BOSTON COLLEGE VS. MIAMI - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 54th meeting between the two schools.
- The Eagles hold a 27-26 lead in the all-time series.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 10-17 versus the Hurricanes.
- Last season, the two teams won on their respective home floors.
- On Jan. 12, BC earned an 84-62 win at Conte Forum.
- On March 5, Miami outlasted the Eagles, 80-76, in Coral Gables.
- The home team has been victorious in each of the last six meetings.
- From 1989-2004, both schools were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 15-6 mark versus Miami during that span.
- The Eagles are 14-10 vs. Miami at Conte Forum all-time.

BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Boston College is 97-192 in 16+ seasons in the ACC.
- BC won its ACC opener, 73-57, at home vs. Notre Dame.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish.
- BC tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and was fourth in 2010-11 (9-7). In 2019-20, BC was 7-13 in ACC play, finishing 10th.
- It marked the most ACC wins since the 2017-18 season and was the seventh time since 2005-06 that BC had at least seven ACC wins.

BOSTON COLLEGE AT CONTE FORUM

- Boston College is 335-198 all-time - and 65-80 in ACC games - played at the Silvio O. Conte Forum.
- The Eagles started 6-0 at home in 2021-22 - the 18th time that BC has won its first six home games to start a season.
- The last BC team to win its first six home tilts - 2017-18 - started 8-0.
- BC was 10-8 at home in 2019-20 - the 18th time that BC won 10+ games at Conte Forum in a single-season.

GIMME THAT

- Jaeden Zackery's 49 steals so far this season is the fourth-most steals by a Boston College freshman.
- Dana Barros holds BC's freshman single-season mark - 57 - set during the 1985-96 season.
- Ryan Sidney (56, 2000-01) and Duane Woodward (55, 1994-95) rank second and third, respectively.
- Zackery's 49 steals is tied for the fourth-highest total in the ACC; his 1.75 steals/game average also ranks fourth in the ACC.
- Among all freshman nationally, Zackery ranks tied for ninth in total steals and 12th in steals/game

FLIP THE SCRIPT ON THE IDES OF MARCH

- With a win today, Boston College would notch its first win in the month of March since the 2017-18 season.
- On March 7, 2018, the Eagles bested N.C. State in the second round of the ACC Tournament in Brooklyn.
- BC's last regular season win in March came against Wake Forest (79-61) on March 7, 2015.
- Boston College has lost its last 12 games in the month of March.

ON THIS DATE: MARCH 2

- Boston College is 6-5 all-time - and 1-1 in ACC play - in games played on the March 2 calendar date.
- March 2 marks the celebration of National Read Across America and National Banana Cream Pie Day.
- Several notable events in history occurred on March 2 - 1799 - Congress standardizes U.S. weights & measures; 1836 - Texas declares its independence from Mexico; 1853 - Territory of Washington separates from Oregon Territory; 1861 - Congress creates Dakota and Nevada territories out of Nebraska and Utah; 1951 - Boston Garden plays host to the first NBA All-Star game; 1959 - groundbreaking ceremony held for the Sydney Opera House; 1962 - Wilt Chamberlin shoots 36-63 from the floor and 28-32 from the foul line, scoring 100 points en route to a 169-147 win against the N.Y. Knicks.
- Notable March 2 birthdays: actress Rebel Wilson; author Dr. Seuss; rock star Jon Bon Jovi; actor Daniel Craig; rapper Method Man; Heisman; former Russian leader Mikhail Gorbachev; actor Desi Arnaz; Hall of Fame Basketball Coaches Clair Bee and Denny Crum.

POST PRESENCE AT N.C. STATE

- Quinten Post made 9-of-10 shots from the floor at N.C. State, finishing with 18 points.
- Over the last 25 years, only four BC players have shot 90% or better from the floor, with a minimum of 10 field goals attempted.
- The last Eagle to do so was Ryan Anderson (11-12) against Harvard on Dec. 4, 2012.
- Corey Raji (12-12) vs. Maine on Dec. 23, 2008 and Craig Smith (10-10) vs. St. Bonaventure on Dec. 4, 2002 did not miss.

ZACKERY IN RARE ACC COMPANY

- Jaeden Zackery posted a complete stat line vs. Florida State.
- He had 18 points, eight rebounds, six assists, and five steals while committing one turnover in 35 minutes of play.
- Zackery's rebounds, assists, and steals totals were all season-highs.
- **Over the last 25 seasons, only one other player posted that stat line or better in an ACC game.**
- Georgia Tech's Iman Shumpert did so against Virginia Tech on Jan. 25, 2011 (22 points, 12 rebounds, 11 assists, 7 steals).

BACK-TO-BACK DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR CAPTAIN CANADA

- James Karnik registered consecutive double-doubles in ACC play - the first BC player to do so in two years.
- He logged 16 points and 11 rebounds against Florida State and also had 11 points and 11 rebounds at Syracuse.
- The senior narrowly missed a third straight - registering 11 points and nine boards at N.C. State.
- Karnik has four double-doubles on the season 16 in his college career.
- Prior to Karnik, the last BC player to register a double-double in consecutive games was Steffon Mitchell.
- The recent BC grad did so on Feb. 26, 2020 vs. Notre Dame (12p/11r) and on March 3, 2020 against Syracuse (11r/10a).
- Mitchell was also the last BC player to log two straight double-doubles in points and rebounds, on Dec. 10 & 15, 2019.

MAKING THEIR POINT

- Over the last seven games, Boston College's primary playmakers have been highly efficient.
- In addition to scoring 14.0 points per game, Jaeden Zackery has registered 29 assists to eight turnovers (3.63:1 Assist/TO).
- The freshman has also notched 21 steals over the last seven ballgames (2.63:1 Steal/TO).
- Makai Ashton-Langford has dished out 33 assists to 14 turnovers (2.36:1 ATR), while logging 12 steals (0.86:1 Steal/TO).
- Ashton-Langford registered new career-highs in assists (9) and steals (4) against Florida State.
- On the season, both Zackery and Ashton-Langford rank among the top 25 in the ACC in assist/TO and steal/TO ratios.

KARNIK THE CATALYST

- In six ACC wins, James Karnik is averaging 14.5 points and 8.2 rebounds while shooting 70% (37-53) from the floor.
- In 12 ACC losses, Karnik is posting 8.8 points and 4.8 boards per outing, making 47% (42-90) of his FG attempts.
- When Karnik scores 16 or more points, Boston College is 4-3 - all of those games have come in ACC play.
- When Karnik scores at least in double figures, BC is 6-6 - including a 5-5 record in conference games.
- Karnik is scoring 15.8 points per game and shooting 65.5% (78-119) when he reaches double digits in the scoring column.

ZACKERY MAKING AN IMPACT

- Jaeden Zackery ranks third on BC in scoring (10.3), second in assists (2.8), and first in steals (1.8) this season.
- *Among all ACC first-year players, Zackery ranks sixth in scoring, third in assists, and first in steals.*
- With 49 steals, Jaeden Zackery has registered the fourth-most swipes in a season by a Boston College freshman.
- He has reached double-digits 14 times and has led the Eagles in scoring on six occasions.
- **Zackery is one of 24 players nationally - and only four frosh - to shoot 45% or better from 3-point land (min. 40 3FGM).**
- Against Syracuse on Feb. 8, he had a team-high 18 points with season-bests in rebounds (6), assists (6), and steals (3).
- Since 1996, 10 BC players matched Zackery's stat line vs. Syracuse - 18 points, 6 rebounds, 6 assists, 3 steals
- They are: Ryan Sidney (three times), Ky Bowman (twice), Troy Bell (twice), Tyrese Rice, and Troy Bell.
- However, Zackery is the ONLY Boston College player to register that stat line without committing a turnover.
- The Salem, Wisc. product has registered an effective FG% of 54.6% and a true shooting percentage of 56.8% in 28 games.
- He was named to the Sunshine Slam All-Tourney team, after scoring a season-high 19 points against Rhode Island.
- Earlier this season, he became the first BC freshman to dish out at least six assists in consecutive games in nearly a decade.
- Zackery was a 2020-21 NJCAA Third Team All-American out of Chipola College in Florida.

BACKCOURT BEST SERVED LATE

- Makai Ashton-Langford and Jaeden Zackery are scoring at a higher clip in the second half.
- Ashton-Langford is scoring 6.9 of his 11.9 points per game in the second half - nearly 60% of his scoring.
- Zackery is averaging 6.0 points during the second half - nearly 60% of his scoring. He is scoring 10.3 points per game.
- Twenty-two of Zackery's 43 3-pointers have come in the second half; 10 of those 22 in the final 5:00 of regulation.

SEVEN-FEET TALL x 22 FEET, 1.75 INCHES AWAY

- Quinten Post's six 3-pointers made tie him for second in BC history for the most 3FG made by a true 7-footer in a season.
- Post is 6-of-24 from beyond the arc this season. Three of his six made 3's have come in ACC play.
- Nate Doornekamp made eight 3-pointers during the 2004-05 season and finished his BC career with 16 3FGM.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. MIAMI...

- BC would move to 12-17 overall and 7-12 in ACC play
- BC would improve to 10-6 overall (5-6 ACC) at home
- It would mark the 19th time that BC has won at least 10 games in a season at Conte Forum
- It would snap a 12-game losing streak in the month of March, dating back to March 8, 2018
- Boston College would move to 28-26 all-time vs. Miami, including a 15-10 record at home and 11-17 in ACC play
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 12th victory at Boston College and his 139th as a collegiate head coach
- BC would earn win #1,236 all-time dating back to 1904-05 and win #98 in ACC play dating back to 2005-06

WITH A LOSS VS. MIAMI...

- BC drops to 11-18 overall and 6-13 in ACC play
- The Eagles would fall to 9-7 (4-6 ACC) in home games
- Boston College would move to 27-27 all-time vs. Miami, including a 14-11 record at home and 10-18 in ACC play
- Boston College would register the 1,063rd loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

PATTERNS OF IMPROVEMENT FOR MAKAI

- Makai Ashton-Langford has shown marked statistical improvement, year over year, from 2020-21 to this season.
- Ashton-Langford is scoring 3.3 more points/game, leading BC at 11.9 ppg. He was at 9.6 points per game in 2020-21.
- His rebounding and assists per game figures are also improved by 0.5, and 0.3 per game, respectively.
- In 28 games, Ashton-Langford has posted three 20+ performances. In his previous 90 games, he had scored 20+ once.
- Ashton-Langford has scored in double digits in 20 of 28 games for BC in 2021-22.
- From 2017-20, he scored in double figures 14 times over a 78-game span.
- He has led the team in scoring six times this year; he did so twice from 2017-20 at both Providence and Boston College.
- In ACC games, Ashton-Langford is averaging +2.0 ppg year over year - 12.0 in 2021-22 vs. 10.0 in 2020-21.
- His points/rebounding averages are also improved year over year in ACC play: 12.0/3.8 in 2021-22 vs. 10.0/3.3 in 2020-21.

DEMARR TRENDING

- Over his last eight games, DeMarr Langford Jr. is averaging 13.3 points, 5.1 rebounds, and 1.9 assists.
- He's shooting nearly 54% (42-79) from the floor over the span, while registering an assist/turnover ratio of 1.67:1.
- Last time out vs. Clemson, Langford Jr. grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds (four OReb; seven DReb).
- Returning from injury at N.C. State, Langford Jr. posted a full stat line - nine points, five boards, three assists, and four steals.
- On Feb. 16 at Notre Dame, Langford Jr. scored a career-high 23 points (10-14) to go with seven rebounds.
- The 6-5 guard had 16 points against #7/7 Duke - 10 coming in the second half
- On Feb. 8, Langford Jr. had 14 points (6-9 FG) and six rebounds at home against Syracuse.
- The sophomore had his second-best scoring night of the season against Pitt on Jan. 30, pouring in 17 points.
- Langford Jr. added 11 points and five boards at Virginia on Feb. 1.
- He scored 10 points on five shots in 16 first half minutes at Syracuse before leaving the game with an injury.
- The Worcester wing ranks second on BC in scoring (11.0), fourth in rebounding (4.7), and third in assists (2.1).

FREE THROW DISCREPANCIES OVER LAST 10

- In 18 ACC games, BC is being outscored at the FT line by nearly 5.0 points; opponents are taking +5.2 FT attempts per game.
- Over the last 10 conference matchups, BC is being outscored by +8.2 points per game from the foul line.
- Opponents have made close to twice as many trips to the free throw line - and have twice as many makes - during the span.
- Over the last 10 ACC tilts, opponents are 166-of-209 (.794) from the line. Boston College is 84-of-107 (.785)

BOARD MAN BICKERSTAFF

- T.J. Bickerstaff registered his second 17-rebound game of the season at North Carolina.
- Bickerstaff is one of 15 players nationally - two in the ACC (Bacot - UNC) to have multiple games with 17 rebounds or more.
- Fourteen of Bickerstaff's 17 rebounds came on the defensive glass versus the Tar Heels.
- The last BC player to grab at least 14 defensive boards in a game - Ky Bowman (16) - against Notre Dame on Jan. 12, 2019.
- The 17 rebounds tied for the fifth-most rebounds in a game in Boston College history.
- Danya Abrams holds the BC rebounding record, grabbing 20 boards at home vs. Providence on Jan. 22, 1994.
- Bickerstaff also corraled 17 boards at home vs. Columbia - the fourth-most in a single-game in Conte Forum history.
- The last BC player to have at least two games with 17+ rebounds - Ryan Anderson - during the 2012-13 season.
- Bickerstaff has registered four games with at least 15 rebounds this season - tied for most in the ACC this season (Bacot).
- The last BC player to have at least four games with 15+ rebounds - Craig Smith - during the 2005-06 season.
- The Atlanta product has six double-digit rebounding games so far in 2021-22.
- The last BC player to have at least six games with double-digit rebounds - Steffon Mitchell - during the 2019-20 season.
- Bickerstaff has two double-doubles on the season, most recently at Louisville, finishing with 12 points and 15 rebounds.
- He registered his first collegiate double-double - 22 points/15 rebounds - and three steals and two blocks at Rhode Island.
- He leads BC and ranks sixth in the ACC in overall rebounding (7.8), including ranking third in OReb (2.8).

KARNIK CAREER NIGHT; CAREER MILESTONE VS. VT

- James Karnik poured in a career-high 26 points - including his 1,000th point - in a win over Virginia Tech on Jan. 22.
- Karnik was 10-of-12 from the floor, scoring his milestone basket on a stepback 3-pointer. He was also 5-of-6 from the foul line.
- Karnik narrowly missed a double-double, grabbing nine boards in 30 minutes of play.
- He posted an efficiency rating of 32 (EFF is calculated: PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed Shots - TO).
- The 26 points were the most by a Boston College player this season.

COMEBACK FOR THE AGES - DOWN 23, WIN BY TWO

- Boston College erased a 23-point deficit to win, 70-68, at Clemson.
- Trailing 34-11, with 7:11 remaining in the first half, BC outscored Clemson by 25 - 59-34 - over the next 33 minutes.
- BC took its first lead on a Brevin Galloway 3-pointer - his fifth of the night - with 26 seconds left, giving BC a 69-68 advantage.
- Makai Ashton-Langford tacked on a free throw with 15 seconds left, making it 70-68.
- At the time of Clemson's 34-11 lead, **the Tigers held a 99.5% win probability rate.**
- **It tied as the largest comeback in an ACC game in conference history.**
- Duke erased a 23-point deficit at Louisville (2/13/19), while UVA overcame a 23-point hole vs. Duke in 2OT on Jan. 14, 1995.
- **It is the largest comeback in a game in Boston College program history.**
- Previously, the biggest comeback was 18 points, coming on Dec. 29, 2004 at home against Kent State.
- BC trailed, 41-23, in the first half, before rallying for the 67-65 win, capped by a Craig Smith 12-footer at the buzzer for the win.
- **It tied for the largest comeback in an ACC game for Boston College since Jan. 27, 2009.**
- The Eagles erased a 16-point first half deficit in College Park, holding the Terps to only 27 second half points.
- **It is the largest comeback in regulation in 2021-22.** JMU erased a 23-point deficit to beat W&M in OT this past Saturday.
- The largest deficit overcome in Division I was 34. Drexel overcame a 53-19 deficit to beat Delaware, 85-83 on Feb. 22, 2018.

MORE ABOUT THE WIN AT CLEMSON

- The win snapped Boston College's 13-game road losing streak, dating back to Feb. 12, 2020.
- The win snapped Boston College's nine-game losing streak vs. the Tigers - the longest such streak vs. an opponent.
- The win saw Boston College's NET improve 39 points (198 to 159) and KenPom ranking 15 points (147 to 132).

SUB-60 OPPONENTS IN ACC PLAY

- Boston College held back-to-back ACC foes under 60 points. Pitt scored 56 points on Jan. 30 and UNC had 58 on Jan. 26.
- It marks the first time since the 2018-19 season that BC held consecutive ACC opponents under 60 points on the scoreboard.
- That season, Boston College held Pittsburgh and Miami to 57 points apiece from Feb. 12-19, 2018.
- In total in 2021-22, Boston College has held four ACC foes below 60 points. The Eagles are 3-1 in those games.
- Dating back to 2005-06, the Eagles have held consecutive conference foes below 60 points on four occasions.
- During the 2011-12 season, the Eagles did so twice - Jan. 12-14, 2012 vs. Clemson (57) and Miami (59) and from Feb. 1-4, 2012 against N.C. State (56) and Georgia Tech (51).

CAREER NIGHT FOR QP VERSUS GEORGIA TECH

- Quinten Post scored a career-high 24 points - against Georgia Tech. Post scored 18 of his 24 in the second half.
- The 7-footer from Amsterdam connected on 10-of-14 shots from the floor - tying for the most FG by a BC player in 2021-22.
- Between 2020-21 and this season, Post is averaging +6.5 points and +3.5 rebounds per game.
- Percentage-wise, Post and is shooting nearly +8.0% better from the floor and +16.0% better from the free throw line.
- Post ranks fourth on BC in scoring (9.3 ppg) and is second in rebounding (5.6 rpg) this season.

COBRA KAI - EFFICIENT PERFORMANCE AT PITTSBURGH

- At Pitt, Makai Ashton-Langford put forth one of the most efficient performances by a point guard in the nation in 2021-22.
- Ashton-Langford finished the game with 23 points (4 3FGM), 3 rebounds, 4 assists (1 turnover), 1 block, and 3 steals.
- His EFF rating ($PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed Shots - TO$) was a team-best 24, while his offensive rating was 133.8.
- The 23 points - and four 3-pointers made - were new career-highs for the 6-3 point guard.
- He is one of only two players to post that statistical line on the box score this season (A.J. Walker of Air Force).
- Dating back to 1996-97, Troy Bell was the only BC player to post at least those totals in a single game - doing it twice.
- Among all ACC players since 1996, eight players have registered those totals in a single game.
- They are (in chronological order): Coby White (UNC) vs. Virginia Tech; Dennis Smith Jr. (NCST) vs. McNeese; Angel Rodriguez (Miami) vs. Duke; Lamar Patterson (Pitt) vs. Texas Tech; Tim Pickett (FSU) vs. UNC; Mike Dunleavy Jr. (Duke) vs. NC State; Shane Battier (Duke) vs. N.C. A&T. Four of those eight performances came in an ACC game.

BOO FROM THE WOO - LANGFORD JR. SHINING IN SECOND SEASON

- Through 27 games played, DeMarr Langford Jr. is settling into his sophomore season.
- He helps lead a balanced BC attack, averaging 11.0 points - second on BC - with 4.7 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game.
- The sophomore scored a career-best 23 points at Notre Dame on Feb. 16, making 10-of-14 shots from the floor.
- Langford Jr. kickstarted the Jan. 30 win over Pitt, scoring 11 of his 17 points in the first half.
- He averaged 17.3 points per game while shooting nearly 63.3% (19-30) from the floor in the Eagles' first three wins.
- Langford Jr. scored a career-high 20 points (6-9 FG; 8-8 FT) in 31 minutes vs. Holy Cross.
- The sophomore connected 13 of his first 15 field goal attempts on the season, making his first five shots vs. Holy Cross.
- He opened the season with a 16-point performance vs. Dartmouth, making 8-of-10 shots on the night.
- Since 1996-97, only 23 Boston College players have shot at least 80% while attempting at least 10 field goals in a game.
- Last season as a freshman, he averaged 6.7 points and 4.2 boards while adding 1.4 assists, and 1.1 steals per game.
- Langford Jr. - nicknamed Boo by his grandmother - is the younger brother of starting point guard Makai Ashton-Langford.
- On Nov. 26, 2020 vs. Rhode Island, they became the first brothers from Massachusetts to start in the same game for BC.

TIS' THE SEASON TO BE STINGY

- From Nov. 26-Dec. 3, BC limited opponents to 55.3 ppg - the lowest three-game scoring defense mark in over a decade.
- During the 2010-11 season, the Eagles yielded 55.0 ppg over a three-game stretch.
- During that span, BC held No. 19 North Carolina to 48 points, Miami to 73, and Virginia to 44 between Feb. 19-20, 2011.
- Since the 1996-97 season, BC's lowest three-game span of opponent scoring was 48.7 (Feb. 22-March 3, 2004).

INSIDE THE METRICS - STYLE OF PLAY (per KenPom)

- Earl Grant-coached teams have shown a strong ability to take care of the ball.
- Boston College is averaging 11.6 turnovers per outing - 71st nationally - including 11 games with 10 or fewer turnovers.
- BC has registered fewer than 10 turnovers on six occasions, including a season-low six against USF.
- Boston College's turnover rate is 2.2 turnovers/game fewer than last season and is the lowest since 2013-14 (11.2)
- From 2016-21, Grant's Charleston teams consistently ranked among the top teams in the country in TO% (# of poss/turns).
- In 2017-18 - CofC's NCAA Tournament season, the Cougars posted a 15.1% TO rate - good for 16th-best nationally.

BOSTON COLLEGE ANNOUNCES NATIONALLY-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS

- Boston College has secured one of its highest-rated recruiting classes in program history.
- The quartet of Prince Aligbe, D.J. Hand, Chas Kelley, and Armani Mighty - rank 26th nationally as a class per Rivals.com.
- Aligbe is a 6-7, 215 lb. forward from Minnehaha Academy in Minneapolis, Minn. and is a four-star rated recruit.
- He averaged 11.2 points per game as a junior in a program that has featured two of the top prep players in the country over the past two seasons - Jalen Suggs and Chet Holmgren, both of Gonzaga.
- Hand is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Landstown H.S. in Virginia Beach, Va. and is also a four-star ranked player.
- One of the top shooting guards in the country, Hand averaged nearly 33 points per game as a junior and was a First Team All-State selection.
- Kelley is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Houston who is playing his final prep season at The Phelps School in Malvern, Pa.
- A high three-star rated recruit, Kelley played his first two seasons of prep basketball at Cy-Creek H.S. in Houston, averaging nearly 16 points, five rebounds, five assists, and four steals as a sophomore.
- Mighty is a 6-10, 220 lb. center from Toronto and United Scholastic Academy.
- Born in Jamaica, the three-star rated big man has been playing organized basketball for only three years and shined on the grassroots circuit this past summer with Canada Elite - the country's top AAU program.
- Head coach Earl Grant on his four-player class: *"We believe that we added four high character guys to our program. They are welcome additions and we look forward to seeing the impact they will have in Boston!"*

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



On March 17, Earl Grant was introduced as The Clement and Elizabeth IZZI Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Grant brings an impressive track record to BC after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant is the 13th head coach in Boston College men's basketball history.

"When we began our search for a new head men's basketball coach, we set out to find a leader of young men, someone who shares our vision and our values, who could lead our program to championships while ensuring a world-class student-athlete experience and education for our players," said Kraft. "After a comprehensive national search, it was clear that Earl is exactly what we were looking for and what our basketball program needs at this moment and I am confident he will have tremendous success in Chestnut Hill, on the court and off."

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

"My family and I are really excited about the opportunity to start a new journey," Grant said. "I look forward to representing such a prestigious academic institution, to coach in the top basketball conference in America, and do it in one of the best cities in the world. I can't wait to meet and develop a relationship with all who have worked so hard over the years to make BC a special place. I am thankful to Pat Kraft, Father Leahy and the Board of Trustees for affording me this tremendous opportunity."

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players – Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley – were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley – the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson – 58.4 points per game – in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyaiah and Elonzo.
