#### NEED TO KNOW

- Duke entertains No. 17 Miami for a Saturday matinee at Cameron Indoor Stadium on ESPN in what will be the 500th consecutive sellout at the historic venue.
- The 500-game sellout streak dates back to the 1990-91 season and is an all-time NCAA record (per Yahoo Sports). Duke is 453-46 (.908) at Cameron Indoor during the streak.
- Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the sixth straight week, Miami is the third of three straight games for Duke versus teams that entered the game in first or second place in the ACC. Duke is looking to rebound after letting a second-half lead slip at first-place Clemson last
- Saturday -- a game in which Duke led by eight in the second half, limited the hot-shooting Tigers to just 3-of-17 from three and held Hunter Tyson and Chase Hunter to 12 total points.
- Freshman Kyle Filipowski, who was named ACC Rookie of the Week for a league-leading fifth time, poured in 46 points and grabbed 29 rebounds last week -- including a monster 28-15 effort vs. Pitt to become just the third Duke freshman all-time with at least 28-15 in a game.
- Filipowski is fifth in the ACC, 32nd nationally and leads all power conference freshmen in rebounds (9.2). His eight double-doubles are sixth in the ACC and lead all Division-I freshmen.
- Stepping up to handle point guard duties in place of junior starting guard **Jeremy Roach**, who has missed the last three games with a toe injury, freshman Tyrese Proctor scored a careerhigh 17 points at Clemson on the heels of 14 points, five assists and no turnovers vs. Pitt.
- Duke has out-rebounded 14 of its first 18 opponents and is 12-2 this season when holding an advantage on the glass. Duke is 10-2 when leading in offensive rebounding.
- The ACC's best rebounding team, Duke ranks fourth nationally in rebound margin (+9.0), 11th in offensive rebounds (13.7) and 19th in rebounds per game (39.8) -- leading the conference in each category. Duke has not finished as the ACC's team leader in rebounds since 1998-99.
- Duke, Tennessee and Alabama are the nation's only teams ranked inside the NCAA's top 20 for each rehound margin, offensive rehounds and total rehounds.
- Duke has held 16 of 18 teams below their season scoring average, ranking second in the ACC and 39th nationally in scoring defense (63.4) and 16th nationally in three-point defense (.284).

- » Miami enters Saturday's game ranked No. 17 in the AP Poll at 15-3 overall and 6-2 in the ACC.
- » Of the teams' shared opponents in ACC play, Miami has a win over Boston College and split with NC State.
- » This is the first of two meetings between Duke and Miami over the next 16 days -- Duke is in Coral Gables for a Big Monday showdown on Feb. 6.
- » Duke leads the all-time series 23-9, but the teams have split their ACC regular-season meetings, 5-5.
- » Duke's last two losses in the series have been two-point decisions -- 76-74 in Durham on Jan. 8, 2022 and 77-75 at Miami in on Feb. 1, 2021.
- » Miami won in Durham last season, 76-74, behind 18 points and seven steals by Charlie Moore as the Hurricanes racked up 15 steals and forced 17 Duke turnovers.
- » Duke won in the ACC Tournament semifinals last year, 80-76, thanks to 21 points from AJ Griffin and limiting the Hurricanes to just six steals.

- » The Hokies fell 78-68 at No.10 Virginia on Wednesday and travel to No.19 Clemson Saturday before Monday's game with Duke.
- » VT has lost six straight, including one in overtime, by a combined 34 points entering Saturday's game at Clemson.
- » Sean Pedulla's 16.4 points leads the Hokies in scoring, while Grant Basile (13.8) and Justyn Mutts (13.4) are the others averaging in double figures.

#### **DUKE GAME NOTES**

#### Scheyer In First Season as Head Coach

- » Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain **Jon Scheyer** is the 20th head coach in Duke's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.
- » The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic*'s 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.
- » He has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.
- » As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. Over his previous nine years on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).
- » The Northbrook, III., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign. Duke announced its five-man 2023-24 class this week, which includes five top-50 players and is currently ranked as the No. 2 class by ESPN and 247Sports.
- » Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in 10 seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
- » Among Scheyer's personnel moves in June were the hiring of Jai Lucas as an assistant coach and the promotion of Amile Jefferson to assistant coach. Scheyer also added Mike Schrage as special assistant to the head coach and Rachel Baker as general manager.

#### Cameron Indoor Stadium's 500th Consecutive Sellout is Saturday

- » Duke has sold out 499 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium -- the all-time NCAA record per Yahoo -- with the next home game against Miami on Jan. 21 is slated to be the 500th consecutive sellout.
- » The last time Duke played before a non-sold out crowd at Cameron was Nov. 16, 1990 against Boston College -- 11,754 days (as of Jan. 21, 2023).
- » The sellout figure is the longest current streak (by time) in either men's college basketball or the NBA.
- » Duke's record at Cameron during the sellout streak is 453-46.

#### The Blue Devils Have Won Nearly 85% of Games at Cameron Indoor Stadium

- » Duke has posted an all-time record of 939-171 (.846) at Cameron Indoor, that included a 572-76 (.883) record under Coach K.
- » Duke has won more games at its current home venue than any team in college basketball.
- » Cameron celebrated its 83rd birthday on January 6 as the home of the Blue Devils.
- » Duke has averaged 11.1 wins since the venue opened January 6, 1940 -- a 36-27 win over Princeton.
- » The Blue Devils have 18 undefeated home seasons.
- » This season, Duke is 9-0 at home, averaging 80.2 points and winning by an average margin of 22.5 points.

#### Filipowski's Big Week Leads to Fifth ACC Weekly Honor

- » Áfter averaging 23.5 points and 14.5 rebounds in two games this past week, **Kyle Filipowski** was named the ACC Rookie of the Week in men's basketball for the fifth time this season.
- » Filipowski had a monster outing in Duke's comeback win over Pitt on Jan. 11, scoring a career-high 28 points on 8-of-14 shooting and 11-of-13 from the free throw line, while matching his career-high with 15 rebounds.
- » He is now just the third Duke freshmen all-time to have at least 28-15 in a game, joining Marvin Bagley III who did it four times in 2017-18 and Jabari Parker, who did it once in 2013-14.
- » Flip is just the 13th player in Division-I to have at least 28-15 in a game this season (seventh power conference player) and the only freshman nationally to do so.
- » Saturday at Clemson, Filipowski scored 18 points and grabbed 14 rebounds, both team-highs, for his eighth double-double.
- » Over Duke's last four games which has included three road games Filipowski is averaging 18.8 points and 11.5 rebounds and shooting .417 in that stretch.
- » His eight double-doubles are top-15 nationally and lead all Division-I freshmen, while his 9.2 rebounds per game are fifth in the ACC and the most by a power conference freshman.
- » The Westtown, N.Y., native also leads Duke in scoring (14.8) and steals (15). He has scored in double-figures in 16 of Duke's 18 games played this season, and has been the team's leading scorer nine times.
- » Filipowski's honor marks Duke's ACC-leading 151st all-time Rookie of the Week selection. Over the last 10 seasons (since the start of 2013-14), Duke has had an ACC Rookie of the Week in 79 of a possible 163 weeks (48.4%). Twenty-two different Blue Devils have won the award at least once in that time. The Blue Devils' 151 all-time Rookie of the Week awards lead the ACC by 54.
- » Filipowski became the ACC's first player to open a season with four straight Rookie of the Week honors.

#### Duke is No. 4 in Offensive Rebounding Percentage; Top 20 in Overall Rebounding

- » Duke has been among the nation's best rebounding teams this season, ranking fourth nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (38.8), fourth nationally in rebound margin (+9.4), 11th in offensive rebounds per game (13.7) and 19th in total rebounds per game (39.8) leads the ACC in each category.
- » Duke, Tennessee and Alabama are the nation's only teams ranked inside the top 20 for each rebound margin, offensive rebounds and total rebounds.
- » Leading the ACC in rebounding, Duke is looking to finish as the conference's leader in total rebounds per game for the first time since 1998-99.
- » The Blue Devils have out-rebounded 14 of their first 18 opponents, including nine by double-digit margins. Duke opened the season with a double-digit rebound margin in each of the first six games -- the program record for longest such streak (at any point in a season). Duke had five-game streaks in 2017-18, 1998-98, 1962-63 and 1960-61.
- » Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Duke is 44-6 when out-rebounding its opponent (12-2 this season).
- » Offensive rebounding has been a significant strength, with Duke totaling 20+ on the offensive glass four times already -- the Blue Devils hadn't had more than 19 offensive boards in any game over each of the last two seasons.
- » Duke is +96 (235-139) in second-chance scoring this season and Duke is 9-3 in games this season when leading in second-chance scoring.
- » Individually, freshman **Kyle Filipowski** is 32nd nationally and fifth in the ACC in rebounds (9.2) and leads all power conference freshmen. Graduate **Ryan Young** is 41st nationally (fourth in the ACC) in offensive rebounds (3.1) and is ranked No. 16 nationally in KenPom in offensive rebound percentage (16.1).

## Blue Devils Allowing 63.4 Points -- Second in ACC and 39th Nationally in Scoring Defense; First in ACC, 16th Nationally in Three-Point Defense

- » Duke is second in the ACC and 39th nationally in scoring defense, yielding just 63.4 points per game. Thirteen of the first 18 opponents have been held to less than 70 points, while seven have failed to score more than 60.
- » Duke has held 16 of the 18 opponents to below their season scoring average -- Duke is 13-3 in those games. Six scored their then-season low for points, including holding lowa to a then-season-low 62 and Xavier to 64 (20 points below its average).
- » Duke's strong defensive numbers come against a schedule rated 23rd-toughest versus opponent offenses (per KenPom).
- » Ten opponents this season have failed to top 30 percent from behind the arc, as Duke leads the ACC and is 16th nationally in three-point defense (.284).

#### **Bounce-Back Ability**

- » Duke is 26-3 following a loss since the 2016-17 season, not dropping consecutive games since 2019-20 -- not including the 2020-21 COVID season.
- » Over the last 25 seasons, Duke has lost by 20+ points in the regular season just six times, and is undefeated in the game to follow -- including the Jan. 7th win at Boston College.

#### **DUKE GAME NOTES**

#### **Duke's Three-Point Streak**

- » Duke has connected on at least one three-pointer in 1,171 straight games, the second-longest streak nationally.
- It has been more than 30 years since Duke was held without a three-point field goal -- Dec. 30, 1989, versus Hawai'i.

#### A Season for Charity

- » Duke is 13th nationally and second in the ACC in free throw percentage, hitting .783 from the charity stripe. The Blue Devils have 10 games this season shooting .800+ at the free throw line -- each of the 10 have come over the last 16.
- Duke has made 53 of its last 64 (.828) at the stripe over the last three games.
- Individually, eight different Blue Devils are converting .700+ at the line.
- Graduate Jacob Grandison has made each of his nine attempts this season, while freshman Darig Whitehead has converted 12-of-13 (.923) and freshman Tyrese Proctor has made 37-of-42 (881)
- Graduate Ryan Young had a streak of 19 consecutive free throws snapped at NC State -- the team's longest streak this season (Proctor hit 17 straight earlier). Young is 35-of-42 (.833).
- In the last five minutes of games, Duke is 51-of-61 (.836) -- including going 5-of-6 in the final five minutes at BC -- a game Duke won, 65-64.
- Grandison is 8-of-8 at the line in the final five minutes of game this season, with Proctor going 12-of-14 and Filipowski 9-of-11.

#### Duke Storms Back to Beat Pitt; Out-Rebounds Panthers 51-28

- » Duke trailed Pitt by 11 at the half, 43-32 -- a deficit that grew to 12 in the second half -- before out-scoring Pitt, 45-26, after halftime and winning, 77-69, at Cameron Indoor on Jan. 11.
- It marked Duke's largest halftime deficit overcome in a win since coming from 12 points down vs. Texas, 43-31, on Nov. 24, 2017, to win 85-78 at the PK80 in Portland.
- Duke yielded 43 points in the first half and held the Panthers to 26 in the second half, the 17-point difference from first to second half marking the team's best since a difference of 19 versus Virginia Tech (41-22) on Dec. 6, 2019.
- Duke held a 51-28 rebounding advantage, including a 24-9 edge in offensive rebounds. It marked the 13th time in 17 games that Duke out-rebounded an opponent, including the ninth time by double figures.
- » Duke's +23 rebound margin was its highest in an ACC game since 47-24 (+23) vs. Florida State on Jan. 25, 2014.
- Duke recorded 20+ offensive rebounds for the fourth time this season Duke hadn't had a game with more than 19 offensive in any game over the previous two seasons.

- Duke was 23-of-27 (.852) at the free throw line, marking the 10th time this season Duke has shot .800+ at the line.

#### Freshmen Clutch for Blue Devils in Pitt Win....

- During Duke's 15-0 run in the second half that flipped an eight-point Pitt lead (52-44) to a seven-point Duke advantage (59-52) -- all 15 points came from freshmen -- six from Filipowski, four from Mark Mitchell, three from Tyrese Proctor and two from Dereck Lively II.
- Proctor finished with 14 points (nine in the second half), was 5-of-5 at the free throw line and totaled five assists and no turnovers in 27 minutes.
- Mitchell scored 10 points (eight in the second half) and grabbed a career-high nine rebounds while going 6-of-6 at the free throw line.
- After Pitt closed the gap to 71-67 in game's final 1:49, Duke sealed it with Proctor's jumper and 2-of-2 free throws each from Proctor and Mitchell.

#### ... And at Boston College

- Filipowski and Mitchell made the winning plays late, as Duke rallied from a point down in the game's final 28 seconds to win, 65-64, at Boston College on Jan. 7.
- Filipowski finished with 15 points, nine rebounds and three blocks to match his career high while Mitchell scored 14 points with six rebounds and a career-high three blocks.
- The pair combined were 11-of-12 at the free throw line as Duke was 17-of-19 as a team from the line.
- Filipowski's jumper with 1:42 left gave Duke a 63-59 lead, and following a three-pointer from BC that cut the lead to one, Flip came up with a crucial steal on the Eagles' ensuing possession to preserve Duke's lead.
- After BC seized its first lead of the game with 28 seconds left, 64-63, Filipowski grabbed an offensive rebound, was fouled and canned what proved to be game-winning free throws with 16 seconds left for a 65-64 lead.
- Mitchell nailed a pair of free throws with 2:20 left that gave the Blue Devils a 61-57 lead and his chase-down block of Jaeden Zackery with 38 seconds allowed Duke to maintain its 63-62 lead.

#### **Duke's Depth is the Difference Maker**

- » Seven different players have led the team in scoring over the last 12 games -- after Kyle Filipowski was the leading scorer in five of the first six.
- Graduate Ryan Young's 20-point. 12-rebound effort off the bench led Duke vs. Florida State on Dec. 31, while sophomore Jaylen Blakes' careerhigh 17 points off the bench at Wake Forest on Dec. 20 marked the first time in his career he led Duke in scoring. - Head coach Jon Scheyer has utilized five different starting lineups this season as Duke has navigated injury issues, including playing four games (and each of the last three) without starting point guard **Jeremy Roach** with a lingering toe injury.
- Stepping up to handle point guard duties in place of junior starting guard Jeremy Roach, who has missed the last three games with a toe injury, freshman Tyrese Proctor scored a career-high 17 points at Clemson on the heels of 14 points, five assists and no turnovers vs. Pitt.

#### Blue Devils Out-Dunking Teams 56-24

- » Duke has opened the season out-dunking the opposition 56-24, led by Dereck Lively II's 22 and Mark Mitchell's 17 slams.
- » Lively is 27-of-45 from the field with 22 of his first 27 career field goals being dunks.

#### Duke's Social Presence Soars in 2022

- » Duke continues to set the standard in college sports in the social media space and is coming off a year of record-setting growth in the 2022 calendar year.
- The Blue Devils continue to have the most followers of any collegiate team nationally across all DukeMBB platforms with 5.16 million, topping Alabama Football's 3.65 million for most collegiately.
