**Friars Versus Miami:** The Friars have posted a 16-15 record all-time versus Miami, including a 2-1 mark at neutral site arenas. In the first meeting all-time, the Friars were defeated by the Hurricanes, 82-75, in Providence on December 8, 1962. In the most recent matchup, Providence defeated Miami, 76-62, on December 22, 2014 in Brooklyn, N.Y.

- \*The Friars are making their third appearance in the Hall of Fame Tip-Off (2014, champs; and 2019, 2nd place).
- \*The Friars have posted a 3-2 mark all-time at Mohegan Sun Arena.
- \*The Friars have posted a 104-71 (.594) mark all-time in in-season tournaments.
- \*Ed Cooley's 1-0 all-time versus Miami - 76-62 win in Brooklyn on Dec. 22, 2014.
- \*Miami Head Coach Jim Larranaga '71 averaged 16.3 ppg and 6.0 rpg over his three-year career at PC.
- \*PC is 69-28 (.711) under Ed Cooley in games decided by FIVE points or less since the 2013-14 season.
- \*The Friars were picked fifth of 11 teams in the Preseason BIG EAST Coaches Poll.
- \*Jared Bynum was selected Preseason First Team All-BIG EAST by the league's coaches.
- \*The Friars have eight newcomers to the roster this season.
- \*The Friars have three graduate students on the roster - Jared Bynum, Noah Locke and Clifton Moore.
- \*The Friars have 14 players on the roster and seven of those players came via a transfer.
- \*The Friars are 702-307 all-time versus New England opponents.
- \*With the win over Stonehill, PC improved to 82-5 all-time under Ed Cooley in non-conf. games at the AMP.
- \*The Friars won the BIG EAST regular season title for the FIRST time ever in 2022.
- \*The Friars made their 21st NCAA Tournament appearance and first since 2018 last season.
- \*The Friars advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2022 for the first time since 1997 (25 years).

- \*The Friars were 3-0 in overtime games in 2021-22.

**Friars' Third Appearance In Hall of Fame Tip-Off:** The Friars are making their third appearance all-time in the Hall of Fame Tip Off. On November 23, 2014, the Friars defeated Notre Dame (75-74) to capture the tournament title. On November 18, 2019, Providence was defeated by Michigan (66-47) in the championship game. The Friars have posted a 3-1 mark all time in the Hall of Fame Tip Off.

**Friars Defeat Stonehill:** The Providence College men's basketball team defeated Stonehill College, 100-76, on Tuesday, Nov. 15 at the Amica Mutual Pavilion in Providence, R.I. It marked the first meeting between the Friars and the Skyhawks in 43 years. With the win, the Friars improved to 3-0 this season. RS senior Ed Croswell (Philadelphia, Pa.), sophomore Bryce Hopkins (Oak Park, Ill.) and graduate student Clifton Moore (Ambler, Pa.) each recorded a game-high 16 points for the Friars. Croswell hauled in seven offensive rebounds. Six Friars finished in double figures in the game for the first time since Feb. 23, 2022.

**Fielder And Santoro Each Sign A NLI:** Providence College men's basketball Head Coach Ed Cooley announced on Nov. 16 that student-athletes Drew Fielder (Meridian, Idaho) and Donovan Santoro (Austin, Texas) each have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend Providence College beginning in September of 2023. Both players attend Southern California Academy in Castaic, Calif., where they play for head coaches Julius Von Hanzlik and Chris Chaney. Fielder, a 6-foot-10-inch, 215-pound center is rated as a four-star recruit. He transferred to Southern California Academy after beginning his high school career in Idaho. Over the summer, Fielder had a strong showing at the Under Armour Association showcase in July. He averaged 10.7 points, 8.5 rebounds, 1.2 assists and 1.2 steals in six games at the UAA. He also shot 47.6 percent from the field, 38.5 percent from three and 71.4 percent from the free-throw line. Fielder is rated as the No. 23 center in the nation in the class of 2023, according to 247Sports.com. Santoro, a 6-foot-8-inch, 185-pound forward transferred to Southern California Academy after playing at Westlake High School in Austin, Texas. Last season, he helped Westlake post a 38-2 mark and advance to the Texas High School Semifinals. His squad recorded a 14-0 record in its district. For his efforts, Santoro earned second team All-District honors.

**Bynum Named Preseason All-BIG EAST First Team:** It was announced on October 18 that Providence College graduate guard Jared Bynum (Largo, Md.) was named to the 2022-23 Preseason All-BIG EAST First Team. Bynum, who earned 2022 All-BIG EAST Second Team accolades, was named recipient of the BIG EAST Sixth Man Award and received USBWA All-District 1 accolades, had a break out season for the Friars in 2021-22. He led the team in scoring in BIG EAST games, averaging 15.6 ppg in 17 games. His 15.6 points per game ranked fifth in the league. He shot a team-best 46.5 percent (33-71) from behind the three-point arc in league play. Bynum also ranked third in the league in assists per game (4.9) in BIG EAST action. In overall action, he averaged 12.2 ppg and 4.0 assists per game. He was named BIG EAST Player of the Week twice. He scored a career-high 32 points in the Friars' win at Georgetown on February 6. He was 7-8 from three-point territory and 11-15 from the field. He came off the bench in 14 of the team's 17 league games and became the first BIG EAST player in 25 years with three games of 25 or more points off the bench in the same season. In addition to the 32 points at Georgetown, he also had 25 points versus DePaul on February 12 and 27 points versus Xavier on February 23.

**Ed Cooley Inducted Into The RIIL Hall Of Fame:** On October 26, 2022, Ed Cooley was inducted into the Rhode Island Interscholastic League High School Athletic Hall of Fame. The Rhode Island League High School Athletic Hall of Fame is dedicated to preserving the tradition of high school athletics in Rhode Island and seeks to highlight the past in order to insure a promising future for Rhode Island high school athletics. Inductees exemplify the highest standard of sportsmanship, ethical and moral character and were considered on the merits of their contributions and achievements to high school athletics. Cooley, who grew up in Providence, attended Central High School in the City. He played basketball at Central High School and he was a two-time Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honoree.

**Friars Sign Two Through Team IMPACT:** Providence College men's basketball Head Coach Ed Cooley announced two new team members, signing 13-year-old twin brothers Brody and Brennan Smith through Team IMPACT. Brody and Brennan, who were both diagnosed with a genetic disorder, were officially introduced at a signing day press conference on Saturday, October 22 at the Ruane Friar Development Center. They will participate in many activities with the team including games, practices, and other team events. Team IMPACT, a national non-profit organization, has developed a unique multi-year program that matches children facing serious illness and disability with college athletic teams across the country. Based on a clinical model, Team IMPACT guides a symbiotic relationship between teams and children focused on socialization, empowerment, and resilience.

**Friars Have Eight Newcomers Join The Roster:** After the Friars posted a 27-6 mark, captured the BIG EAST Regular Season title and advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2022, the team had all five starters graduate. The team returns three players, graduate student Jared Bynum (Largo, Md.), senior Ed Croswell (Philadelphia, Pa.) and junior Alyn Breed (Powder Springs, Ga.), who saw action last season. The squad welcomes eight new players to the lineup - freshman Jayden Pierre (Elizabeth, N.J.), freshman Quante Berry (Cleveland,

**How The Friars Got To The NCAA Tournament In 2022:** The Friars earned an at-large bid as a four seed to their 21st NCAA Tournament overall and sixth in 11 years under Head Coach Ed Cooley. Providence posted a 27-6 mark and a 14-3 record in BIG EAST play. The Friars won the BIG EAST Regular-Season Title for the first time in the 43-year history of the league. Providence entered the NCAA Tournament with a NET Ranking of **32**. The Friars defeated South Dakota State (66-57) in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament on March 17 and Richmond (79-51) in the Second Round to advance to the Sweet 16. The Friars held Richmond to 51 points. It marked the fewest points allowed by the Friars in the NCAA Tournament all-time. The Friars made their first appearance in the Sweet 16 since 1997 and their sixth appearance overall. The team was defeated by No. 3/3 Kansas (1 seed), 66-61, on March 25 in the Midwest Regional.

**Friars All-Time In The NCAA Tourney:** The Friars made their 21st appearance all-time in the NCAA Tournament in 2022. It was the Friars' sixth trip to the NCAA Tournament under Head Coach Ed Cooley (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2022). The Friars have posted a 17-22 mark all-time in NCAA Tournament play. The team has made two trips to the Final Four (1973 and 1987), four appearances in the Elite Eight (1965, 1973, 1987 and 1997) and six trips to the Sweet Sixteen (1965, 1973, 1974, 1987, 1997 and 2022).

**Friars Earn Highest Seed All-Time In The NCAA Tournament:** Providence's No. 4 seed was the highest in program history since the tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985. The Friars' highest seed prior to the 2022 tournament was a No. 5 seed in 2004.

**Head Coach Ed Cooley Breaks Dave Gavitt's Mark Of Five Friar NCAA Tournament Appearances:** The Friars made their sixth appearance in the NCAA Tournament under Head Coach Ed Cooley in 2022. With the 2022 appearance, Cooley eclipsed former Friar Head Coach Dave Gavitt's mark of five tournament appearances - which was the most for any Friar head coach all-time. Other former Friar head coaches who reached the NCAA Tournament are Joe Mullaney (three NCAA appearances), Rick Pitino (one NCAA appearance), Rick Barnes (three NCAA appearances), Pete Gillen (one NCAA appearance), and Tim Welsh (two NCAA appearances).

**Ed Cooley Captures 2022 Naismith Coach Of The Year Award:** It was announced on April 3 that Providence's Ed Cooley was named the recipient of the Werner Ladder Naismith Coach Of The Year Award. Cooley is the first Friar coach to earn the prestigious honor. He also is the first Friar coach to earn national coach of the year accolades since Rick Pitino earned NABC Coach of the Year in 1987.

**Watson And Bynum Named 2022 All-BIG EAST Second Team:** It was announced on March 6 that center Nate Watson (Portsmouth, Va.) and guard Jared Bynum (Largo, Md.) each earned 2022 All-BIG EAST Second Team honors. It marked the second consecutive year that the Friars had two players earn all-league honors as Watson and David Duke received Second Team accolades in 2021.

**Bynum Earns 2022 BIG EAST Sixth Man Award:** It was announced on March 7 that Providence guard Jared Bynum (Largo, Md.) earned the 2022 BIG EAST Sixth Man Award. Bynum became the first Friar to earn the honor.

**Cooley Named 2022 BIG EAST Coach Of The Year:** It was announced on March 9 at Madison Square Garden in New York that Providence's Ed Cooley was named BIG EAST Coach Of The Year. Cooley, who became the first Friar coach in the 43-year history of the league to earn the honor, guided the Friars to a 27-6 mark. In BIG EAST league play, the Friars set a team record for wins after registering a 14-3 mark and capturing the program's first BIG EAST Regular Season title. The Friars, who finished in first place, were picked to finish seventh in the annual BIG EAST Preseason Coaches' Poll which was released in October.

**Ed Cooley Gets The Key To The City:** Providence Mayor Jorge O. Elorza joined Former Rhode Island State Senator Harold Metts, Providence Public Schools Superintendent Dr. Javier Montañez and Providence Public School District students to present a Key to the City to Providence College Men's Basketball Coach Ed Cooley on May 17. Cooley led Providence College to the 2022 NCAA

Cooley was named Werner Ladder Naismith Coach of the Year and BIG EAST Coach of the Year. He is the first Friar coach to win either award. His Friars also won the BIG EAST Regular Season title - the first time ever for a Providence men's basketball team. Cooley, who grew up in Providence, attended Central High School in the City. He played basketball at Central High School and he was a two-time Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honoree.

**Friars In Overtime:** The Friars recorded a 3-0 record in overtime games in 2022. On February 23, the Friars defeated Xavier, 99-92, in triple overtime. They have registered a 71-67 mark all-time in overtime games.

**Friars Finished Season Ranked No. 13/13 In The Nation:** The Providence College men's basketball team was ranked No. 13 in the FINAL Associated Press Poll (March 14) and No. 13 in the FINAL Coaches Poll (April 5). The Friars, who entered the polls on December 20 at No. 22/23, were ranked for 13-consecutive weeks heading into the First Round of the NCAA Tournament. The Friars final ranking of No. 13 is the highest the team has been ranked at the conclusion of the season since the 1986-87 squad was ranked No. 6 at the end of the season.

**After Nine Years, Friars Have Fourth Best Record In BIG EAST Action:** Since the formation of the new BIG EAST, the Friars have posted the fourth best mark in league play over the last nine years. The Friars' 93-69 mark (.574) trails only Villanova's 130-31 record (.808), UConn's 24-12 record (.667) and Creighton's 95-70 record (.576).

**Providence College Basketball:** The 2022-23 campaign marks the 96th season of basketball at Providence College. Since the program started in 1926-27, Providence has posted a **1,525-1,015** mark, good for a .600 winning percentage. The Friars have made the NCAA Tournament 21 times and the National Invitation Tournament on 20 occasions.

**Friars Earn 20 Wins For The First Time Since 2018:** With the Friars' 71-52 win at Georgetown on February 6, the team posted its 20th victory of the season. It marked the first time the team earned 20 wins in a season since 2017-18 and the sixth time under Ed Cooley (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2022). It also marked, the 28th time the Friars won 20 or more games in a season. In 2022, the Friars registered 27 victories, which is the most wins by the Friars under Ed Cooley and tied for second most all-time for the program.

**Steve Napolillo Named Athletic Director:** It was announced on January 26, 2022 that Steve Napolillo would be the 11th athletic director in the history of Providence College. On July 1, Napolillo replaced Bob Driscoll, who announced his retirement on January 21. Napolillo, who was the senior associate athletic director/assistant vice president for external relations, has worked at the College since 2004.

**Ed Cooley Ranks Second On The PC All-Time Win List:** With the Friars' win versus Butler on January 23, 2022, Ed Cooley recorded his 210th victory as the Friar Head Coach and moved into second place on the all-time win list for PC Head Coaches. The top three all-time winningest Friar head coaches are: Joe Mullaney (319-164), Ed Cooley (**224-141**, 11 seasons) and Dave Gavitt (209-84).

**Friars All-Time Versus Top-25 Teams:** The Friars have posted a 127-274 (.317) mark all-time versus top-25 teams, including a 4-3 mark last season.

**Friars At The Amica Mutual Pavilion:** All-time, the Friars have recorded a 606-236 (.720) mark in 50 seasons of games at the Amica Mutual Pavilion. The AMP, formerly the Providence Civic Center and the Dunkin' Donuts Center, opened on November 3, 1972. The Friars had played their home games there for 48 consecutive seasons, prior to the 2020-21 season when the team played on campus at Alumni Hall with no fans in attendance due to the pandemic. PC posted a 16-1 mark at the AMP in 2021-22, the team's best record at home since 1973-74.

**Friars Are 82-5 In Non-Conference Home Games Under Ed Cooley:** The Friars have posted an 82-5 mark (.943) in 12 seasons under Ed Cooley in non-conference home games.



On March 22, 2011, Ed Cooley became the 15th head coach at Providence College. He came to Providence College after spending five seasons as the head coach at Fairfield University.

In 12 seasons at Providence College, Cooley has posted a 224-141 mark, which includes six trips to the NCAA Tournament, a berth in the Sweet 16 (2022), a BIG EAST Regular Season Title (2022) and a BIG EAST Tournament Title (2014). In 2022, he was named the recipient of the Naismith Coach of the Year, the Sporting News Coach of the Year, the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, the NABC District 5 Coach of the Year and the USBWA District 1 Coach of the Year. He is the only Friar head coach to be named the BIG EAST Coach of the Year.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Cooley has a 316-210 record. When Cooley was hired in 2011, the Friars had finished under .500 in six of the 10 previous seasons and had been to just one NCAA Tournament (2004) in that 10-year span. Since his hiring, Cooley has led the Friars to eight post-season tournament berths (seven consecutive from 2013-19) (2019-20 there was no post-season due to the Covid-19 pandemic), including a school-record six NCAA Tournament appearances (2014-18 and 2022). In 2022, he guided the team to the NCAA Sweet 16 and the program's first BIG EAST regular season title. In 2014, he led the team to the BIG EAST Tournament title.

Cooley reached new heights in 2021-22. His team registered a 27-6 mark to log the second most wins in team history. The team also recorded a program best 14-3 BIG EAST record and captured its first-ever BIG EAST Regular Season Title despite being picked seventh in the Preseason Coaches' Poll. The squad also earned the top seed in the history of the program when it was selected as a 4 seed for the NCAA Tournament. The Friars posted wins in the First and Second Rounds of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time in 25 years (1997) and the sixth time in the history of the program. Graduate student Nate Watson and junior Jared Bynum earned Second Team All-BIG EAST honors. Bynum also became the first Friar to receive the BIG EAST 6th Man Award.

The 2020-21 squad posted a 13-13 mark and a 9-10 record in BIG EAST play. The team was led by Nate Watson and David Duke. Both players earned Second Team All-BIG EAST accolades. Duke also was named Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America.

In 2019-20, the Friars had the best mid-season improvement of any Division I team as the squad improved from 6-6 to finish the year with a 19-12 mark - a NET ranking improvement of 119 spots (156 to 37). The team posted a 12-6 record in BIG EAST action and finished in fourth place. The 12 league wins was the most ever by a Friar squad. In addition, the Friars defeated every BIG EAST team at least once - another first for the program. The Friars finished the season winning six consecutive games and eight of the last 10. Five of those wins occurred in February over ranked teams, which marked just the fifth time in the history of college basketball that a team posted five wins over ranked squads in a calendar month during the regular season.

In August of 2019, Cooley served as the Head Coach of Team USA at the Pan Am Games in Lima, Peru. His squad was a group of BIG EAST All-Stars, including Alpha Diallo, Nate Watson, David Duke and AJ Reeves. Despite having the youngest team at the tournament, Cooley led the squad to a Bronze Medal.

In 2018-19, Providence advanced to its seventh consecutive post season when the Friars were selected to the NIT as a four seed. It marked the first time that PC advanced to seven straight post-seasons since Dave Gavitt's Friars accomplished the feat from 1971-78. The 2019 Friars finished the season with an 18-16 mark.

The 2017-18 season, proved to be another successful season for the Friars under Cooley as the squad made its team record fifth consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament and produced another season with 20 or more wins (21-14). It marked the first time the Friars recorded five consecutive seasons with 20 or more wins since 1974-78. Providence finished tied for third in league standings with a 10-8 mark. The team had another strong performance at the BIG EAST Tournament, advancing to the championship game where the squad nearly knocked off eventual national champion Villanova before losing in overtime. One of the highlights for the squad was earning three wins over top-5 ranked teams. It marked the first time ever that the Friars accomplished that feat.

In 2016-17, the Friars were picked ninth in the Preseason BIG EAST Coaches' Poll after losing stars Kris Dunn and Ben Bentil to the NBA Draft. However, the Friars finished the year with a 10-8 mark in league play and in third place in the conference standings. To achieve that mark, the team overcame a 4-8 record in early February and won its final six BIG EAST Conference games to earn the third place finish. The Friars also posted a 20-13 record overall and earned an at-large berth to the squad's fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament. In recognition of his efforts, Cooley was named NABC District 5 Coach of the Year.

Juniors Kyron Cartwright and Rodney Bullock were named 2017 Second Team All-BIG EAST. In addition, Cartwright became the third player in six seasons under Cooley to earn BIG EAST Most Improved accolades.

During his time at Providence, Cooley has coached five All-Americans. He also has had players earn two BIG EAST Player of Year honors, two BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year accolades, three BIG EAST Most Improved Player awards, one BIG EAST Tournament MVP, five BIG EAST All-Tournament Team accolades, two BIG EAST All-Rookie Team awards, one BIG EAST Sportsmanship honor and 10 All-BIG EAST honors.

In 2016, Cooley led the Friars to a 24-11 mark and a 10-8 record (fourth) in the BIG EAST. After finishing fourth in league standings for the third straight season, Providence advanced to the BIG EAST Semifinals for the third-consecutive year, which has only occurred one other time in the history of Friar basketball. Most importantly, the Friars earned their third-consecutive berth in the NCAA Tournament, where the team registered a 1-1 mark, which included a First Round win over Southern California. It marked just the third time in the history of Friar basketball that the team reached the NCAA Tournament in three consecutive seasons. The squad also recorded 24 wins, which is the most since the 1996-97 season. With 24 wins, the Friars posted their third-consecutive season with 20 or more victories. Another milestone for the Friars was that they finished the regular season with 22 wins, which was the most since 1978 and just the sixth team all-time at PC to accomplish the feat. Cooley's Friars also were ranked for 13 weeks during the season, including a No. 8 national ranking on January 4. It marked the Friars' highest ranking in the Associated Press Poll since March 1, 1977 when the team was ranked No. 8.

Two of Cooley's players earned significant honors in 2015-16 and were both drafted as junior guard Kris Dunn and sophomore Ben Bentil earned All-BIG EAST

accolades. Dunn also earned his second-consecutive BIG EAST Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year honors. He also earned numerous All-America accolades and was named a Consensus All-American. Bentil became the seventh Friar all-time and the third under Cooley to lead the BIG EAST in scoring, averaging 22.9 points per game. For his efforts, he was named BIG EAST Most Improved Player - the second time a Friar has received the honor in Cooley's five seasons at Providence.

Dunn was the fifth pick overall by the Minnesota Timberwolves and became the fourth highest Friar drafted all-time in the history of the NBA. Bentil was selected 51st overall in the second round by the Boston Celtics.

In 2015, the Friars were picked fifth in the Preseason BIG EAST Coaches Poll. The team exceeded expectations when the squad placed fourth with an 11-7 record. It marked just the third time ever and the first time since 2004 that the Friars registered 11 conference wins. Overall, the squad posted a 22-12 mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 1988-89 and 1989-90 seasons. The team also posted its second consecutive season with 20 or more wins for the first time since 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

Senior LaDontae Henton and sophomore Kris Dunn paced the Friars in 2015. Both players earned First Team All-BIG EAST honors and Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America accolades. Dunn, who led the BIG EAST in assists, ranked third in the nation in assists and fifth in the nation in steals. He was named the 2015 BIG EAST Player of the Year and he also earned BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year accolades. Dunn became the first guard in the history of the league to win both honors in the same year. Henton, who led the BIG EAST in scoring in 2015 (20.1 ppg), finished his career ranked second all-time in scoring at Providence (2,059 points) and fifth all-time in rebounding (1,054). He is just the second player ever at Providence to score more than 2,000 points and grab more than 1,000 rebounds.

Cooley's 2014 team was picked to finish sixth in the Preseason BIG EAST Coaches Poll, but overcame losses of personnel during the season to finish 10-8 and fourth overall. The Friars went on a run in the league tournament, posting three straight wins, including a thrilling 65-58 victory over No. 14 Creighton in title game. With the win, the Friars earned the league's automatic berth in the NCAA Tournament and made their first trip to the Tournament since 2004.

His 2014 squad was led by senior All-American Bryce Cotton. Cotton had an amazing senior season in which he led the BIG EAST in assists (5.8) and finished second in scoring (21.8). He also led the nation in minutes played (39.9). He earned BIG EAST Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors and garnered his second consecutive First Team All-BIG EAST accolade. He finished his career ranked fifth overall in scoring at Providence with 1,975 points. His teammate, senior Kadeem Batts (Boston, Mass.) also was recognized for his stellar play as he was named All-BIG EAST Second Team.

It did not take long for Cooley to turn the Friar fortunes around. In his second season, he led the Friars to a 19-15 record overall and a 9-9 mark in league play. Included in the 9-9 BIG EAST record in 2012-13 was a 7-2 mark over the last nine games of the conference season. That impressive record marked the second best turnaround over the second half of the season in BIG EAST history. He then guided the Friars to the NIT where the squad posted a 2-0 record before losing in the quarterfinals to eventual NIT Champion Baylor.

Leading the way for the Friars in the 2012-13 season were Cotton and Batts. Cotton was named All-BIG EAST First Team after he led the league in scoring. His teammate, Batts was recognized as a co-winner of the league's Most Improved Award and earned All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention accolades.

In his first season at Providence, Cooley led the Friars to a 15-17 mark overall. The team posted an impressive 11-3 mark in non-conference action, which included an 8-0 record at home. In league action, the Friars defeated No. 14/15 Louisville, 90-59. The 31-point win marked the Friars' largest margin of victory ever over a ranked team.

Two of Cooley's players earned BIG EAST honors in his first season. Point guard Vincent Council was named All-BIG EAST Third Team and one of his first recruits, forward LaDontae Henton, earned BIG EAST All-Rookie Team accolades.

In addition to coaching the Pan Am Games team in 2019, Cooley has extensive experience with USA Basketball. In 2013, he served as a court coach during the USA U19 Training Camp for the World Championships. In 2014, Cooley served as an assistant coach for the USA U18 Team which captured a Gold Medal at the FIBA Americas Championship. He was an assistant coach for the USA U19 Team at the World Championships in Greece in 2015. Cooley helped the team win a Gold Medal, his second in as many years.

Prior to coming to Providence, Cooley guided Fairfield to a school-record 25 wins and a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular season title in 2010-11. He was named the 2011 MAAC Coach of the Year. He also earned United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District I Coach of the Year honors. His 2011 squad finished the season with a 25-8 mark (15-3 MAAC) and advanced to the second round of the NIT.

In five seasons at Fairfield, Cooley's teams posted a 92-69 mark, including a 58-32 record in MAAC action. Cooley became the first Fairfield head coach to guide the team to a .500 or better mark in MAAC action in each of his first five seasons. In 2009-10, he led the Stags to a 23-11 mark and the team's first post-season berth since 2003. For his efforts in 2010, Cooley was the first recipient of the Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority men's basketball coach in the nation. Prior to taking the Fairfield position, Cooley spent 10 seasons as an assistant coach for Al Skinner. He coached for one season at Rhode Island under Skinner (1996-97) and nine seasons as an assistant at Boston College (1997-06), where the Eagles posted a 175-108 mark and advanced to five NCAA Tournaments and one NIT. Cooley also helped lead the Eagles to the 2001 BIG EAST Tournament title and three BIG EAST regular season titles (2001, 2003 and 2005). In 2004-05, Boston College started the season with a school-record 20 consecutive wins. In 2005-06, the Eagles advanced to the Atlantic Coast Conference championship game against Duke. At BC, Cooley was instrumental in the recruitment of Troy Bell, a two-time BIG EAST Player of the Year. Bell also went on to play professional basketball after leaving Boston College, which included a stint in the NBA with the Memphis Grizzlies.

A 1994 graduate of Stonehill College, he was a three-time captain for the basketball team and was inducted into its Athletic Hall of Fame in 2019. Cooley began his coaching career at UMass-Dartmouth. He helped lead UMass-Dartmouth to a 25-4 mark and a No. 3 national ranking (1994-95). He returned to his alma mater, Stonehill, and served as an assistant coach for one season (1995-96) before joining Skinner's staff at URI. Cooley, a native of Providence, attended Central High School and earned two Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honors. In 2022, he was inducted into the Rhode Island Interscholastic League High School Hall of Fame. He also did a post-graduate year (1988-89) at New Hampton Prep. before attending Stonehill. He and his wife, Nurys, have one daughter, Olivia, and one son, Isaiah.
