» THE OPENING TIP

- » The Blue Devils are back at Cameron for a Sunday afternoon tilt, playing host to Miami in their Play4Kay game on Feb. 12 at 2 p.m., live on RSN.
- » Dean Linke and Tabitha Turner will call the action on RSN while Chris Edwards calls the game on the radio on the Blue Devil Sports Network from Learfield.
- » Boasting a 21-3 overall record and an 11-2 record in ACC play, the Blue Devils are having their best season dating back to the 2013-14 campaign.
- » In its game against Boston College on Thursday, Duke commanded the game from start to finish en route to a dominant, 68-27, victory - picking up the program's 1,000th victory.
- » With the win, the Blue Devils became the fourth ACC school and 24th program overall to achieve the feat.
- » Duke checked in at No. 9 in the Week 14 Associated Press (AP) and No. 11 in the USA Today Coaches Polls.
- » It marks the Blue Devils' first appearance in the top 10 since 2016-17, when Duke finished the year ranked ninth in the final AP poll of the regular season.
- » In the latest NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) rankings, Duke is slotted eighth (as of Feb. 10).
- » Defense has been the calling card for the Blue Devils this season as the team has won each of its games by an average of 20.8 points and held each of its opponents below their season scoring average, including 13 of the 24 to 50 points or less.
- » Elizabeth Balogun was tabbed as one of 10 players selected to the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Mid-Season Top-10 list while Celeste Taylor was named to the 2023 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year 2023 Watch List.
- » Duke has held its foes to 50.7 points per game on 34.4 percent shooting from the floor, marks that currently rank second and eighth in the NCAA, respectively, as well as first in the ACC (as of Feb. 10).
- » The Blue Devils have received a huge lift from their reserves, averaging 24.5 points off the bench.

- » Oliver has made an immediate impact for the Blue Devils and has done an excellent job of taking care of the rock, totaling a team-high 57 assists to just 27 turnovers for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.1. Her 2.38 assists per game is second on the team.
- » Oliver has dished out at least three assists in nine games, which includes a six assist and zero turnover outing vs. Charleston Southern and pair of seven assist to zero turnover performances in back-to-back games against Northwestern and at Richmond.
- » With her 437 minutes played on the year, Oliver has also surpassed her minutes total from her freshman (220) and sophomore (279) seasons.

IN ELITE COMPANY

- » The Blue Devils are the only women's basketball team so far this season to shoot 100 percent from the charity stripe and 64 percent or higher from beyond the arc in the same game, according to HerHoopStats.
- » Duke cashed in nine of its 14 three-point attempts and went 15-of-15 from the foul line in the win over the Wolfpack.
- » After tallying 15 points, six rebounds, four assists and four steals against Syracuse, Celeste Taylor joined Chelsea Gray (3X), Haley Gorecki (4X), and Lexie Brown (4X) as the only Duke women's basketball players since 2009-2010 to post multiple career games of 15+ Points, 5+ Rebounds, 4+ Assists, and 4+ Steals, according to HerHoopStats.

A QUICK LOOK AT THE HURRICANES

- » Miami enters the weekend tilt with the 16-8 overall record that includes a 9-4 mark in conference play.
- » Haley Cavinder and Destiny Harden lead the team in scoring at 12.8 and 12.2 points per game, respectively. Harden paces the squad on the boards (5.3) while Ja'Leah Williams averages a team-best 2.7 assists per game.

SISTERHOOD TIES

- » Miami head coach Katie Meier shares ties with #TheSisterhood having played for the Blue Devils from 1986-90. The former Duke women's basketball standout earned ACC Rookie of the Year and Basketball Yearbook Freshman All-America honors in 1986, as well as Kodak/WBCA District 2 All-America and All-ACC first team accolades in 1990.
- » A 2002 Duke Hall of Honor inductee, Meier has her fingerprints all over the Duke record books as she ranks seventh all-time in program lore in scoring (1,761) while also being tied for fourth in career scoring average (16.2).
- » Meier is one of just seven players in Duke history to record a triple-double in a game - dropping 16 points, 11 rebounds, 10 assists vs. Manhattan on March 11, 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- » The No. 9 Duke women's basketball team flexed its muscle Thursday night as the Blue Devils commanded the game from start to finish en route to a dominant, 68-27, victory over Boston College in ACC action at Conte Forum.
- » Duke finished the game with three in double figures, led by Reigan Richardson's season high 14 points. Celeste Taylor tallied 11 points and four rebounds while Jordyn Oliver matched her season-high with 10 points to go with four boards and dishing out two assists.
- » Vanessa de Jesus dropped a team-high three dimes while Elizabeth Balogun led the way on the glass with six rebounds.

JADYN DONOVAN NAMED MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN

- » Duke women's basketball signee Jadyn Donovan was selected as one of 24 high school seniors selected to the McDonald's All-America team on Tuesday afternoon.
- » A native of Washington, D.C., Donovan has led Sidwell Friends High School to another impressive season as the Quakers currently check in at No. 2 in the MaxPreps High School Girls Basketball Rankings and have compiled a 14-2 overall record and 4-0 mark in conference play.
- » Currently ranked the No. 3 player in the 2023 Class, Donovan averaged 15.2 points, 8.4 rebounds and 3.3 steals per game during the 2021-22 season while helping lead Sidwell Friends to an unblemished 30-0 record, the DCSAA Championship and the No. 1 overall team ranking.
- » Donovan is the 34th Blue Devil to be selected as a McDonald's All-American.
- » The 2023 McDonald's All American game will be played on Tuesday, March 28 at the Toyota Center at 6:30 p.m. ET on ESPN2.

HEIDE NAMED TO 20TH WBCA 'SO YOU WANT TO BE A COACH' CLASS

- » Duke women's basketball graduate student Mia Heide was named as one of 62 individuals selected to the 20th 'So You Want To Be A Coach' class, the Women's Basketball Coaches Association, in partnership with WeCOACH, announced on Tuesday.
- » Each student-athlete will participate in the two-day workshop on March 30-31 during the 2023 WBCA Convention in Dallas.
- » The "So" program increases the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increases the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching.
- » The program also introduces female basketball players to coaches and administrators and raises awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

BLUE DEVILS SIGN THREE DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

- » Duke women's basketball head coach Kara Lawson announced the three members of the Blue Devils' 2023 recruiting class with the signing of Jadyn Donovan (No. 3), Oluchi Okananwa (No. 27) and Delaney Thomas (No. 29) during the NCAA's early signing period.
- » The three signees comprise the No. 6 class in the country -- Duke's highest class ranking since 2012.

- » The 2023 class marks Duke's first recruiting haul with a player ranked in the top-five nationally by ESPN since the 2015 class, as well as the first group since the 2014 class with at least three prospects ranked in the ESPN top 30.

- » **Oluchi Okananwa** -- 5-10 | G | Boston, Mass. | Worcester Academy

LAWSON ENTERS THIRD SEASON

- » Head coach Kara Lawson enters her third year at the helm of the Duke women's basketball program.
- » In her second season, Lawson led Duke to a 17-13 overall record, featuring a pair of top-25 victories over No. 9/12 Iowa (Dec. 2) and No. 17 Notre Dame (Jan. 2).
- » The 2021-22 season also saw Lawson guide the Blue Devils to their first national ranking since the 2018-19 preseason, ranking as high as 15th nationally in the AP poll.

FRESH FACES

- » The Blue Devils feature eight new faces on the roster as the team welcomes five transfers and three freshmen into the fold.
- » Duke added a veteran presence with the additions of grad transfers Taya Corosdale (Oregon State) and Mia Heide (Tulane), while also gaining two promising young players with collegiate experience in junior Kennedy Brown (Oregon State) and sophomore Reigan Richardson (Georgia).
- » The quartet has combined to play in 321 career games with 234 starts, totaling 7,678 minutes of action. They have scored 1,941 points, grabbed 1,733 boards, dished 460 assists and blocked 333 shots.
- » Duke's freshman trio is comprised of 2022 McDonald's All-America and Jordan Brand Classic selection Ashlon Jackson (China, Texas), McDonald's All-America nominee Shay Bollin (Raynham, Mass.) and 2021 U19 Canadian National Team member Emma Koabel (Port Colborne, Ont., Canada).
- » Duke also returns nine letterwinners from a season ago, including several key contributors - sophomore Shayeann Day-Wilson, seniors Elizabeth Balogun and Celeste Taylor and junior Vanessa de Jesus.

THREE TABBED TO PRESEASON AWARD WATCH LISTS

- » The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced its preseason watchlists for national positional awards, with three Blue Devils earning recognition.

- » Sophomore Shayeann Day-Wilson entered the 2022-23 campaign after winning 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year honors - the first Blue Devil to achieve the feat since Elizabeth Williams in 2012, while also earning a nod to the ACC All-Freshman Team.
- » Day-Wilson enjoyed one of the best rookie seasons in Blue Devil history as she led Duke, along with all ACC freshmen, in scoring with 368 points (12.7 ppg). Her 368 points rank No. 10 on Duke's freshman record charts.
- » She was one of only four true freshmen in the nation and the only rookie in power five conferences to average 12.3 points and 3.5 assists.
- » The Toronto, Ontario native became just the fifth Blue Devil to earn the honor, joining Alana Beard (2001), Katie Meier (1986), Chris Moreland (1985) and Elizabeth Williams (2012). Current Duke senior Elizabeth Balogun also earned ACC Freshman of the Year accolades when she was a rookie in 2018-19 at Georgia Tech.
- » Day-Wilson notched 23 games with three-or-more assists and four contests with 20-or-more points.
- » Day-Wilson is the 24th Blue Devil to be selected to the ACC All-Freshman team. She earned a trio of ACC Freshman of the Week honors during the season, becoming just the seventh Duke player to earn the accolade three-or-more times.
- » She also etched her name in the top 10 of several Duke record lists.

HEAD COACH KARA LAWSON



BIO SNAPSHOT

Former WNBA and Olympic Champion Kara Lawson was named Duke University's sixth head women's basketball coach on July 11, 2020. Lawson enters her third year at the helm in 2022-23.

Lawson brought her decorated basketball career, both on and off the court, to the Blue Devils after spending the 2020 season as an assistant coach with the Boston Celtics. She helped Boston to a 43-21 record and a third-place standing in the Eastern Conference prior to the stoppage of the 2019-20 NBA season due to COVID-19. Lawson was the Celtics first female coach in the franchise's 73-year history.

Lawson helped Team USA make history in the summer of 2021 as she guided the United States 3x3 Women's National Team to a gold medal in its Olympic debut in Tokyo. It marked her 10th overall gold medal in USA Basketball competition and seventh as a coach. Lawson is one of only three women in Olympic history to win gold as both a player and head coach in basketball, joining Anne Donovan and Dawn Staley.

Her impact on the women's basketball community is evident as she was named one of the 100 most influential people in women's college basketball, as announced by Silver Waves Media in the summer of 2020. Lawson is also a founding board member for the Boston Celtics United for Social Justice.

Following an exceptional playing career, Lawson spent two years as the primary television analyst for the Washington Wizards while also broadcasting games for ESPN Radio. In addition to her role covering the Wizards for NBC Sports Washington, Lawson served as a game and studio analyst for men's and women's college basketball and the NBA for ESPN. On January 12, 2007, she became the first female analyst for a nationally-televised NBA game. Lawson also served as a color announcer during the 2021 Olympics in Tokyo with NBC.

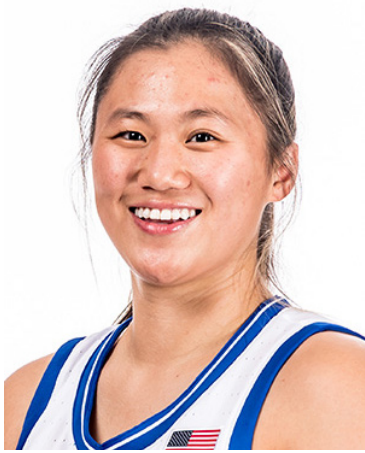
