## KEY STORYLINES

### LAST TIME

- **ELISE CONTINUES TO SHINE:** The Deacs were led in the score column by Williams who was helped by a big night at the free throw line. The Raleigh, N.C. native netted 5-of-6 at the charity stripe and the sophomore is now shooting nearly 80 percent from the free throw line this season. Williams recorded her 10th double-figure scoring game of the season. This is the fifth consecutive for the sophomore guard and five of her 10 double-figure games have come in conference play this season. She also led the way in the assist column, totaling three helpers.
- **DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE:** The Fighting Irish came into the game with nearly five players averaging double-figure points. The Demon Deacons limited just two of Notre Dame's double-figure scorers to double digits Thursday night.

### FEAR THE SPEAR

- **1,000:** With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Spear moved into 25th on the all-time scoring list against Clemson passing former Wake Forest guard Ariel Stephenson (2015-19). Additionally, Spear passed Nicole Levesque (1991-94) for third on the all-time three-point list against Duke.
- **FROM BEHIND THE ARC:** Through 17 games played, she has averaged 15.2 points per game and ranks 16th in the nation with 47 three-point makes and her 2.76 makes per game is 32nd.
- **CONSISTENT SCORER:** Spear has netted 259 total points in her first 17 games this season.

### SERIES HISTORY

- **ALL-TIME VS MIAMI:** This marks the 26th time in program history that the two schools will play each other with the Demon Deacons owning a 10-15 mark against the Hurricanes.
- **LAST TIME AGAINST MIAMI:** The Demon Deacons split the season series with the Hurricanes a season ago earning a 47-46 victory (Jan. 6, 2022), before suffering a 66-59 loss 21 days later (Jan. 27, 2022). In the victory on Jan. 6, Wake Forest used a 25-5 run in the first and second quarters to build an insurmountable lead and held Miami to under 50 points defensively for the contest. Jewel Spear lead the Deacs, finishing the night with a game-high 15 points while also adding a pair of rebounds and a block shot to her statline. Forward Olivia Summiel tallied a team-high nine rebounds.
- **A WIN WOULD:** Mark the Deacs' first road ACC win of the 2022-23 campaign.

FAST BREAK

FEAR THE SPEAR

- Jewel Spear was named a Preseason All-ACC selection and Wooden Award Watch List member heading into the 2022-23 season. This comes on the heels of being named a First Team All-ACC selection as a sophomore and both to the ACC All-Freshman Team and the ACC All-Tournament Team in 2020-21.
- With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Spear moved into 25th on the all-time scoring list against Clemson passing former Wake Forest guard Ariel Stephenson (2015-19). Additionally, against Duke, Spear passed Nicole Levesque (1991-94) for third on the all-time three-point list.
- Through 17 games played, she has averaged 15.2 points per game and ranks 16th in the nation with 47 three-point makes and her 2.76 makes per game is 32nd.
- Last season, Spear became just the fifth player in Wake Forest program history to earn first team honors, joining Ivana Raca (2020-21), Dearica Hamby (2013-14, 2014-15), Tracy Connor (1995-96) and Jen Hoover (Mitchell) (1989-90). Additionally, it marked just the second time in program history the Demon Deacons have had First Team All-ACC members in back-to-back seasons.
- A product of The Colony, Texas, Spear finished last season as the ACC leading scorer with 18.3 points per game. She became the first sophomore leading scorer in the conference since Alyssa Thomas did it a decade ago at Maryland in 2011-12. Additionally, it was just the third time in the last 20 seasons as the only other sophomore to lead the conference in scoring during that time was Alana Beard for Duke in 2001-02.
- Since stepping onto campus, Spear has been one of the best shooters in program history. She went into her junior season sixth in program history with 148 career three-point makes in just 56 career games. Last season, Spear finished second in single-season threes, trailing Cotelia Bond-Young (2004-05) by just seven makes
- A year ago, Spear had one of the great performances in program history against ETSU on Dec. 13, netting 40 points, the second best mark in school history while also breaking the program record with 10 three-point makes.
- Spear went for 30-plus three times last season and 20-plus 10 times.
- Her rookie campaign was the best in program history from behind the arc. Spear holds the Wake Forest freshman record with 2.32 three-point makes per game. Additionally, her career mark of 40.0 percent shooting from behind the line is the best mark in program history.
- During her freshman campaign, Spear was named to the 2021 ACC All-Freshman Team, ACC All-Academic Team and ACC All-Tournament Team.

SPECIAL GAME AT MINNESOTA

- Junior guard Jewel Spear had a historic game against Minnesota, becoming the first player since Dearica Hamby in the 2013-14 season to record a double-double with 19-plus points in a road win over a Power-5 program. Additionally, Spear's performance marked the fifth such game since the start of the 2009-10 season:

- During Spear's 540 minutes played this season, the Demon Deacons are +109 when she is on the court.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

- Through 18 games this season, the Demon Deacons have done a stellar job of holding their opponents down in shooting. Wake

Forest has held their opponents to just 37.1 percent shooting from the field and just 28.6 percent shooting from behind the arc. The opponent shooting percentage ranks 65th in the nation and the Deacs also rank 61st with 4.2 blocks per game. The Deacs achieve a block on 10.2 percent of possessions this season, the third-highest rate in the Her Hoops Stats era (2009-10 to present).

- Over the last 13 games, the Demon Deacons have been playing their best defense of the season, holding 11 of 13 opponents to 61 points or less and six opponents in that stretch to less than 55 points. Over the last five ACC games, Wake Forest has forced 16.6 turnovers including 20 in the win over Pitt and 19 against Duke.
- Over six games during the month of December, the Deacs limited opponents to just 51.8 points per game with opposing teams shooting just 32.6 percent from the field and just 23.5 percent from behind the arc. In three games, the Deacs held opponents to 51 points or fewer including the ACC home opener against Pitt.
- In the win over Pitt, Elise Summiel finished the game with a career-best six steals and led the Demon Deacons to a season best effort in that category as Wake Forest ended the game with 11 total steals and 20 forced turnovers, resulting in 17 points off turnovers.

LIV BLOCKS EVERYTHING

- Senior forward Olivia Summiel displayed her versatility against Clemson as the Dayville, Conn. native tallied 11 points, eight rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block. She led the Demon Deacons in rebounds, assists, steals and blocks.
- This marked the first time since Ivana Raca on Nov. 20, 2020 in a win over Missouri State that a Demon Deacon has had that many points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks in a single game. Raca finished her game with 23 points, nine rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block.
- Summiel recorded another block against Georgia Tech Sunday. She now ranks 30th nationally with 29 blocks on the season and her total already is the most by a Demon Deacon since the 2018-19 season when Ona Udoh had 41 blocks for the season.
- Her 1.66 blocks per game also rank third in the ACC and 48th nationally.
- As a team, the Deacs have blocked 4.2 shots per game which is close to a school record and ranks 61st nationally. The school record was set in 2010-11 when that squad averaged 4.3 blocks per game.

TEAMWORK

- As a team, Wake Forest recorded 23 assists on 30 made baskets (76.7 percent) against Longwood, which marked the most assists the Demon Deacons have recorded in a game since Nov. 8, 2019 against College of Charleston. The Deacs were led with a career-high tying eight assists from Elise Williams.
- This season, the Demon Deacons have tallied 256 assists on 404 made baskets overall and have registered 15 or more assists in two games last season.

SUMMIEL'S CAREER NIGHT

- The Demon Deacons owned the glass against High Point, finishing +21 in the rebounding battle including a career-best performance from senior forward Olivia Summiel.
- With a game-high and career-high 16 rebounds, Summiel notched her second career double-double and the first for her this season. Additionally, that performance marked Summiel's 10th double-digit rebounding performance of her career. This marked the most rebounds by a Demon Deacon since Ivana Raca pulled down 19 in a victory at Virginia Tech on Jan. 17, 2021.

## MORE NOTES

- The Deacs have owned the arc on both sides of the floor through the first 18 games of the season, knocking down 120-of-391 (30.7 percent) threes while allowing opponents to shoot just 83-of-290 (28.6 percent) threes. The Deacs 6.7 threes made per game rank third in the ACC.
- Last season, Megan Gebbia's American coached team was one of the best in the nation in three-point defense. The Eagles finished the season ranked third in the nation, allowing their opponents to shoot just 24.4 percent from behind the arc.

**CRASHING THE BOARDS**

- Wake Forest has tallied 645 rebounds in its first 18 games, winning the rebounding battle in 11 of 18 games.
- In the last seven seasons, Wake Forest has averaged better than 38 rebounds per game including averaging 40 or more during the 2013-14 season (40.5 rebounds per game) and the 2016-17 season (41.1 rebounds per game).

**ELISE CONTINUES TO GROW**

- Against Georgia Tech, Elise Williams finished the game as the Deacs' high scorer, totaling 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting while also converting 3-of-3 free throws.
- Additionally, the Raleigh, N.C., native had a well-rounded game for the Deacs in the win over Rhode Island as she led the team in rebounding (6) and assists (5).
- The sophomore guard ended the conference opener against Virginia with a new career high on the glass, posting nine rebounds against the Cavaliers. In addition to the rebounding effort, Williams also finished in double figures in the score column, tallying 10 points in the loss, a team best. The sophomore was nearly perfect at the line, going 7-of-8 from the charity stripe which was also a team-high and career-best.
- In her first full season at Wake Forest a year ago, Williams was a key to the Deacs success last season contributing in nearly every area.
- She led the team in assists (87), steals (51) while ranking second for the Deacs in scoring (9.5 PPG), three-point makes (28) and blocks (13) in 2021-22.
- This season, Williams leads the Deacs in assists (66) and steals (26), while ranking second in points per game (9.8). Additionally, Williams ranks fourth on the team in rebounds per game (3.7).

**TOP-25 SIGNING CLASS**

- The Wake Forest women's basketball team announced the addition of three players during National Signing Day, marking the first official signing class for head coach Megan Gebbia.
- In Madisyn Jordan, Makaela Quimby and Rylie Theuerkauf, the Demon Deacons signed some of the best talent in the country. This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class. - Additionally, ESPN ranked the Demon Deacons class as one of the top-25 in the country.

**IMPROVED NON-CONFERENCE SLATE**

- The Wake Forest women's basketball team entered the season with a higher NET score overall than during the 2021-22 season.
- The Demon Deacons non-conference slate was 80 points better than it was last year and had multiple challenges against Power-5 programs.
- Through 18 games this season, Wake Forest has played its hardest schedule in the Her Hoops Stats era (2009-10) with an Opponent Average NET Rating of 7.0 and it also ranks in the 78th percentile versus the rest of Division I teams. Additionally, the Demon Deacons hold a 5.3 NET Rating which is the best rating since the 2011-12 season

**RETURNING PRODUCTION**

- The only departure from last year's roster is Christina Morra, who graduated and is now playing professionally overseas.
- That means the 2022-23 Wake Forest women's basketball team returns 89.2 percent of their minutes, 87.2 percent of their scoring, 91.2 percent of their rebounding and 95.8 percent of their assists from a season ago.
- The returning scoring production is the most in the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- Additionally, the Demon Deacons return nine players who were on the NCAA Tournament team during the 2020-21 season.

YEAR ONE IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Eagles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wenthe and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball."

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Ac-

ademic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by The Frederick News-Post. She played college basketball at Towson University from 1990 to 1994.
