• Thursday's game in Coral Gables is UNC's second consecutive road game to open 2023. After this, the Tar Heels host Notre Dame on Sunday for the first homecourt action of the new year.

• UNC and Miami are meeting for the 28th time.

• Four Tar Heels are scoring between 16.2 and 12.5 points per game and all rank in the ACC's top 21 in scoring: Deja Kelly is fifth (16.25 ppg), Alyssa Ustby is ninth (14.0), Kennedy Todd-Williams is 12th (13.8 ppg) and Eva Hodgson is 21st (12.46 ppg).

• On Wednesday, Deja Kelly was announced as one of 25 players on the Midseason Watch List for the Wooden Award.

NOTING THE TAR HEELS

Heels vs. Hurricanes

The Tar Heels and Hurricanes are meeting for the 28th time in a series that dates back to the 1980-81 season. Carolina leads the series 15-12, but the Hurricanes have eight of the past 12 meetings.

- UNC won last season's game, 85-38 on Feb. 6 in Chapel Hill. The 47-point margin of victory was Carolina's largest in ACC play since the 2006-07 season. Deja Kelly scored a team-high 18 points, including four three-pointers in a row late in the second quarter. Kennedy Todd-Williams contributed 16 points, then equal to her career high.

UNC was 20-21 from the foul line and won the rebounding battle 53-34.

- Miami won the last match-up in Coral Gables, on Dec. 14, 2020. The Hurricanes led throughout the 67-63 win. The game was scheduled at the last minute after both teams had games postponed due to Covid protocols.

Alyssa Ustby came off the bench for a then-career-high 17 points and Deja Kelly scored 16, including nine in the final 1:14 as the Tar Heels cut the margin to two points but couldn't pull out the win.

- UNC trails 6-5 all-time in matchups played at Miami. The Tar Heels' last win in Coral Gables was in the 2014-15 season, 66-65 on Feb. 22, 2015. UNC took the lead on a pair of free throws by Jamie Cherry with 1.7 seconds to play.

Coming up

Next up is a home game for Carolina as the Tar Heels host No. 4 Notre Dame on Sunday. It will be UNC's fourth game of the season against a top-10 team and the third against a top-5 opponent. UNC is 1-1 against top-5 teams and 1-2 against teams ranked in the top 10.

No. 7 Virginia Tech 68, No. 13 UNC 65

BLACKSBURG, Va. – The North Carolina women's basketball team dropped a back-and-forth, hard-fought battle Sunday at No. 7 Virginia Tech, falling 68-65 in a game that included 26 lead changes.

No. 13 UNC is 9-4 (0-2 Atlantic Coast Conference) after a third straight loss, two of them to ranked teams and the other to a team poised to climb into the rankings. The Hokies improved to 12-2 overall and 2-2 in ACC play.

Junior Deja Kelly led the Tar Heels with 21 points, the third time in the last four games she's hit for at least 20. Freshman Paulina Paris came off the bench for 15 points, nine of them in the fourth quarter, to tie her career high. Junior Alyssa Ustby scored 12 despite playing just under 24 minutes because of foul trouble.

Virginia Tech guard Georgia Amore, who was honored in a pregame

Trending

- In a nod to Carolina's versatility, four different players have scored 20 or more points on 11 occasions in the season's first 13 games. (Kennedy Todd-Williams with 20 vs. Jackson State, at Indiana, and vs. Wofford, Destiny Adams with 23 vs South Carolina State, Deja Kelly with 24 vs James Madison, 29 vs Iowa State, 20 vs USC Upstate and FSU, and 21 at Virginia Tech; and Eva Hodgson with 21 vs. Oregon and 20 vs Wofford.) A fifth Tar Heel, Alyssa Ustby, has reached 19 on two occasions.
- No conference school has more players with multiple 20-point games than UNC. Carolina and Virginia Tech each have three players with two or more 20-point outings, the most in the league.
- Five Tar Heels have led the team in scoring or tied for the lead in at least one game this season.
- Carolina has four players ranked among the ACC's top 21 in scoring average (Kelly 5th, Ustby 9th, Todd-Williams 11th, Hodgson 21st).
- Alyssa Ustby ranks in the ACC's top 10 in scoring (9th), rebounding (4) and field goal percentage (4th). In ACC games only, she's the conference leader in field goal percentage, hitting 70 percent of her shots in UNC's two conference games.
- Eva Hodgson has hit at least one three in every game this season and is the only UNC player to have done so. She ranks fifth in the ACC in threes made (2.5 per game).
- UNC's 10 blocks against Iowa State were the most for a Tar Heel team since the 2017-18 season. Redshirt freshman Teonni Key had three in just 14 minutes of play. Carolina is averaging 4.77 per game, sixth in the ACC and 32nd nationally.
- Destiny Adams is 10th ACC in blocks with 1.2 per game in an average of 17.5 minutes per game on the court.
- Two Tar Heels rank among the ACC's top seven in assist-turnover ratio. Eva Hodgson is third (2.4) and Deja Kelly is seventh (2.2). UNC's team assist-turnover ratio of 1.18 is second in the ACC and 34th in the nation.
- Alyssa Ustby has hit double figures in rebounds seven times this season, including five of the past six games. The exception was Sunday's loss at Virginia Tech, in which she had five rebounds in 24 minutes of playing time.

More to Know

- Deja Kelly is 13 points from becoming the 29th player to score 1,000 career points at UNC. Thursday will be her 69th game as a Tar Heel – she has scored 987 points in 68 games, a career scoring average of 14.5 points per game. This year she's averaging a team-best 16.3.
- Following two comeback wins in Portland in November, UNC was recognized as the Team of the Week by NCAA.com. PKI MVP Deja Kelly was named ACC Player of the Week.
- Eva Hodgson ranks fourth among all active DI players in career free throw percentage, hitting 88.2 of her foul shots in her fourth season of collegiate play. She's 13th in career three-point percentage at 41.4.
- With 11 free throws in the game against Michigan, Deja Kelly passed 250 makes for her career, which is the minimum for inclusion on the NCAA's career leaders list. With a career free throw percentage of 81.0, she ranks 31st among all DI players.
- According to @OptaSTATS, the Twitter platform of StatsPerform.com, Alyssa Ustby's line against Jackson State was historic: with 19 points, 10 rebounds, 5 assists, 3 blocks and 2 steals in 19 minutes, she's the only player (including DI men and women, NBA and WNBA) in the past 15 years with 15+ points, 10+ rebounds, 5+ assists, 2+ blocks and 2+ steals in under 20 minutes.
- Although there are three seniors on this year's team, forward Malu Tshitenge is the only fourth-year UNC player. She's the sole Tar Heel who was part of coach Courtney Banghart's first squad.



ceremony for recently registering the program's first triple-double, led all scorers with 24 points, including six three-pointers and 4-5 shooting from the foul line in 40 minutes on the court.

UNC started 0-3 from the field with the first basket of 2023 not coming until almost four minutes in on a jumper from Kennedy Todd-Williams. The home team led 16-14 after the first quarter and the Hokies were still up by two at halftime, 37-35.

Throughout the course of the game, neither team led by more than six, which was Carolina's advantage midway through the third period.

The Hokies' biggest lead was four, midway through the second period.

UNC took a four-point lead (62-58) on a pull-up jumper by Kelly with 4:15 to play, and the Tar Heels were still up by two with 2:55 remaining after a bucket by Paris. Virginia Tech's D'asia Gregg made a three with 1:45 to play to put her team up by one and the Tar Heels never led again, although they tied the score at 65-65 on a free throw by Anya Poole with 56 remaining. The only scoring after that came on three free throws by Amooore that put the Hokies up with a second to play.

Virginia Tech hit 12 three-pointers, equal to the second-highest total of the season by a Tar Heel opponent. The Hokies' .875 free throw percentage (14-16) was a high by a UNC opponent.

UNC took 10 foul shots, a season low, and made eight of them. The Tar Heels forced 20 turnovers while committing only 10 and outscored the Hokies 28-14 in the paint.

Both Ustby and Kelly were hampered by fouls through much of the game, with Kelly fouling out with 1:23 remaining.

Strong Core Returning

UNC had the same starting lineup in all 32 games last season and four of those players return to this year's team. The lone departure is point guard Carlie Littlefield, who spent one season at UNC as a graduate transfer from Princeton and is now playing professionally in Belgium while working remotely toward her MBA from UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School.

The other four returning starters are all juniors this season: guard Deja Kelly, wings Kennedy Todd-Williams and Alyssa Ustby, and post Anya Poole. UNC also returns sixth-man Eva Hodgson, who came off the bench to play in 31 games and averaged 9.1 ppg. The Tar Heels return eight of their top nine scores from last season, with Littlefield the exception.

- The four returning starters were in for the opening tip in the first two games, along with senior Eva Hodgson, the first player off the bench last season. Against South Carolina State, Deja Kelly sat out for precautionary measures and sophomore Destiny Adams made her first career start. Since then, the Tar Heels have been back to the starting lineup of Hodgson, Kelly, Todd-Williams, Ustby and Poole.

Top-10 Incoming Class

A class of four is headed for Chapel Hill after signing with the Tar Heels in November. RyLee Grays, Laila Hull, Reniya Kelly and Ciera Toomey will join the Tar Heel program ahead of the 2023-24 season.

"My staff and I search tirelessly for the right combination of talent, character, and a relentless and winning mentality to add to our Tar Heel program," coach Courtney Banghart said. "These four student-athletes bring exactly what we need. They offer size, versatility, toughness, and a relentless work ethic. RyLee, Laila, Reniya, and Ciera come to Chapel Hill excited to wear the Carolina blue and to help us take important steps forward as a program."

Toomey, ranked fourth in the class of 2023, is a five-star recruit. Kelly (No. 30), Grays (No. 90) and Hull are four-star recruits. Together they're ranked as the nation's No. 9 recruiting class.

This class is the third in Banghart's four seasons at UNC to be ranked among the nation's top 11.

Noting the 2021-22 Team

- UNC reached the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2015, falling to South Carolina, the eventual NCAA Champion.

- UNC led the ACC and ranked fourth nationally in defensive efficiency. The Tar Heels held opponents to .77 points per possession. Nationally, Carolina ranked behind UCF, South Carolina and Princeton in that stat.

- The Tar Heels were one of the final three teams to stand undefeated, winning their first 13 games before suffering their first loss on Jan. 6 at NC State.

- The NCAA Tournament second round win at Arizona was UNC's ninth true road win of the season, matching 2005-06 for the most in program history. The team's 5-4 ACC road record was its first winning ACC road record since 2013-14.

- The Tar Heels moved into the coaches' poll at No. 24 the week of Dec. 6 and into the AP poll at No. 25 the following week. During the season, UNC got as high as 16th in the AP poll and 15th in the coaches' poll. The 2021-22 spot marked UNC's first appearance in the polls since the 2015-16 preseason polls.

Storylines

- Eva Hodgson is in her second year of the MBA program at UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School after completing her undergraduate degree in business analytics in three years at William & Mary. After graduating in May, she hopes to play basketball overseas and then work in consulting.

She is one of seven Hodgson children and her family runs a Christian retreat center in Rindge, N.H., called Toah Nipi (TOE-uh NIP-ee, which means "wide water"). The center can accommodate up to 200 guests and Eva worked there often growing up. She continues to pitch in when at home and also helps with marketing remotely while she's in Chapel Hill. When there in person, a favorite role is cooking and baking for the guests, with carrot cake her specialty.

- Deja Kelly serves as an anchor for Sports Xtra, a student-run sports TV show through UNC's Hussman School of Journalism and Media. She hopes to work as a sports broadcaster after graduation.

- Alyssa Ustby continues to burnish her reputation for versatility, one she brought with her to Chapel Hill after excelling in three sports (soccer and softball were the other two) in high school. At UNC's spring football game in April, she won the women's Punt, Pass and Kick competition by kicking a 35-yard field goal. Later that week, she was named to the Academic All-ACC team, which takes into account both academics and athletics. (She was also named to the All-ACC second team for 2021-22.) In August, she was named to the USA Basketball Under 23 3x3 Team and represented the U.S. in the Dominican Republic in August and then in Romania in September. Playing a game that prizes versatility, she says, has made her that much more versatile a player. Additionally, she has done a series of off-season TikToks training with other Carolina teams (including gymnastics, softball, swimming and soccer) and trying out skills from their sports.

- Anya Poole's first sporting love was soccer and she played it through eighth grade, when she was already 6-2 and was told her height would be better utilized on the volleyball or basketball courts.

- Assistant coaches Joanne Aluka-White and Itoro Coleman, whose friendship dates back to high school in Hephzibah, Ga., were teammates on Nigeria's National Team at the 2004 Athens Olympics.

- Assistant coach Adrian Walters started his coaching career with the men's program at Gallaudet University in Washington, D.C., where he was an assistant coach for two years and the head coach for one. He learned sign language while coaching there and is still fluent.

COURTNEY BANGHART

Head Coach • Fourth season at UNC, 16th season as a head coach



The 2022-23 season is the fourth at UNC for head coach Courtney Banghart, who has transformed the Tar Heel roster and led the team to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022.

Banghart was announced on April 30, 2019 as North Carolina's head coach, the first new face in the position since 1986. She came to Chapel Hill after 12 years as the head coach at Princeton, where her teams won seven Ivy League crowns and made eight NCAA Tournament appearances. (Before her arrival, Princeton hadn't reached the tournament even once.)

A New Hampshire native, Banghart was a three-year starter at Dartmouth, where she twice earned All-Ivy honors. She still holds the Ivy League record for career three-pointers (273) and as a senior competed in the three-point shooting contest at Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse during the men's Final Four in Indianapolis.

Including a WNIT appearance at Princeton, Banghart has led her teams to 11 postseason appearances in 15 seasons as a head coach.

More on Banghart:

- She was the 2015 Naismith National Coach of the Year and is the only current ACC coach to have won that honor.
- A player she coached was picked in the top 10 in back-to-back WNBA Drafts (Stephanie Watts from UNC 10th in 2021, Bella Alarie from Princeton 5th in 2020)
- In 2015 she was named to Fortune's list of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders. Also on the list that year: Pope Francis, Bill and Melinda Gates, Chief Justice John Roberts Jr., LeBron James, Elon Musk and Taylor Swift.
- She holds a bachelor's degree in neuroscience and a master's degree in writing and leadership, both from Dartmouth. Her graduate thesis was on sport leadership.
- She hitchhiked through Alaska after college (after ditching the outdoor leadership course in which she was enrolled) and has bungeed off a jump in Switzerland that was then the highest in the world.
- Right around the time she got the Princeton job, she and her brother were finalists to appear on "The Amazing Race."
- A four-time soccer state champion in high school, she planned to play that sport at Dartmouth until a coaching change made her rethink her path and talk the women's basketball coach into giving her a spot. (She also won two high school state titles in basketball and three in tennis.)
- She's mom to three kids under the age of 9.

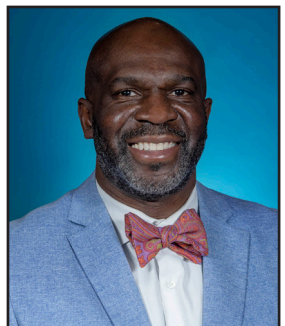
