STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech returns home to open a three-game homestand beginning on Thursday night, welcoming Miami. The Yellow Jackets and Hurricanes are set to tip at 8 p.m. in McCamish Pavilion on ACC Network. Fans can also tune-in to hear Richard Musterer's call on the GT Gameday App.
- The Yellow Jackets look to get back to winning ways and snap a four-game skid, while collecting their first conference win of the season on Thursday. Miami narrowly leads the all-time series against Georgia Tech, 19-17, after taking a pair of wins last season. The Hurricanes escaped with a one-point win in Coral Gables before defeating Tech, 51-39, at home in February.
- Georgia Tech concluded a stretch of playing nine-of-12 games on the road, including four-of-five ACC contests, last Sunday. Since Nov. 25, the Yellow Jackets played only three games at home, but are set to open a three-game homestand after Sunday's contest at Wake Forest.
- Kayla Blackshear and Aixa Wone Aranaz both posted career-high scoring performances at Wake Forest. Blackshear totaled 16 points and 13 rebounds (career-best) for her first double-double, while Wone Aranaz added 10 points for her first double-figure scoring effort while at Georgia Tech.
- Tonie Morgan was two assists shy of recording a triple-double against Furman, finishing with 11 points, 10 rebounds and eight assists. The last Yellow Jacket to record a triple-double dates all the way back to Milli Martinez on Feb. 23, 2002. Morgan's double-double against Furman was the first of her career, and the first by a Yellow Jacket this season.
- Bianca Jackson hit a major milestone to close out 2022, recording 14 points at Virginia to hit 1,000 career points between her time at South Carolina, Florida State and Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jacket totaled 392 points in two seasons at South Carolina, 440 at FSU and sits at 188 as a Yellow Jacket.
- Georgia Tech has seen solid production from its freshmen to start the season. Tonie Morgan is third on the team in scoring, averaging 8.6 points per game. She recorded her personal-best in scoring with a team-high 17 points against South Florida in the Gulf Coast Showcase. Freshman Kara Dunn is fourth on the team in scoring at 6.8 ppg. She scored a personal-best 17 points at Louisville, earning her first collegiate start.
- Experience has been shining through to open the season as transfers Cameron Swartz and Bianca Jackson have been leaders for the Yellow Jackets. Swartz has led the Jackets in scoring in seven games and posted 12 games scoring in double-figures. Jackson has contributed 10 double-figure scoring games, including dropping a game-high 24 points in the win over Belmont on Nov. 27. On the season, Swartz and Jackson are leading Tech offensively, averaging 12.6 and 11.8 points per game, respectively.
- Tech finished the 2021-22 season with a 21-11 overall record and 11-7 Atlantic Coast Conference mark. The Jackets earned the No. 6 seed in the ACC Tournament and faced Wake Forest in the second round, gutting out a 45-40 win despite playing without first-team all-conference performer Lorela Cubaj for nearly three quarters. The win pushed Tech into the quarterfinals for the 33rd time in program history.

PRODUCTIVE BLACKSHEAR

At Wake Forest, sophomore Kayla Blackshear led Georgia Tech on both ends of the floor, dropping career-highs in scoring and rebounding. Blackshear led Tech with a team-high 16 points, while securing a personal-best 13 rebounds. The double-double marked the first collegiate double-double for Blackshear in her collegiate career and second by a Yellow Jacket this season.

CAREER-HIGH IN FIRST CAREER START

Freshman Kara Dunn earned her first collegiate start of her career at Louisville and wasted no time making it productive. The Dallas, Ga., native led the Jackets offensively in the outing with 17 points. Dunn shot 50.0 percent (6-12) from the floor, hitting a pair of three-pointers, and went a perfect 3-for-3 from the free throw line in personal-high 33:54 of playing time.

Freshman Inés Noguero also earned her first collegiate career start at Louisville, contributing four points, four rebounds and two assists in 20 minutes.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

Florida State scored 99 points against Georgia Tech on Jan. 1, marking the highest offensive output by an opponent this season. In fact, the last opponent to score 99-plus points dates back to March 2, 2008 when Virginia scored 103 in double-overtime (GT scored 101). That same season (2007-08), Maryland also scored 99 points in double-overtime (GT scored 95). In regulation play, the last team to score 99-plus points was No. 4 North Carolina in a 99-78 loss on Jan. 5, 2008.

FAMILIAR TIES

When Georgia Tech hosted Florida State on Jan. 1, Bianca Jackson had familiar ties having played two seasons with the Seminoles before transferring to Georgia Tech for her fifth year of eligibility. As a Seminole, Jackson appeared in 45 games, earning the start in 26 total outings, including all 19 her first season (2020-21). In 45 games, Jackson scored 440 points to average 9.8 points per game after contributing 14.1 points per game in 2020-21. She helped FSU to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances.

BIANCA JOINS 1,000 CAREER POINTS CLUB

In Georgia Tech's game at Virginia, graduate transfer Bianca Jackson joined the elite 1,000-career points club with a three-pointer in the third quarter. Needing just 14 points to hit the mark, Jackson finished with 14 points, five rebounds, four steals and three assists in the contest.

Jackson reached the milestone after producing 392 points at South Carolina, 440 points at Florida State and 168 points at Georgia Tech.

LOOKING TO SHAKE A SLOW START

Georgia Tech seeks its first ACC win of the season on Sunday, after opening the conference slate at 0-5. In her third season at the helm, this marks the first time under head coach Nell Fortner the Jackets have opened ACC play at 0-5. The last time Georgia Tech was 0-5 to start conference play was 2002-03. The Jackets opened the 2002-03 season 0-5 against ACC opponents before collecting a win against Clemson in overtime. That season, Tech finished 8-8 in ACC action.

LENDING A HAND

In Georgia Tech's game against Furman on Dec. 21, Georgia Tech dished out a season-high 24 assists with six different Yellow Jackets recording multiple on the day. Tonie Morgan led the way with eight, marking the most assists by a Jacket since Lotta-Maj Lahtinen recorded 12 against Clemson on Feb. 13, 2022.

Morgan's eight assists marked the first time a freshman recorded eight or more in a game since Antonia Peresson dished out eight helpers against Loyola Chicago on Nov. 14, 2014 in her freshman

SEEING DOUBLE

Against Furman, Tonie Morgan recorded the first double-double by a Yellow Jacket this season with 11 points and 10 rebounds. It marked the first time a freshman recorded a double-double since Elizabeth Balogun and Elizabeth Dixon each recorded double-doubles their freshman seasons in 2018-19. Balogun finished the season with two double-doubles, while Dixon recorded four.

JACKSON HELD SCORELESS

Bianca Jackson was held scoreless in Tech's game at Boston College on Dec. 18, going 0-for-9 from the field in 23:47 minutes of action. The game marked the first time since March 24, 2019 the Montgomery, Ala., native was held to zero points in a game. On March 24, 2019, Jackson was a sophomore at South Carolina competing against Florida State in the NCAA Tournament.

In her two seasons at Florida State (2020-22), Jackson scored in all 45 games she appeared in.

At South Carolina, Jackson was scoreless in 12-of-68 games. During her entire collegiate career, Jackson has only gone without scoring in 13 games and has appeared in 129.

SHOOTING STRUGGLES

Georgia Tech has only been held to under 30.0 percent shooting three times this season - versus South Florida (27.9), at Boston College (28.2) and versus Florida State (27.3). The Jackets were held to exactly 30.0 percent shooting in its first game against Belmont in the Gulf Coast Showcase.

When held to under 30.0 percent shooting, Tech fell in all three games and lost the rebounding battle. Tech's best shooting percentage this season was 48.2 percent (27-56) versus Air Force.

DOUBLE FIGURES

For the third time this season, Georgia Tech distributed its offense amongst four players at Virginia on Dec. 29 - Cameron Swartz led the way with 16 points, followed by Bianca Jackson (14), Tonie Morgan (12) and Nerea Hermosa (10). Previously, four or more Yellow Jackets scored double-figures:

* vs. Central Michigan (Dec. 11) - Bianca Jackson (14), Cameron Swartz (11), Kara Dunn (10), Inés Noguero (10);

* at Auburn (Nov. 16) - Cameron Swartz (16), Bianca Jackson (12), Elyia Love (12) and Tonie Morgan (10).

Swartz leads Tech with 12 games scoring in double-figures, right ahead of Jackson with 10. Swartz also had led Tech in scoring in a team-high seven games.

FAMILIAR GROUND

When Georgia Tech opened conference play at Boston College on Dec. 18, it was familiar ground for transfer Cameron Swartz - who played three seasons for the Eagles. From 2019-22, Swartz played in 82 games for BC, starting 71. She finished with 1,055 career points for a 12.9 points per game average. The Marietta, Ga., native averaged double-figure scoring her final two seasons in Chestnut Hill, leading the Eagles last year at 16.1 points per game. While at BC, Swartz scored a game-high 39 points at Clemson (1/9/22) to tie the school record. An all-ACC first team selection last season, Swartz was also the ACC Most Improved Player in 2022.

Swartz was limited in the first half with four points, two coming from the free throw line. She posted 10 points in the second half to finish with a team-high 14 on the day. The

FIVE-GAME SWING

Georgia Tech spent a three week span away from McCarnish Pavilion, competing in a Thanksgiving tournament before a pair of road games. During the five-game swing, three Yellow Jackets averaged double-figure scoring totals, paced by Bianca Jackson (14.2 ppg), Cameron Swartz (12.2 ppg) and Tonie Morgan (10.8 ppg). Morgan also paced the team in rebounds (5.8 rpg) and assists (11) - Kayla Blackshear followed at 5.4 rebounds per game. The Yellow Jackets shot 78.7 percent (70-89) from the free throw line, led by Swartz's 20-for-23 (87.0 percent) effort. Jackson followed at 86.7 percent (13-for-15).

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

Closing out the ACC/Big Ten Challenge with the 15th installment, Georgia Tech ended the series on a high note with a win at Michigan State. The win was the first on the road in the Challenge since 2009 for the Yellow Jackets, who finished the Challenge with a 9-6 record. In the Challenge, GT secured wins over Michigan State (A-2022), Wisconsin (H-2019), Purdue (H-2017), Illinois (H-2013), Nebraska (H-2011), Northwestern (H-2010), Penn State (2009), Michigan State (H-2008) and Iowa (2007).

The ACC won the 2022 edition of the Challenge, marking the 11th ACC/Big Ten Challenge win and moved its all-time advantage in the series to 11-1-3. Collectively, the ACC finished with a 112-80 record against the Big Ten in the Challenge.

On Nov. 29, the ACC, Southeastern Conference and ESPN announced the formation of the ACC/SEC Challenge for men's and women's basketball, scheduled to begin as part of the 2023-24 season. Each of the 28 games (30 starting in

GULF COAST SHOWCASE BREAKOUT

Freshman Tonie Morgan put together a pair of impressive performances in the first two games of the Gulf Coast Showcase. The Tallahassee, Fla., native led Tech offensively (vs. USF, vs. Air Force), producing back-to-back double-figure scoring performances to average 15.5 points per game. Morgan also led Tech on the glass in both games for a team-best 8.0 rebounds per game average and assists, totaling nine (4.5 assists per game average). In the three games, Morgan averaged 11.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 26.1 minutes per game, while accumulating a team-high 10 assists. On the season, Morgan is third on the team in scoring, averaging 8.6 ppg, while tying for the team-lead in assists (42).

Bianca Jackson led Georgia Tech in the three-game tournament, averaging a team-best 13.3 points per game. She dropped a season-high 24 points against Belmont in the final game, helping the Jackets overcome a five-point deficit late in the ballgame to secure the win. One point shy of matching her career-high in scoring, Jackson finished the tournament shooting 87.5 percent (7-8) from the free throw line and 41.7 percent from the field.

SCORELESS FROM THREE

Georgia Tech held the Lady Bulldogs of Georgia scoreless from three-point distance on Nov. 20. Georgia went 0-for-7 from long range, marking the first opponent this season held without a three-pointer.

The Yellow Jackets have held at least one opponent a season without a three-pointer in the Nell Fortner Era. The last time dates back to last season against Kennesaw State (11/11/21), which went 0-for-6. In 2020-21 season, Tulane (12/3/20) was held scoreless from three-point range (0-11) and in 2019-20, Notre Dame (2/2/20) went without a three-pointer (0-7).

STIFLING DEFENSE

Nell Fortner teams have become known for their stifling defense, and this squad is no different. In Georgia Tech's first three games of the season (Georgia State, Kennesaw State and Auburn), they held every opponent to under 30.0 percent shooting. Georgia was the first program to shoot over 30.0 percent, connecting on 45.2 percent (28-62) from the field. The best shooting percentage by opponent to date was Florida State (1/1), shooting 49.2 percent (32-65). Through 16 games, Georgia Tech has held eight opponents to under 35 percent shooting.

In the Nell Fortner era at Georgia Tech (since 2019-20), the lowest field goal percentage an opponent was held to was 16.7 percent (9-54) by Georgia State on Nov. 20, 2019. The highest field goal percentage by an opponent is 56.4 percent (31-55) by South Carolina in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 on March 28, 2021.

REBOUNDING GAME

Through Tech's first 16 games, the Yellow Jackets have averaged 39.8 rebounds per game, paced by Kayla Blackshear at 6.4 rebounds per game. Tech won the rebounding battle in its first two games against Georgia State and Kennesaw State, but dropped the battle in back-to-back-to-back games at Auburn (51-39), against Georgia (47-24), and vs. South Florida (50-34). Tech pulled out the win despite losing the battle on the glass at Auburn thanks to its defense and holding Auburn to a low shooting efficiency. Tech snapped a three-game skid losing the battle on the glass against Air Force, winning the rebounding game, 45-23.

Auburn proved heavy on the boards and finished with 29 offensive rebounds, converting for 22 second chance points. With its 29 offensive boards, the Tigers were able to attempt 26 shots. The 29 offensive rebounds marked the most by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era at GT. The previous high was 19 twice - at Clemson (1/7/21) and at Florida State (2/18/21).

The last time an opponent secured 29 offensive rebounds or more dates back to Tech's game at Tennessee on Nov. 17, 2013 when the Lady Vols recorded 33 offensive boards. Tennessee finished with 32 defensive rebounds for a total of 65 boards and took the game, 87-76. Since the 2013-14 season, Georgia Tech has allowed opponents to pull down 20 or more offensive rebounds 20 times.

HOW MANY ATTEMPTS?

In Georgia Tech's game at Auburn on Nov. 16, the Tigers recorded 76 field goal attempts, marking the most field goal attempts by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era (since 2019-20). In her four seasons, only two opponents have attempted 70 or more field goals, the other being Notre Dame (70) last season on Feb. 17, 2022.

While Auburn attempted 76 field goals, they were held to a mere 26.3 percent (20-76) efficiency thanks to Georgia Tech's defense.

ATL'S TEAM

Georgia Tech captured a 60-42 win over Georgia State on Nov. 10 to open the 2022-23 season led by Cameron Swartz with 19 points and Bianca Jackson with 18 points. The Yellow Jackets shot 87.5 percent (21-24) from the free throw line and dominated on the glass, 50-30, led by Kayla Blackshear and Tonie Morgan with eight rebounds each.

Georgia Tech limited the Panthers to single digits in both the first and second quarters to gain a comfortable halftime lead. GSU outscored Tech, 20-14, in the third frame to rally, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Jackets.

Six Yellow Jackets made their White and Gold debuts on Nov. 10. Tech's starting lineup featured four new faces to Georgia Tech, while leading returning rebounder and scorer, Nerea Hermosa, held down the recognizable returners.

The Yellow Jackets followed that performance with a victory over Kennesaw State, keeping with the local flair. A trio of Jackets finished in double-figures led by Swartz (14), Kara Dunn (13) and Kayla Blackshear (11).

Kennesaw State was limited to single offensive scoring totals in three of four quarters and were held to a 28.1 percent shooting efficiency. No Owls finished the game in double-digits.

APPROACHING A MILESTONE

Georgia Tech's Nerea Hermosa is closing in on a prestigious career milestone, the 1,000 career points club. Currently, Hermosa owns 820 career points in three seasons, needing just 180 points to become the 34th player in Georgia Tech women's basketball history to hit 1,000 career points.

Last season, the Yellow Jackets lauded two players into the club - Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Lorela Cubaj.

Fifth-year transfer Bianca Jackson hit the prestigious mark in Tech's game at Virginia, finishing with 14 points to hit 1,000 career points on the dot. She accomplished the feat in 126 career games between South Carolina, Florida State and Georgia Tech.

FINAL TUNEUP

The Yellow Jackets hosted Clayton State in its final preseason tune-up on Nov. 3 in an exhibition contest, squeaking out a 69-62 win. Tech was led offensively by Cameron Swartz (12) and Kara Dunn (11). The Jackets got off to a strong shooting start, connecting on 53.3 percent from the field in the first quarter before hitting 39.1 percent over the final three quarters. Tech also struggled from the free throw line, hitting 50.0 percent (12-for-24) led by Avyonce Carter's 4-for-4 effort. Both teams were hindered by turnovers with Tech committing 25 to Clayton State's 24. The Lakers shot 40.9 percent from the field.

ACC PREDICTIONS

Georgia Tech was picked to finish eighth in the preseason Atlantic Coast Conference poll, as picked by the Blue Ribbon Panel. The Yellow Jackets finished sixth in the league last season and advanced to their second consecutive NCAA Tournament.

However, Tech lost three of its starters to graduation and eligibility, including its leading rebounder (Lorela Cubaj - 11.1 rpg) and scorer (Lotta-Maj Lahtinen - 10.9 ppg). Cubaj, who averaged a double-double behind 10.0 ppg, led the ACC in rebounding. Cubaj finished ninth in the nation in rebounds and 16th in rebounds per game.

ANN MEYERS DRYSDALE WATCH LIST

Georgia Tech fifth-year transfer, Cameron Swartz was one of 20 shooting guards named to the watch list. The reigning ACC Most Improved Player, Swartz transferred to Georgia Tech for her fifth year of eligibility after leading Boston College in scoring last season, averaging 16.1 points per game. The local native ranked sixth overall in the ACC in scoring and earned an all-ACC first team nod.

Swartz was one of five players from the ACC on the list, joining Celeste Taylor (Duke), Hailey Van Lith (Louisville), Jakia Brown-Turner (NC State), and Ashley Owusu (Virginia Tech).

HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech hit the transfer portal over the summer and welcomed two transfers to The Flats for their fifth seasons of eligibility. Joining the 2022-23 roster are Bianca Jackson (Florida State) and Cameron Swartz (Marietta, Ga.)

Jackson - A native of Montgomery, Ala., Jackson played the last two seasons at Florida State, helping the Seminoles to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. At FSU, she appeared in 45 contests, starting 26 and averaged 9.8 points per game in two years. Last season, she finished third on the team in scoring, posting 6.7 ppg, switching to a shooting guard. Her first season with the Seminoles, Jackson averaged a team-best 14.1 ppg as a redshirt-junior. She played her first two seasons at South Carolina (2017-19) before transferring to Florida State. Jackson played in 57 games in two seasons, helping the Gamecocks reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2019. She was named SEC All-Freshman Team in 2017-18.

Swartz - A three-year starter at Boston College (2019-22), Swartz averaged 12.9 points per game over her career as an Eagle. She played in 82 games, starting 71. Swartz started all 33 games her senior season, earned all-ACC first team recognition and was named ACC Most Improved Player. She averaged a team-high 16.1 points per game, led the team in three-pointers (60) and three-point percentage (35.5 percent). Swartz led the ACC in scoring in conference play and finished sixth overall. Last season, she increased her scoring average by 6.5 points, rebounding by 1.2, field goal percentage by plus-four percent and 3-point field goal percentage by over 10 percent from her junior season. Swartz played her freshman season at Colorado, taking the floor in seven games.

Also arriving from the transfer portal, Kayla Blackshear was a mid-year transfer from Alabama, joining the team in January. Blackshear appeared in the Crimson Tide's first three games of the 2021-22 season, averaging 10.2 minutes per game off the bench. Blackshear contributed 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game in the first three games.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Georgia Tech will have some big shoes to fill this season, having lost three of its starters from last season, including its leading scorer and rebounder. The Yellow Jackets lost All-American starters Lorela Cubaj and Lotta-Maj Lahtinen, who led the team in rebounding (11.1 rpg) and scoring (10.9 ppg), respectively. Cubaj, an honorable mention all-American last season, was the Georgia College Player of the Year for the second straight year and was selected No. 18 overall in the WNBA Draft. Cubaj finished

the season as the ACC's leading rebounder by nearly two rebounds per game above Elizabeth Kitley (VT) in second place.

GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech has made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Last season's appearance marked the 11th in the Big Dance. The Jackets fell to Kansas in the first round, traveling to Palo Alto, Calif., for the contest.

ACC WINS

Nell Fortner has guided Georgia Tech to three-straight seasons of double-digit ACC wins, marking the first time in program history for such a feat.

Prior to Fortner's arrival, Georgia Tech had posted double-digit ACC wins just once, going 12-4 in 2011-12. Tech's outright third-place finish in 2021 marked the best overall finish in program history as the Jackets tied for third in 2012.

WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returned two of its top three scorers from last season, and 41.2 percent of its scoring overall. Nerea Hermosa came back as the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 10.6 points per game as a junior. Tech had four players last season average 10.0 points per game or higher, led by Lotta-Maj Lahtinen at 10.9 ppg.

On the glass, Georgia Tech has big shoes to fill after losing its leading rebounder in Lorela Cubaj (11.1 rebounds per game). The Jackets return 34.8 percent of its rebounding this season, paced by Hermosa who averaged 5.6 rpg last season. Hermosa was the team's second leading rebounder after Cubaj as the Jackets have lost two of its top three rebounders (Digna Strautmane - 5.3 rpg).

WHAT'S NEW?

The Yellow Jackets will look quite a bit different this season, welcoming seven newcomers (three transfers plus four freshmen).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Georgia Tech will face a challenging schedule in 2022-23 with 12 teams having gone to postseason play in 2021-22. Of those 12 teams, 10 went to the NCAA Tournament, including five reaching the Sweet 16 or beyond.

The Yellow Jackets will also have some holiday fun, participating in the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Fla., over Thanksgiving week. Tech will face South Florida in the first game followed by either Air Force or Michigan in its second game. Tech has the potential to face Baylor, Belmont, Saint Louis or Villanova in the final game. The tournament will be played at Hertz Arena and streamed on FloHoops.

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 405-225 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last nine-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season. Last season, Tech defeated Kennesaw State in its home opener, 72-45.

HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

4th Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 372-225 (.625) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 12 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and four at Georgia Tech (2019-22) – and has compiled a 229-155 (.598) overall record in the college ranks.
