## QUICKIE NOTES

- ▶ The Aggies are competing the Colonial Athletic Association for the first time in school history during the 2022-23 season.
- ▶ A&T spent one season in the Big South (2021-22) and 39 seasons in the MEAC (1982-21).
- ▶ Last time out, head coach Tarrell Robinson recorded his 192nd win at A&T to become the school's all-time winningest coach in program history.
- ▶ The Aggies 89-38 victory against Mid-Atlantic Christian gave head coach Tarrell Robinson's 100th career victory in Corbett Sports Center. He is the first women's coach to reach that milestone. He has a 100-28 (.781) record in Corbett.
- ▶ The game against Mid-Atlantic Christian on Nov. 15 will be the 500th women's basketball game played in Corbett Sports Center.
- ▶ A&T looks for its 600th win in program history this season. The Aggies have 587 program wins.
- ▶ Jazmin Harris recorded 17 points at South Carolina State to record her 1,000th career collegiate point.
- ▶ Nyah Willis is also closing in on her 1,000th career point. She needs 59 points to reach the milestone.

- ▶ Jazmin Harris landed on the CAA All-Preseason Second Team as the Aggies were picked ninth in the Colonial Athletic Association.
- ▶ The Aggies return six players from last year's team and welcomes eight newcomers, including five transfers.
- ▶ A&T has been a force in the MEAC over the last six seasons winning three MEAC tournament titles and four regular-season titles including the final year's regular-season championship.
- ▶ Robinson has sixth postseason appearance in the 10 years he has been the Aggies head coach. He has three NCAA appearances (2016, 2018, 2021) and three WNIT appearances (2013, 2014, 2019).
- ▶ In the past 15 seasons, the Aggies have claimed seven regular-season titles. During four of those championship runs, the Aggies compiled 15 or more wins. The Aggies have finished no lower than fourth only once in the past 15 seasons in the MEAC, during the 2016-17 season.
- ▶ N.C. A&T has 11th postseason appearances with five NCAA tournament appearances (1994, 2009, 2016, 2018, 2021) and five WNIT appearances (2008, 2010, 2013, 2014, 2019). It was their first

## THE LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Aggies won their third consecutive game with a 68-49 victory at South Carolina State Tuesday for the first road victory of the season.
- ▶ Head coach Tarrell Robinson recorded his 192nd win at A&T to become the Aggies winningest coach in program history.
- ▶ Maleia Bracone led the way with 18 points, shooting 7-for-14 from the field and added eight rebounds.
- ▶ Jazmin Harris added 17 points on 7-for-12 shooting with seven rebounds. Her 17 points pushed her to 1,002 career points.
- ▶ Chaniya Clark recorded her first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds.

## Robinson Chases School Record

- ▶ Head coach Tarrell Robinson has 192 wins at A&T, setting the record against SCSU.
- ▶ Robinson passed Tim Abney, who went 191-172 (.526) record, including a 116-87 (.571) MEAC record.
- ▶ Robinson has a 192-109 (.638) overall record and a 109-27 (.801) MEAC record.
- ▶ In the only season in the Big South, Robinson posted a 11-7 (.611) conference record.
- ▶ Robinson looks to become only the third men's or women's coach to reach 200 wins at A&T.

## A&T Looks for Win No. 600

- ▶ North Carolina A&T is looking for its 600th win in program history.
- ▶ The Aggies need 13 wins this season to reach the milestone and has a program record of 587-572.
- ▶ A&T has a 347-261 MEAC record and an 11-7 Big South record. This season will be the first season in the Colonial Athletic Association.

## Home Court Advantage

- ▶ Under head coach Tarrell Robinson, A&T is 100-28, a .781 winning percentage in Corbett Sports Center. The Aggies posted at least nine wins in seven of his 10 completed seasons.

▶ Over the last 16 seasons, the Aggies have a 158-35 record at home, a .818 winning percentage. A&T won at least nine home games in 12 of the last 16 seasons.

## Harris and Willis Look for 1,000th career point

▶ Jazmin Harris recorded 17 points at South Carolina State to give her 1,002 career points.

▶ She recorded 611 points in three seasons at Charlotte and has 392 points in over one season at A&T.

▶ Nyah Willis needs 659 points for her 1,000th career point.

▶ She recorded 467 points in one season with Chabot and 443 points in two seasons at Presbyterian. So far this season, she has 31 points in her only season at A&T.

## NCAA Rankings

▶ The Aggies rank in the top 50 in 13 categories.

▶ A&T leads the CAA and ranks second in the NCAA in rebounding margin (19.2) and rebounds per game (52.8).

▶ defensive rebounds per game (37.0) and rebounds per game (56.0)

▶ LSU leads the country in rebounding margin (26.2) and in rebounds per game (56.0)

▶ The Aggies also leads the CAA and ranks fourth in the NCAA holding opponents to a 28.5 field goal percentage. LSU leads the country holding opponents to a 24.9 shooting percentage.

▶ A&T leads the CAA and ranks fifth with 19.5 offensive rebounds per game, and leads the conference and ranks 12th in the NCAA with 33.2 defensive rebounds per game.

▶ A&T leads the CAA and ranks 31st in free throws made per game (19.33).

▶ The Aggies lead the CAA and rank eighth holding opponents to a 18.5 3-point field goal percentage and lead the CAA and rank 14th with a 30.8 scoring margin.

▶ A&T ranks second in the conference and 49th in the NCAA with 6.0

blocks per game and leads the CAA and ranks 12th holding opponents to a 48.2 points per game.

▶ The Aggies ranks fourth in the CAA and ranks 52nd in the NCAA with 17.0 assists per game and lead the conference and ranks 48th with 79.0 points per game..

## Harris Lands on CAA Preseason Team

▶ Playing in her second season at A&T landed herself on the Colonial Athletic Association second-team.

▶ Last season, Harris was second on the team with 13.1 points per game, which ranked 13th in the Big South and second on the team with 6.1 rebounds per game, which ranked 12th in the conference.

▶ She led the team with 1.2 blocks per game, which ranked third in the conference.

▶ She received Big South Honorable Mention last year.

## Aggies Picked 9th in CAA

▶ In the first season in Colonial Athletic Association, the Aggies were picked ninth out of 13 teams.

▶ The Aggies received 58 points and was picked ahead of two CAA newcomers of Hampton and Monmouth with 43 points each, UNC Wilmington with 28 points and Hofstra with 22 points.

▶ A&T trailed Northeastern with 70 points, William & Mary with 81 points and Delaware with 92 points.

▶ Drexel is expected to repeat as CAA championship and received 10 of the 12 first place votes with 142 points, followed by College of Charleston (125 points and one first place vote) and CAA newcomer Stony Brook (108 points).

▶ Last season, the Aggies finished sixth in the only season in the Big South.

### THE AGGIES DEFENSE

- ▶ The Aggies have prided themselves on being a strong defensive team since Tarrell Robinson became head coach in 2012.
- ▶ Last season, A&T ranked 83rd in the country with 8.9 steals per game and 106th with 259 steals.
- ▶ The Aggies also ranked 25th with 18.1 turnovers forced.
- ▶ Defense has been a staple of Robinson's teams. In his nine seasons, the Aggies have ranked in the top-50 in scoring defense seven times. Also, in his nine seasons, the Aggies have ranked in the top-50 nationally in field goal percentage defense six times.
- ▶ The Aggies have led the conference in scoring defense six times in Robinson's tenure, and they have led the conference in field goal percentage defense four times.
- ▶ In the 296 games he has coached as the Aggies head man, N.C. A&T opponents have scored 59 points or fewer 195 times. Opponents have shot less than 40 percent against Robinson's Aggies teams 189 times.
- ▶ Robinson's teams have only allowed opponents to score more than 80 points 14 times. The Aggies are 0-14 in those ballgames.

### THE BIG MOVE TO CAA

- ▶ After 50 years in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, Aggie Athletics will become a member of the Big South Conference starting in last fall.
- ▶ But this fall, the Aggies left the Big South after one season and entered the Colonial Athletic Association.
- ▶ Aggies women's basketball has been a part of the MEAC since 1982, winning five MEAC tournaments and winning 10 regular-season titles.
- ▶ They Aggies will join former MEAC member Hampton who left for the Big South four years ago and enters the CAA in their first season.
- ▶ In the past 14 seasons in the MEAC, the Aggies have won seven MEAC regular-season titles, they have finished second three times and have finished no lower than fourth only once in that span.
- ▶ Hampton was one of the Aggies biggest rivals in the MEAC. Hampton won five regular-season titles and six tournament titles before leaving for the Big South.
- ▶ Entering the CAA with the Aggies and Hampton is Stony Brook and Monmouth. Stony Brook comes from the American East, while the Monmouth comes from the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.

## ROBINSON'S AGGIE PRIDE

- ▶ North Carolina A&T head women's basketball coach Tarrell Robinson came to N.C. A&T in 1997 and the 43-year old has had success at the university ever since.
- ▶ Robinson spent four seasons playing on the men's basketball team where he led the team in rebounding as a junior. After graduating in 2001, he returned to A&T in 2003 to serve as a graduate assistant under Saudia Roundtree for the women's basketball program.
- ▶ Two years later he was hired as an assistant coach under the legendary Patricia Cage-Bibbs. Under Bibbs, the Aggies won three MEAC regular-season championships and one MEAC tournament title before Robinson left the program for VCU in 2010.
- ▶ He returned as the Aggies head coach in 2012 where he has put together five 20-win seasons, 175 wins, four MEAC regular-season titles, three MEAC tournament titles and two NCAA tournament titles. He also has the school's best winning percentage (.658)
- ▶ In total, in Robinson's 14 seasons with the A&T women's basketball program as both an assistant and head coach, the Aggies have won 306 games for an average of 22 wins per season. They have secured seven MEAC regular-season titles, four MEAC tournament titles and four NCAA tournament appearances.
- ▶ He has never been named conference coach of the year.
- ▶ Robinson is in his ninth season and is 175-91 (.658). He is 17 wins shy of becoming the school's all-time leader in wins, and he has posted an impressive 109-27 (.801) record against MEAC opponents without ever having a losing season in league play.



- ▶ Under Robinson, the Aggies have five 20-win seasons, three MEAC tournament titles and six postseason appearances.

## A&T IS THE SCHOOL OF CHAMPS

- ▶ The women's basketball team is not the only success story at A&T.
- ▶ A&T Athletics has had a string of championships over the past few seasons.
- ▶ The Aggies indoor track and field team has become one of the nation's best programs over the past five years. In 2019, Kayla White claimed the 200m indoor NCA national championship, and last week the Aggies 4x400-meter relay team featuring Randolph Ross Jr., Trevor Stewart, Elijah Young and Daniel Stokes won the NCAA national title by running a 3:03.16 for the fifth-fastest time in NCAA history.
- ▶ The Aggies bowling team is also nationally-ranked at No. 4 in the nation by the National Tenpin Coaches Association (NTCA).
- ▶ N.C. A&T's football team has won four out of the last five MEAC championships and Celebration Bowls.

## GREAT SCOTT

- ▶ Chanin Scott played three seasons at Georgia Tech.
- ▶ Before the 2019-20 season, she sustained a knee injury that forced her to miss the season which was shortened by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- ▶ Scott took her extra year of eligibility to attend N.C. A&T because she wanted to have the historically black university experience.
- ▶ In 98 games played as a Yellow Jacket, Scott averaged 5.6 points, 3.9 rebounds, 0.8 assists and 0.9 steals while shooting 46.2 percent from the floor.
- ▶ But she has meant the world to the Aggies during the 2020-21 season.
- ▶ Scott is a first-team All-MEAC performer and ranks in the top-5 in 11 different statistical categories in the conference.
- ▶ She is fourth in scoring (13.7), fifth in rebounding (8.7), third in shooting (.444), fifth in assists (3.5), fifth in free throw shooting (.791), second in steals (2.3), first in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4), second in offensive rebounding (3.7), fourth in defensive rebounding (5.1) and fourth in minutes played per game (31.1).

## HEAD COACH TARRELL ROBINSON

Tarrell Robinson is one of the most impactful figures in the history of Aggies basketball from his time as a men's player to his time as the associate head coach of the women's program to now his substantial status as the head coach of N.C. A&T women's basketball. He came to the N.C. A&T as an assistant in 2005 and since that point the women's program has produced seven Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference titles, four MEAC tournament titles, two MEAC Rookies of the Year (Ebony Ross, T'Wuana Cook) and a MEAC Player of the Year (Brittanie Taylor-James).

Robinson was named the sixth head coach in the history of the program on May 2, 2012. As head coach, he has won three of the last five MEAC tournament (2016, 2018, 2021) and four of the last six regular-season titles (2016, 2018, 2019, 2021). As he enters his 11th season, the Aggies have made six postseason appearances – three NCAA tournaments (2016, 2018, 2021) and three WNIT's (2013, 2014, 2019). Robinson has five 20-win seasons as the Aggies head man and his teams have finished lower than third place only twice during his tenure.

Robinson has compiled a 175-92 (.655) in 10 seasons and has the highest winning percentage in school history. The Aggies are also 89-23 (.795) at Corbett Sports Center and 109-29 (.790) against MEAC foes under Robinson. He is the only basketball coach in school history (men or women) to open their respective N.C. A&T tenure with three consecutive 20-win seasons.

Robinson's teams have also been stellar in the classroom. In 2015, it was announced the Aggies had a perfect single-year APR score of 1000. Five players on Robinson's 2015-16 team had already earned their undergraduate degrees. Four of those players pursued master's degrees. Center Alexus Lessears was named N.C. A&T's 2018 academic athlete of the year after posting a 4.0 for the 2017-18 school year.

Defense and sharing the basketball has also been a staple of Robinson's program. The Aggies have finished first twice in scoring defense and have finished no lower than fourth only once in Robinson's six seasons. Opponents are only averaging 56.9 points per game against N.C. A&T while being defeated by an average scoring margin of 5.9 points since Robinson became the head coach. The Aggies also have not finished lower than third in the conference in assists per game since 2013-14 season including leading the conference in 2015-16.

The program has also made some of its most significant historic achievements under Robinson. During the 2013-14 season, the Aggies got off to the best start in school history by going 7-1 as they finished the year 24-7. Also that season, the Aggies made history by becoming the first historically black college or university to win consecutive games in the preseason WNIT. Robinson was also selected to participate in The Center for Coaching Excellence presented by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA).

In his first season as head coach, Robinson inherited a talented team, including three players – Amber Calvin, Nikia Gorham and JaQuayla Berry – he recruited to the program. Robinson used that talent to win 22 games in his rookie season, which is more wins than any other first-year coach in program history. During the 2017-18 season, the Aggies went into their NCAA tournament game against South Carolina winners of 19 of their last 20 games a 4-7 start.

Robinson returned to N.C. A&T after spending three years as an assistant coach, recruiting coordinator and associate head coach at Virginia Commonwealth under head coach Beth Cunningham. Before his stint at VCU, Robinson spent four successful seasons at N.C. A&T under legendary head coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs. Robinson made a name for himself as a talented recruiter, having brought in highly-touted players to N.C. A&T and helping to lead the Aggies to consecutive MEAC regular-season championships starting in 2007.

Robinson coached four seasons under Bibbs. After a 9-19 season in 2005-06, Robinson assisted Bibbs in signing what turned out to be some of the best players in school history, starting with Fayetteville, N.C., native Ta'Wuana Cook. Cook went on to be the program's first MEAC Rookie of the Year, its second all-time leading scorer and its all-time leader in assists. He was also instrumental in signing two-time MEAC all-tournament performer Lamona Smalley and 2009 MEAC Player of the Year Brittanie Taylor-James. When Jaleesa Sams, who was ranked as high as No. 31 nationally by Scouts.com, signed to play at N.C. A&T in 2007, the women's basketball team had its most highly-touted recruit in history.

From 2007-09, Robinson and his recruits helped the Aggies compile a 51-15 record and their first MEAC tournament championship since 1994 when they took the title in 2009. The MEAC championship win earned the Aggies a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2009 as they were awarded a 14th seed, the highest seed for an HBCU team at the time. Cook, Sams, Taylor-James and JaQuayla Berry are all 1,000-point career scorers and all-conference performers. His tenure as an Aggie assistant also yielded 13 all-conference selections. He was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2008-09 season.

After leaving N.C. A&T for VCU, Robinson continued to excel as a recruiter. He was promoted to associate head coach in May 2011 at VCU after serving as the program's recruiting coordinator. He helped the Rams make three-consecutive postseason appearances from 2009-12. The Rams also made it to the third round of the WNIT in 2010 and 2012. He helped land back-to-back classes that ranked among the best in the Colonial Athletic Association including players that ranked among the Top 30 in their respective positions.

His 2011-12 class included the Ram's most highly-recruited player in center April McRae, who was named the 22nd-best post player in the nation by ESPN. McRae would go on to transfer to N.C. A&T where she was a two-time second-team All-MEAC selection under Robinson leading the Aggies to the 2016 MEAC title. In 2011, Robinson was recognized as one of the nation's top 25 Mid-Major women's basketball assistants by CollegelInsider.com. Robinson was also invited to the prestigious Nike Villa 7 Consortium in 2011 and 2012.
