Two teams tied for second in the ACC standings match up when Syracuse plays at #16/15 Miami on Jan. 16.

The Syracuse-Miami Series

- ✓ Syracuse has a 20-11 lead in the all-time series with Miami.
- ✓ The Hurricanes have captured the last two pairings, including a 75-72 victory in the Dome in March 2022.
- ✓ The two programs have maintained a rivalry in the BIG EAST Conference and now the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Syracuse Notes

- ✓ The Orange are winners of nine-of-11 contests after coming from behind to defeat Notre Dame, 78-73.
- ✓ Freshman forward **Chris Bell** is coming off a season-best 17-point showing.
- ✓ Senior center **Jesse Edwards** (13.3 ppg., 11.0 rpg.) is averaging a double-double.
- ✓ Freshman forward **Maliq Brown** is averaging 9.0 points and 6.8 rebounds in four January games.

Miami Notes

- ✓ Two of Miami's three defeats have come in its last three contests -- 76-70 at Georgia Tech and 83-81 in overtime at NC State.
- ✓ Coach Jim Larranaga is fourth among active Division I coaches in games (1,188).
- ✓ Sophomore forward **Norchad Omier** leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.617) and ranks third in rebound average (9.9).
- ✓ Junior guard **Isaiah Wong (17.2)** is Miami's top scorer.

- ✓ **Chris Bell** had a career-best 17 points and **Jesse Edwards** totaled 13 points and 15 rebounds. **Maliq Brown** added a season-high 15 points and seven rebounds.
- ✓ **Jan. 11:** **Joseph Girard III** (24 points) led five players in double digits and the Orange defeated Virginia Tech, 82-72.
- ✓ **Maliq Brown** posted his first collegiate double-double (11 points, career-high 12 rebounds) and **Jesse Edwards** totaled 13 points, nine rebounds and six assists.
- ✓ **Jan. 7:** #11 Virginia constructed a 23-point advantage and held off a late Syracuse rally to defeat the Orange, 73-66.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard III** tallied 14 of his 19 points in the second half, **Judah Mintz** had 18 points and **Maliq Brown** contributed 10 points and eight rebounds. **Jesse Edwards** grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds.
- ✓ **Jan. 3:** **Joseph Girard III** scored 28 points, including two free throws with 17 seconds left, to help Syracuse win at Louisville, 70-69. Girard added a season-high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals in 40 minutes of work.
- ✓ **Jesse Edwards** produced his seventh double-double (12 points-11 rebounds) of the season and **Judah Mintz** had 16 points.
- ✓ **Jan. 1:** **Judah Mintz** was named the ACC Rookie of the Week for the third time. Mintz was recognized after contributing 18 points, seven assists, three rebounds and two steals in Syracuse's victory against Boston College.

- ✓ **Dec. 31: Joseph Girard III** had a game-high 24 points and Syracuse defeated Boston College for the ninth straight time, 79-65.
- ✓ **Benny Williams** had his second career double-double (16 points-11 rebounds) and **Judah Mintz** contributed 18 points and six assists against the Eagles.
- ✓ **Dec. 20:** Syracuse rallied from a 20-point, second-half deficit to pull within one but could not convert the game winner in an 84-82 loss to Pittsburgh.
- ✓ **Judah Mintz** tied his career-best with 24 points and had five boards and five steals.
- ✓ **Dec. 19: Judah Mintz** was named the ACC Rookie of the Week. Mintz averaged 19.0 points, 4.5 assists and 3.5 steals in wins against Monmouth and Cornell.
- ✓ **Dec. 17:** The Orange broke open a 45-43 contest with 12 unanswered points and went on to defeat Cornell, 78-63.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard III** had 19 points and **Jesse Edwards** contributed his sixth double-double (11 points-12 rebounds) of the campaign.
- ✓ **Dec. 12:** Syracuse had five players score in double digits and the Orange defeated Monmouth, 86-71. **Judah Mintz** led the way with a career-high 24 points.

- ✓ **Jesse Edwards** contributed 12 points and 10 rebounds for his fifth double-double. Joseph Girard III (16 points), Benny Williams (13) and Maliq Brown (11) rounded out the double-digit point-getters.
- ✓ **Dec. 12:** Judah Mintz was named the ACC Rookie of the Week for the first time. He averaged 13.0 points, 7.5 assists and 3.0 steals per game in Syracuse victories against Oakland and Georgetown.
- ✓ **Dec. 10: Jesse Edwards** (20 points-11 rebounds) and **Judah Mintz** (16 points-10 assists) posted double-doubles and the Orange defeated Georgetown, 83-64.
- ✓ It was the 98th Syracuse vs. Hoya contest.
- ✓ **Dec. 6: Jesse Edwards** (18) and **Joseph Girard III** (18) led five players in double digits and SU defeated Oakland, 95-66.

Boeheim, Pearl First Two Men's Basketball Stars on Ring Of Honor

Jim Boeheim and **Dwayne "Pearl" Washington** -- two of the most prominent names in Syracuse history -- were formally recognized as members of the Syracuse University Athletics Ring of Honor in the JMA Wireless Dome on Dec. 10. The ceremony was held at halftime of the Georgetown game..

Boeheim has been associated with the Syracuse program since enrolling at the school in 1962. He began as a walk-on player and by his senior season he was a captain on an NCAA Tournament team.

Boeheim's coaching career started at his alma mater, as a graduate assistant coach for Roy Danforth in 1969. Boeheim was promoted to an assistant coach and in 1976 was hired to be the head coach.

Boeheim is in his 47th season at the Orange helm. He is the winningest active coach in Division I. Boeheim also ranks second in NCAA Tournament appearances (35 seasons) and 20-win seasons (34) and is fourth in NCAA Tournament victories (57).

He has guided the Orange into the NCAA Final Four five times and led Syracuse to the 2003 NCAA Championship.

In 2005, Boeheim was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and received the John R. Wooden "Legends of Coaching" Award the following April.

A standout point guard on three of head coach Jim Boeheim's teams of the mid-1980s, Washington established a lasting legacy during a collegiate career in which he tallied 1,490 career points, a total that still ranks 27th on the school's list. He led the Orange in assists and steal in all three of his seasons and ranks fourth in career assists and fifth in career steals.

He helped the Orange earn NCAA Tournament berths each year. Washington received All-America recognition in all three seasons. He was a consensus All-America following his third year, which included second team United Press International and third team Association Press laurels. He was named first team All-BIG EAST Conference three times and was the 1984 BIG EAST Freshman of the Year. He earned BIG EAST Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player in 1986.

After foregoing his final collegiate year of eligibility to enter the NBA Draft, Washington was the 13th overall selection by the New Jersey Nets. Following two campaigns with the Nets, he was selected by Miami in the 1988 Expansion Draft and spent one season with the Heat.


On March 2, 1996, Washington's jersey was retired in a ceremony at the Dome. He was the third Syracuse player to receive the honor, following Dave Bing and Vic Hanson into the Dome's rafters. Washington passed away in April 2016.

McNamara, Warrick To Have Jerseys Retired

Gerry McNamara and **Hakim Warrick**, two of the key players on Syracuse's 2003 NCAA Championship squad, are scheduled to have their jerseys retired at the JMA Wireless Dome on Saturday, March 4, 2023. A ceremony will be conducted at the Syracuse vs. Wake Forest game that closes out the Orange basketball regular season.

McNamara and Warrick currently sit next to each other on the Syracuse career points list, at fourth (2,099) and fifth (2,073). They represent two of the six Syracuse players who accumulated 2,000 points in their collegiate careers.

Warrick arrive at Syracuse one year before McNamara, in 2001. By the time his four seasons were up, Warrick had taken over the fourth spot in career rebounds (1,025) with the Orange. Some of his Warrick's other career highlights included:

- ✓ 2004-05 BIG EAST Conference Player of the Year
- ✓ 2004-05 BIG EAST Conference Tournament Champion

McNamara joined the program in Warrick's sophomore season, 2002-03. He was an immediate starter on the team that won the 2003 NCAA Championship. McNamara played on four NCAA Tournament clubs at Syracuse. He is the all-time leader in season (107) and career (400) 3-point field goals, and career minutes played (4,799).






