THE LEAD

In its first season under head coach T.J. Otzelberger, Iowa State is making its sixth Sweet Sixteen appearance this weekend when it faces Miami in the Midwest Regional semifinal at United Center in Chicago, Illinois.

KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State owns a 22-12 record, a +20 improvement in the win column this season compared to last, the best turnaround in school and Big 12 history and the best-ever by a team led by a first-year head coach ... only Towson (+21) has a bigger improvement in NCAA history.
- The Cyclones are looking to make their second Elite Eight of the modern tournament era (2000).
- ISU has defeated LSU and Wisconsin in the tournament, which matches its win total from last season ... in the two wins, ISU's defense has been stifling, holding opponents to 51.5 points per game, 33.3 percent shooting and 14.6 percent 3-point shooting and forcing 18.0 turnovers.
- ISU leads Sweet Sixteen teams in scoring defense, FG percentage defense, 3-point FG percentage defense and turnovers forced ... for the season, ISU is KenPom's fifth-ranked team in defensive efficiency and fourth-ranked team in turnover percentage.
- Otzelberger is the eighth head coach in school history to lead the Cyclones to the tournament ... he is the third coach in NCAA Tournament history to lead his program to the Sweet Sixteen in the first year after taking over a team with a losing record the previous season.
- Iowa State is 15-0 this season against non-conference opponents ... ISU, Purdue (13-0) and Minnesota (9-0) are the only teams this season with undefeated records against non-con foes ... ISU's non-con opponents are averaging 55.1 points and shooting 36.8 percent from the field, 23.4 percent behind the arc while turning it over 18.5 times per game.
- Gabe Kalscheur propelled the Cyclones to the Sweet 16 with his 22-point performance against Wisconsin.

IN THE PAST...INTO THE FUTURE

LAST TIME OUT...

- Iowa State defeated Wisconsin on Sunday evening to advance to the Sweet Sixteen of the Midwest Region ... the Cyclones held the Big Ten regular season champion to a season-low 29.8 percent shooting and stifled Big Ten Player of the Year Johnny Davis to just 4-for-16 shooting ... the Badgers made a season-low two 3-pointers ... Gabe Kalscheur scored 22 points on 10-of-19 shooting to lead the Cyclones ... ISU controlled the glass (39-36) and forced UW into a season-high 17 turnovers ... the Badgers entered the game first nationally in turnovers per game, committing just 8.4 per contest.

NEXT UP: KANSAS/PROVIDENCE

- If Iowa State defeats Miami, the Cyclones would advance to face either No. 1-seed Kansas or No. 4-seed Providence in the Midwest Regional final.

AT THE NCAA BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

ISU NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Iowa State is playing in its 21st NCAA Tournament in school history as the No. 11 seed as part of the Midwest Region.
- Iowa State has advanced to the Sweet Sixteen six times (1986, 1997, 2000, 2014, 2016, 2022) in the modern era ... ISU is looking for its second Elite Eight appearance in the modern era (2000).
- ISU is 21-20 all-time in the NCAA Tournament ... T.J. Otzelberger is the eighth coach to lead Iowa State to the NCAA Tournament and the third to lead the Cyclones in their first season leading the program (Tim Floyd, Steve Prohm).
- Otzelberger is the only coach to lead the Cyclones to the NCAA Tournament in his first season while coming off a losing season ... he joins Prohm as the only Cyclone coaches to win two tournament games in his first season.
- Iowa State has made the tournament in eight of the last 11 seasons ... the Cyclones are one of 14 teams with eight tournament berths since the 2011-12 season.
- ISU is a No. 11 seed for the first time in school history.
- The Cyclones are 0-4 all-time against No. 1 seeds (Michigan State, 2000; North Carolina, 2005; Kentucky, 2012; Virginia, 2016) ... three of the four teams were the number one overall seeds and went on to win the national title with all three games being played in the opponent's home state.
- Iowa State is 13-8 playing in the Midwest Region.
- The farthest the Cyclones have advanced in the NCAA Tournament is the Final Four in 1944.
- ISU, which was one of eight teams to qualify in 1944, won its first game vs. Pepperdine to advance to the semifinals.
- The farthest Iowa State has advanced in the NCAA Tournament since the current 64/65/68-team field, which began in 1985, is the Elite Eight in 2000.
- The Cyclones have won their first game in 11 of their last 14 NCAA Tournament appearances.
- ISU has had two players lead the NCAA Tournament in scoring average (minimum of three games played) during their respective careers ... Detric Willoughby averaged 24.7 ppg in 1997 (3 games) and Marcus Fizer led all players in 2000 with a 20.0 ppg average in four games played.
- Individual NCAA Tournament records: Points- 34 by Detric Willoughby (vs. UCLA in 1997), 34 by Lafester Rhodes (vs. Georgia Tech in 1988) 34 by Dustin Hogue (vs. UCONN in 2014); Rebounds- 20 by Jared Homan (vs. North Carolina in 2005); Assists- 11 by Jamaal Tinsley (vs. UCLA in 2000); Blocks- 8 by Kelvin Cato (vs. Illinois State in 1997); Field Goals- 15 by Dustin Hogue

(vs. UCONN in 2014); 3-Pointers- 8 by Detric Willoughby (vs. UCLA in 1997).

- The first time two teams from the same conference played in the NCAA Tournament in the same year was 1944 when ISU and Missouri from the Big Six were among the 8 teams chosen.

TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

- Iowa State owns an 8-8 record vs. eight teams in the 2022 NCAA Tournament field: Baylor (0-2), Creighton (1-0), Iowa (1-0), Kansas (0-2), Memphis (1-0), Texas (1-1), TCU (1-1), Texas Tech (1-2), LSU (1-0), Wisconsin (1-0).
- Eight of ISU's 21 regular season opponents earned tournament bids.
- ISU is playing in Chicago for the first time since the 2016 NCAA Tournament when it fell to Virginia (84-71) in the Sweet Sixteen.
- All-time, ISU is 0-2 playing at United Center: Lost to Duke (86-65, 1/6/2010) and Virginia (84-71, 3/25/16).
- The eight coaches to lead the Cyclones to the NCAA Tournament are: T.J. Otzelberger, Steve Prohm, Fred Hoiberg, Wayne Morgan, Larry Eustachy, Tim Floyd, Johnny Orr and Louis Menze.
- Otzelberger is coaching in his third NCAA Tournament (2017, 2018, 2022) and his fourth postseason overall (2019 NIT) ... he is 2-2 in NCAA Tournament games.
- Hunter leads all true freshmen in the NCAA Tournament with 165 assists.
- Kunc blocked a pair of shots in both of ISU's first two NCAA Tournament games ... he's the first Cyclone to have back-to-back NCAA Tournament games with two blocks since Jameel McKay.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 2 - The highest seed ISU has ever been was a No. 2 seed in 2000 and 2001.
- 6 - Six of nine eligible Big 12 teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament this season ... the Big 12 went 6-0 in the first round and is 9-3 overall with three teams in the Sweet Sixteen.
- 3 - ISU is one of three teams with both its men's and women's teams in the Sweet Sixteen (Michigan and North Carolina).
- 84 - Total NCAA Tournament experience (in minutes) on the ISU roster entering the tournament, the ninth-fewest among major conference teams in the tournament.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

BIG 12 HONORS ROLL IN

- Brockington was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year as well as a First-Team All-Big 12 selection ... he was the 10th Cyclone in school history to earn the honor and the first since Deonte Burton in 2016.
- Hunter earned Big 12 Freshman of the Year accolades, the first Cyclone since Curtis Stinson in 2004 and just the sixth overall.

HUNTER SHINES

- Hunter put together a performance for the ages against LSU, scoring a career-high 23 points and connecting on 7-of-11 3-pointers ... the seven 3-pointers were the second-most by a Cyclone in an NCAA Tournament (Dedric Willoughby, 8 vs. UCLA in 1997).
- Hunter also had five steals in the game, joining him with Steph Curry as the only players in NCAA Tournament history with seven 3-pointers made and five steals in the same game.
- Hunter made six of his threes after halftime.
- Hunter is tied for the most steals by a player on opening weekend (8, tied with JD Notae of Arkansas) and tied for the most 3-pointers made (Cormac Ryan, Notre Dame).

TAKE IT AWAY

- Iowa State broke its own school NCAA Tournament record with 15 steals against LSU ... it was a season-high for the Cyclones, who converted the turnovers into 22 points.
- ISU is one of just eight teams to have 15 steals in an NCAA Tournament game since the 2011 Tournament.

CHI-TOWN

- Cyclone senior George Conditt is a Chicago Southsider, growing up in the Roseland area ... Conditt attended Corliss High School where he led the team to within a game of its first state tournament appearance in 2018.

CLOSE CALLS

- Iowa State is 7-2 in games decided by five points or less, including wins in the last six games ... ISU is 4-1 in one possession games.
- Brockington averages 19.6 ppg in games decided by five points or less.

ON NEUTRAL COURTS

- Iowa State is 4-1 in neutral site games this season, defeating Xavier and Memphis to win the NIT Season Tip-Off and falling to Texas Tech in the Big 12 Tournament ... in the NCAA Tournament, ISU got back on track with wins against LSU and Wisconsin.
- Some of ISU's top performances this season have come at neutral sites ... Kalscheur (vs. Memphis) and Brockington (vs. Xavier) had 30-point games at neutral sites, while Hunter dropped 23 against LSU.

ON THE ROAD

- ISU won four true road games after entering the season on a 25-game road losing streak ... it is the most road wins in a season since 2018-19.
- ISU had three conference road wins, beating Oklahoma State, TCU and K-State.
- Caleb Grill is shooting 45.6 percent behind the arc away from home (road and neutral site).

DROPPING DIMES AND STEALING PASSES

- Hunter has set the ISU freshman record for assists with 165 this season, passing Gary Thompkins record of 146 that had stood for more than 35 years.
- Against Wisconsin, he broke Fred Hoiberg's freshman steals mark and now has 68 takeaways.
- He dished out 13 assists in the regular season finale against Baylor, the second-most ever by an ISU freshman behind only single-game record holder Tyrese Haliburton's 17 (vs. Southern).

- The Cyclones and Hurricanes are meeting for just the second time ... Iowa State won the only other meeting in the semifinals at the 2016 Advocare Invitational ... Deonte Burton led the Cyclones in that game with 21 points.
- Iowa State and Miami have no common opponents this season.
- The Cyclones are 2-0 all-time against No. 10 seeds in the NCAA Tournament, defeating Florida in 1995 and Miami (Ohio) in 1986.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

A TOP TRANSFER

- Brockington is one of the nation's top transfers and has been named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, the 10th Cyclone to earn that honor and first since Deonte Burton in 2016.
- He is one of the best rebounding guards in the nation, pulling down 6.8 boards per game and having posted seven double-doubles.
- The last Cyclone to average 17 points and 7 rebounds was Big 12 Player of the Year Melvin Ejim in 2013-14, Brockington just dipped under 7.0 rebounds for the first time this season.
- He is the first Cyclone since Michael Jacobson in 2018-19 to pull down 200 rebounds in a season and the first since Marial Shayok to score 500 points in a season ... he is the first player with 500 points and 200 rebounds since Deonte Burton in 2016-17.
- Brockington sits 20 points shy of becoming the third player (four times) in school history to post a season of 600 points, 200 rebounds and 40 steals ... the others were Melvin Ejim, DeAndre Kane and Jeff Grayer (2x).

BEHIND THE ARC

- ISU is only averaging 6.8 3-point makes per game, its fewest since 2009-10, but has only been outshot behind the arc nine times this season.

Q1 WINS

- Iowa State had nine quad 1 wins (9-8) ... the Cyclones are one of seven schools nationally with at least nine Q1 victories.
- ISU's nine Q1 wins matches the most in school history (2018-19).

- Iowa State has its most non-conference regular season wins (15) since 1994-95 (15) ... It is ISU's first unbeaten nonconference regular season since 2013-14 (12-0) ... ISU is the only Big 12 team that didn't drop a nonconference game in the regular season.
- The Cyclones have snapped a number of long losing streaks to start the season: - 18-game losing streak, 8-game home losing streak, 25-game losing streak to power conference opponents, 19-game losing streak to ranked opponents, 28-game losing streak away from Hilton Coliseum, 18-game losing streak when trailing at the half, 24-game losing streak to conference foes, a 25-game losing streak in true road games, a 24-game losing streak in conference road games,

78-game losing streak when trailing with one minute left in regulation and a 42-game losing streak when trailing with five minutes left in regulation.

INDIVIDUAL QUICK HITS

- Among Big 12 players, only Brockington (25.9) and KU's Ochai Agbaji are averaging at least 25.0 points+assists+rebounds per game.
- Kunc shot 49.1 percent behind the arc at Hilton Coliseum.
- Grill was the first Cyclone since Tyrese Haliburton in 2019-20 to record to multiple games in a season with six 3-pointers made ... Hunter's seven against LSU in the NCAA Tournament was ISU's second-most ever in a tourney game (8, Detric Willoughby, UCLA, 1997).
- Brockington has seven double-doubles this season after not posting a double-double the first 91 games of his career.
- Brockington has posted career highs in points per game, rebounds per game, field goal percentage, assists, blocks and steals.
- Brockington and Kalscheur tallied 30 points in back-to-back games, the first Cyclone teammates to reach the 30-point mark in consecutive games since Jeff Grayer and Lafester Rhodes in 1988.
- Hunter has a team-high 68 steals this season ... the last Cyclone with 70 steals in a season was Curtis Stinson in 2006.
- Hunter topped 100 assists against KU, becoming the first Cyclone freshman since Haliburton to dish out 100 dimes ... with 160 assists, Hunter is the Cyclone freshman record holder and ranks among the top-five Big 12 freshmen all time.
- George Conditt is one of three active Big 12 players more than 100 career blocks (127).
- Conditt has seen his efficiency improve this season ... after shooting just 40.6 percent from the field last season (26-64 FG), Conditt has shot 66.0 percent this season ... he's also got 66 assists this season, the most in a single season in his career ... Conditt is one of 14 major conference players 6-9 or taller with at least 65 assists.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

THROUGH THE SEASON

- ISU rallied from 12 points down in the second half against West Virginia, the Cyclones' first double-digit second half comeback since 2016.
- The Cyclones shot 67.3 percent from the field against Oklahoma, the school record for field goal percentage against a conference opponent.
- Iowa State beat TCU in Fort Worth for the first time since 2016.
- ISU's overtime win at Oklahoma State was its first since Feb. 20, 2017 at Texas Tech ... it was the first conference road win since Feb. 16, 2019 at K-State.
- Iowa State made just three field goals in the second half against Texas Tech (15.8 percent), but its defense carried it to the win ... ISU trailed just 0:26 seconds in the game, despite shooting only 30.6 percent from the field.
- The Cyclones' 51 points in the win against Texas Tech were their fewest in a league win since a 48-46 victory at Nebraska on Feb. 10, 1979.
- ISU shot 76.9 percent from the field in the second half against Southeastern Louisiana, the best shooting half for the Cyclones since the 2018-19 season (Ole Miss).
- ISU's 47-37 win against Jackson State marked the lowest scoring game Hilton Coliseum history.
- Iowa State's 19-point win against Memphis was the largest margin of victory over a top-10 opponent in school history and the second-largest margin of victory over a top-25 team.
- ISU also topped its previous largest win against Iowa, defeating the Hawkeyes by 20 points.
- ISU held Iowa, which entered the game averaging 90.1 points and shooting 48.7 percent from the field to just 53 points and 27 percent shooting.
- ISU held the nation's leading scorer among power conference teams Keegan Murray (Iowa) to nine points on 4-17 shooting ... the Cyclones also held Big Ten Player of the Year Johnny Davis to just 4-16 shooting.
- The Cyclones won their fourth preseason tournament in the last eight seasons by defeating No. 25 Xavier and No. 9 Memphis to win the NIT Season Tip-Off.
- Against Memphis, ISU recorded its first game since 2004 in which it had 10 steals and 10 blocks in the same game.

- ISU became one of nine teams since 1996-97 to shoot 1-for-20 behind the arc and win a game as it did against Alabama State.

STREAKS OF NOTE

- 35 - ISU has won 35 consecutive games when scoring 80 or more points.

ON FIRE!!

- Jaz Kunc had one of the best shooting performances in school history against Grambling State ... his 5-for-5 3-point shooting performance made him just the eighth Cyclone in school history to attempt five three-pointers and make them all ... on top of that, Kunc hit his other two field goals to finish 7-for-7 from the field, also matching the school record for field goal percentage in a game (11th player to go at least 7-for-7 from field) ... Kunc's only miss came at the line, where he went 2-for-3.

NEW LOOK CYCLONES

- Along with a new coaching staff, Iowa State returned just five players (three scholarship) from last season's team ... the Cyclones had just 20 total starts back from last season, but no player with double-digit starts.
- It marks the first time since the 1997-98 season that the Cyclones officially returned no starters.
- ISU returned just 13.3 percent of its scoring, 25.6 percent of its rebounding and 24 percent of minutes played, all of which rank at the bottom of the Big 12 Conference.

OTZ IS BACK!

- After spending the last five seasons as head coach at South Dakota State and UNLV, T.J. Otzelberger has returned to Iowa State as the 21st head coach in program history.
- Otzelberger, the second youngest coach in the Big 12 Conference (44 years old), has averaged 19.8 wins per season and made four postseason appearances (3 NCAA/1 NIT).
- Otzelberger has been on staff for the school's previous three coaches: Greg McDermott, Fred Hoiberg and Steve Prohm.
- The last three Cyclone teams he worked with went 69-35 (.663) with NCAA Tournament appearances every season.

- Credited with signing or development of Cyclone greats like Royce White, Will Clyburn, Tyrus McGee, Georges Niang, Melvin Ejim, Monte Morris, Abdel Nader, Scott Christopherson, Matt Thomas, Naz Mitrou-Long and Deonte Burton, among others.

- At SDSU, coached three-time Summit League Player of the Year Mike Daum, who scored more than 3,000 career points.

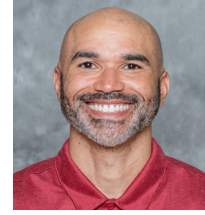

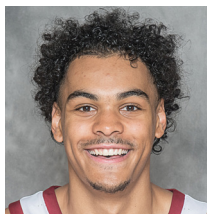
