TIPPING OFF

• Sunday's game is the first of back-to-back home games for the Tar Heels. It's the first time they've played two in a row in Chapel Hill since hosting Syracuse on Dec. 30 and Clemson on Jan. 2. That was also the last time UNC won two games in a row.

• Sophomore guard Deja Kelly leads UNC and is tied for third in the ACC in scoring with 15.7 points per game, up from 11.0 per game last season. She's one of five players to have put up 30 points in an ACC game this season.

• UNC is fifth in the latest NET ranking and has been in the top five all season. The Tar Heels are 24th in this week's AP poll and 23rd in the USA Today/WBCA coaches' poll.

• UNC will recognize Courtney Banghart prior to the start of Sunday's game. The Carolina head coach earned career win No. 300 on Thursday at Wake Forest.

NOTING THE TAR HEELS

UNC vs. Miami

The Tar Heels and Hurricanes are meeting for the 27th time in a series that dates back to the 1980-81 season. Carolina leads the series 14-12, but the Hurricanes have won the last two and eight of the past 11.

• The teams met twice last season, with Miami taking both. **Dec. 14, 2020 in Coral Gables:** Miami led throughout en route to a 67-63 win, but the Tar Heels kept it close. Alyssa Ustby came off the bench for a then-career-high 17 points and Deja Kelly scored 16, including nine in the final 1:14 as the Tar Heels cut the margin to two points but couldn't pull out the win.

Jan. 10 in Chapel Hill: Three games later, the teams met again. Miami again came out on top in a close game, 69-59. Coming off three weeks without a game, Janelle Bailey and Petra Holešinská were the only Tar Heels in double figures, marking the first time in the season that at least three had not made it to double digits. Kelsey Marshall led Miami with 19 points.

• UNC won at home in the 2019-20 season, finishing with a 20-point victory (78-58) despite trailing by one at halftime. Current junior Malu Tshitenge contributed seven points and five rebounds.

Scouting the Hurricanes

Miami is 12-8 overall and 5-5 in ACC play coming off a 71-65 homecourt win over Syracuse on Thursday. Maeva Djaldi-Tabdi and Lola Pendande scored 14 points each and Kelsey Marshall added 10 for her seventh consecutive double-digit game.

Moulayna Johnson Sidi Baba grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds as Miami outrebounded the Orange 53-36.

• Marshall leads the team in scoring with 13.8 points per game and is the only Hurricane averaging in double figures. She ranks third in the ACC in threes per game with 2.45. Pendande leads the team in rebounding with 5.6 per game.

Ja'Leah Williams leads Miami and ranks third in the ACC in steals with 2.2 per game. As a team, the Hurricanes rank fourth in the ACC in steals per game with 9.4.

• With five straight games at home or against in-state rivals, UNC will go almost three weeks without leaving North Carolina. After returning from

Quick Hits

- The Tar Heels are fifth in the NET rankings, 23rd in the coaches' poll and 24th AP poll. Carolina appeared in both preseason polls in 2015-16 (20th coaches, 22nd AP) but fell out as the season started and didn't show up again until this December.
- All four of UNC's losses this season have come to teams ranked higher at game time, and three of those have been on the road.
- The Tar Heels were one of the final three teams to stand undefeated this season, winning their first 13 games before suffering their first loss in the Jan. 6 game at NC State.
- Carolina has already significantly bettered its 2021-22 wins total. The Tar Heels finished 13-11 last season after making the program's 28th NCAA Tournament appearance.
- UNC has played the same starting lineup in all 21 games this season, with Deja Kelly, Carlie Littlefield, Kennedy Todd-Williams, Alyssa Ustby and Anya Poole in for the opening jump. In comparison, the Tar Heels tried seven different lineups during the course of last season's 24 games.
- UNC won its first four true road games for the first time since the 2013-14 season and is 6-3 overall in away games. The Tar Heels' six true road wins are the most in a year since 2014-15, when UNC won seven on the road.
- The Tar Heels played six of their first 10 games away from home this season, including two at a neutral site, a Thanksgiving tournament in Bimini, Bahamas.
- UNC's 89-33 win at Charlotte on Nov. 14 was the 1,000th victory in program history. Carolina now has a program record of 1,015-484, dating back to 1974-75, the first season for women's basketball as a varsity program under the umbrella of the Department of Athletics. UNC is the 18th DI program to reach 1,000 wins.

Story Lines

- Eva Hodgson and Carlie Littlefield are both enrolled in the MBA program at UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School after completing their undergraduate degrees at their previous schools, Hodgson at William & Mary (where she was the 2019 CAA Freshman of the Year) and Littlefield at Princeton (where she played two seasons for Courtney Banghart prior to Banghart taking the head job at UNC).
- In early August, the Tar Heels took a team bonding trip to West Virginia, where they stayed in cabins and went zip-lining and white-water rafting. "It's just a really fun group to have an adventure with and that's kind of what the season is – it's an adventure," coach Courtney Banghart said.
- Assistant coaches Joanne Aluka-White and Ito Coleman, whose friendship dates back to high school in Hephzibah, Ga., were teammates on Nigeria's National Team at the 2004 Athens Olympics.
- Assistant coach Adrian Walters started his coaching career with the men's program at Gallaudet University in Washington, D.C., where he was an assistant coach for two years and the head coach for one. He learned sign language while coaching there and is still fluent.

Sophs on the Move

The Tar Heel starting lineup includes four sophomores, all of whom have made significant increases in their scoring from last year to this year. With Kennedy Todd-Williams hitting for a career-high 15 against Virginia on Jan. 20 (and repeating that against Duke and NC State), all four have either set new career highs in scoring or matched a high set late last season.

The fifth member of that recruiting class, Courtney Banghart's first at UNC, is Alexandra Zelaya, who provides key post depth off the bench and matched her career high of seven points in the game at Duke.

Welcome to the Tar Heel Family

On the first day of the signing period, Nov. 10, the Tar Heels inked a standout in Paulina Paris, a 5-7 guard from New City, N.Y.

"It's a really exciting day for our program as we add Paulina Paris to the Carolina family," said UNC coach Courtney Banghart, who has signed exceptional classes in each of her previous two falls in Chapel Hill. "Paulina is one of the nation's elite perimeter threats. Her competitiveness, toughness, and ability to score at all three levels makes her a great add to our program. In addition, she is a gym rat and will continue to raise the level of her game throughout her career in the Carolina blue. We are all so glad she's a Tar Heel."

Paris is currently ranked 27th overall in the class of 2022 and seventh at her position by espnW HoopGurlz.

The daughter of Bryan Paris, a former member of Puerto Rico's National Team, and Melissa Paris, she is a junior at Saddle River Day School. A two-time Rockland County Player of the year. She has averaged 20+ points in all three of her high school seasons so far, with 21.3 points per game as a freshman, 25.4 as a sophomore and 24.6 as a junior in 2020-21, when she was named All-Bergen County. She has already passed the 1,000-career-points mark and headed into her senior season with a total of 1,361.

• Paris was recently named one of 25 finalists for the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy as the National Player of the Year and a nominee for the McDonald's All-American Game.

Key, Young Sideline

On the eve of her team's season opener in November, UNC women's basketball coach Courtney Banghart announced that two of her Tar Heels will be sidelined for 2021-22.

Freshman Teonni Key and redshirt junior Ariel Young each suffered a knee injury during the preseason. Both have subsequently been diagnosed with ACL tears. Young hurt her left knee in a practice early in the preseason and Key hurt her right knee during the team's closed scrimmage at South Carolina in late October.

"I'm absolutely heartbroken for both Ariel and Teonni, two very important pieces of our team's puzzle," Banghart said. "Both of these athletes have such a genuine love for the game and this program, and both have become huge parts of this team. They have put so much work into their development and training and to be forced to the sideline for the duration of the season is a tough pill to swallow for us all."

"It's also undoubtedly a huge hit for our team. Our collective group is hard at work to fill their void on both sides of the ball. Both AY and Teonni will redshirt and they will attack their rehab in much the same way they have attacked their development plan. We look forward to having them back better than ever."

Key is a guard/forward from Cary, N.C. A McDonald's All-American and the ninth-ranked recruit in the freshman class, she was named the 2021-22 Atlantic Coast Conference Newcomer Watch List.

Young is a guard from Tallahassee, Fla. A transfer to UNC after spending her freshman year at Michigan, she appeared in all 24 games last season for the Tar Heels, averaging 2.4 points per game and contributing valuable minutes off the bench.

Numbers of Note

- UNC coach Courtney Banghart, in her 15th season as a head coach and her third in Chapel Hill, recorded her 300th career win in Thursday's game at Wake Forest. She's the sixth among active ACC coaches to reach that milestone and has a career record of 300-132.
- UNC ranks in the top three in the ACC in scoring (3), scoring defense (3), scoring margin (1), rebounds per game (2), offensive rebounds (2), field goal percentage defense (2), three-point percentage defense (1), steals (2) and turnover margin (1).
- UNC and Miami come into Sunday's matchup with nearly identical free throw shooting percentages, but with very different totals. UM is at 196-285, for a .6877 percentage. Carolina is 291-423, having made more free throws than Miami has attempted, for a .6879 percentage.
- UNC has held all but two opponents this season to sub-40-percent field goal shooting. The only schools to top that have been ACC opponents BC (49.1 percent) and NC State (41.8 in the first meeting, 44.1 in the second). Opponents are shooting .338 and Carolina ranks second in the ACC and fifth in the NCAA in field goal percentage defense.
- The Carolina defense has forced all 20 opponents into double-digit turnovers and has forced 20+ 10 times this season, including on Thursday at Wake Forest. Opponents are averaging 19.9 turnovers per game vs. UNC.
- Carolina committed a season-low six turnovers in the Jan. 27 game at Duke. It was the team's third single-digit turnover total of the season. UNC is averaging 13.5 turnovers per game, third-lowest in the ACC.
- UNC is 11-0 this season when reaching double digits in steals. The Tar Heels average 10.3 per game, second in the ACC.
- Kennedy Todd-Williams set a new career high with 15 points against Virginia and then matched that two games later against Duke and again against NC State. In between, she led the Tar Heels in scoring at Georgia Tech with 10 points. Her current double-figure scoring streak of six games is the longest of her career.
- The loss at Georgia Tech on Jan. 23 marked the first time this season that only one Tar Heel reached double figures and the first time the Tar Heels had lost when holding their opponent under 70 points. (NC State won a week later scoring 66.)
- Deja Kelly turned in a career-best scoring performance in the Jan. 2 game against Clemson, scoring 31 points. She's one of five players to score 30+ in ACC play this season and the first to do so on a Courtney Banghart Carolina team. (The last Tar Heel to score 30+ was Paris Kea in February of 2019.)
- UNC hit season highs for three-point attempts in back-to-back games with 25 against Syracuse then 26 against Clemson. The Tar Heels averaged 14.7 attempts per game in nonconference play and so far have averaged 20.1 per game in league play.
- UNC's 107 points vs. UNC Asheville was the team's highest total of the season and the first time in triple digits since the 2018-19 opener. It was UNC's highest scoring game since hitting 124 in a neutral-site win over New Orleans in 2013 and the highest score at home since 109 vs. Gardner-Webb in 2011.
- Six Tar Heels average between 19.8 (Anya Poole) and 30.3 (Alyssa Ustby) minutes per game.
- Eight different Carolina players have scored in double figures at least once this season and six are averaging 8.1 points or more per game.
- Two freshmen hit double figures for the first time as Tar Heels in the same game, against App. State on Nov. 17. Destiny Adams scored all 10 of her points in the fourth quarter, and Morasha Wiggins had seven of her 10 after halftime.

McPherson to Redshirt

On December 16, UNC coach Courtney Banghart announced that freshman Kayla McPherson will redshirt the 2021-22 season while continuing to rehabilitate a knee injury sustained in high school.

McPherson, a top-20 recruit who tore the ACL in her right knee during her senior year at Madison County High School, had not seen action through the Tar Heels' first nine games of the season.

"We're obviously heartbroken not to have Kayla on the court this season, but our highest priority is to ensure that she's fully healthy before she's cleared," Banghart said. "Kayla is a special talent with a long career in front of her, which we want to include four full years with us in

the Carolina blue. I can't say enough about how Kayla has handled the grueling rehabilitation process. She's proven to be a tireless worker and an outstanding teammate and she is getting better and better every day. Tar Heel fans are going to learn soon that she's worth waiting for."

McPherson, a 5-7 guard from Hull, Ga., was a standout player at Madison County. She was named to the McDonald's Girls All-American Team and the Jordan Brand Classic Girls National team and ranked 17th in ESPNW rankings of the freshman class. She led the nation with an average of 36.3 points per game her junior season, when she scored 63 points in a single game.

She earned Georgia Player of the Year honors in her sophomore and junior years but didn't compete during her senior year after she was injured in a preseason practice.

2021-22 Team Captains

In October, UNC coach Courtney Banghart announced that graduate students Eva Hodgson, Carlie Littlefield and Jaelynn Murray would serve as team captains for 2021-22.

"Team leadership is the catalyst and accountability that serves as the driving force for a team's success," said Banghart, who in addition to her 15 years of head coaching experience owns a master's degree in leadership development. "We have a great group this season and all have spoken. Carlie, Jaelynn, and Eva have earned the honor to lead together. This trio has unique gifts and a collective voice. We are eager for their impact, and trust that they will lead competitively, compassionately, and with proven consistency all year long. We are in great hands."

The trio is charged with leading a young team that includes a total of nine sophomores and freshmen among its 14 members.

Murray, a redshirt senior athletically, graduated from UNC in May and is now enrolled in the Master of Arts in Educational Innovation, Technology, and Entrepreneurship (MEITE) program through the UNC School of Education. Hodgson and Littlefield are both in the MBA program through UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School, Hodgson after graduating from William & Mary and Littlefield from Princeton. Hodgson joins the Tar Heels as a redshirt junior in eligibility, while Littlefield is in her final season of play.

Noting the 2020-21 Tar Heels

- Five players averaged 9.9 points or better per game as the Tar Heels finished 13-11.
- Graduate student Stephanie Watts was the 10th overall pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft.
- Current sophomores Alyssa Ustby and Deja Kelly led the team in minutes. Ustby averaged 30.0 per game and Kelly 28.8. Both players were named to the All-ACC Academic Team and Kelly was also named to the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- UNC won five of its last six regular season games and earned an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. It was the 28th NCAA Tournament appearance in program history.

Hodgson Among Nation's Best in Career FT

In her first year at UNC and third in the college ranks, Eva Hodgson is currently third in NCAA DI and fifth among all divisions in career free throw percentage. Through 80 career games (20 at UNC), she has made 87.8 percent of her free throws (281-320).

COURTNEY BANGHART

Head Coach • Third season at UNC, 15th season as a head coach



The 2021-22 season is the third at UNC for head coach Courtney Banghart, who has transformed the Tar Heel roster and led the team to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021.

Banghart was announced on April 30, 2019 as North Carolina's head coach, the first new face in the position since 1986. She came to Chapel Hill after 12 years as the head coach at Princeton, where her teams won seven Ivy League crowns and made eight NCAA Tournament appearances. (Before her arrival, Princeton hadn't reached the tournament even once.)

A New Hampshire native, Banghart was a three-year starter at Dartmouth, where she twice earned All-Ivy honors. She still holds the Ivy League record for career three-pointers (273) and as a senior competed in the three-point shooting contest at Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse during the men's Final Four in Indianapolis.

Including a WNIT appearance at Princeton, Banghart has led her teams to 10 postseason appearances in 14 previous seasons as a head coach.

More on Banghart:

- She was the 2015 Naismith National Coach of the Year and is the only current ACC coach to have won that honor.
- A player she coached has been picked in the top 10 in the past two WNBA Drafts (Stephanie Watts from UNC 10th in 2021, Bella Alarie from Princeton 5th in 2020).
- In 2015 she was named to Fortune's list of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders. Also on the list that year: Pope Francis, Bill and Melinda Gates, Chief Justice John Roberts Jr., LeBron James, Elon Musk and Taylor Swift.
- She holds a bachelor's degree in neuroscience and a master's degree in writing and leadership, both from Dartmouth. Her graduate thesis was on sport leadership.
- Her first coaching position was head coach of a high school boys' tennis team, during her junior year at Dartmouth. She also worked as a tennis pro during high school, providing lessons to a range of abilities.
- She hitchhiked through Alaska after college (after ditching the outdoor leadership course in which she was enrolled) and has bungee off a jump in Switzerland that was then the highest in the world.
- Right around the time she got the Princeton job, she and her brother were finalists to appear on "The Amazing Race."
- A four-time soccer state champion in high school, she planned to play that sport at Dartmouth until a coaching change made her rethink her path and talk the women's basketball coach into giving her a spot. (She also won two high school state titles in basketball and three in tennis.)

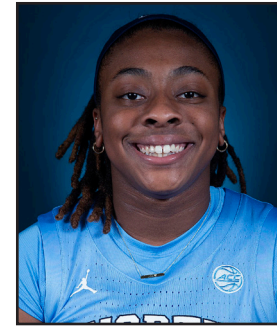

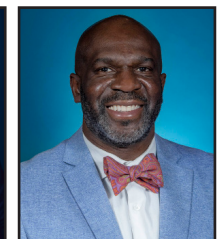
