PACK TRACKS

- The Pack won its second consecutive game and fifth in its last six outings as NC State won at Virginia Tech, 73-69, on Saturday night.
- NC State never trailed in the contest, jumping out to a 13-2 lead and took a 36-22 advantage into halftime. The Pack turned away multiple comeback attempts by the Hokies, including a last minute 15-6 run that brought Virginia Tech within two, 71-69, with seven seconds remaining, but Terquavion Smith knocked down two free throws with six seconds to play to clinch the win.
- Terquavion Smith led NC State in scoring for the third consecutive game, finishing with 22 points against the Hokies. The Greenville, N.C., native hit two early three-pointers to help NC State jump out to a 13-2 lead and then closed the game for the Pack, scoring seven points in the final 1:12 of the game to secure the win.
- Smith was joined in double figures against the Hokies by Jarkel Joiner (21), Casey Morsell (15) and DJ Burns (10). Greg Gantt only scored one point, but grabbed a career-high tying nine rebounds.
- Graduate guard Jarkel Joiner was terrific last week in two wins for NC State. He scored 21 points, knocking down five three-pointers while also grabbing six rebounds and passing out a career-high nine assists (with no turnovers) in the win over 16th-ranked Duke. He followed up that performance with 21 points and grabbed a season-best eight rebounds in the win at Virginia Tech. For the week, Joiner averaged 21 points, 7.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.5 steals (and had zero turnovers in 64 minutes played).

SATURDAY STORYLINES

■ Saturday's game will be the Pack's third this season against a ranked opponent (beat #16 Duke on Jan. 4, 84-60, at PNC Arena and lost on Nov. 23 to #3 Kansas, 80-74, in the first round of the Battle 4 Atlantis in Paradise Island, Bahamas). Now in his sixth season with NC State, head coach Kevin Keatts has led the Pack to 10 wins over ranked opponents. NC State has a 7-8 record in home games against ranked teams under Keatts.

■ NC State has not trailed in 2023: The Pack is 2-0 in 2023 and hasn't trailed in either game. NC State jumped out to a 15-0 lead on 16th-ranked Duke on Jan. 4, eventually leading by as many as 29 points in an 84-60 win. At Virginia Tech on Jan. 7, NC State ran out to a 13-2 lead and took a 36-22 lead into the break before holding on for a 73-69 win over the Hokies. In the earlier meeting against Miami, NC State led by 16 points in the first half and had a nine-point advantage at the break, but the Canes battled back to win the game. It's the only game this season that NC State has lost when it has had a halftime lead. The Pack is 12-1 when it leads after 20 minutes.

■ Defense Setting the Tone: NC State's defense has helped the Pack jump out double-digit halftime leads in the last two outings. NC State held Duke to 29 percent shooting and Virginia Tech to 37 percent shooting in the opening 20 minutes as it held both teams to 22 first half points. Overall in the last two games, NC State has limited opponents to 33 percent shooting (16-of-48), including 21 percent from three-point range (3-of-14) in the opening 20 minutes.

■ Saturday will mark the 50th career game at NC State for sophomore guard Terquavion Smith. The Greenville, N.C., native is averaging 17.1 points for his career which ranks as the eighth-highest career scoring average in program history. In 49 career games, Smith has scored in double figures 40 times, including 19 games of 20 or more points. He has led NC State in scoring 20 times in his career, including the last three games heading into Saturday's game against the Hurricanes. But Smith is more than a scorer, he has also led the Pack in assists and steals 20 times in his career. Smith is leading this year's NC State team in scoring, assists and steals.

■ Smith and Joiner Having Career Years in Sharing the Ball: The Pack's two lead guards - Jarkel Joiner and Terquavion Smith - have both already passed out more assists this season than either had last season. Smith leads the ACC and ranks fourth in the ACC with an average of 4.9 assists per game. Smith already has 82 assists this season in 17 games. Last season, he had 67 assists in 32 games. Joiner has 60 assists in 17 games to rank 15th in the ACC in assists at 3.5 per game. Joiner is playing in his fifth collegiate season, but this 60 assists this season are already the most he's ever had in a single season. The Oxford, Miss., native ranks fourth in the ACC with a 2.31 assist-to-turnover ratio. Joiner has played 100 total minutes in the last three games and has zero turnovers (14 assists in that span).

■ DJ Burns stepping in Mahorcic's absence: In the six games since Dusan Mahorcic was injured, graduate forward DJ Burns is averaging 13.3 points per game and 5.3 rebounds (including 2.4 offensive rebounds) per game. Burns is shooting 60.9 percent from the field (39-of-64).

■ NC State leads the ACC in turnover margin (+4.0), steals (8.9 per game) and forcing turnovers (14.8 per game). The Pack is 8-0 this season when it forces its opponent into 15 or more turnovers and 9-0 when it has at least 18 points off of opponent turnovers. In the Pack's four losses, its opponents are only averaging 10 turnovers per game and NC State is only averaging 10.5 points off of opponent turnovers.

■ NC State and Miami rank second and third in the ACC in scoring. The Pack averages 79.4 points per game while the Canes average 78.0 points per game.

■ NC State is 13-2 this season if it scores 70 or more points, but 0-2 if it scores under 70. Miami is one of two games this season that NC State has lost when it scored over 70 points.

■ Pack has held its own on the boards: NC State has outrebounded its opponent in 12 of 17 games this season (NC State only outrebounded its opponent in 10 of 32 games last season). In the four games it has been outrebounded, Kansas, Coppin State and Clemson only edged NC State by one rebound and Miami finished +4 in rebounding in its win. NC State tied Louisville in rebounding. NC State is 12-1 when it ties or wins the rebounding battle, but is just 1-3 when it is outrebounded. The Pack ranks third in the ACC in rebounding margin at +3.94. It finished 14th in the ACC last season in rebounding margin at -2.8.

NC STATE - MIAMI SERIES

■ Saturday will be the 29th all-time meeting between the two programs.

■ The all-time series is tied at 14. Miami has a 14-13 advantage in games played since the Hurricanes joined the ACC prior to the 2004-05 season.

■ Miami has a three-game winning streak in the series, including an 80-73 win earlier this season (12/10/22) at the Watsco Center. NC State led 31-15 in the first half and had a nine-point advantage at the break, 43-34, over the Hurricanes. Miami outscored NC State, 18-6, to end the game to win going away. The Pack led for 32:06 of game time in the loss. Jarkel Joiner led NC State with 26 points on 10-of-16 shooting while Terquavion Smith added 19 points and a team-high seven assists.

PACK ADDS MIDSEASON ENROLLEE, ISAIAH MIRANDA

■ NC State added a consensus four-star prospect to the roster when Isaiah Miranda joined NC State. Miranda's first official practice with the Pack was Thursday, Dec. 15.

■ Miranda was originally a Class of 2023 prospect, but decided to reclassify and join NC State. He is a consensus four-star recruit and top-60 player in Class of 2022. He's ranked the No. 30 overall prospect in the country by Rivals, No. 40 by On3, No. 47 by 247Sports and No. 55 by ESPN.

JACK CLARK OUT INDEFINITELY

■ NC State lost a second starter when Jack Clark was ruled out indefinitely with a core muscle injury. Clark suffered the injury at the end of the Pack's game against Clemson on Dec. 30. Clark started the first 15 games for NC State. At the time of his injury, he was leading the team in rebounding (7.3) and steals (1.9). He ranked 10th in the ACC in rebounding and was second in steals. Clark also contributed 9.1 points per game and had hit 18 three-pointers.

DUSAN MAHORCIC OUT INDEFINITELY

■ Graduate forward Dusan Mahorcic suffered a dislocated right patella in Tuesday's win over Coppin State. He will have surgery and is out indefinitely. Mahorcic started nine of 10 games for the Pack this season and is averaging 8.7 points and 6.6 rebounds per game. His 64.3 percent field goal shooting leads the team and his 26 offensive rebounds were the most on the team and eighth-most in the ACC at the time of his injury.

REPLACE THE LEADING SCORER? NOTHING NEW FOR KEATTS

■ NC State lost its leading scorer from the previous season as Dereon Seabron and his team-best 17.3 points per game is now in the NBA. The loss of the previous season's leading scorer is nothing new for Keatts though, since he became head coach of the Pack in the spring of 2017 he has to replace the team's leading scorer each season.

■ As a program, NC State has not had a player repeat as scoring leader since C.J. Leslie led the team in scoring in the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons.

■ One small caveat, while Dereon Seabron did lead the team in scoring last season at 17.3 points per game, Terquavion Smith led the team in scoring in ACC games. The freshman averaged 18.3 points per game in 20 conference games last season while Seabron averaged 16.0 points per game in league competition.

TERQUAVION SMITH NAMED TO FIRST-TEAM PRESEASON ALL-ACC

■ NC State sophomore guard Terquavion Smith received 46 votes, the fourth-most of any ACC player, to make the preseason All-ACC First Team.
 ■ Smith averaged 16.3 points per game last season and led the ACC with 96 three-pointers made. He upped his scoring average to 18.3 points in ACC-only contests last season to rank second in the conference in scoring in league contests.
 ■ The Greenville, N.C., native is the first NC State player to make the preseason All-ACC First Team since C.J. Leslie was named Preseason ACC Player of the Year prior to the 2012-13 season.

PACK PICKED 10TH IN THE PRESEASON ACC POLL

■ NC State was picked to finish 10th in the preseason ACC poll that was released a week after the league's annual ACC Tipoff Event. It's the second-worst preseason slot for the Pack in the Kevin Keatts era, but hope is not lost. The only other time NC State was picked in double digits in the preseason poll under Keatts was in 2017-18. That season, the Pack was selected 12th in the preseason poll, but went 11-7 in the ACC and finished in a tie for third place.

PACK GOT OLD

■ After last season ended, Kevin Keatts knew one thing immediately that he wanted to change about next year's team ... he wanted to get older. The Pack went out and did that. NC State signed four transfers, all who are college graduates. DJ Burns (Winthrop), Jack Clark (La Salle), Jarkel Joiner (Ole Miss) and Dusan Mahorcic (Utah) all transferred to NC State in the offseason. Last season, the Pack's eight player rotation for a majority of the season was six underclassmen and just two veterans in junior Casey Morsell and senior Jericole Hellem. The Pack's starting lineup in its final game of last season consisted on a senior, junior, two sophomores and a freshman. In NC State's exhibition contest on Wednesday, the Pack's starting lineup was three graduate transfers (Clark, Joiner, Mahorcic), a senior (Morsell) and a sophomore (Smith).

NO SHORTAGE OF SCORERS

■ NC State only returned one double-digit scorer from last season's team (Terquavion Smith - 16.3 ppg.), but added three players in DJ Burns (15.0 ppg., at Winthrop), Jack Clark (12.0 ppg., at La Salle) and Jarkel Joiner (13.2 ppg., at Ole Miss) who averaged double digits in scoring last season.
 ■ The Pack is one of four ACC teams that has four players on its team that averaged double figures last season. Miami, Boston College and Virginia also have four players that averaged in double-digits last season.

FOUR 30-POINT SCORERS

■ 30-point games are notable enough that NC State lists every 30-point performance in the program's history in the media guide. This year the Pack has four players that have scored 30 or points in a game in their career.
 - Terquavion Smith had two 30-point performances last season; 34 at UNC (1/29/22) and 30 at Florida State (3/5/22).
 - DJ Burns scored 30 points last season against Mary Baldwin (11/9/21)
 - Jack Clark scored 30 points last season vs. Duquesne (3/5/22)
 - Jarkel Joiner scored 34 points while a member of the CSU Bakersfield team against
 ■ NC State and Miami are the only teams in the ACC that have four players that have had 30-point performances in their career.

IMPORTANCE OF A DEEP BENCH

■ Injuries last season robbed the Pack of one of its biggest advantages NC State has enjoyed during the Kevin Keatts era ... scoring off the bench. Keatts first four teams at NC State all averaged over 20 points off the bench, but that number dropped to just 12.7 points per game last season. Coming into last season, NC State had outscored the opponent's bench by 850 points in the first four seasons under Keatts. Last season, NC State's bench was outscored by 231 points.

■ Kevin Keatts teams have accounted for 11 of top-21 NC State bench scoring performances since 1999-2000 season, including the top-3. (see chart to left for best bench performances under Keatts).

PACK HAS BEEN ONE OF ACC'S BEST UNDER KEATTS IN TURNOVER MARGIN

■ In five seasons with Kevin Keatts, NC State has finished second three times, third place once and fourth place once in the ACC in turnover margin. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin in 2018-19. Last season, despite its record, NC State still finished in second place in the conference in turnover margin at +2.66. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 87-43 (66.9%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 16-28 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ In the first two seasons under Kevin Keatts, the Pack led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers and ranked second in the ACC in Keatts fourth season. In his third and fifth seasons, the Pack ranked fifth in forcing opponent turnovers. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. In 2018-19, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 57-19 (75.0%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

TERQUAVION SMITH SHOOTING PROWESS

- Terquavion Smith enters his sophomore season as one of the top three-point shooters in college basketball.
- He led the ACC in three-pointers per game last season at 3.0 per game, knocking down 96 in 32 games. He was one of just three power conference players in the NCAA to average three or more three-pointers per game last season. His 96 three-pointers were the second-most by a freshman in NCAA DI last season.
- Smith became the first ACC player to lead the league in three-pointers made as a freshman since Duke's J.J. Redick led the conference in the 2002-03 season.
- Smith upped his shooting in league play, hitting 73 three-pointers in 20 ACC regular season games, an average of 3.65 made threes per game. Smith hit 13 more three-pointers in ACC play than second place Buddy Boeheim of Syracuse.
- Smith's 96 three-pointers are the third-most in a single-season in program history.

SMITH ... THE PASSER?

- After putting his name in the NBA Draft after last season, one of the things scouts told him they wanted to see was Smith's ability to create for others. The Greenville, N.C., native has shown that ability in the preseason. Smith had seven assists in the Pack's secret scrimmage against Davidson on Oct. 22 and passed out six assists against Lees-McRae in the exhibition contest on Nov. 2. Smith's best assist game last season with six at Pitt.

BREON PASS PRIMED TO BREAK THROUGH

- Many coaches have said that a player makes their biggest improvement from their freshman to sophomore seasons. The thinking behind that is they've now spent a year in a collegiate program and have been around older players that have shown and taught them what it takes to be successful in a college program. In Breon Pass' case, this past year marked the first time in his life that he was solely focused on basketball.
- Pass was a two-sport start at Reidsville (N.C.) high school. He was a four-star recruit in both basketball and football and had numerous Power-5 offers to play wide receiver in college. He was named the 2021 N.C. High School Athletic Association Male Athlete of the Year for his prowess in both sports.
- Pass played his last official football game on May 8, 2021 when he caught five passes for 88 yards and two touchdowns to be named Most Outstanding Offensive Player as he helped lead Reidsville to the 2A State Championship.
- Since May 8, 2021, it has been all basketball for Pass. He appeared in just 25 games and averaged 2.2 points last season, but Pass has shown significant improvement in the offseason and has set himself up to likely be the first guard off the bench for NC State.

GANTT AND ROSS HEALTHY FOR THE PACK

- It was a tough season last year for two frontcourt players that figure to have big roles for the Pack frontcourt this season.
- After two years at Providence, Greg Gantt transferred to NC State in the summer of 2021, but the Fayetteville, N.C., native could never get healthy and missed the entire 2021-22 season with injury.
- Ernest Ross was a freshman last season, who was coming on in early January, he played pivotal minutes late in the Pack's road wins at Virginia Tech and at Louisville, but was lost for the season with a broken ankle he suffered between the Pack's win at Louisville and its game at Duke.
- The duo is back though and both showed flashes of what they can be in the Pack's exhibition win over Lees-McRae on Nov. 2. Gantt had two dunks while Ross scored 12 points on 6-of-7 shooting and added seven rebounds, including five offensive boards.

NEW FACES ON THE BENCH

- NC State head coach Kevin Keatts has an entirely new coaching staff on the bench with him this season. The Pack replaced all three assistant coaches from last season.
- Levi Watkins: The former Pack player and staff member returned to NC State this offseason as an assistant coach. Watkins played at NC State from 2001-05 and immediately joined the coaching staff at the conclusion of his career. He was a video coordinator for three years and director of operations for four years at NC State before leaving the Pack to become an assistant coach at Buffalo, Arizona State and Ole Miss.
- Kareem Richardson: The former Kansas City head coach is the only assistant coach that has worked with Keatts before. Richardson and Keatts were both assistant coaches at Louisville for the 2012-13 season. Richardson was the head coach at Kansas City from 2013-19 and was an assistant coach at Clemson last season.
- Joel Justus: The North Carolina native joined the Pack in June as an assistant coach. Justus grew up in Winston-Salem and played collegiately for UNCW. A long-time assistant coach at Kentucky, Justus comes to NC State after one season as an assistant coach at Arizona State.

PACK TO HONOR 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF 83 CHAMPIONSHIP

- NC State will honor the 40th anniversary of the 1983 National Championship team throughout the 2022-23 men's basketball season.
- The Pack will wear special Adidas 1983 throwback uniforms for NC State's annual Heritage Game at Reynolds Coliseum on Tuesday, Dec. 6 against Coppin State and on Wednesday, Feb. 22 when the Pack hosts Wake Forest at PNC Arena. The game in February against Wake Forest will serve as a reunion for the members of the 1983 championship team. The Feb. 22 date was chosen by members of the 1983 team as it allowed the most former players to be able to attend.
