NEED TO KNOW

- » Putting its three-game winning streak on the line, Duke heads to No. 23 Miami on Big Monday looking for the season sweep of the Hurricanes.
- » A pair of teams in the top six of the ACC standings, Duke and Miami are within 1.5 games of first-place Clemson heading into Monday's showdown. Duke is at 9-3 Virginia on Saturday.
- » Freshman **Kyle Filipowski**, staking his claim as the ACC Rookie of the Year, leads all conference freshmen in scoring, rebounding and double-doubles. He has 11 doubles-doubles, including a monster current seven-game stretch averaging 20.0 points and 11.1 boards.
- » The seven-time ACC Rookie of the Week, Filipowski is the only freshman nationally averaging at least 15 points and nine rebounds this season.
- » Guards junior **Jeremy Roach** and freshman **Tyrese Proctor** combined for 69 points in Duke's wins last week over Wake Forest and North Carolina. Roach has posted consecutive 20-point games for the first time in his career, while Proctor is averaging 9.0 for the season, including 12.4 points and a 2.5 assist-turnover ratio over the last seven games.
- » Freshman **Dereck Lively II** (right) had a career highs for rebounds (14) and blocks (eight) in Saturday's win over UNC -- the most blocks by a Blue Devil all-time vs. UNC and the second most blocks in a game by any player in college basketball this season.
- » Lively is second in the ACC and 16th nationally in blocks (2.3). He has 20 over the last five.
- » Duke has out-rebounded 19 of its first 23 opponents and is 16-3 this season when holding an advantage on the glass. Duke is 13-3 when leading in offensive rebounding.
- » The ACC's best rebounding team, Duke ranks third nationally in rebound margin (+9.0), ninth in offensive rebounds (13.4) and 10th in rebounds per game (40.0) -- leading the ACC in each.
- » Duke and Tennessee are the only teams ranked inside the NCAA's top 10 for each rebound margin, offensive rebounds and total rebounds.
- » Duke has held 20 of 23 teams below their season scoring average, ranking second in the ACC and 33rd nationally in scoring defense (63.4). UNC was the most recent of nine teams this season to post a then season-low in points versus the Blue Devils.

DUKE GAME NOTES

Scheyer In First Season as Head Coach

- » Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain **Jon Scheyer** is the 20th head coach in Duke's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.
- » The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic's* 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.
- » He has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.
- » As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. Over his previous nine years on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).
- » The Northbrook, Ill., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign. Duke announced its five-man 2023-24 class this week, which includes five top-50 players and is currently ranked as the No. 2 class by ESPN and 247Sports.
- » Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in 10 seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
- » Among Scheyer's personnel moves in June were the hiring of **Jai Lucas** as an assistant coach and the promotion of **Amile Jefferson** to assistant coach. Scheyer also added **Mike Schrage** as special assistant to the head coach and **Rachel Baker** as general manager.

Filipowski's Last Seven Games: 20.0 Points, 11.1 Rebounds, Five Double-Doubles

- » **Kyle Filipowski**, the seven-time ACC Rookie of the Week, enters Monday's game at Miami having scored 140 points with 78 rebounds over the last seven games while shooting .451 (46-of-102) from the field -- included in that span are 28 points and a career-best 15 rebounds vs. Pitt and a career-high 29 points and 10 rebounds at Virginia Tech.
- » He is the only freshman nationally averaging at least 15 points (15.7) and nine rebounds (9.3), and his averages increase to 16.4 and 9.6 in ACC play.
- » He is just the third Duke freshmen all-time to have at least 28-15 in a game, joining Bagley (four times in 2017-18) and Parker (once in 2013-14).
- » His 11 double-doubles lead all D-1 freshmen, while his 9.3 rebounds per game are fifth in the ACC and the most by a power conference freshman.
- » Filipowski is the first Blue Devil since Bagley in 2017-18 to record at least three consecutive games with at least 17 points and 14 rebounds -- that streak was snapped with his 29-10 performance at Virginia Tech.
- » Has scored in double-figures in 21 times this season, including in each of the first 12 games and each of the last nine games.

Filipowski Awards Watch

- » **Kyle Filipowski** is the seven-time ACC Rookie of the Week, winning the award in each of the last three weeks after becoming the first freshman in league history to open a season with four-consecutive Rookie of the Week honors.
- » Now with seven ACC Rookie of the Week honors, he is tied with former Blue Devil **Marvin Bagley III** for the sixth most in a season in conference history -- the ACC record of 10 is held by Duke's **Jabari Parker** (2014), UNC's Tyler Hansbrough (2006) and GT's Kenny Anderson (1990).
- » In ACC history, the six previous players to win seven or more Rookie of the Week awards went on to be named ACC Rookie of the Year.
- » He is one of just two freshman on the 20-player late-season watch list for the John R. Wooden Award, joining Alabama's Brandon Miller.

Proctor Emerging for Blue Devils

- » Freshman guard **Tyrese Proctor** was originally committed to Duke's 2023 class, but made the decision to reclassify for this season in June 2022.
- » In the absence of junior starting guard **Jeremy Roach** (who missed three consecutive games in January with a toe injury), Proctor stepped up to handle point guard duties. Finding his groove over the last seven games, Proctor is Duke's third-leading scorer in that stretch at 12.4 points -- double figures six times -- with 30 assists and 12 turnovers in the span (2.5 assist-turnover ratio).
- » He scored 17 points in last Tuesday's win over Wake to match a career high, and scored 11 with seven rebounds, five assists and two steals in a career-high 38 minutes in the UNC win Saturday.
- » Proctor's 2.16 assist-turnover ratio in conference play ranks ninth.
- » Proctor became Duke's first Aussie-born player to post a double-double with 13 points, 10 rebounds and four assists vs. Delaware.

The Captain Sets Tone, Seals Win Over Tar Heels

- » Junior captain **Jeremy Roach**, Duke's only returning player that saw significant playing time from last year's Final Four run, led all scorers in Saturday's 63-57 win over North Carolina with 20 points -- his second straight 20-point game for the first time in his career.
- » Roach set the tone early -- scoring the Blue Devils' first five points of the game -- and sealed the victory by scoring Duke's final four points and eight of the team's final 10, helping Duke pull away after the game was tied at 47-47 and again at 57-57.
- » Roach is averaging 14.6 points over the last five games and is on pace for a career scoring year at 12.6 points this season.

Healthy Lively Paying Dividends for Duke

- » A calf injury held 7-foot-1 freshman **Dereck Lively II** out for much of the preseason, but the No. 1 recruit in this year's class and the preseason ACC Rookie of the Year is finding his stride of late with 5.7 points and 7.1 rebounds and 22 blocked shots (3.1) over the last seven games.
- » The versatile big, who has the skill and quickness to guard all five positions, has emerged as one of the best rim protectors nationally.
- » Coming off a monster 14-rebound, eight-block game against the Tar Heels, Lively's 2.3 blocks per game rank second in the ACC, 16th nationally and lead all power conference freshman.
- » His eight blocks Saturday were the most by a Duke player all-time vs. UNC, the second most by a Duke freshman in any game all-time and the second most by any Division-I player this season behind nine from Indiana's Trayce Jackson-Davis vs. Kansas in December.
- » Lively's eight rejections were two shy of Duke's single-game record for blocked shots (set by **Cherokee Parks** and **Shelden Williams**) and one shy of **Mike Gminski's** freshmen record.
- » Duke's field goal percentage defense at the rim is 11 percentage points better with Lively on the floor this season. Opponents are shooting 42 percent on field goals inside three feet with Lively on the court against 53 percent without him on the floor.
- » Lively has blocked at least one shot in 20 of his 21 games played this season. He has 11 games with multiple blocks and six games with three or more. His block rate this season of 9.1 percent is second in the ACC and eighth nationally.

Blue Devils Allowing 63.4 Points -- Second in ACC and 33rd Nationally in Scoring Defense; Leads ACC in Three-Point Defense

- » Duke is second in the ACC and 33rd nationally in scoring defense, yielding just 63.4 points per game. Sixteen teams have been held to less than 70 points, while nine have failed to score more than 60.
- » Duke has held 20 of the 23 opponents to below their season scoring average -- Duke is 17-3 in those games. Nine scored a then-season low for points, including holding Iowa to a then-season-low 62, Xavier to 64 (20 points below its average), Miami to a season-low tying 66 (12 off its scoring average), Georgia Tech to a season-low 43 and North Carolina to a season-low 57 (21 off its average). The Hurricanes' also shot their lowest field goal percentage of the year vs. Duke (.349).
- » Duke's strong defensive numbers come against a schedule rated 23rd-toughest versus opponent offenses (per KenPom).
- » Thirteen opponents this season have failed to top 30 percent from behind the arc, as Duke leads the ACC and is 22nd nationally in three-point defense (.299).
- » Duke defeated Georgia Tech on the road Jan. 28, 86-43, holding the Yellow Jackets to 18 second-half points and winning by 43 -- Duke's second-largest road ACC win in school history and just the third 40-point ACC road win all-time by the Blue Devils.
- » The 43 points were tied for the second fewest allowed by Duke in an ACC road game all-time and its fewest allowed since beating Notre Dame, 57-43, last season in South Bend.
- » The 57 points by UNC were its fewest in Durham since an 82-50 Duke win on **Jon Scheyer's** Senior Night in 2010.

DUKE GAME NOTES

Scheyer Ties ACC Record for Longest Home Winning Streak by First-Year ACC Coach

- » Duke has opened the season winning its first 12 home games, as head coach **Jon Scheyer** has tied the ACC record for longest home court winning streak by a first-year head coach.
- » North Carolina's Hubert Davis also won 12 consecutive games at home in his first year in 2021-22 -- a streak that was snapped by Duke's 87-67 win on Feb. 5.
- » Scheyer becomes the first in program history to defeat Carolina as both a player and head coach. He is now 1-0 in the rivalry as a head coach, won three games as a player and 11 as a Duke assistant coach.

Bedeveled By Injuries

- » The Blue Devils have dealt with their fair share of injuries this season, beginning in the preseason when Duke was without both freshmen **Dariq Whitehead** (foot fracture) and **Dereck Lively II** (calf) for an extended period of time. Lively missed the season opener and Whitehead made his debut in limited minutes on Nov. 18 vs. Delaware.
- » Junior **Jeremy Roach** sustained a toe injury on Nov. 27 vs. Purdue, played through the injury for three games before missing the game vs. UMES on Dec. 10. He returned for three more games and then missed the next three in early January as he dealt with the same injury.
- » Both Whitehead and Lively missed Duke's game at Wake Forest on Dec. 20 due to illness.
- » Sophomore **Jaylen Blakes** sustained a broken nose in practice on Jan. 17 and has played limited minutes over the last five games with a custom-fitted, 3-D printed mask.
- » Whitehead left the game at Virginia Tech on Jan. 23 with a lower leg injury and has not played since.
- » Duke has played just 12 of its 23 games, and had no more than 10 practices this season, with its full roster of scholarship players available.

Duke: NCAA's Top 10 for Rebounds, Offensive Rebounds and Rebound Margin; No. 2 in Offensive Rebound Percentage

- » Duke has been among the nation's best rebounding teams this season, ranked No. 2 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (37.9), third nationally in rebound margin (+9.0), ninth in offensive rebounds per game (13.4) and 10th in total rebounds per game (40.0) -- leads the ACC in each category.
- » Duke and Tennessee are the only teams ranked inside the NCAA's top 10 for each rebound margin, offensive rebounds and total rebounds.
- » Leading the ACC in rebounding, Duke is looking to finish as the conference's leader in total rebounds per game for the first time since 1998-99.
- » The Blue Devils have out-rebounded 19 of their first 23 opponents, including 10 by double-digit margins. Duke opened the season with a double-digit rebound margin in each of the first six games -- the program record for longest such streak (at any point in a season). Duke had five-game streaks in 2017-18, 1998-98, 1962-63 and 1960-61.
- » Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Duke is 48-7 when out-rebounding its opponent (16-3 this season).
- » Offensive rebounding has been a significant strength, with Duke totaling 20+ on the offensive glass four times already -- the Blue Devils hadn't had more than 19 offensive boards in any game over each of the last two seasons.
- » Duke is +111 (300-189) in second-chance scoring this season and Duke is 11-4 in games this season when leading in second-chance scoring.
- » Individually, freshman **Kyle Filipowski** is 30th nationally and fifth in the ACC in rebounds (9.3) and leads all power conference freshmen. Filipowski (2.8) and graduate **Ryan Young** (2.8) are each fourth in the ACC in offensive rebounds

Blue Devils Out-Dunking Teams 74-32

- » Duke is out-dunking the opposition 74-32, led by **Dereck Lively II**'s 32 and **Mark Mitchell**'s 19 slams.
- » Lively is 40-of-69 from the field with 32 of his 40 career field goals being dunks.

Current Freshman Class Ranked No. 1 Nationally; Next Year's Class Ranked No. 2 -- Duke's Ninth and 10th Consecutive Top-3 Class

- » In the first class recruited and signed by Scheyer, Duke's freshman class was ranked No. 1 in ESPN's 2022-23 class rankings.
- » Duke announced the signing of Scheyer's second class this week, which is on pace to finish No. 2 in ESPN's 2023-24 class rankings.
- » The current class is led by ESPN's overall top two players -- **Dereck Lively II** and **Dariq Whitehead** and was boosted even more when five-star guard **Tyrese Proctor** reclassified.
- » The class includes three McDonald's All-Americans (Lively, Mitchell, Whitehead), three named the Gatorade Player of the Year in their state (Lively, Schutt, Whitehead) and three that participated in the Jordan Brand All-Star Game (Filipowski, Lively, Whitehead).
- » Next season's five-man class has each of the five ranked in 247Sports' top 25, with four in the top 20, led by the No. 5 overall player in forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** (pronounced "em-BAH-ko"). Three of the signees are ranked as the overall No. 1 player in their respective state - forward **Sean Stewart** (Florida), **Caleb Foster** (California) and **TJ Power** (Massachusetts). The class also includes the No. 18 overall player in guard **Jared McCain**.
- » Including the 2023-24 class, Scheyer has helped Duke sign a top-three class in each of his 10 seasons on the staff, including the No. 1 class five times (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).

25 Blue Devils on Current NBA Rosters; Three Named All-Star Game Starters

- » Duke has 25 members of The Brotherhood on NBA rosters, including three of the 10 starters for the upcoming NBA All-Star game in Boston's **Jayson Tatum**, Brooklyn's **Kyrie Irving** and New Orleans' **Zion Williamson**.
- » The 25 includes two-way and inactive lists and is comprised of any Blue Devil that played and finished their college basketball careers at Duke.
- » Duke's players are spread across the country at a total of 17 NBA franchises, including a trio of Blue Devils with the Knicks (**Cam Reddish**, **Trevor Keels**, **RJ Barrett**), and duos in Atlanta (**Jalen Johnson**, **AJ Griffin**), Brooklyn (Irving, **Seth Curry**), Charlotte (**Mark Williams**, **Mason Plumlee**), Orlando (**Paolo Banchemo**, **Wendell Carter Jr.**), Minnesota (**Wendell Moore Jr.**, **Austin Rivers**) and New Orleans (**Williamson**, **Brandon Ingram**).
- » The overall No. 1 pick in the 2022 NBA Draft, Banchemo was the fifth Blue Devil drafted No. 1 overall - joining active players Irving and Williamson - as Duke boasts the most No. 1 picks in NBA history. The Blue Devils have also produced 29 Lottery picks, an NBA draft record for a single school.
- » Duke's 25 NBA players - the second most on opening-day rosters behind Kentucky's 27 - also join more than 30 former players, coaches, managers and Duke graduates that serve on NBA coaching staffs or in front office roles. That includes 1984 Duke graduate **Adam Silver** as NBA Commissioner.

Duke's Social Presence Soars in 2022

- » Duke continues to set the standard in college sports in the social media space and is coming off a year of record-setting growth in the 2022 calendar year.
- » The Blue Devils continue to have the most followers of any collegiate team nationally across all DukeMBB platforms with 5.16 million, topping Alabama Football's 3.65 million for most collegiately.
- » Duke generated 613 million total impressions across all DukeMBB platforms, generating over \$4 million in brand value for Duke.
- » The program boasted 46.3 million social engagements across all platforms in 2022 -- a 51% increase from 2021 and tops in college sports.
- » It gained 390,644 followers (a 1003% increase in follower gain from 2021) and generated 148 million video views across all platforms (138% increase from 2021).
- » No team in college sports generated more YouTube watch hours in 2022 than Duke's 163,000 -- thanks in part to the team's Duke Blue Planet series, which has twice earned the Sports Video Group (SVG) award for best series in college athletics.

Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain Jon Scheyer is the 20th head coach in Duke University's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Fame head coach Mike Krzyzewski, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.

While Scheyer enters his first season as head coach in 2022-23, he has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.

The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic's* 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.

As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. In his previous time on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).

The Northbrook, Ill., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign.

Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in nine seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
