#### BOSTON COLLEGE VS. MIAMI - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 56th meeting between the two schools.
- Miami holds a slim 28-27 lead in the all-time series.
- BC is 11-15 all-time at Miami, but have lost nine straight versus the Hurricanes in Coral Gables.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 10-18 versus the Hurricanes.
- BC is 1-2 against Miami all-time in ACC Tournament play.
- Last season, Miami won two games against Boston College - an 81-70 win at Conte Forum on March 2 and a 71-69 overtime buzzer beater in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals on March 10.
- From 1989-2004, both schools were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 15-6 mark versus Miami during that span.

#### BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Boston College is 99-197 in 17+ seasons in the ACC.
- The Eagles won six ACC games a season ago.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish.
- BC tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and was fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).

#### BOSTON COLLEGE AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Boston College is 68-256 overall against ranked opponents
- The Eagles are 1-2 this season against teams ranked in the Associated Press and Coaches top 25 polls.
- On Dec. 21, BC downed #20/21 Virginia Tech, 70-65, in overtime, snapping a nine-game slide vs. ranked opponents.
- BC lost twice to Duke - 75-59 vs. the #17/17 Blue Devils to start ACC play on Dec. 3 and 65-64 against #16/14 Duke on Jan. 7.
- BC was 0-1 vs. teams ranked in the top 25 in 2021-22 - dropping the lone matchup with #7/7 Duke, 71-62, on Feb. 12, 2022.

#### QUINTEN POST RETURNS TO LINEUP

- Quinten Post has made an immediate impact since making his 2022-23 debut at Syracuse on Dec. 31.
- Post missed the first 13 games of the 2022-23 season due to a foot injury and has played in the last three games.
- Last time out against Duke, Post scored 16 points and grabbed six boards in 27 minutes off the bench.
- Post put BC ahead with his jumper in the lane with 28 seconds remaining; he made six FG on the day, including two 3-pointers.
- The 7-footer made his first five field goal attempts last time out vs. Notre Dame, finishing with 10 points and nine boards.
- In his season debut at Syracuse, he came off the bench and tallied eight points, three boards, and two assists in 17 minutes.
- He is averaging 11.3 points, 6.0 rebounds, 1.3 assists, and 1.0 blocks in nearly 23 minutes per game.
- A 2022 ACC All-Tournament pick, Post finished last season as one of the league's top big men, averaging 11.2 points, 5.5 boards, 1.0 blocks while shooting nearly 58% from the floor and 56% from the perimeter over the final 10 games.

## TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Boston College has committed 10 or fewer turnovers in three of its last four games - good for a 1.28:1 ATR during the span.
- Additionally, in three of the last four games, BC has held its opponents at least 7.1 points under their season average.
- Virginia Tech (76.3 avg/65 in OT), Notre Dame (70.1 avg/63), and Duke (72.9 avg/65) were the three games.

## ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 11

- Boston College is 8-7 all-time and 3-1 in the ACC in games played on the January 11 calendar date.
- January 11 marks the dual celebration of National Milk and National Arkansas Days.
- Several notable events in history occurred on January 11- 1569 - the first recorded lottery in England is held; 1838 - first public demonstration of Morse Code held in New Jersey; 1922 - Insulin first used on humans to treat diabetes; 1935 - Amelia Earhart flies from Honolulu to Oakland; 1949 - first recorded snowfall in Los Angeles.
- Notable January 11 birthdays: R&B royalty Mary J. Blige; founding father Alexander Hamilton; suffragist Alice Paul; saxophonist Clarence Clemons; two-time Masters champ Ben Crenshaw; Big Bank Hank of the Sugar Hill Gang.

## ALLOW ME TO RE-INTRODUCE MYSELF

- Jaeden Zackery scored a season-high and game-high 18 points in the win over Notre Dame on Jan. 3.
- The sophomore guard tallied 14 of his 18 points over the final 10 minutes of play in the second half against the Irish.
- He made a career-high seven field goals in the game, while adding four boards and three assists in 37 minutes.
- BC is 4-0 when Zackery scores at least 16 points in a game this season (Notre Dame, Stonehill, Rhode Island, Wyoming).
- Prior to his 16-point game vs. Wyoming, he had tallied 11 points in his previous two games - including a season-low four points against Tarleton State, going without a field goal for the first time in his career to that point (39 games).
- Against Wyoming (8-8) and Rhody (7-8), he went to the free throw line 16 times, connecting on 15.
- When Zackery goes to the free throw line at least five times, Boston College is 3-1 in 2022-23 and 6-2 all-time.
- Zackery has been BC's high scorer on five occasions and ranks second in scoring (10.8) through 16 games.
- Zackery has committed three turnovers in his last 195 minutes of play - he's dished out 15 assists over that span.

## SWIPERS

- BC has three players - Makai Ashton-Langford (18th, 1.5), Jaeden Zackery (10th, 1.4) and T.J. Bickerstaff (13th, 1.4) - rank among the top 13 in the ACC in steals. BC is the only team with at least three players among the ACC top 13 in steals.

## LATE AND CLOSE

- In five of Boston College's eight wins, the Eagles have trailed or been tied at some point during the final 4:00 of regulation.
- In those games, Boston College has hit five baskets with under 2:00 remaining in regulation to either tie (VT) or go ahead for good (Cornell, Detroit Mercy, Rhode Island, Notre Dame).

Notre Dame: Mason Madsen, go-ahead baseline jumper, 1:43 to play

Virginia Tech: Makai Ashton-Langford, game-tying floater, :32 to play (FG forced overtime)

Rhode Island: Devin McGlockton, go-ahead layup, 1:07 to play

Detroit Mercy: Madsen, go-ahead 3-pointer, :15 to play

Cornell: Prince Aligbe, go-ahead putback, :0.9 to play.

## McGLOCKTON EARLY LEADER FOR ACC SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR

- Among all ACC players without a start, Devin McGlockton leads the league in scoring (7.6) and rebounds (4.8).
- On Dec. 21, McGlockton scored 13 of his 18 points in the second half to help lead BC over #20/21 Virginia Tech.
- Six of those 13 second half points came during a key 8-0 run, helping BC build a nine-point lead with under 5:00 to play.
- McGlockton is the only BC reserve - and one of only eight bench players in the ACC - to log a double-double this season.
- The 6-7 redshirt freshman is playing his first season of college ball and has scored in double figures on six occasions.
- BC is 5-3 when he grabs at least six rebounds and is 6-2 when he blocks at least one shot.
- McGlockton leads Boston College in FG% (46-75, 61.3%), effective FG% (64.0%), and true shooting percentage (66.4%).
- McGlockton had career-highs in points (20) and rebounds (11) en route to his first career double-double at Nebraska.
- Against Rhode Island, McGlockton scored the eventual go-ahead basket with 1:07 remaining in the game.
- He also sealed the victory with two free throws with eight seconds remaining; scoring six of his 11 points in the final 1:40.
- Against Wyoming, McGlockton had 12 points (5-8 FG; 2-3 3FG), four rebounds, an assist, a steal, and three blocks.
- The last player to post a similarly complete stat line - Steffon Mitchell against Duke (12p/5r/1a/1s/3b).
- McGlockton is the first Boston College player in at least 26 years to post that stat line coming off the bench.

## THE ARTIST FORMALLY KNOWN AS PRINCE

- Prince Aligbe is averaging 11.0 points and 5.3 rebounds over his last three games for Boston College.
- On Jan. 3 versus Notre Dame, Aligbe had 15 points (5-8 FG) and seven boards in 24 minutes.
- He saw a season-high 25 minutes of action at Syracuse, tallying 12 points and five boards, to go along with a steal.
- Aligbe announced his presence with authority, connecting on the gamewinner in the opener vs. Cornell on Nov. 7
- Aligbe led Boston College in scoring with 16 points, while also grabbing nine rebounds - narrowly missing a double-double.
- The 6-7 four-star forward from Minneapolis scored 12 of his 16 points in the second half, including eight in the final 4:00 of play.
- Aligbe became the first Boston College freshman in 11 years to lead the Eagles in scoring in his first career game.
- On Nov. 14, 2011, newcomer Patrick Heckmann led BC in scoring (19 points) in the season lidlifter vs. New Hampshire.
- After an injury early against Detroit Mercy, he missed the next six games before playing four minutes at Duke on Dec. 3.

## LANGFORD JR. DEVELOPING AS PLAYMAKER

- Over his last two games, DeMarr Langford Jr. has dished out 11 assists to five turnovers.
- On Jan. 3 against Notre Dame, Langford Jr. registered a career-high eight assists to only one turnover in 36 minutes.
- It is the highest single-game assist mark by a BC player since Makai Ashton-Langford had nine on Feb. 21, 2022 vs. FSU.
- In ACC play, Langford Jr. is posting a 2.0:1 assist/turnover ratio, including a 5.0:1 mark over his last two games.
- For the season, he ranks third on the Eagles in assists (27) and is tied for his brother, averaging 2.1 dimes per game.

## IF THIS, THEN THAT...

### WITH A WIN AT MIAMI...

- Boston College would move to 9-8 overall and 3-3 in ACC play.
- BC would tie the all-time series with Miami at 28-28
- The Eagles would snap a nine-game losing streak at Miami; the last win in Coral Gables came Jan. 19, 2010
- BC would also move to 12-15 at Miami and 11-18 vs. Miami in ACC regular season play
- BC would win its 69th game all-time versus a ranked opponent and would improve to 2-2 this season vs. ranked opponents
- It would mark the first time since 2017-18 that BC logged two wins over ranked opponents in the same year.
- BC would improve to 7-5 in night games, 8-3 in weekday games, and 1-3 in true road games this season.
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 22nd victory at Boston College and his 149th as a head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,246 all-time through 90 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

### WITH A LOSS AT MIAMI...

- Boston College would fall to 8-9 overall and 2-4 in ACC play.
- The Eagles fall to 27-29 all-time vs. Miami, including a 10-19 mark in ACC regular season play and 11-16 at Miami
- Boston College would drop its 10th straight game at Miami, dating back to Jan. 19, 2010
- BC would move to 1-3 vs. ranked opponents this season
- BC would drop to 6-6 in night games, 7-4 in weekday games, and 0-4 in true road games this season.
- Boston College would register the 1,074th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

### LESS IS MORE?

- Last season, when BC attempted 15 or fewer 3-pointers, it was 8-4; with 16 or more 3-point attempts, it was 5-16.
- So far this season, the Eagles are 4-2 when attempting fewer than 15 3FG and 4-6 with 16 or more 3FG attempts.

### ASHTON-LANGFORD RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF SETH GREENBERG'S PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- Makai Ashton-Langford was recognized by ESPN's Seth Greenberg as one of his Players of the Week on Dec. 27.
- The grad student posted season-highs in scoring (21) and rebounding (7) in a 70-65 overtime win over #20/21 Virginia Tech.
- He tallied 13 of his 21 points in the second half - forcing OT with a driving layup with 32 seconds remaining in regulation.
- With 36 seconds to play in overtime, Ashton-Langford the dagger 3-pointer, giving BC a five-point advantage
- Ashton-Langford grabbed a season-best seven rebounds - six on the defensive glass, leading directly to six fast-break points.

### CJ PENHA JR. - CERTIFIED BUCKET GETTER

- CJ Penha Jr. has reached double digits in the scoring column in six of his 16 games this season.
- The grad transfer scored a game-high 16 points on Dec. 3 at Duke, making 7-of-13 shots from the floor in 33 minutes.
- He ranks third on the Eagles in scoring (9.9 ppg), ranks second in FG% (52.0%), and is tops in 3FG% (34.1%).
- In the 2022-23 opener, Penha Jr. came off the bench to score 15 points on 6-of-8 shooting (2-4 3FG) against Cornell.
- He added 13 points at Nebraska and had 12 points in two games at the Paradise Jam - George Mason and Tarleton State.
- Penha Jr. ranks third for BC in field goals made (54) and ranks second on the Eagles in 3-pointers made (14).
- The grad transfer compiled nearly 1,600 points at Taylor University (NAIA) and Trevecca Nazarene (DII), including 155 3FG's.
- During his 100 games played at both Taylor and Trevecca, Penha Jr. scored 20 or more points on 35 occasions.

### MADSEN FROM DEEP

- Mason Madsen connected on three 3-pointers against Villanova in the Never Forget Tribute Classic.
- It was the second game this season - and ninth career game - in which Madsen made at least three trifectas.
- He leads the Eagles in 3-pointers made this season, with 16.

### ZACKERY'S 3-POINT EFFICIENCY

- Dating back to last season, Jaeden Zackery ranks 60th nationally among all active players in 3-point field goal percentage.
- Zackery has connected on 41.4% of his long-distance shots for his career, making 65-of-157 from beyond the arc (49 games).

### BOARD MAN BICKERSTAFF

- T.J. Bickerstaff has picked up where he left off last season - as one of the top rebounders in the ACC.
- Bickerstaff ranks 12th in the ACC, averaging 6.5 rebounds per game during the 2022-23 season.
- The 6-9 forward from Atlanta ranks fifth in the ACC on the offensive glass, averaging 2.6 OR/g.
- He posted double digits in the rebounding column in each of the first three games this season and five times overall.
- Last season, the 6-9 forward was eighth in the ACC (7.2 rpg); he ranked as the fifth-leading returning rebounder in the league.
- Bickerstaff was one of 15 players nationally - two in the ACC (Bacot - UNC) to have multiple games with 17 rebounds or more.
- Against UNC on Jan. 26, 14 of Bickerstaff's 17 rebounds came on the defensive glass.
- [The last BC player to grab at least 14 defensive boards in a game - Ky Bowman \(16\) - against Notre Dame on Jan. 12, 2019.](#)
- Bickerstaff registered four games with at least 15 rebounds in 2021-22 - tied for most in the ACC this season (Bacot).
- [The last BC player to have at least four games with 15+ rebounds - Craig Smith - during the 2005-06 season.](#)

### CK3

- Chas Kelley III scored a season-best 10 points at Nebraska, playing 25 minutes off the bench.
- The rookie guard made 4-of-9 shots, including two 3-pointers, to go along with two rebounds, two assists, and two steals.

### 'TIS THE SEASON TO BE STINGY

- For the first time in the shot clock era, Boston College held consecutive opponents under 50 points on the scoreboard.
- On Nov. 21, the Eagles held Wyoming to 48 points and on Nov. 27, limited Rhode Island to 49 points.
- Prior to that, the last time BC kept its opponent under 50 in consecutive games came during the 2003-04 season, limiting Rutgers to 44 points on Feb. 22, 2004 and Virginia Tech to 48 on Feb. 25, 2004.

### ZACKERY'S RARE GIVE AND TAKE TOTALS

- Jaeden Zackery had 11 points, a career-high seven assists, four steals in the season opening win vs. Cornell.
- Zackery is one of only six Boston College players since 1996 to log at least 11 points, seven assists, and four steals in a game.
- The others: Troy Bell and Ryan Sidney (twice), Olivier Hanlan, Duane Woodward, and Rakim Sanders.

### MAKAI NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Makai Ashton-Langford was named to the 2022 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam all-tournament team.
- The veteran guard averaged 11.3 points, 2.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists in the tourney - including 17 points against George Mason.

### MAKAI SHINES IN SECOND HALF VS. DETROIT MERCY

- Makai Ashton-Langford scored all 15 of his points - including a posterizing dunk - in the second half vs. Detroit Mercy.
- After starting the game 0-for-4 in the first half, the veteran point guard made 5-of-7 shots in 14 minutes in the second half.
- Last season, Ashton-Langford tallied better than 60% of his scoring over the final 20 minutes of play.

### DOUBLE DIP

- T.J. Bickerstaff is the first Boston College player since Jared Dudley to start a season with consecutive double-doubles.
- Dudley began the 2006-07 season with back-to-back double-doubles in points and rebounds, recording 19 points and 11 rebounds vs. UNH on Nov. 10, 2006 and 19 points and 14 boards against Vermont on Nov. 13, 2006.
- Bickerstaff registered double digits in the rebounding column in the first three games of the season - four games overall.
- The last time a BC player to have at least 10 rebounds in each of the first three games - Kenny Harley in 2000-01.

- He suffered the injury in the first half of BC's game vs. Detroit Mercy and he will miss the remainder of the 2022-23 season.

### BICKERSTAFF WITH A FULL STAT LINE VS. CORNELL

- T.J. Bickerstaff's stat line vs. Cornell: 12 points, 10 rebounds, four assists, five steals, and two blocked shots.
- It was his third career double-double in points and rebounds, while his five steals vs. the Big Red were a career-best.
- Dating back to 1996, Bickerstaff is only the second ACC player to post a game stat line with at least those totals.
- Florida State's Chris Singleton had 22 points/11 boards/6 assists/10 steals/4 blocks vs. UNC Greensboro on Nov. 14, 2010.

### MANY HAPPY RETURNS

- Boston College returns its top three and four of its top five scorers, accounting for 71.3% of its scoring from a season ago: Makai Ashton-Langford (12.0 ppg), DeMarr Langford Jr. (11.3), and Jaeden Zackery (10.3), along with Quinten Post (9.4)
- BC also returns nearly 75% of its rebounding, 83% of assists, 76% of steals, 80% of blocks, and 71.0% of minutes played.
- The Eagles three players who started 30 or more games, four with at least 22, and five with at least 11.
- A stark difference from last year, when BC had the seventh-lowest percentage nationally of minutes played returning.
- Per barttorvik.com, BC ranks third in the ACC and 37th nationally in returning possession minutes.
- In 2021-22, returning BC players accounted for 27.6% of minutes played - fourth-lowest among power conferences.
- Additionally, BC returned 30.3% of its scoring, 37.2% of its rebounding, and 39.1% of its assists entering 2021-22.

### FINAL FOUR OPPONENTS ON SHORT NOTICE

- Boston College faced two opponents which played in the 2022 Final Four in the span of a week.
- The Eagles played at Duke on Dec. 3 and faced Villanova on Dec. 10 in the Never Forget Tribute Classic.
- It marked the first time since the 1987-88 season in which BC faced two teams from the previous Final Four in the same week.
- That year, BC traveled to Syracuse on Monday, Jan. 18, 1988 before hosting Providence on Saturday, Jan. 23.
- BC takes on two 2022 Final Four teams in the span of 10 days in January, - hosting Duke on Jan. 7 and at UNC on Jan. 17.

### HASTINGS, PAYNE SIGN NATIONAL LETTERS OF INTENT

- Jayden Hastings and Fred Payne signed their NLI's to continue their academic and athletic careers at Boston College.
- Hastings** is a 6-9, 225 pound forward is completing his prep career at the IMG Academy in Sarasota, Fla. A four-star rated recruit by ESPN.com and Rivals.com, Hastings is a mobile, high-motor post player who can finish at the rim on offense and protect it on the defensive side of the floor. He competed this summer with Nightvydas Elite (Nike EYBL), using his length and explosive athletic ability to rank as one of the circuit's top shot blockers (2.0 bpg). He began his high school career at Orlando Christian Prep, helping to guide the Warriors to the 2022 FHSAA Class 2A state championship. For his efforts, he earned All-State honors by SBLive Florida in 2022.
- Earl Grant on Jayden Hastings:** "Jayden is really long and athletic. He is an elite shot blocker and can rebound at 12 feet. Jayden has a lot of upside and is developing at a fast pace. He can score on the block and gets out on the run for layups and dunks. He is also a very good passer from the low block and the high post."
- Hastings on Boston College:** "I chose Boston College because of the coaches and everyone up there. The coaches and I really get along and we've talked for a long time about a lot of things...When I hung out with the players, it seemed like they were really together. I'll be with those guys 24-7, so the bond is important to me. I really loved Boston and had a really good experience seeing the city...Their program is on the rise and I can be a big part of that." (Rivals.com - Travis Graf)
- Payne is a 6-2, 185 pound guard who is playing his final prep season at Legacy the School of Sport Sciences in Spring, Texas. A four-star rated combo guard according to ESPN.com, Payne gave his verbal commitment to the Eagles this past May. He competed with LivOn Fleur De Lis on the Nike EYBL circuit over the summer, averaging 10.5 points, 4.1 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.0 steals in 13 games. The left-handed guard was named the MVP at the Big Shots Prep Nationals in March. Payne began his prep career at Lincoln Prep in Grambling, La. before transferring to Sunrise Christian in Kansas.
- Earl Grant on Fred Payne:** "Fred brings a lot of versatility to our program. He is a hard-nosed defender and enjoys pressuring the basketball full court. He is fast and athletic and has a knack for getting his hands on the ball. He is wired to score and does a great job of creating his own shot. His passing ability and vision is really good. Fred is crafty, finishing in the paint with both hands."
- Fred Payne on Boston College:** "I chose Boston College because it was the best fit and the coaches made me feel at home. I also like the style of play and they have a history of developing guards like me. Head coach Earl Grant flew out to watch me work out at 7 in the morning and that made them jump over all the programs because from the minute they started recruiting me, they always showed love. Boston College recruits underrated guards and dogs and I feel like that's where I'm going to get better as a player and as a person." (On3.com - Joe Tipton)

### POST PARTY

- Quinten Post finished last season strong, earning ACC All-Tournament team honors averaging 14.0 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.3 blocks, and 2.0 steals per game during BC's run to the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament in Brooklyn.
- The true 7-footer is an inside-outside threat, making nearly 53% of his 2FG and over 34% of his 3FG attempts last season
- His 11 made 3-pointers are the most in a single-season by a BC true 7-footer. Nate Doornekamp (2001-05) holds the career record for 3-pointers made by a BC 7-footer, with 16.
- While he earned the start in the last eight games - 11 starts overall - Post was among the best ACC reserves in 2021-22.
- Post led the ACC in scoring (9.3), rebounding (5.7), and blocks (1.0) as a reserve (min. 20 games)
- He poured in a career-high 24 points (10-14 FG), while adding nine rebounds in 24 minutes off the bench vs. Georgia Tech.
- Post scored in double digits in 12 of 20 games as a reserve, including two double-doubles.
- Was the starting center for the Netherlands Senior Men's National Team during August, as the Dutch Lions prepared for FIBA EuroBasket, averaging better than 5.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 20 minutes of play.

# EARL GRANT

## THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant enters his second season as the Clement and Elizabeth IZZI Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Grant used his first full season at the Heights to forge a new path for the men's basketball program, establishing a culture of gritty and relentless play, selfless humility and a family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes

in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players – Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley – were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley – the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson – 58.4 points per game – in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyaiah and Elonzo.
