#### **NEED TO KNOW**

Scored 22 points (8/10 FG, 4/6 3FG, 2/2 FT) in just 15 minutes vs. Pitt (3/9)

- Putting its season-long seven-game win streak on the line, No. 21 Duke battles No. 14 Miami in the semifinals of the 2023 ACC Tournament on Friday night at Greensboro Coliseum.
- The Blue Devils are the winningest ACC Tournament team all-time with more wins (108), titles (21) and a better winning percentage (.701) than any team in the league.
- Duke is 100-40 (.714) all-time at the Greensboro Coliseum, including 42-18 (.700) in the 28 previous ACC Tournaments with eight titles (1978, 1980, 1986, 1988, 2003, 2006, 2010, 2011).
- A finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award for best first-year coach, **Jon Scheyer** holds the program record for wins in a debut season and is the ACC's first first-year coach to go unbeaten at home.
- Duke reached its 49th ACC semifinal by posting season highs for points (96), assists (27) and field goal pct. (.620) in Thursday's 96-69 win over Pitt with four Blue Devils in double figures. Duke's 27 assists vs. Pitt set an ACC Tournament record, surpassing 26 by UNC in 2001.
- Duke has held opponents below their season scoring average 28 times (24-4 in those games) and the Blue Devils are second in the conference in scoring defense (64.0), second in threepoint field goal defense (.305) and second in field goal defense (.409).
- Kyle Filipowski is Duke's ACC-leading 14th Rookie of the Year and also earned a spot on the All-ACC Second Team. He was an All-Freshman pick with Dereck Lively II and Tyrese Proctor. Lively was an All-Defense honoree, while Jeremy Roach was honorable mention All-ACC.
- Filipowski (right) poured in 22 points in just 15 minutes vs. Pitt, hitting 8-of-10 from the field and 4-of-6 from three-point range to lead all scorers. He is the first Duke freshman with a 20-point ACC Tournament debut since **Zion Williamson**'s 29 vs. Syracuse in the 2019 qtrs.
- Freshman Tyrese Proctor posted his second career double-double with 11 points, a career high 10 assists (one turnover) in the Pitt win. He leads Duke with 102 assists and 1.89 A/T ratio. The balanced Blue Devils, who have had four or more starters score in double figures in five
- straight games, lead the ACC in bench scoring at 19.4 points per game.
- Freshman Mark Mitchell is averaging 12.8 points, 5.0 rebounds and shooting .579 (22-of-38) from the field over five consecutive games in double-digit points

#### **DUKE TOURNAMENT NOTES**

- Duke has been the ACC Tournament's winningest team all-time with conference records for wins (108), winning percentage (.701) and titles (21) in the tournament.
- » Duke has won 53 of its last 64 tournament games and is 48-10 in this century (.828).
- » Duke's five straight titles (1999 to 2003) and its nine consecutive title game appearances (1998 to 2006) are each ACC records.
   » Duke's 20 Tournament MVPs are the most in league history.
- » Duke has won two of the last five ACC Tournaments that have been completed -- becoming the first team to win four games in four days to capture the 2017 crown in Brooklyn and winning in 2019 in Charlotte behind ACC Player of the Year and Tournament MVP Zion Williamson, who was the first freshman in ACC history to achieve both in the same season and the 11th Blue Devil all-time to do so.
- » Duke reached the title game in 2022, its 34th title game appearance.
  » Entering his first ACC Tournament as a head coach, Jon Scheyer was 7-2 in the event as a player -- finishing 6-0 over his final two seasons with titles in 2009 and 2010 -- and was 16-5 as a Duke assistant with titles in 2017 and 2019.

#### Greensboro-Duke Notes

14-4 (.778)

- » The Blue Devils have posted an all-time record of 100-40 (.714) at the Greensboro Coliseum dating back to 1960.
- » The program's 100 wins at the venue place it behind only Duke's current home (Cameron Indoor Stadium) and former homes (Card Gym and Duke Gym) as the winningest venue for the Blue Devils.
- Duke is 42-18 all-time in ACC Tournament games at Greensboro Coliseum where it has claimed eight of its ACC-leading 21 crowns, including three consecutive in 2016, 2010 and 2011.

- » Duke's other titles in Greensboro came in 1978, 1980, 1986, 1988 and 2003.
- » In 2020 in Greensboro, Duke was the 4-seed, but the tournament was canceled before the quarterfinal round due to the COVID-19 nandemic
- » A year later in Greensboro, Duke won a pair of games to advance to the quarterfinal round before having to withdraw from the tournament due to the University's COVID-19 protocols.

#### **DUKE GAME NOTES**

#### Schever In First Season as Head Coach

- » Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain **Jon Scheyer** is the 20th head coach in Duke's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.
- » The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic*'s 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.
- » He has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.
- » As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. Over his previous nine years on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).
- » The Northbrook, III., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign. Duke announced its five-man 2023-24 class this week, which includes five top-50 players and is currently ranked as the No. 2 class by ESPN and 247Sports.
- Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in 10 seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
   Among Scheyer's personnel moves in June were the hiring of Jai Lucas as an assistant coach and the promotion of Amile Jefferson to assistant coach. Scheyer also added Mike
- » Among scheyer's personnel moves in June were the niring of Jai Lucas as an assistant coach and the promotion of Amile Jefferson to assistant coach. Scheyer also added Mike Schrage as special assistant to the head coach and Rachel Baker as general manager.
- » Scheyer is just the third Duke coach all-time to win 20+ games in a debut season, joining Harold Bradley in 1950-51 (20-13) and Gerry Gerard in 1942-43 (20-6).

#### Notes on Duke's Season-Long Seven-Game Winning Streak

- » Duke's current seven-game win streak is a season long and tied for second longest by power conference teams (through March 9 games).
- » It marked just the eighth time in Duke's ACC era (since 1953-54) that the team entered the postseason on a win streak of six or more games -- Duke ultimately reached the Final Four in four of those seasons (1963, 1986, 1999 and winning the title in 2015), while three of those season produced an ACC Tournament title (1963, 1986 and 1999).
- » The Blue Devils have won these seven by an average of 13.6 points, allowing 62.7 points and a .389 field goal percentage and .317 from three.
- » Four Blue Devils have averaged double-figure points in the streak -- Kyle Filipowski (16.6), Jeremy Roach (14.0), Mark Mitchell (11.4) and Tyrese Proctor (10.3).
- » Duke has 115 assists on 195 field goals in the streak -- a 59 percent assist rate -- and just 63 turnovers -- 1.83 ratio, with Proctor at 31 assists and 11 turnovers (2.8-to-1) and Roach at 30 and 12 (2.5-to-1).
- » Duke is shooting .492 in the streak, led by freshman **Dereck Lively II**'s 24-of-31 (.774) and Mitchell's 28-of-50 (.560).
- » As a team, the Blue Devils have converted 93-of-119 (.782) at the free throw line over the last seven wins.

#### **Duke Beats Pitt In ACC Quarterfinals**

- » Duke reached its 49th ACC semifinal by posting season highs for points (96), assists (27) and field goal pct. (.620) in Thursday's 96-69 win over Pitt with four Blue Devils in double figures.
- » The 27 assists set an ACC Tournament record. The previous mark of 26 was held by North Carolina in the 2001 quarterfinals vs. Clemson.
- » Duke's 96 points were its most in an ACC Tournament game since beating North Carolina, 96-73, in the 1999 championship game in Charlotte. It was tied for the sixth most all-time for Duke in the ACC Tournament.
- » Duke's 27-point margin of victory was its ninth largest in the ACC Tournament and largest since beating Boston College, 86-51, in the 2021 first round
- » The 96 points marked the third most by any ACC team in the quarterfinal round.
- » The game was the 24th in the all-time series versus Pitt, with Duke now leading 16-8. It was the teams' first ACC Tournament meeting. With the win over Pitt, Duke has now played every current (and former) member of the ACC at least once in the ACC Tournament -- the Blue Devils are .500 or better against every team.
- » Duke held Pitt to 5-of-18 from three-point range (.278), marking the 18th time this season Duke has held a team below .300 for the game.
- » Duke had four starters score in double figures the fifth straight game with at least four reaching double digits.
- » With 22 points, Kyle Filipowski is the first Duke freshman with a 20-point game in an ACC Tournament debut since Zion Williamson's 29 vs. Syracuse in the 2019 quarterfinals.
- » Filipowski's 8-of-10 from the field marked the eighth time a Duke player has shot .800 or better (min. eight attempts) in an ACC Tournament game, and first since Zion's record 13-of-13 in the 2019 ACC quarterfinals vs. Syracuse.
- » Freshman **Tyrese Proctor** recorded his second career double-double first career with points-assists with 11 points and a career-high 10 assists (one turnover) with three rebounds and two steals on 4-of-6 shooting.
- » The 10 assists were tied for the third most by a Blue Devil in the ACC Tournament and most since **Trevon Duval** had 11 vs. Notre Dame in the 2018 quarterfinals. **Bobby Hurley**'s 13 vs. Maryland in the 1992 quarterfinals is the program record.

#### Filipowski Named ACC Rookie of the Year; Four Earn ACC Honors

- » Kyle Filipowski took home the program's league-leading 14th ACC Rookie of the Year honor and also earned a spot on the All-ACC Second Team.
- » Junior Jeremy Roach garnered Honorable Mention All-ACC recognition, while Filipowski, Tyrese Proctor and Dereck Lively II were each tapped to the ACC All-Freshman Team.
- » Lively also earned one of the five spots on the league's All-Defensive Team.
- » Duke now boasts 154 All-ACC selections all-time (first, second and third teamers), leading the league ahead of North Carolina (153) and NC State (87).
- » The Blue Devils have had at least one All-ACC player in every season since 1975.
- » Filipowski is Duke's second consecutive ACC Rookie of the Year, the ninth in the last 12 years and the program's ACC-record 14th all-time (leading Georgia Tech's 11 and North Carolina's nine).
- » Lively is Duke's 31st All-Defensive honoree and extends the Blue Devils' streak of at least one on the All-Defensive Team to four straight years.
- » The trio of All-Freshman honorees extends the Blue Devils' conference lead to 37 selections all-time and at least one in 12 consecutive seasons.
- » Filipowski was a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team with 75 votes and received 68 of the 75 votes as the Rookie of the Year. Of the 28 all-time unanimous picks to the All-Freshman Team, he is the 11th Blue Devil.

#### Duke is 16-1 with its Full Roster Available

- » Finding continuity at the end of the season after a year full of disruptions by injury or illness, Duke enters the ACC semifinals having played eight consecutive games with its full complement of scholarship players available (7-1 in those games) and having started the same lineup in 12 consecutive games (10-2) -- both its longest stretches of continuity this season.
- » Duke has played just 17 games all season with its full complement available having not lost in regulation in those games (16-1), including wins over Xavier, lowa, Ohio State, Miami, NC State, Notre Dame, North Carolina, Syracuse, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Pitt.
- » Seven of Duke's losses have come in the 15 games that Blue Devils were injured during the game or did not play due to injury or illness.
- » Freshman Dariq Whitehead sustained a lower leg injury at Virginia Tech on Jan. 23 and missed four consecutive games.
- » Whitehead began the season on the injured list after sustaining a foot fracture in the preseason and missing the first three games. He was held out of the loss at Wake Forest due to illness.
- » Classmate Dereck Lively II was also injured in the preseason (calf) -- missing the season opener -- also being held out at Wake (illness).
- » Junior **Jeremy Roach** sustained a toe injury on Nov. 27 vs. Purdue, played through the injury for three games before missing the game vs. UMES on Dec. 10. He returned for three more games, then re-aggravated the injury at NC State and missed the next three.

#### **Duke's Three-Point Streak**

- » Duke has connected on at least one three-pointer in 1,185 straight games, the second-longest streak nationally.
- » It has been more than 30 years since Duke was held without a three-point field goal -- Dec. 30, 1989, versus Hawai'i.

#### **HEAD COACH JON SCHEYER**



Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain Jon Scheyer is the 20th head coach in Duke University's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Fame head coach Mike Krzyzewski, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.

While Scheyer enters his first season as head coach in 2022-23, he has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.

The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to The Athletic's 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.

As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. In his previous time on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).

The Northbrook, III., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign.

Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in nine seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
