#### THE GAME

- The #25/#25 Miami Hurricanes continue their first season under the direction of head coach **Mario Cristobal** on Sat., Sept. 24 vs. Middle Tennessee State at Hard Rock Stadium. Kickoff for the Hurricanes' final nonconference game, slated for broadcast on ACC Network, is set for 3:30 p.m. ET.
- The game will be broadcast on ACC Network with Chris Cotter (pxp), Mark Herzlich (color) and Lericia Harris (sideline) on the call. Joe Zagacki (pxp) and Don Bailey, Jr. (color) are in the 560 WQAM radio booth for their 21st season together while Josh Darrow manages the sideline duties. Alfredo Alvarez (pxp) and Joe Martinez (color) will carry the game live on WMYM 990AM from Hard Rock Stadium, as will WVUM 90.5 FM.

#### THE SERIES

- The Hurricanes trail the all-time series with the Blue Raiders, 0-2. The two teams have not competed in a head-to-head matchup since 1932.
- In the Blue Raiders' only previous trip to play the Hurricanes in Miami, UM lost, 7-0. Miami fell in its lone trip to Murfreesboro, 25-6, in 1931.

#### THE HURRICANES

- Miami fell for the first time Sept. 17, dropping a matchup to #23/#25 Texas A&M, 17-9, in its first road game of 2022 at Kyle Field in College Station.
- The Miami Hurricanes officially kicked off the Mario Cristobal era Sept. 3, when the Hurricanes topped Bethune-Cookman, 70-13, in their 2022 opener.
- The Hurricanes return home for their final non-conference game on Sept. 24, when they play host to the Middle Tennessee State Blue Raiders.
- Through the first three weeks of the season, the Hurricanes have seen two players earn ACC weekly honors. OL Jalen Rivers was named ACC Offensive Lineman of the Week following Miami's win over Bethune-Cookman, while K Andy Borregales was named ACC Specialist of the Week on Sept. 12.
- . Cristobal, a double alum of the University, was named the 26th head coach in program history by school president Dr. Julio Frenk on Dec. 6, 2021.
- Cristobal returned home after spending the previous four seasons as head coach at Oregon. During his time in Eugene, the Ducks were the only team to play in a Power-5 conference championship game each of his final three years. He led the Ducks to a Rose Bowl win and two Pac-12 titles.
- . Cristobal is one of only two active head coaches to have produced a top-10 pick in each of the last three drafts, joining only Alabama's Nick Saban.
- The first-year Miami head coach drew widespread acclaim for the staff he assembled, which includes reigning Broyles Award winner Josh Gattis as offensive coordinator, longtime coordinator and SEC veteran Kevin Steele as defensive coordinator and Charlie Strong as co-DC/linebackers coach
- OB **Tyler Van Dyke** enters his first full year as a starter with high expectations after earning ACC Rookie of the Year and ACC Offensive Rookie of the Year honors as a second-year freshman in 2021. Named to nearly every major offensive award preseason watch list, Van Dyke became the first quarterback since Joe Burrow (2019) to record a streak of six straight 300-yard passing games with three-or-more TDs in each of those games.
- TE Will Mallory (Mackey Award), James Williams (Bednarik Award), P Lou Hedley (Ray Guy Award), K Andy Borregales (Lou Groza Award), OL Zion Nelson (Outland) and DL Leonard Taylor (Bronko Nagurski Trophy) were also among those recognized with preseason watch list selections.
- In addition to a talented group of returners, the Hurricanes feature a 2022 recruiting class that finished ranked among the top 15 nationally by every scouting service and a group of newcomers through the transfer portal that includes DL Mitchell Agude (UCLA), DL Jacob Lichtenstein (USC), DL Akheem Mesidor (West Virginia), DL Darrell Jackson (Maryland), DL Antonio Moultrie (UAB), LB Caleb Johnson (UCLA), DB Daryl Porter, Jr. (West Virginia), OL Logan Sagapolu (Oregon), OL Jonathan Denis (Oregon) WR Frank Ladson, Jr. (Clemson) and RB Henry Parrish (Ole Miss).

#### **QUICH HITS**

#### CANES WRAP UP NONCONFERENCE SLATE

- #25/#25 Miami continues its highly anticipated first season under the direction of **Mario Cristobal** on Saturday, Sept. 24 against Middle Tennessee State.
- The Hurricanes are wrapping up their non-conference slate with the Blue Raiders; following its open date (Oct. 1), Miami opens ACC play with North Carolina Oct. 8.
- Last time out, Miami fell to #23/#25
   Texas A&M, 17-9, in College Station, Texas on Sept 17
- Cristobal racked up a 35-13 record and a 22-1 home mark during his four years at Oregon. He is 2-0 at home with Miami.

#### DEFENSE IMPRESSING UNDER STEELE

- Miami's defense is playing at a dominant level under DC Kevin Steele.
- The Hurricanes are tied for the ACC lead in scoring defense (12.3) and rank second in the league in total defense (282.3). They also place No. 16 overall and No. 24 overall in the FBS in those two categories.
- After conceding nine carries for 53 yards (5.9 average) in the first quarter, UM allowed 23 rushes to go for 71 yards (3.1) the rest of the game. In the fourth quarter, Texas A&M ran the ball six times and amassed only nine yards (1.5). On the season, Miami is fourth in the ACC in rush defense, allowing 83.7 yards per contest.

#### RADAKOVICH NAMED ATHLETICS DIRECTOR

- Not only were the Hurricanes bolstered by the return of Mario Cristobal, but Miami named longtime Clemson AD Dan Radakovich to the same post in December 2021.
- Radakovich, whose career spans more than 30 years, earned his MBA from the University of Miami in 1982 and worked in the school's business office from 1983 - 1985.
- Prior to Clemson, Radakovich served as Georgia Tech's AD from 2006 to 2012, and before that, he was a Senior Associate AD at LSU. Radakovich earned his bachelor's degree from Indiana University of Pennsylvania in

### #25/#25 MIAMI WRAPS UP NONCONFERENCE WITH BLUE RAIDERS

- #25/#25 Miami continues its first season under the direction of head coach **Mario Cristobal** Sept. 24 with its final nonconference game of 2022 a home tilt with the Middle Tennessee State Blue Raiders.
- Last time out, the Hurricanes dropped their first game of the season, 17-9, to Texas A&M on the road.
- Cristobal was named the 26th head coach in the history of the program on December 6, 2021 after spending the previous four years at the helm of the Oregon Ducks. Cristobal is a two-time UM alum.
- When he departed Eugene, Cristobal was the only Power-5 head coach to lead his team to three straight conference championship games from 2019-2021. He won two Pac-12 titles, delivered a Rose Bowl to the Ducks and is one of just two active coaches to produce a top-10 pick three straight years.
- The Canes are matching up with MTSU for the third time in history; UM is 0-2 in the all-time series.
- UM's game versus the Blue Raiders is slated for broadcast on 560 WQAM, Radio Actualidad & WVUM.

#### A LOOK BACK: MIAMI FALLS TO TOP-25 AGGIES IN CLOSE ROAD TEST

- The Hurricanes fell in their first road test of 2022, dropping a matchup with top-25 Texas A&M, 17-9, in College Station, Texas last time out on Sept. 17. Miami outgained the Aggies, 392-264, in the defeat.
- The Hurricanes held Texas A&M to just 16 first downs and 124 rushing yards, but came up just short.
- Miami had 27 first downs (compared to 16 for Texas A&M) and 217 yards passing (140 for Texas A&M).
- Miami's defense totaled six tackles for loss and three sacks on defense, including one each from DL Darrell Jackson and DL Jahfari Harvey. DB James Williams led the defense with seven tackles.
- Miami's offense was led by RB Henry Parrish, Jr. (16 carries, 85 yards) and RB Jaylan Knighton (14 carries, 77 yards). TE Will Mallory had six catches for 56 yards while eight players caught a pass.
- Miami did not allow a single sack against the talented Texas A&M defense, marking the second time in three games it has not allowed a QB takedown. UM allowed only three TFLs for just three yards.

#### MIAMI DEFENSE PLAYING AT ELITE LEVEL UNDER STEELE'S DIRECTION

- The Hurricanes are tied for the ACC lead in scoring defense (12.3) and rank second in the league in total defense (282.3). They place No. 16 overall and No. 24 overall in the FBS in those two categories.
- After conceding nine carries for 53 yards (5.9 average) in the first quarter at Kyle Field, Miami allowed 23 rushes to go for just 71 yards (3.1) the rest of the game. In the fourth quarter, Texas A&M ran the ball six times and amassed only nine yards (1.5). Through their first three games of 2022, the Hurricanes are fourth in the ACC in rushing defense, allowing an impressive 83.7 yards per contest on defense.
- The Hurricanes have done their job in the trenches on both sides of the ball this season, as they are fourth in the ACC sacks against (1.33 per game) and tied for fourth in sacks record (2.67 per game).

#### **HURRICANES OFFENSE GAINING STEAM THREE GAMES INTO 2022**

- Miami became just the third team in the last two years to total at least 390 yards of offense vs. Texas A&M, joining Alabama (10/9/21) as the only ones to do so at Kyle Field. LSU (11/27/21) did it at home.
- Under Broyles Award winner Josh Gattis, UM is putting up 476.0 yards of offense per game so far, good for the third-best mark in the ACC. Their 6.43 yards per play average puts them fourth in ACC.
- Miami's ground game has been superb so far, with its nine rushing touchdowns tied for second in the ACC, its 218.0 rush yards per game placing third and its 5.15 yards per carry good for fourth. Meanwhile, the team has also been efficient throwing the ball, placing third in the league with both
- 258.0 yards per game and with a 66.3 completion percentage. Miami is in second in the ACC in time of possession, retaining the ball for an average of 33:38 per game, a figure that places No. 17 in FBS.

#### CRISTOBAL ASSEMBLED SUPERSTAR STAFF HEADING INTO FIRST YEAR

- Among the many storylines of the offseason was Mario Cristobal's staff assembly in Coral Gables, where the Hurricanes added some familiar faces from South Florida to a staff with national ties.
- Cristobal pulled the reigning Broyles Award winner (top assistant coach) **Josh Gattis** from Michigan, where the OC helped lead the Wolverines to their first College Football Playoff appearance in 2021.
- Boasting over 40 years of experience including stints as defensive coordinator at Clemson, Auburn and LSU, Kevin Steele joined Cristobal's staff as DC. Longtime head coach Charlie Strong is Co-DC.
- Frank Ponce and Alex Mirabal, two Miami natives, moved back home to join Cristobal's staff as well.
- The impressive nature of Cristobal's staff build-out was not restricted to just full-time assistants; NFL
  Hall of Fame defensive end Jason Taylor is a quality control analyst, longtime NFL personnel director
  and UM alum Alonzo Highsmith was named General Manager of Football Operations.
- Between Taylor and senior football advisor **Ed Reed**, Miami has two Pro Football Hall of Fame members who combined for 15 Pro Bowl nods, 12 All-Pro picks and eight First Team All-Pro plaudits.

#### PARRISH JOINED ELITE GROUP WITH THIRD STRAIGHT GAME OF 85+

- **Henry Parrish, Jr.,** has amassed 85-plus rushing yards in each of his first three games as a Hurricane. This is just the sixth time since the turn of the century (2000-present) a Miami Hurricane has hit 85 yards in each of the first three games of a season, as Parrish joins DeeJay Dallas (2019), Mark Walton (2016), Duke Johnson (2014), Lamar Miller (2011) and Frank Gore (2003) to accomplish the feat.
- He co-leads the ACC in rush yards per game (100.67) (Israel Abanikanda / Pitt, Treshaun Ward / FSU).
- Parrish is No. 18 nationally in rush TDs, No. 23 in rush yards / game and No. 45 in all-purpose average.
- Parrish, Jr., who returned home to Miami after spending the first two years of his career at Ole Miss, rushed for 108 yards and three touchdowns on just 14 carries in the opener. The 108 yards marked the second-highest total of his career, while the three scores set a new mark - his previous high was two.
- Parrish, Jr. bested himself against Southern Miss, rushing for 109 yards with one touchdown in a 30-7 win on Sept. 10. Outside of Parrish, no other Miami player this century (2000-pres.) has opened his career as a Hurricane by rushing for 100-plus yards in the team's opening two games of a season
- Parrish, Jr., rushed 16 times for 85 yards last time out at Texas A&M, averaging 5.3 yards per carry.
- In his two years with the Rebels, the Miami native totaled more than 1,000 all-purpose yards. He was a four-star prospect who rushed for more than 4,600 yards in an illustrious high school career.
- Miami's game vs. Bethune-Cookman made it three consecutive years where Miami has had a game with two players scoring at least two rushing TDs. That hadn't happened since 2013 before 2020.

## VAN DYKE HAS THROWN MULTIPLE TDs IN SEVEN OF LAST NINE

- Named to nearly every offensive award major preseason watch list, QB Tyler Van Dyke is poised for another big season after putting together an ACC Rookie of the Year campaign at Miami in 2021.
- Van Dyke became the third Miami Hurricane to win both ACC Rookie of the Year and ACC Offensive Rookie of the Year honors, joining Hurricanes QB Brad Kaaya (2014) and RB Duke Johnson (2012).
- Van Dyke took over starting duties three games into the season and ended the year by throwing for 2,931 yards, 25 passing touchdowns and just six interceptions. He completed 62.3 percent of passes.
- In the season opener vs. Bethune-Cookman, Van Dyke extended his streak of throwing multiple TDs to seven consecutive games. For the fifth time during that stretch, Van Dyke threw zero interceptions.
- Van Dyke's streak of seven straight games with multiple touchdown passes ended vs. Southern Miss.

#### MIDDLE TENNESSEE LEADS, 2-0

#### MIAMI IMPRESSING ON THIRD DOWN THREE GAMES INTO SEASON

Miami ranks second in the ACC and No. 10 in the nation with a 55.3 percent third-down conversion. It
is one of only three ACC teams above 47 percent. The success has helped lead to 82 first downs, tied
for the top mark by any team in the conference and good for No. 13 in the FBS.
That figure is also double what it has allowed, as Hurricane foes have amassed only 41 first downs,
good for the second-fewest conceded by any ACC school an 17th-fewest in the country thus far.

### A RAY GUY AWARD CANDIDATE, HEDLEY OFF TO DAZZLING START

A 2020 Ray Guy Award finalist and a 2022 Preseason First Team All-ACC pick, Lou Hedley is off to a
dazzling start. The sixth-year standout has UM at second in the ACC in both yards per punt (46.0) and
net yards per punt (44.5), posting zero touchbacks. The 44.5 mark puts Miami sixth in the country.

#### WILLIAMS CONTINUES ASCENT WITH STRONG SHOWING VS TEXAS A&M

- A former five-star recruit who made his presence felt in 2021, second-year safety James Williams was named to the watch list for the Chuck Bednarik Award honoring the nation's top defensive player.
- Williams continued his ascent into one of the nation's premier defensive backs Saturday night in College Station. He totaled a team-high seven tackles, including six solos, and defended two passes.
- Williams became the fourth Hurricane—fifth occurrence—in the last 10 seasons, including the second
  on the road, to notch seven takedowns and two breakups in the same game, joining Kamren Kinchens
  (11/6/21 vs. Georgia Tech), Te'Cory Couch (9/20/21 vs. Virginia and 12/20/20 vs. Oklahoma State) and
  Shaquille Quarterman (10/26/19 at Pittsburgh); no Miami player had managed to do so from 2013-18.
- Williams appeared in all 10 games for which he was healthy in 2022, making seven starts and finishing with 31 tackles and a team-best two interceptions. Williams was one of only 15 ACC players on the list.
- The south Florida native recorded an interception and finished and had three tackles in the opener.
- Williams enjoyed a breakout year as an All-ACC Honorable Mention selection, headlining a secondary that included fellow first-year players Kam Kinchens and Avantae Williams in the safety rotation.
- The Hurricanes will be coached be secondary coach Jahmile Addae, whose Georgia Bulldogs unit ranked No. 13 in the nation in pass defense in 2021 and checked in as the No. 1 scoring defense.
- Addae's 2020 unit at West Virginia ranked No. 1 nationally in fewest passing yards allowed per game.
- Williams and Leonard Taylor III both signed with Miami in 2021 as five-star recruits, marking the first five-star pair to join the Hurricane in the same year since Duke Johnson and Tracy Howard in 2012.

#### MIAMI ALREADY IMPROVED IN RED ZONE DEFENSE THREE WEEKS IN

 After conceding a red-zone score all but twice in 2021 (37-of-39), Miami has already matched that number in 2022. Miami has allowed six red-zone trips, giving up points on four and a touchdown on just one vs. Bethune-Cookman (Sept. 3), Southern Miss (Sept. 10) & Texas A&M (Sept. 17) combined.

#### RESTREPO ENJOYED FAST START BEFORE SUFFERING FOOT INJURY

- WR **Xavier Restrepo** turned in the finest game of his Miami career in the opener, catching all five balls thrown his way to finish with 100 yards and a touchdown. It was the first 100-yard game of his career.
- Before suffering an injury before Miami's game against Texas A&M, Xavier Restrepo was off to a fast start to begin 2022. The third-year sophomore wide receiver was averaging 86.0 yards per game, which was good for the fourth-best mark in the ACC. Only eight players in the league had 60-plus yards per contest. At the time of his injury, Restrepo was also tied for fourth in ACC with 11 catches.
- Restrepo, who started and was a team captain vs. B-CU, caught a career-long 52-yard pass.
- Restrepo totaled 24 catches for 373 yards and two touchdowns as a second-year freshman in 2021.

## MALLORY SHOWED OUT VS A&M, COULD HAVE #TIGHTENDU RECORDS

- After the announcement of Mario Cristobal's appointment as head coach at The U, a number of student-athletes elected to return for their final year of eligibility rather than train for the NFL Draft.
- One of Miami's most important returnees is TE **Will Mallory**, who was among Miami's top offensive performers a season ago. Mallory set career marks in catches (30), yards (347), starts (12) and longest reception (57) last year, while also matching his career mark for touchdowns in a season (four).
- The Mackey Award candidate had his best game yet versus Texas A&M: six catches for 56 yards.
- Mallory started the season opener and had two catches totaling 21 yards in the 70-13 win on Sept. 3.
- Mallory needs 40 receptions, 670 yards and three touchdowns to set the Miami records for a tight end.
- The Jacksonville native's accomplishments are even more impressive given the history of tight ends
  at Miami, an alumni group that includes Jeremy Shockey, Greg Olsen, Bubba Franks, David Njoku and
  Jimmy Graham. Mallory was named a candidate to watch for the Mackey Award as the top tight end.

#### **BROTHERLY LOVE: BORREGALES CARRYING ON FAMILY LEGACY AT UM**

- A year after his older brother Jose became the first Lou Groza Award winner in program history, Andres
   "Andy" Borregales earned starting placekicker responsibilities as a true freshman in 2021.
- Andy went on to earn All-ACC Honorable Mention honors in a 2021 season where he connected on 17-of-21 field goal attempts and a perfect 45-of-45 extra point attempts. He was 5-6 of kicks longer than 40.
- Borregales has been impressive to begin 2022. He is one of just four players—two of whom are kickers—averaging double-digit points per game. The sophomore has put up 10.33 per contest, good for the third-best mark in the league, by connecting on all 13 of his extra-point attempts and six of his eight FG tries. His six makes place him second in ACC, trailing only Wake Forest's Matthew Dennis (seven).
- The younger Borregales nailed a 55-yard kick in 2021 that was the longest ever by a UM freshman.
- Jose was Miami's first consensus All-America since 2004 in his lone season at The U, finishing 20-for-22 on field goal attempts and a perfect 37-for-37 on extra point attempts. He passed on #30 to Andy.

#### IT STARTS IN THE TRENCHES - WHERE MIAMI HAS LOADS OF EXPERIENCE

- One of Mario Cristobal's focal points has been in building Miami's depth and ability in the trenches, and the Hurricanes return and add a number of key players at the line of scrimmage for 2022.
- The Hurricanes have done their job in the trenches on both sides of the ball this season, as they are fourth in the ACC sacks against (1.33 per game) and tied for fourth in sacks record (2.67 per game).
- Miami has three players who each have more than 30 starts on the offensive line: Zion Nelson (32 career starts), Jakai Clark (34) and DJ Scaife (34). In addition, the Hurricanes return several other played who have started, including Justice Oluwaseun, Jalen Rivers and John Campbell.
- On the defensive line, some of Miami's most experienced players arrive via the transfer portal, including All-Big 12 defensive lineman Akheem Mesidor (West Virginia), defensive end Mitchell Agude (UCLA), secondyear defensive tackle Darrell Jackson (Maryland), south Florida native and longtime USC defensive lineman Jacob Lichtenstein and defensive lineman Antonio Moultrie (UAB).

#### MIAMI PLACES THREE ON 2022 PRESEASON ALL-ACC FOOTBALL TEAM

- Among Miami's preseason honorees were OL Zion Nelson and TE Will Mallory, along with P Lou Hedley, who were all selected to the All-ACC Preseason Team in a poll of conference media.
- QB Tyler Van Dyke finished third in Preseason Player of the Year voting with 21 votes, trailing only QB Sam Hartman of Wake Forest (30) and QB Devin Leary of NC State (40), who ranked as the top two.
   Van Dyke is the reigning ACC Rookie of the Year and ACC Offensive Rookie of the Year entering 2022.
- Mallory has 73 career receptions for 1,006 yards with 11 touchdowns in his four seasons at The U.
- Nelson, an All-ACC Honorable Mention pick last year, has played in all 36 games since arriving to Miami in 2019. He has made 32 starts of his career, including all 12 in 2021 and all 13 in 2019.
- Hedley was a 2020 finalist for the Ray Guy Award honoring the nation's top punter and is a two-time Second Team All-ACC designee. He has averaged 45.2 yards per punt in his three seasons at Miami.

## WEEK 2: MIAMI TOPPLES SOUTHERN MISS, 30-7, TO MOVE TO 2-0

- A week after rolling to a 70-13 win in its season opener against Bethune-Cookman, the Hurricanes improved to 2-0 in Mario Cristobal's first season with a 30-7 win over Southern Miss on Sept. 10.
- Making the 11th start of his career, QB Tyler Van Dyke completed 20 of 29 passes for 261 yards with one
  touchdown and one interception. Miami improved to 8-3 in games started by Van Dyke all-time.
- Miami held Southern Miss to just seven points in the victory. It marked the first time Miami has conceded single-digit points in a game since 9/25/21 versus Central Connecticut State (zero). The last time the Hurricanes held an FBS team below 10 points was 12/5/20 at Duke (zero) and the last time they did so against a non-conference FBS foe was 11/11/17 versus third-ranked Notre Dame (eight).
- Five different Southern Miss players logged at least one carry Saturday. All of them averaged fewer than 1.5 yards per attempt, with three at 0.0 or below. Miami racked up 32 yards in TFLs on the day.

## WEEK 1: MIAMI DOMINATES WILDCATS, 70-13, IN SEASON OPENER

- The Hurricanes improved to 6-0 all-time against Bethune-Cookman in its season opener on Sept. 3.
- Miami amassed all but 15 possible offensive yards against the Wildcats in its 70-13 win at Hard Rock Stadium. It scored a touchdown on nine of its 11 drives, while another one ended at the opposing six-yard-line. The Hurricanes' final drive ended at the nine-yard-line when the game clock expired.
- The Hurricanes logged three interceptions in the win against Bethune-Cookman, with one each by Gilbert
  Frierson, Kamren Kinchens and James Williams. It marked the second time in the last four years Miami had
  three interceptions in a game, joining the 9/26/20 matchup with Florida State.
- WR Xavier Restrepo turned in the finest game of his career in Miami's season opener, catching all five balls
  thrown his way to finish with 100 yards and a touchdown. It was Restrepo's first 100-yard game.

## HIGHSMITH NAMED GENERAL MANAGER OF FOOTBALL OPERATIONS

- The University of Miami hired longtime National Football League executive and Hurricanes great **Alonzo Highsmith** as general manager of football operations, it was announced on May 26, 2022.
- As general manager of football operations, Highsmith will work directly with Cristobal to support all
  administrative functions of the football program, including budget related items, culture building,
  program imaging, and working directly with staff members both on and off the field.
- Highsmith, a former first-round selection in the NFL Draft, also serves as a liaison between the
  administration and program, serve as a liaison between former players and assists with scouting.
- Highsmith, who played running back for the Hurricanes from 1983-1986, boasts 29 years' experience and 18 playoff appearances as an NFL player, scout and executive. He has spent the past 23 years in scouting and personnel, most recently serving as senior executive advisor to the GM for Seattle.
- Highsmith joined the Packers as a college scout in 1999 and spent 13 years on their college scouting staff. He was promoted to senior personnel executive in 2012 and remained in that role through the 2017 season. During his time in GB, the Packers made 13 trips to the playoffs, captured nine division titles and won Super Bowl XLV.

#### RADAKOVICH SIGNS ON AS DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS AT MIAMI

- One of the nation's most well-respected athletics administrators returned to the institution where nearly three decades ago he launched his career—the University of Miami. **Dan Radakovich**, who served as director of athletics at Clemson University for nine years, was named vice president and director of athletics on Dec. 9, 2021 - shortly after the hiring of head coach Mario Cristobal.
- Radakovich took the helm at Clemson in late 2012 and during his tenure, Clemson won 15 Atlantic Coast Conference team titles. The Tigers football program won two national championships, made six College Football Playoff appearances, and captured six ACC titles. In the classroom, Clemson student-athletes recorded nine semesters with a 3.0 GPA or higher. The athletic department attained the school's highest-ever NCAA Graduation Success Rate at 93 percent in 2020.

## ACC ANNOUNCES NEW MODEL; HURRICANES TO PLAY BC, FSU, Uofl

- The new ACC football scheduling model is based on a 3-5-5 structure whereby each team will play three primary opponents annually and face the other 10 league teams twice during the cycle. The schedule allows for each team to face all 13 conference opponents home and away at least once during the four-year cycle. The structure was adopted by the league's ADs and faculty reps.
- The new schedule will eliminate the Atlantic and Coastal divisions with all 14 schools competing in one division beginning in 2023. The top two teams based on conference winning percentage will compete in the Subway ACC Football Championship Game on the first Saturday in December.
- Miami's three opponents primary annual opponents are Boston College, Florida State and Louisville.

#### FORD SELECTED BY PACKERS, UM'S DRAFT STREAK CONTINUES IN '22

- University of Miami defensive lineman Jonathan Ford was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 NFL Draft by the Green Bay Packers on the final day of the draft. Ford's selection continued Miami's streak of having at least one player picked in every NFL Draft since 1975 – the fourth-longest streak,
- 2022 marked the sixth straight year the NFL Draft featured at least one UM lineman selected.
- A three-year starter for the Hurricanes, Ford saw action in 10 games and made eight starts in 2021.
- Ford made 30 starts over his career. He finished his career with 60 tackles and 7.5 tackles for loss.

#### **UM LEADING THE WAY WITH A DIVERSE STAFF REPRESENTING SOFLA**

 Miami is tied with Hawai'i for the highest percentage of minority representation on its full-time staff. Nine of UM's 11 full-time coaches are either African-American, Hispanic or Polynesian, exactly (81.8%)

#### CANES PULL IN RECRUITING CLASS RANKED AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Thanks to the late work of Mario Cristobal and his staff on the recruiting trail, the Hurricanes 2022 high school recruiting class soared to a top-15 class by nearly every recognized outlet by end of year.
- The Hurricanes picked up several impactful pieces on Early Signing Day, signing LB **Wesley** Bissainthe, DL Nyjalik Kelly, DL Cyrus Moss and TE Jaleel Skinner, who enrolled before spring ball.
- Miami added RB TreVonte' Citizen, one of the nation's best running backs, and inked offensive linemen like **Matthew McCoy** and **Anez Cooper** to move into a class ranked in the top 15.
- The Hurricanes signed five top-125 prospects for the first time since 2018. The four highest-rated members of that group committed after Mario Cristobal took over at the helm of the Hurricanes.

# MARIO CRISTOBAL

HEAD COACH | FIRST SEASON AT MIAMI (11TH OVERALL) | 2-1 | 64-61

Mario Cristobal has returned home to Miami.

Cristobal, who helped lead the University of Miami to two national championships in 1989 and 1991 as a standout offensive lineman, was named the University's 26th football head coach on December 6, 2021.

One of college football's most highly regarded coaches, Cristobal returned to his alma mater after leading the University of Oregon to three straight Pac-12 Conference championship game appearances and two Pac-12 titles. He is the only coach in the nation whose team has played in a Power Five conference championship game in each of the past three seasons.

"We are incredibly excited to welcome Mario, his wife, Jessica, and their sons Mario Mateo and Rocco home to Miami," UM President Julio Frenk said. "Mario's legacy as a student-athlete at the U is well established. And the standard for competitive excellence that he and his teammates helped establish is one to which we continue to aspire. Our selection, however, was not one based in nostalgia for a proud past, but rather in a bold vision for a promising future.

"The characteristics that helped Mario excel as a national championship-winning player—drive, determination, and discipline—continue to propel his success as a coach. In Mario we have found a head coach who shares our belief in providing student-athletes with the very best opportunities to succeed on and off the field, and our commitment to winning at the highest level."

"My family and I are excited to return home to the University of Miami, which has been so instrumental in shaping me as a person, player, and coach," Cristobal said. "This program has an unparalleled tradition and an exciting future ahead of it. I can't wait to compete for championships and help mold our student-athletes into leaders on and off the field who will make our University, our community, and our loyal fan base proud."

Cristobal brings more than 20 years of FBS coaching experience to Coral Gables, including 10 as a head coach. He compiled a 35-13 record at Oregon, leading the Ducks to consecutive Pac-12 titles in 2019 and 2020. Oregon advanced to three straight conference championship games from 2019 to 2021 and earned bowl-game appearances in each of Cristobal's seasons in Eugene, highlighted by a Rose Bowl victory that capped a 12-win season and No. 5 ranking in the final Associated Press and AFCA Coaches polls in 2019. Cristobal was named the Associated Press Pac-12 Coach of the Year for his efforts that season.

Over Cristobal's first three seasons in Eugene, Oregon players earned 44 all-conference selections and 14 players were selected in the NFL Draft, including firstround selections in each of the past three drafts. With the selections of Kayvon Thibodeaux (2022), Penei Sewell (2021) and Justin Herbert (2020), Cristobal is one of only two active head coaches to produce top-10 picks in each of the last three drafts.

During his tenure as both an assistant and head coach at Oregon, two players— Noah Sewell and Thibodeaux—earned Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year honors, and three players—Thibodeaux, Penei Sewell, and Tyrell Crosby—earned the Morris Trophy, awarded to the Pac-12's best offensive and defensive linemen.

Cristobal served as Oregon's co-offensive coordinator, run-game coordinator, and offensive line coach during the 2017 season before being elevated to head coach.

Cristobal's national title-winning pedigree isn't limited to his time as a player. At Alabama, where he served as assistant head coach, offensive line coach, and recruiting coordinator, he helped lead the Crimson Tide to the national championship in 2015 and a runner-up finish the following season.

During his four years in Tuscaloosa, from 2013 to 2016, five Alabama offensive linemen were selected in the NFL Draft and, with Cristobal's tutelage, the 2015 offensive line unit won the inaugural Joe Moore Award, given to the most outstanding offensive line unit in the nation.

Considered one of the country's elite recruiters and evaluators of talent, Cristobal, during his tenures at both Alabama and Oregon, helped assemble national top-15 recruiting classes eight straight years, with seven of those classes rated in the top 10. The 2018 class at Alabama produced three NFL first-round draft picks. At Oregon, he constructed the Pac-12's top-rated recruiting classes in 2019, 2020, and 2021.

Cristobal's move to Miami brings his coaching career full circle. A son of South Florida who played prep football at nearby Christopher Columbus High School, he launched his coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Miami from 1998 to 2000 under head coach Butch Davis. He served as an assistant coach at Rutgers from 2001 to 2003 and then returned to Miami as an assistant coach from 2004 to 2006 under head coach Larry Coker.

In 2007, Cristobal was named head coach at Florida International University, becoming the first Cuban American head coach in FBS history. He inherited a struggling FIU program that had been winless the year before his arrival and, in just his fourth season, led it to the Sun Belt Conference title and a bowl-game victory. That season, 2010, he was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year. In total, he coached six seasons at FIU, from 2007 to 2012.

Cristobal, who played his Hurricanes career under coaches Jimmy Johnson and Dennis Erickson, was an All-Big East selection in 1992. He is a double-alumnus of the University of Miami, earning a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree from the University. Cristobal was born in Miami on Sept. 24, 1970. He and his wife, Jessica, married in June 2006 and are the parents of two sons, Mario Mateo and Rocco.
