (31.88) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (.264).
- Tech's defensive game was strongly present in its win over Virginia on Jan. 9. The Jackets held Virginia to a mere 22.9 percent shooting effort and held the Cavaliers to single digits in three quarters. The Cavaliers hit a combined six field goals in 30 minutes (three quarters) to finish with 11 made field goals in the outing, marking the lowest total field goals by an ACC team this season. Virginia's 31 points also marked the lowest offensive output by an ACC team this season, and the third time Georgia Tech has held an opponent to under 40 points this year.
- Over the last four games, Georgia Tech has held its opponents to single-digit points in 7-of-16 quarters. The Yellow Jackets limited Pitt's offense to single-digits in the first and third frames, while keeping Virginia at bay in the final three periods. Against a top-five program in Louisville, Tech held the Cardinals to single digits in the first and third quarters as well. In Tech's five ACC games to date, 9-of-20 quarters have witnessed single-digit offensive numbers by Tech's opponents.
- In 10 games this season, the Jackets have scored double-figure points off the bench - 29 at Central Michigan, 27 vs. Kennesaw State, 10 vs. Belmont, 12 at ETSU, 12 vs. Auburn, 16 vs. Hofstra, 29 vs. Furman, 21 vs. Boston U., 12 vs. Virginia and 12 vs. Florida State - to average 13.1 points per game off the bench this season. Last season, the Yellow Jackets averaged 11.1 points off the bench.
- After 16 games, the Yellow Jackets are averaging 15.69 assists per game with a season-high of 21 coming at Central Michigan. On the season, that sits fourth in the ACC. Notre Dame leads the league, averaging 18.73 assists per game. Tech's high last season was 23 against Clemson (2/4).

FOUR-GAMES-IN-EIGHT-DAYS

During this current stretch of four-games-in-eight-days for the Yellow Jackets, Tech has picked up three wins and is looking to go 4-0 in the week. In the three games thus far, Tech has outscored its opponents by a +17.0 margin and is shooting at a 42.5 percent clip from the field. At the free throw line, the Jackets have gone 38-for-49 (77.6 percent) and is dishing out 14.7 assists per game, while averaging 5.0 blocks per game.

Lorela Cubaj is leading the Jackets offensively on the week, nearly averaging a double-double behind 17.7 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. She set a new career-high against Florida State, leading all scorers with 24 points after scoring Tech's first eight points of the game and going 6-for-6 from the field before missing a field goal midway through the second quarter.

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen has also contributed strong numbers during the week and is averaging 13.0 points per game, while leading the team in assists (8) and steals (6). She is shooting 51.9 percent from the field in the three games. With double-figure scoring games in her last two outings, Lahtinen now owns 967 career points, needing 33 to reach 1,000 and become the second Yellow Jacket this season to hit the milestone (Cubaj did so earlier).

STEADY TO START

In Nell Fortner's three years on The Flats, she has guided the Yellow Jackets to strong opening starts to the seasons.

Fortner finished her first season in 2019-20 with a 20-11 overall record to mark the best record by a first-year head coach in Georgia Tech women's basketball program history. The Jackets also finished that season 10-8 in ACC play, good for the first winning conference record since 2013-14 and the first 10-win ACC ledger since 2011-12.

TOPS IN THE NATION

The nation's toughest defense belongs to Georgia Tech as it ranks No. 1 in scoring defense in the nation as of Jan. 13. Holding its opponents to 46.3 points on average, the Jackets have held 11 opponents 50 points or less this season. Only one opponent has scored above 60 points against the Jackets (FSU - 64) with the lowest offensive total coming by Virginia with 31 points.

Virginia's 31 points marked the lowest by an opponent since Georgia State scored only 28 on Nov. 20, 2019 in Nell Fortner's fourth game as head coach. For an ACC opponent, it was the lowest offensive output since Feb. 3, 1996 when Georgia Tech defeated Maryland, 59-30.

CLIMBING IN THE POLLS

In the latest Associated Press national poll released on Jan. 10, Georgia Tech climbed one spot to No. 15. The weekly ranking matched Georgia Tech's highest-ever ranking in the AP poll when it spent three consecutive weeks at No. 15 during the 2011-12 season from Feb. 27 - March 12.

Georgia Tech has appeared higher in the USA Today/Coaches Poll, finishing the 2011-12 season at No. 10. It was also ranked No. 13 in the USA Today/Coaches Poll on March 5, 2012. The 2012 team finished the season making the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

MIDSEASON WATCH LIST

Georgia Tech's Lorela Cubaj was one of 25 players named to the Wooden Award Midseason Watch List on Jan. 5. She was one of four representing the ACC, joining NC State's Elissa Cunane, Virginia Tech's Elizabeth Kitley and Notre Dame's Maddy Westfeld.

Cubaj leads the Jackets on the glass, averaging 12.1 points per game, while also leading the ACC and ranking fifth in the nation in rebounds per game. She has amassed 194 rebounds thus far, placing her first in the ACC and third in the nation. She also leads the Jackets in assists with 70 this season for a 4.38 assists per game average, making her the only post player in the ACC to lead their team in assists.

DROPPING A HEARTBREAKER

Looking for its second win over a top-three opponent this season, Georgia Tech led against No. 3/2 Louisville for 33:33 minutes of the game before the Cardinals hit the game-winning layup with three seconds on the clock. Tech played with a short-handed lineup with only seven active players available to dress. It marked the second game this season the Yellow Jackets fell on a last second shot, having dropped the Big Ten/ACC Challenge at Purdue on a buzzer beater by the Boilermakers. In Tech's three losses, the Jackets have fallen by a combined 11 points.

Tech's game against Louisville also marked the first game this season the Yellow Jackets were out-rebounded by an opponent. Through 16 games, Tech has only dropped the rebounding battle three times, while also tying with UConn.

Limited on the inside, the Yellow Jackets hit eight three-pointers against the Cardinals led by Digna Strautmene with four triples. Tech has hit five or more three-pointers in 10 games this season with a season-high of 11 made against Furman.

TAKING THE FLOOR

In taking the floor against Virginia, Lorela Cubaj has broken another Georgia Tech record, playing in the most games during a career by a Yellow Jacket with 137 and counting. Cubaj broke the previous record of 134 games played by a Yellow Jacket set by Mo Bennett (2009-12), Sasha Goodlett (2009-12) and Antonia Peresson (2014-18). With 3,980 minutes played, Cubaj surpassed yet another all-time record, now having played the most career minutes by any Yellow Jacket. Francesca Pan owned the previous record with 3,945 career minutes played from 2017-20 and Tyaunna Marshall (2011-14) is now third at 3,935 minutes.

LOVE TO SEE IT

Sophomore Eylia Love owned a career night against Boston University (Dec. 21), scoring a personal-best 19 points. Love shot 7-for-10 from the field for a 70.0 percent clip and hit two three-pointers in the process. She was 3-for-5 from the free throw line, while securing five rebounds and two assists in 25 minutes of action.

It marked the second straight game she set a personal best, having scored a then-career-high 16 points the game before against Wake Forest.

Love now owns eight games this season with double-figure scoring totals.

SURPASSING A MILESTONE

Having already surpassed 1,000-career points and 1,000-career rebounds this season, Cubaj hit another major milestone on Dec. 19, becoming Georgia Tech women's basketball's all-time leading rebounder. Cubaj needed five rebounds to match the all-time rebounding record of 1,039 career rebounds set between 1977-79 by Bonnie Tate. She tied the record and then some, finishing with 12 rebounds to set the all-time program record. Cubaj currently owns 1,103 rebounds and climbing.

STRONG FROM THE OUTSIDE

In Tech's game against Furman (Dec. 12), fifth-year forward Digna Strautmene was on fire from three-point range, connecting on 6-of-12 to set a career-high from long distance. Strautmene finished with 20 points for a season-high at Georgia Tech and third game scoring in double-figures this season.

Also against the Paladins, sophomore Avyonce Carter finished with a career-high in scoring, posting 14 points in the win. Carter led the Jackets at the free throw line, converting 6-of-9 attempts to set a new career-high.

From three-point range against Furman, Tech hit 11 triples - six from Strautmene, four from Sarah Bates and one from Elizabete Bulane. It marked the sixth time in program history the Jackets hit 11 treys in a game and first since Nov. 14, 2018 against Western Carolina.

TEAM OF THE WEEK

After upsetting then-No. 3/2 UConn, Georgia Tech women's basketball was named the NCAA.com and U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Team of the Week on Dec. 14. The win, coupled with Tech's win at then-No. 20/19 Georgia, propelled the Jackets back into the national rankings, coming in at No. 18 in the Associated Press poll and No. 21 in the *USA Today Coaches* Poll. Meanwhile, UConn dropped to No. 7 in the AP poll, and No. 6 in the *USA Today Coaches* poll, marking the lowest ranking since 2007.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

On Dec. 15, Georgia Tech announced the addition of freshman transfer Kayla Blackshear from Alabama. Blackshear will join the Yellow Jackets in January 2022, and begin practicing, and be eligible to play in fall of 2022. At Alabama, she appeared in its first three games, averaging 10.2 minutes off the bench. She contributed 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game in those three outings.

Ranked the No. 75 overall recruit in espnW's class of 2020, Blackshear attended Lake Highland Prep where she averaged 11.6 points, 7.1 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game. In 2020, she helped Lake Highland Prep claim the Florida High School Athletic Association's 4A State Championship.

LET'S TALK ABOUT UCONN...

On Thursday, Dec. 9, Georgia Tech defeated No. 3/2 UConn, 57-44, inside McCamish Pavilion in front of a raucous crowd of 4,587. The historic win marked several fun facts, including:

-Snapped UConn's 240-game winning streak against unranked opponents

-First UConn loss to an unranked opponent since 2012

-UConn was held to under 45 points for the first time since 2006

-The crowd of 4,587 was the second-largest for a women's basketball game in McCamish Pavilion since it opened in 2012

-The win marked the first over a top-three opponent since GT beat No. 2 UNC, 66-62, on Jan. 22, 2009

-It was the 12th top-10 win in program history

-First time GT has defeated back-to-back ranked opponents in consecutive games since 1992 when it topped No. 4 Maryland

on March 7 and No. 8 Clemson on March 8 (GT beat two ranked opponents in 2020 separated by an unranked contest - No. 23 Miami, Wake Forest, No. 11 Florida State)

-It was the second top-five win under head coach Nell Fortner in three years

SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Senior guard Lotta-Maj Lahtinen was named one of 30 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award that recognizes seniors in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The 2021 ACC Most Improved Player, Lahtinen led the Yellow Jackets offensively last season, averaging 15.0 points per game and was tabbed all-ACC first team. A team captain, Lahtinen helped GT reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 last season for just the second time in program history.

Off the court, Lahtinen serves as the women's basketball representative of the Student-Athlete Advisory Board (SAAB) and has dedicated time giving back to the community. With the women's basketball team, the senior helped build a home with Habitat for Humanity and is active in the program's reading group, Buzzer Beaters, for youth.

JOINING AN ELITE CLUB

At Georgia (Dec. 5), forward Lorela Cubaj surpassed a mark only one other person in Georgia Tech women's basketball program history has done - 1,000 career rebounds. Needing eight rebounds heading into the contest, Cubaj hit the mark in the second quarter to become only the second player in program history to own 1,000-career points and 1,000-career rebounds. Cubaj secured 1,000 rebounds in 129 career games and currently owns 1,103 in her collegiate career.

REBOUNDING DOMINATION

In Tech's game at Purdue on Dec. 1, Lorela Cubaj dominated the glass, pulling down 20 rebounds. While it matched her career-high, she became the first player, and only player, in the ACC to secure 20 or more rebounds in a game this season.

Cubaj set her career record of 20 rebounds last season at Clemson (1/7), becoming the first Yellow Jacket to reach the feat since Kisha Ford had 21 against Mercer on Nov. 26, 1996. The 20 rebounds is the fourth highest rebounding total in a game in program history.

With her 20 rebounds at Purdue, Cubaj became the second player to record two games with 20-plus rebounds. Dolores Bootz did so in 1986 and 1987.

WHERE IT RANKS...

With 1,103 career rebounds, Lorela Cubaj ranks first in the ACC in career totals. She is also second among active Division I players in the same statistical category, and one of only seven active players in Division I to own 1,000-plus career rebounds.

WIN THE BATTLE ON THE GLASS

Through 16 games, Georgia Tech has taken the rebounding battle in all but four contests - against UConn, Louisville, Pitt and Florida State - and is outrebounding its opponents by an +8.4 average. Lorela Cubaj is currently leading the Jackets on the boards, averaging 12.1 rebounds per game. She ranks first in the ACC and 3rd nationally in rebounds with 194 on the young season. To date, the most rebounds secured by a GT opponent is 37 by Georgia and UConn.

NEW TO THE CLUB

In Tech's win over Belmont on Nov. 14, Lorela Cubaj became the 33rd player in Georgia Tech women's basketball history to join the 1,000-career points club. The Italian native hit the mark with a pair of free throws to close the game, finishing with 15 points on the day. She accomplished the feat in 124 career games.

NETTING A GOOD START

Nerea Hermosa has been off to a solid start in Tech's first games and currently ties for the team lead in scoring, averaging 10.4 points per game. Hermosa opened the season dropping a then-career-high 18 points at Central Michigan. In Tech's game at ETSU, Hermosa hit the mark and recorded her first double-double of the season, and second of her career, behind 17 points and 10 rebounds. She nearly missed another double-double against Auburn, contributing 11 points and a team-high nine rebounds. Hermosa broke her own career-high against Virginia on Jan. 9, dropping a game-high 20 points to set a new personal-best. She went 8-for-14 from the field, including a 4-for-4 effort at the free throw line, and finished with seven rebounds. Through 16

games, Hermosa is second on the team, averaging 6.6 rebounds per game.

Last season, Hermosa finished the season averaging 8.1 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. She recorded 10 games scoring in double-figures and one game with double-figure rebounds.

STARTING OFF RIGHT

Tech's three newcomers all took the floor in Mount Pleasant, making their Yellow Jacket debuts. Fifth-year transfer Digna Strautmene led all scorers with 19 points, exploding for 17 in the second half. Freshmen Elizabete Bulane and Carmyn Harrison also saw game action. Bulane played 12 minutes, secured a rebound and hit a field goal to finish with two points, while Harrison also finished with a field goal and rebound in two minutes of playing time.

LIMIT THE ERRORS

In Tech's season-opener at Central Michigan, Georgia Tech committed only five turnovers, matching the program record for fewest turnovers in a game. The Jackets posted another outing with only five turnovers against Boston University on Dec. 21. Tech set the record against Grambling State on Nov. 10, 2019 in head coach Nell Fortner's second game at the helm.

To date, Tech's two games with five turnovers mark a season low for an ACC team this season.

200 CLUB

Georgia Tech's season-opening win at Central Michigan marked the 200th collegiate head coaching win for head coach Nell Fortner. In one season at Purdue, Fortner led the Boilermakers to a 17-11 record and won the Big Ten Championship. Following Purdue, Fortner spent eight seasons at Auburn where she amassed 145 wins before arriving at Georgia Tech where she has won 50 games in her three seasons.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Prior to the start of the 2021-22 season, Lorela Cubaj and Lotta-Maj Lahtinen have garnered some national recognitions, appearing on several watch lists. Cubaj returned as Tech's leading rebounder after averaging 11.5 rebounds per game last season. She led the Jackets and ACC in rebounding, and finished 12th in the nation. Lahtinen led Tech offensively last season, contributing 15.0 points per game.

PRESEASON WRAP-UP

Georgia Tech concluded preseason play hosting Clayton State in an exhibition contest at McCamish Pavilion. The Yellow Jackets handled the Lakers, 74-53, behind three players in double-figures. Sarah Bates returned to the floor for the first time since Jan. 24, 2021 in style, shooting 7-for-11 from three-point distance to finish with 21 points. Eyllia Love matched Bates' offensive performance, also contributing 21 to the scoreboard. Lorela Cubaj led the Jackets with 11 rebounds and nine assists.

ACC PREDICTIONS

After finishing third in the Atlantic Coast Conference last season, Georgia Tech was slated to finish third by both the Blue Ribbon Panel (media) and league's head coaches for 2021-22. It marks the eighth time the Yellow Jackets have been predicted to finish in the top five since 1991 - and the second time they were predicted to finish third. Tech was also predicted to finish third in 2012 following its first trip to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

In addition to the preseason predicted order of finish, the ACC announced its preseason All-ACC Teams. Tech saw two placed on the preseason teams - Lorela Cubaj and Lotta-Maj Lahtinen. Both were All-ACC selections at the conclusion of the 2020-21 season.

NATIONALLY RANKED YELLOW JACKETS

In the Preseason AP Poll released on Oct. 19, Georgia Tech was tabbed No. 17 nationally. It marked the third time in program history the Jackets have been ranked in the nation's preseason top 25 and first since 2012. Georgia Tech was one of five teams from the ACC in the top 25, joined by No. 5 NC State, No. 6 Louisville, No. 16 Florida State and No. 24 Virginia Tech. South Carolina sat atop the preseason top 25.

In the preseason USA Today/WBCA Coaches poll, Georgia Tech came in at No. 20.

BE ON THE LOOKOUT

Lorela Cubaj was named one of 20 power forwards to the 2022 Katrina McClain Award watch list. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the Katrina McClain Award recognizes top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball.

The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates in late January, and in late February to just five. In March, the five finalists will be presented to Ms. McClain and the Hall of Fame's selection committee where a winner will be announced.

Cubaj and Lahtinen were also both named to the Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 50 Watch List. The Jackets were two of only eight from the ACC to make the list, while Tech was one of 12 schools that boasted multiple players on the watch list.

BLOCK GAME

In addition to owning the all-time rebounding record, Cubaj entered the season sitting seventh all-time in career blocks in the record book. Owning 27 blocks this season, Cubaj is fifth all-time in career blocks with 155. Joannah Kauffman (1995-98) sits in fourth with 170 career blocks.

Currently with 66 career blocked shots (2019-present), Nerea Hermosa is three blocks away from jumping into the top 12. Katarina Vuckovic (2013-17) ranks No. 12 with 69 career blocked shots.

WELCOME BACK

Returning its core nucleus from last season's squad, Georgia Tech boasts 84.6 percent of its scoring and 81.5 percent of its rebounding from last season. Returning for her fifth year ("COVID" year) in 2021-22, Lorela Cubaj accounted for 19 percent of the team's scoring and 31.3 percent of the team's rebounding last season. She was one of two Yellow Jackets to start all 26 games and averaged a double-double behind 12.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game. Cubaj was named the 2021 ACC Co-Defensive Player of the Year.

Tech also returns the 2021 ACC Most Improved Player in Lotta-Maj Lahtinen for her senior season. Lahtinen led the team in scoring, averaging 15.0 points per game and started all 26 games, while also leading the team in assists (90) and steals (50). She averaged 36.5 minutes per game and shot 43.0 percent from the field, including 34.3 percent from three-point range.

Both Cubaj and Lahtinen were named to the 2021-22 Preseason all-ACC team, while the Yellow Jackets were picked to finish third in the preseason ACC poll by both the Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches.

WHAT'S NEW?

Even though the Yellow Jackets return its core nucleus from last season, Tech welcomed three newcomers to the roster.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Returning to a full schedule in 2021-22, Georgia Tech will face a competitive slate of opponents. On tap for the season, the Yellow Jackets are scheduled to face 12 teams that went to postseason in 2020-21, including 11 that made an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Three of the 11 NCAA Tournament teams reached the Sweet 16 or further.

Also making a trip to Atlanta, preseason ranked No. 2 UConn visited on Dec. 9 for only the second time in program history. The Huskies and Yellow Jackets have met twice before, with UConn taking both decisions. UConn last visited ATL on Nov. 21, 2010.

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 396-220 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last eight-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season.

Georgia Tech's roster boasts players from five different states and four different countries. Fifth years Lorela Cubaj (Terni, Italy) and Digna Strautmane (Riga, Latvia), junior Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (Helsinki, Finland), sophomores Nerea Hermosa (Vitoria, Spain) and Aixa Wone Aranzaz (Pamplona, Spain), and freshman Elizabete Bulane (Adazi, Latvia) are Tech's international student-athletes.

LET'S REWIND TO 2020-21 SHALL WE...

GOING DANCING

Georgia Tech returned to the NCAA Tournament for the 10th time in program history - and first since 2014 - in 2020-21. The Jackets concluded a historic season making its second trip to the Sweet 16. The Yellow Jackets are 7-10 when dancing in the tournament, including 2021, tying its longest run made in 2011-12, advancing to the Sweet 16.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93 after posting a 16-10 record and 8-8 ACC ledger. The Jackets did not return to the Big Dance for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then earned a berth in every tournament from 2007-2012.

In 2012, Georgia Tech was the No. 4 seed and defeated Sacred Heart and Georgetown to secure its first-ever spot in the Sweet 16.

In 2021, the Yellow Jackets advanced to second round action for the fifth time in program history, and first since 2012. Tech made only its second-ever program appearance in the Sweet 16, having made its first in 2012.

KEEP ON DANCING

With Tech's at-large bid into the 2021 NCAA Tournament, head coach Nell Fortner became just one of 15 all-time head coaches to take three different teams to the NCAA Tournament. Fortner guided Purdue to the 1997 NCAA Tournament and led Auburn to a pair of appearances in 2008 and 2009. She is 4-3 when competing in the NCAA Tournament, leading the Boilermakers and Tigers to second round action and GT to the Sweet 16.

Fortner is the only active ACC coach to have led three different teams to the NCAA Tournament. Amanda Butler (Clemson), Katie Meier (Miami) and Wes Moore (NC State) have each guided two teams dancing into March.

Amongst head coaches in San Antonio for the 2021 NCAA Tournament, Fortner was joined by elite company in the coaching ranks as Kelly Graves (Oregon), Joe McKeown (Northwestern), Katie Abrahamson-Henderson (UCF), Kristy Curry (Alabama), C. Vivian Stringer (Rutgers) and Gary Blair (Texas A&M) have all guided three teams to NCAA Tournament action.

TECH IN THE SEMIS

For the first time since 2012, Georgia Tech women's basketball advanced to the ACC Tournament semifinals. After earning a double-bye, courtesy of securing the No. 3 seed, the highest seed in program history - the Jackets defeated Clemson in the quarterfinals to secure just its seventh appearance in the semifinals. Tech led second-seeded and third-ranked NC State heading into the final quarter, but the Wolfpack outscored the Jackets 23-13 in the final 10 minutes to take the win. Lorela Cubaj recorded her second-straight double-double in the ACC Tournament (17 points, 11 rebounds), to earn a spot on the All-ACC Tournament second team. Cubaj averaged 14.5 points and 14.5 rebounds per game in Tech's two tournament contests.

In the tournament, four Yellow Jackets averaged double-figures between the two games. Senior Kierra Fletcher led the way (15.5 ppg), followed by Cubaj (14.5 ppg), Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (13.0 ppg) and Loyal McQueen (10.0 ppg).

JACKETS HAUL IN ACCOLADES

Before the Yellow Jackets opened the ACC Tournament, they hauled in a few ACC honors. Marking program firsts, the Jackets collected a trio of prestigious first-time honors (indicated below):

-Nell Fortner - ACC Coach of the Year (Blue Ribbon Panel)

-Lorela Cubaj - ACC Co-Defensive Player of the Year

-Lotta-Maj Lahtinen - ACC Most Improved Player

Additionally, Cubaj earned all-ACC first team accolades by both the Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches. The senior forward from Terni, Italy also placed on the all-Defensive Team.

Teammate Lahtinen also picked up all-conference honors, being named all-ACC first team by the Blue Ribbon Panel and all-ACC second team by the head coaches.

With Cubaj and Lahtinen both earning all-ACC accolades, it marked the first time since 2014 two Yellow Jackets garnered all-ACC honors in the same season. Cubaj became the first Jacket since 2016 to earn first-team recognition, and just the seventh player in Tech history to earn a spot on the all-Defensive Team (first since 2014).

#BIGTIME

Head coach Nell Fortner picked up some special hardware, being named the 2021 ACC Coach of the Year by the Blue Ribbon Panel. With that accolade, Fortner has now earned coach of the year honors in the Atlantic Coast Conference, Big Ten Conference (1997 at Purdue) and Southeastern Conference (2009 at Auburn).

While also at Purdue, Fortner was named the 1997 *Basketball Times* National Coach of the Year. In 2000 while with USA Basketball, she earned USA Basketball Coach of the Year.

DOMINATING THE ACC

With Tech's win against Pitt (2/28), Georgia Tech recorded its 12th Atlantic Coast Conference win of the 2020-21 season, thereby tying the program record for most ACC wins in a season. The Yellow Jackets went 12-4 in 2011-12 for the best ACC season to date.

HELPING ON THE INSIDE

Senior Lorela Cubaj was a dominating presence for the Jackets defensively. She also was great at lending a hand to her teammates as the Terni, Italy, native averaged 2.9 assists per game to rank second on the team, having dished out 73 assists last season.

Heading into NCAA Tournament action, in the ACC, Cubaj led the league in assists per game among true post players and was only one of three posts players averaging 2.0-plus assists per game.

A YEAR'S DIFFERENCE

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen saw drastic improvement in her consistency last season. As a sophomore in 2019-20, she started 30 games for Tech and averaged 9.1 points. In Tech's 26 games in 2020-21, Lahtinen started all 26 games and was the team's leading scorer, averaging 15.0 points per game - a 5.9 ppg increase from the previous season. A gritty player on the floor, Lahtinen also led the Jackets in steals (50) and assists (90).

Lahtinen recorded 18 games scoring in double-figures last season after recording a total of 14 in 2019-20. Additionally, she posted 14 games of scoring 15-plus points, including six 20-plus point outings, as a junior, compared to five. Lahtinen went on a scoring tear in 2020-21, posting nine straight double-figure outings from Dec. 9 - Feb. 28.

She also saw significant improvement in her three-point performance, shooting 34.3 percent (47-137) compared to 28.7 percent in 2019-20.

For her improved performance, Lahtinen was tabbed the 2021 ACC Most Improved Player by the league's head coaches. In just the third year of the award, Lahtinen became the first Yellow Jacket to receive the honor.

#NELLYEAH

In just two years as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, head coach Nell Fortner guided Tech to a pair of double-digit ACC win seasons - marking the first time in program history the Jackets have posted back-to-back double-digit win ACC campaigns. In 2019-20, the Jackets finished 10-8 in the conference, earning a seventh-place finish in the league. In year two (2020-21), Tech hit the 10-win ACC mark for just the third time in program history, defeating Miami on Feb. 16.

Tech recorded its most ACC wins in a season back in 2011-12, going 12-4 in the league. That season, Tech finished 26-9 overall and reached the NCAA Sweet 16.

In 2020-21, Tech finished third in the ACC standings, behind Louisville (1st) and NC State (2nd) - marking the highest outright finish in program history. Tech's highest ranked finish in the league also took place in 2011-12, when the Jackets finished tied for third with a 12-4 league record.

HITTING A MILESTONE

Kierra Fletcher hit the 1,000-career point mark on Feb. 28 against Pitt on her Senior Day. The Warren, Mich., native became the 32nd member of the Georgia Tech women's basketball 1,000-career point club.

In the first postseason appearance in school history, Georgia Tech's women's basketball team captured the 1992 National Women's Invitational Tournament in Amarillo, Texas. En route to the title, the Jackets defeated Wisconsin-Green Bay, 78-77, in the first round, Nebraska, 73-68, in the semifinals, and Hawaii, 90-72, in the championship game. The 1992 WNIT not only marked Tech's first postseason appearance, but it also marked the first WNIT title for an ACC school. In 1998, the WNIT switched names to the WNIT.

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 355-210 (.621) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 11 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and two at Georgia Tech (2019-21) – and has compiled a 212-140 (.587) overall record in the college ranks.

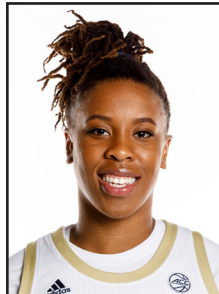
