OPENING SERVE

The Duke volleyball team (10-3, 1-1 ACC) will hit the road for two ACC contests in the state of Florida. The Blue Devils will take on Miami in Coral Gables Friday at 7 p.m., before a 2 p.m. contest Sunday at Florida State. The match against the Seminoles will be broadcast on ACC Network.

LAST TIME OUT

Duke fell to No. 8 Pittsburgh (3-0) before it swept Virginia in ACC action over the weekend at Cameron Indoor Stadium.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SERIES

MIAMI

Duke and Miami meet for the 32nd time in program history as the Blue Devils hold a narrow 17-14 advantage in the all-time series. The Hurricanes have won six of the last seven meetings as Duke is 8-5 in Tallahassee.

FLORIDA STATE

Duke and Florida State meet for the 63rd time in program history. The Blue Devils lead the all-time series 37-25 but have lost 13 of the last 15 meetings, including the last 10.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

MIAMI

Miami enters Friday's contest 8-4 overall and 1-1 in the ACC and most recently fell to Wake Forest (3-1) and defeated Virginia Tech (3-1). Offensively, the Hurricanes are led by Angela Grieve with 142 kills and Flormarie Heredia Colon with 115 kills and a .256 hitting percentage. Setter Savannah Vach owns 482 dimes and leads the team in digs with 97. As a team, Miami is hitting .256 percent this fall with 14.2 kills/set.

FLORIDA STATE

Florida State enters Sunday's contest 8-6 overall and 2-0 in the ACC. The Seminoles outlasted Virginia Tech (3-2) before a 3-0 sweep over Wake Forest. The Seminoles are led by Audrey Koenig and Khori Louis with 132 and 123 kills, respectively. Florida State utilizes two setters - Andjelija Draskovic and Kenna Phelan - who own 277 and 258 assists, respectively. Kyleene Filimaua leads the defensive charge with 134 digs while Kiari Robey has 55 total blocks to her name. As a team, the Seminoles are hitting .313 percent this fall to rank fourth nationally and are sixth nationally with 14.3 kills/set.

LAST TIME YOU SAW US

- The Duke volleyball team bounced back with a 3-0 sweep (25-12, 25-21, 25-18) over Virginia Sunday afternoon at Cameron Indoor Stadium to capture its first ACC win. The Blue Devils improved to 10-3 (1-1 ACC).
- Graduate student Lizzie Fleming collected her 400th-career block, joining an elite group of Blue Devils as the 10th player in Duke history to reach the milestone.
- Offensively, Duke was led by a trio of Blue Devils - Gracie Johnson (12), Kerry Keefe (10) and Fleming (10) - with 10 or more kills as Fleming hit .667 percent with no errors. Setter Emma Worthington collected 33 assists and 11 digs while libero Madison Bryant picked up 13 digs. Jess Robinson headlined the defensive effort with five blocks while Christina Barrow tied her career high in aces with two.

MILESTONE ... CHECK!

• With the 3-1 win over Loyola Maryland on August 31, Duke became the 43rd program in NCAA Division I history to reach 1,000 wins in program history.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- Duke was firing on all cylinders from the first point of the match against Santa Clara and did not take its foot off the gas.
- As a team, the Blue Devils posted a .480 hitting percentage -- its second straight match hitting over .400 percent and a number that is 18th nationally.
- That mark was also best hitting percentage since the team hit .513 against Charleston Southern on August 27, 2011.
- This season, Duke is hitting .257 percent to rank 43rd nationally.

QUARTER OF A CENTURY

- Head coach Jolene Nagel has been at the helm of the Blue Devils since 1999 and is in her 25th season this fall.
- Under Nagel's guidance, she has led the Blue Devils to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11.
- Nagel earned her 600th career victory September 9, 2017 as the Blue Devils downed TCU in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the 22nd active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 600 career victories.
- Duke reached 1,000 wins with the victory over Loyola Maryland - 490 of those are under the direction of Nagel.

T-MINUS SEVEN

- Head coach Jolene Nagel looks to become just the eighth active Division I head coach to reach 700 career wins.

A WIN WOULD BE ...

- Head coach Jolene Nagel's 694th career victory
- Head coach Jolene Nagel's 491st at the helm of the Blue Devils

HOME COURT DUBS

- Duke is set for 14 home contests this fall at Cameron Indoor Stadium and is currently 5-0.
- A season ago, the Blue Devils went 12-4 at home.
- The Blue Devils are 270-93 at home since Jolene Nagel took over the program in 1999.

ONE OF FIVE

- Duke is one of just five schools in Division I to feature two players hitting above .400 percent on the season -- Jess Robinson (.456) + Lizzie Fleming (.411).
- The other four schools are Florida State, Maryland, Ole Miss and Wisconsin.

SEEING DOUBLE

- Three Blue Devils -- Gracie Johnson, Kerry Keefe and Emma Worthington -- tallied double-doubles in Duke's five-set marathon win over No. 18 Creighton.
- This is the first time Duke has featured three with double-doubles since Oct. 30, 2022 when Duke defeated Notre Dame in five sets.

RANKED DUB

- Duke's first win of the 2023 season was a ranked one, defeating No. 18 Creighton (3-2) to close out the opening weekend.
- It was Duke's first win over a ranked opponent since Sept. 20, 2019 against No. 14 Oregon.
- Duke was 0-4 against ranked foes a season ago.

AVCA RANKINGS

- Duke has been receiving votes in the weekly AVCA/TARAFLEX Division I volleyball poll since week one (Aug. 28).
- The ACC features three teams in the top 25 -- No. 5 Louisville, No. 8 Pittsburgh and No. 11 Georgia Tech.
- The Big Ten has the most ranked teams with seven.

DOUBLE THREAT

- Kerry Keefe and Jess Robinson have proven to be offensive threats for the Blue Devils already this fall as the two have combined for 267 kills and just 55 errors.
- The duo was on display against West Virginia -- Robinson knocked down a career-high 21 kills to hit .643 for the match while Keefe added 18 and played to a .417 clip. They committed just six errors between the two of them.

DOUBLE TROUBLE MIDDLES

- Middle blocker duo Lizzie Fleming and Jess Robinson have combined to play in 229 career matches -- the most in Division I this season.
- The two have combined for 170 kills this fall and are playing to an impressive .440 hitting percentage. Fleming and Robinson are also stellar at the net with 87.0 total blocks.

SWEEPS-VILLE

- Duke has six sweeps so far in 2023 and has swept six of its last eight opponents.
- Duke did so three times in 2022 and 11 times in 2021.

NON-CON WRAP-UP

- After starting the season with an 0-2 record, Duke went on a nine-match winning streak and ended non-conference play 9-2.
- Duke's first win of 2023 was a ranked one, defeating No. 18 Creighton 3-2 at Purdue's Reamer Club Xtra Special Premier.
- Jess Robinson (.471), Lizzie Fleming (.388) and Kerry Keefe (.353) led the offensive charge with a combined .395 hitting percentage.
- Duke collected its 1,000th program win with a 3-1 victory over Loyola Maryland on Aug. 31.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- This year's Duke volleyball team has a wealth of experience both on and off the court with graduate students Madison Bryant, Lizzie Fleming, Gracie Johnson, Jess Robinson and Emma Worthington.
- Those five have combined to play in a whopping 1,785 sets since 2019.

MADE A STATEMENT BACK HOME

- Graduate student Jess Robinson returned to her home state against Michigan & Michigan State and put on a show.
- She tallied 20 kills and committed just seven errors in both contests to hit a combined .317 percent.
- She also tied her career high of 10 total blocks against Michigan, her alma mater, in her all-around performance.
- During her time as a Wolverine, she saw great success and during her senior season, she broke the school record career hitting percentage (.341) and the record for a single season Big Ten hitting percentage at Michigan (.388).
- She helped Michigan play to a 60-45 record during her time there, which included trips to the NCAA Tournament in 2019 and 2021. The Wolverines are 2-9 this fall in her absence.

GRACIE THE GREAT

- Graduate student Gracie Johnson returns to Duke for her final year of eligibility and is primed for another stellar campaign as a Preseason All-ACC Team selection.
- Johnson was Duke's engine last fall, but that's no surprise with her impressive numbers on both sides of the ball. During her senior campaign, she saw her best offensive output since her arrival in Durham with 462 kills and a .203 hitting percentage. She also collected 53 aces, 217 digs and 43 blocks, proving she's more than just an offensive threat.
- A 2022 first team All-ACC selection, she finished the season ranked in the top-50 of eight national categories and in the top-five of eight statistical categories in the ACC. She led the conference in total aces and was second in total kills and total points.
- Throughout her career, she owns 1,278 kills, 142 aces, 917 digs and 189 total blocks to go along with 22 career double-doubles and 16 games with 20 or more kills. She became the 28th Blue Devil to reach the 1,000-kill plateau in Duke's five-set victory at Notre Dame (10/30/22)

last season.

- This fall, she looks to become the 13th player in program history to register 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs.

MAKING HISTORY

- The September 13 match at NC Central marked the first time a Duke team has competed on NCCU's campus since the 1970s.
- The volleyball program played there twice -- 1971 + 1975 -- while the women's basketball program played down the road in 1977.

A PARTNERSHIP TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

- Duke and NC Central's volleyball programs partnered up to co-host an event at the Boys & Girls Club of Durham and Orange County last week ahead of Wednesday's historic match.
- The hour-long event began with a facility tour directed by Boys & Girls Clubs of Durham and Orange Counties CEO Jerome Levisy and director of resource development Andrew Borresen. After the tour, team members from the Blue Devils and Eagles conducted volleyball exercises around the gymnasium with club members and guided them

through serving, setting, and hitting drills.

- The match also served as a fundraiser for the B&GC of Durham and Orange Counties.

AMONG NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

- Graduate student Gracie Johnson is currently 36th in total kills among NCAA Division I career active leaders with 1,278 kills. She is the lone ACC player in the top 40. She is also 18th with 139 aces.
- Fellow classmate Lizzie Fleming is tied for 28th nationally with 400 total blocks.

THIS WEEK IN ACC VOLLEYBALL

- Three teams continue to be ranked in the AVCA poll, all three in the top 15: Louisville is No. 5, Pitt holds strong at No. 8 and Georgia Tech moved up to No. 11. Duke is receiving votes in this week's poll.
- The ACC owns the second-best winning percentages among power conferences, along with recording the most games played or won of any conference so far, with an overall record of 118-41.
- In the RPI rankings released this week and for matches played through Sept. 23, four ACC teams are in the top 20 and seven in the top 50. Louisville led the way at No. 9, followed by No. 14 Pittsburgh, No. 17 Georgia Tech + No. 18 Wake Forest.
- The ACC leads nationally in block assists (2,364), is second in aces (1,103) and third nationally in kills (8,828) and assists (8,107).

RETURN OF THE MACK

- Former Duke standout and 2021 graduate Mackenzie Cole returned to Durham as a member of the Blue Devil coaching staff. She will serve as an assistant coach and the director of operations for the 2023 season.

• Cole had a stellar career as a four-year starting libero for the Blue Devils, which culminated in her earning ACC Defensive Player of the Year, All-East Coast Region and second team All-ACC honors during her final season in 2021.

• After her four years as a Blue Devil, Cole used her final year of eligibility at UCLA as the starting libero for the Bruins in 2022. She finished her career ranked 13th on the NCAA active career leaders list with 2,086 digs.

FIRST ACC SETTER OF THE WEEK

• Graduate student setter Emma Worthington was named the ACC Setter of the Week following her performance at Purdue's Reamer Club Xtra Special Premier.

• In her Blue Devil debut, Worthington dished 110 assists for 9.17 assists per set and featured an impressive 52 dimes in Duke's five-set win over No. 18 Creighton. She also tallied 32 digs, seven kills and four blocks as a six-rotation player.

• This is the first ACC Setter of the Week award given by the conference office.

ACC OFFENSIVE POW

• Sophomore outside hitter Kerry Keefe was named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week following her performance against Loyola Maryland and West Virginia.

• Keefe tallied 42 kills for 4.67 kills per set and had just six errors on 75 swings to hit an impressive .480 percent in matches against Loyola Maryland and West Virginia. She also collected two aces, 14 digs and four blocks.

• In Duke's 1,000th program victory over Loyola Maryland, Keefe had a career night with a career-high 24 kills and just three errors to hit .538 percent. She was also instrumental in the five-set victory over West Virginia with 18 kills.

• This fall, she is hitting .335 percent and leads the team with 152 kills.

FROM RED TO BLUE

• In addition to Jess Robinson, head coach Jolene Nagel welcomes Emma Worthington to Duke this fall as a 5-11 setter from Cornell.

• During her senior year, she served as the team captain for the 2022 season and saw action in all 23 contests, leading the team in assists (746) and assists per set (8.99).

• Her assist and assists per set numbers ranked third most in the Ivy League as she posted a career-high 54 assists in a five-set match at Penn. She had seven double-doubles on the year, highlighted by the 54-assists 24 dig performance against the Quakers.

• This season, she owns 346 dimes for 9.89 assists/set, 19 kills, eight aces, 78 digs and 19 blocks. She is currently fifth in the ACC in total assists and assists/set.

ACE, ACE & ANOTHER ACE

• Duke has put an emphasis on its serve the last few years and finished fourth in the ACC last season with 183 (1.58 aces/set).

• The Blue Devils are consistent around the lineup with their serve as seven Blue Devils tallied 10 or more aces a season ago, led by Gracie Johnson with an impressive 53. She finished the year ranked tied for 19th nationally in total aces and led the ACC.

• This season, Duke features five with 10 or more -- Johnson (21), Christina Barrow (13), Madison Bryant (13), Rachel Richardson (13) and Emma Worthington (10).

• Duke leads the ACC with 86 aces and 1.87 aces/set.

KEEPING UP WITH KERRY

• Freshman outside hitter Kerry Keefe emerged as one of Duke's offensive threats last season and was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team.

• She was sidelined to start the season, but quickly found a starting role on the right side. Keefe tallied 160 kills for 2.39 kills/set and played to a .288 hitting percentage. She also added 44 digs and 42.0 total blocks as a important part of Duke's defense. Last fall, she knocked down a career-high 21 kills versus Clemson, added a career-high seven total blocks against Boston College and saw eight contests with 10 or more kills.

• This season, she leads the team with 152 kills and a .335 hitting percentage. She also owns 89 digs and 18 total blocks. Currently, she ranks fourth in the conference in total kills and 10th in kills/set.

Jolene Nagel became Duke University's fifth head volleyball coach in 1999, joining the Blue Devil staff after successful stints at Cornell and Georgetown. Under her guidance, Duke has earned a reputation as one of the elite programs on the East Coast. Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11. A perennial contender in the ACC, Duke has recorded 20 or more wins in 14 of Nagel's 25 campaigns and consistently finished among the top three in the conference. Nagel earned her 600th career victory September 9, 2017 as the Blue Devils downed TCU in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the 22nd active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 600 career victories. The winningest Duke volleyball coach on record, she also ranks among the league coaching leaders in overall winning percentage, ACC winning percentage, ACC wins and NCAA Tournament appearances.
