## QUICK HITS

### FRESH OFF THE FINAL FOUR

A year after reaching the Elite Eight for the first time in program history, Miami made the Final Four for the first time ever. The Hurricanes, who earned back-to-back top-five wins for the first time in program history in their Sweet 16 and Elite Eight outings, became the first ACC team with two Elite Eights and a Final Four in a two-year span since North Carolina in 2016-17.

### A SEASON FOR THE BOOKS

The 2022-23 campaign was one for the ages as Miami went 29-8 (15-5 ACC) to tie the program records for both overall and ACC victories (set in 2012-13). The Hurricanes claimed a share of the ACC regular season crown and earned the No. 1 seed in the ACC Tournament for the second time (2012-13). Miami logged seven top-25 wins, three top-10 victories and registered multiple top-five triumphs for the first time.

### CANES TO WATCH

A trio of Hurricanes earned Basketball Hall of Fame preseason honors this season as one of the top 20 players at their position.  
 > Matthew Cleveland – Julius Erving Award (Small Forward)  
 > Norchad Omier – Karl Malone Award (Power Forward)  
 > Nijel Pack – Bob Cousy Award (Point Guard)

The list will be narrowed down to 10 in late January, with plans to announce the final five in late March.

## THE NUMBERS

- For the first time ever, two Canes earned preseason All-ACC plaudits (Omier, 1st Team & Pack, 2nd Team).
- Miami was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll, the highest projection in program history.
- In nine of Coach L's 12 years, Miami has placed higher in the final ACC standings than it was picked in the preseason poll.
- The Hurricanes went 16-1 at the Watsco Center in 2022-23 to log their most home wins in program history.
- In 2022-23, Miami defeated seven schools with a combined 23 (one vacated) national titles.

## THE MATCHUP

• The Hurricanes will face their final test before the 2023-24 campaign commences when they host The College of New Jersey on Oct. 29 at the Watsco Center. Tipoff against TCNJ is set for 2 p.m. and the game will air on ACC Network Extra with Kyle Sielaff and Jack McClinton on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on WVUM 90.5.

## LAST TIME OUT

• The Hurricanes finished the 2022-23 season as one of the four best teams in the country, advancing to the program's first ever Final Four last year. After defeating Drake, No. 21/19 Indiana, No. 2/1 Houston and No. 5/7 Texas in the NCAA Tournament, Miami ran into the powerhouse that was No. 10/12 Connecticut.

• The Hurricanes could not overcome the Huskies' defense and ultimately fell 72-59 to the eventual national champions. Isaiah Wong scored a team-high 15 points, while Jordan Miller totaled a co-team best 10 rebounds. The Hurricanes shot their second-lowest clip of the season, 32.3 percent (20-of-62), and finished with fewer than 60 points for the first time all year.

## SCOUTING THE LIONS

• TCNJ finished the 2022-23 season at 10-17 overall with an 8-10 mark in NJAC play. The Lions advanced to the semifinals of the NJAC Tournament, before falling to top-seeded Rowan University, 96-83.

• The Lions will look very different this season as they've had to replace their four top scorers and their two best rebounders from a season ago. Fifth-year senior Jason Larranaga is TCNJ's top returning player, averaging 6.6 points and 3.4 rebounds per game in 2022-23.

## IN THE POLLS

• After streaking to the first Final Four in program history, the Hurricanes checked in at No. 13 in the preseason Associated Press and USA TODAY Coaches Polls. Thirteenth ties the program record, set in 2017-18, for highest preseason AP Poll nod, and is second in the Coaches Poll as the Hurricanes were ranked 12th in the 2017-18 preseason poll.

• Miami's second-place prediction in the preseason ACC poll marks the highest selection for the Hurricanes, since joining the ACC ahead of the 2004-05 season. The Hurricanes' five first-place votes is more than they received in every prior ACC preseason poll combined (two in 2022, one in 2017).

## PRESEASON ACCOLADES

• For the first time in program history, two Hurricanes earned Preseason All-ACC plaudits as fourth-year junior Norchad Omier was named Preseason First Team All-ACC, while fourth-year junior Nijel Pack picked up Preseason Second Team All-ACC honors.

• Omier, who was a Third Team All-ACC selection in 2022-23, averaged a double-double last season, tallying 13.1 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. Pack, the NCAA Tournament Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player, scored in double-figures 22 times in 2022-23, averaging 13.6 points per game and shooting 40.4 percent from 3-point range.

• With the nod for Omier, Miami has now placed a player on the Preseason All-ACC First Team in each of the last four seasons.

## LEGENDARY COACH L

• The Hurricanes' Final Four trip last season was the second of Jim Larrañaga's career, making him one of nine active DI head coaches with multiple trips. Coach L and Larry Brown are, per Stats Perform, the only coaches to take two different schools to the Final Four while seeded fifth or lower.

• Coach L, a 2023 Naismith HOF first-time nominee and UM Sports HOF 2023 inductee, is Miami's all-time leader with 255 victories. His eight 20-win seasons are the most by a Miami coach and 40 percent of The U's total (20). Coach L has led Miami to all five of its 25-win years, half its 12 NCAA berths, 11 of its 15 wins in the field, four of its five Sweet 16s, its two Elite Eights, its first Final Four, its two ACC regular season titles and its one ACC Tournament crown.

## CONFERENCE CROWN

• Picked fourth in the ACC preseason poll, Miami went 15-5 in 2022-23 to share the ACC regular season title with Virginia and, for the second time ever, earn the No. 1 seed in the ACC Tournament.

• This was the third regular season league championship for the Hurricanes, joining a 2012-13 outright ACC crown and a 1999-2000 shared BIG EAST title.

## RETURNING FIREPOWER

• Despite losing two Miami greats to the NBA Draft in Jordan Miller and Isaiah Wong, the Hurricanes return four of their six leading scorers from last year, including three starters in guards Nijel Pack and Wooga Poplar and forward Norchad Omier.

• Pack and Omier combined to total 53 double-digit outings in 2022-23 and were Miami's third and fourth leading scorers, respectively. Pack paced the Hurricanes in 3-point shooting (.404) and free throw percentage (.882), while Omier led Miami in rebounding (10.0) and blocks (42).

• The Hurricanes also return starter Wooga Poplar, who started 36 of 37 games in 2022-23. The Philadelphia native averaged 8.4 points and 3.5 rebounds per game as a sophomore, scoring in double-figures on 13 occasions, including six of the last nine games.

## WELCOME TO THE U

• Miami added five freshmen to the roster ahead of the 2023-24 season in Nick Cassano, Paul Djobet, Kyshawn George, Carson Mastin and Michael Nwoko. Three of the five hail from outside the United States (Djobet – France, George – Switzerland and Nwoko – Canada), while Cassano and Mastin come from Florida and Texas, respectively.

• George and Nwoko have both represented their countries on the international stage, competing in several FIBA events. Nwoko helped Canada to a third-place finish at the 2022 FIBA U18 America Championship, while George played in six games for Switzerland in the 2019 FIBA U16 European Championship Division B.

## SUITING UP IN ORANGE & GREEN

• With the graduation of Jordan Miller, the Hurricanes needed to fill the role of small forward, and they did so by bringing Florida State's leading scorer and rebounder, Matthew Cleveland, to Coral Gables.

• Cleveland, a Top 10 candidate for the Julius Erving Small Forward Award in 2022-23, averaged 13.8 points and 7.4 rebounds last season. As a freshman in 2021-22, Cleveland claimed ACC Sixth Man of the Year recognition, receiving twice as many votes as all other players combined.

## WATSCO IS ROCKIN'

• Miami has seen unprecedented fan interest in the program under Larrañaga. In 2017-18, for the third straight season, the Hurricanes sold out their season-ticket allotment at the Watsco Center.

• The 2015-16 campaign marked the first time in UM history that any team sold out of season tickets. Across the last two seasons, 2021-22 and 2022-23, Miami recorded four of the five highest single-game student attendance marks in program history.

In his 12 seasons at the University of Miami, head coach Jim Larrañaga has led the Hurricanes to six NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16. He has guided the Hurricanes to their first Elite Eight (2022), first Final Four (2023), first ACC Tournament title (2013) and first two ACC regular season crowns (2013 and 2023). Larrañaga has been named the Associated Press, Naismith, USBWA and Henry Iba National Coach of the Year, twice was both the ACC and USBWA District Coach of the Year and was the 2013 NABC District Coach of the Year.

The winningest coach in program history, Larrañaga has posted five 25-win seasons at UM – the only Miami coach to do so even once – and seven in his career. He also has recorded eight 20-win campaigns at Miami and 14 in his career. In conference action, the Hurricanes have won nine or more league games in eight of 12 seasons, while prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami had never won more than eight ACC games in a season. Larrañaga has helped the Hurricanes to 30 postseason victories, including 11 in the NCAA Tournament (six appearances), 13 in the ACC Tournament (13) and five in the NIT (two). He ranks top-30 all-time among Division I coaches with 725 victories, including eighth among active coaches. In 2023, Larrañaga was both inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum and named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee.

Miami's 69 total road wins in the past 12 seasons are fourth-most among ACC teams during Larrañaga's tenure and its 114 total victories away from home also place fourth. During that same stretch, the Hurricanes are fifth in overall ACC wins (120), as well as fourth in both ACC road victories (48) and ACC Tournament triumphs (13), plus sixth in ACC home wins (72). In the six years prior to Larrañaga's arrival, when the ACC had only 12 teams, Miami was tied for ninth in ACC victories (36) and won just 10 total ACC road games. In nine of Larrañaga's 12 years, the team has finished higher in the ACC final standings than it was picked in the preseason poll, including placing multiple spots higher on seven occasions.

The Hurricanes have a combined 16 wins over Duke (8-9) and North Carolina (8-10) under Larrañaga, tied for the second-most of any team during his 11-year tenure, after going 4-31 versus those two programs before his arrival. Eight of those victories are by double digits and seven are on the road, the former the most of any team during that stretch and the latter tied for the most. Miami's 27-point win over the Blue Devils on Jan. 23, 2013, is the third-largest ever against the AP No. 1 team in the nation. It is one 31 victories over a top-25 foe under Larrañaga, including 13—five of which came in the past two seasons, 2021-22 and 2022-23—versus a top-10 opponent.

Miami has seen unprecedented fan interest in the program under Larrañaga. In 2017-18, for the third straight season, the Hurricanes sold out their season-ticket allotment at the Watsco Center. The 2015-16 campaign marked the first time in UM history that any team sold out of season tickets. Across the last two seasons, 2021-22 and 2022-23, Miami recorded four of the five highest single-game student attendance marks in program history.

From 2017-19, Miami was one of two ACC programs, alongside Duke, to have a player selected in each NBA Draft. Four total Hurricanes were picked in that span, including Lonnie Walker IV going No. 18 in 2018.

During the most recent campaign, 2022-23, Larrañaga guided Miami to its best year ever. The Hurricanes finished 29-8 (15-5 ACC), shared the ACC regular season title and earned their first Final Four appearance. Miami set or tied program records for overall, ACC, regular season (24), home (16), top-25 (seven), top-10 (three) and top-five (two) victories. The team ended the year third in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll, good for its best finish ever.

Seeded No. 5 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes knocked off top-seeded and No. 2/1-ranked Houston, 89-75, and second-seeded and No. 5/7-ranked Texas, 88-81, in a three-day span in Kansas City, Mo., to clinch their Final Four bid. They also knocked off seven teams with a combined 23 NCAA titles (including one vacated) during the 2022-23 campaign, including an eight-point road victory at North Carolina, a 22-point home win over Duke and a 16-point triumph over Indiana in the NCAA Tournament. The team lost by more than seven points just twice all year.

Larrañaga earned multiple significant achievements during the historic season. First, on Nov. 19, 2022, he led Miami to a 74-64 victory over his alma mater, Providence, in Uncasville, Conn., to become just the 35th coach with DI experience to reach 700 wins, including only the fourth to do so while in the ACC. On Dec., 21, 2022, he was named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee. Following the season, on May 4, 2023, he was inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum.

Numerous Hurricanes claimed major awards during the season, as well. Isaiah Wong became Miami's second ACC Player of the Year and sixth All-America, garnering NABC third-team distinction. He was also a finalist for the John R. Wooden Award and the Jerry West Award, among many other accomplishments. Jordan Miller received Second Team All-ACC status, while Norchad Omier picked up third-team plaudits. Nijel Pack won NCAA Tournament Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player honors, while Miller and Wong both tallied All-Tournament Team status.

The 2022-23 success followed another tremendous season the year before, as Miami, picked No. 12 in the ACC preseason poll, went 26-11 (14-6 ACC). Seeded No. 10 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes rattled off three straight victories to make the Elite Eight for the first time, including throttling second-seeded and No. 8/7 ranked-Auburn, 79-61, in the Round of 32, en route to finishing co-No. 16 in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll.

Larrañaga set the program record with his 221st victory at The U on March 2, 2022, at Boston College, just weeks after a Feb. 9, 2022, triumph over Georgia Tech made him the first coach in NCAA history with 100 league wins at three DI schools and/or in three DI conferences. Kameron McGusty turned in one of the best years in program history, claiming First Team All-ACC, NABC First Team All-District 2, ACC All-Tournament First Team, NCAA Tournament All-Midwest Region and Senior CLASS Award finalist accolades.

In 2017-18, Miami played in its fourth NCAA Tournament in a six-year span, claiming the No. 6 seed in the South Region. The Hurricanes tied for third in the ACC and finished the season with a 22-10 mark, including an 11-7 record in conference play. The Hurricanes were nationally ranked for 15 weeks, reaching as high as No. 6 in the polls.

Freshman Lonnie Walker IV was named Honorable Mention All-ACC, becoming the first freshman all-conference honoree in program history. He also was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team. Miami earned road wins over then-No. 12 Minnesota and then-No. 9 North Carolina, the fourth straight year and the sixth time in Larrañaga's first seven seasons that the Hurricanes defeated two or more top-15 teams.

In 2016-17, Miami went 21-12 overall and claimed the No. 8 seed in the Midwest Region. It defeated three ranked teams, including two in the top 10. Davon Reed won the Skip Prosser Award and Larrañaga registered his 600th all-time win with a 72-46 triumph at

The 2015-16 Hurricanes played their way into the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 for the second time in four seasons, and just the third time in school history.

In 2012-13, Larrañaga helped Miami to a No. 2 national ranking by both the AP and USA TODAY and a No. 2 seed in the NCAA tournament. At the time, he was the 10th coach in the last 10 years to lead two top-10 programs, as Miami was No. 2 on Feb. 18, 2013, and George Mason was No. 8 in the final Top 25 poll in 2006.

Individually, Shane Larkin earned the ACC Player of the Year and Lute Olson National Player of the Year awards, as well as All-American status and finalist nods for the Bob Cousy, John Wooden and James Naismith player of the year honors before declaring early for the 2013 NBA Draft. Larkin was also the ACC Tournament MVP, on the ACC All-Defensive Team and a Defensive All-American. Durand Scott was the ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

Larrañaga came to Miami after serving as the head coach at George Mason for 14 seasons. He guided the program to five NCAA Tournament appearances (1999, 2001, 2006, 2008, 2011), including an unprecedented run to the 2006 Final Four that captured the nation's attention, as the Patriots defeated Michigan State, North Carolina, Wichita State and Connecticut along the way. Following that run, Larrañaga was selected the 2006 Clair Bee National Coach of the Year.

Larrañaga built the George Mason program into a perennial contender in the highly-regarded Colonial Athletic Association, winning more games than any other coach in program and conference history (273) en route to three conference titles (1999, 2001, 2008).

In 2006, Larrañaga became the first coach at a mid-major school to take his team to the Final Four in 27 years and earned the CAA's first NCAA tournament at-large berth in 20 years. Along the way, he led Mason to a school record in wins, its first-ever national ranking, its first-ever appearance in the Top 10 and its first wins over Top 10 teams.

Larrañaga served as the head coach at Bowling Green for 11 seasons (1986-1997) and at Division II American International for two seasons (1977-79).

At Bowling Green, he made an immediate impact in his first season. In 1986-87, the Falcons were the nation's most improved team under a first-year head coach that took over a program with a losing record, posting a 15-14 record for an eight-game improvement over the previous season. Larrañaga went on to record a 170-144 mark in 11 years at Bowling Green, earning 1997 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading Bowling Green to a 22-10 record, a conference regular season co-championship and a berth in the NIT. The 22 victories were the most by a Bowling Green team in 47 years and the 13 conference wins were the second-highest total in BGSU history.

Larrañaga's 170 victories at Bowling Green ranked second all-time on the Falcons' coaching list and he was only the second coach to record consecutive postseason appearances. Larrañaga led his squad to NIT berths in 1990 (18-11) and again in 1991 (17-13), the first time the Falcons enjoyed back-to-back postseason appearances since the early '60s. Bowling Green won better than 60 percent of its games in Larrañaga's last four years, recording a 70-44 mark during that stretch. The Falcons finished fourth or better in the MAC in five of Larrañaga's 11 seasons and he is among the winningest coaches in MAC history.

Larrañaga received his first head coaching position in 1977 when he was named to the post at American International, a Division II program in Springfield, Mass. Taking over a team that had suffered through five consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, Larrañaga turned AIC into a winning program in his first year and compiled a 28-25 mark in two seasons.

Larrañaga's first coaching opportunity came at Davidson College from 1971-76, serving as an assistant coach to Terry Holland. Davidson captured three Southern Conference regular-season championships and an NIT berth in his five years there, and he compiled a 47-12 record doubling as the freshman team coach. In 1976, he left Davidson and spent one season as player-coach for the Geronemo Basketball Club in Belgium.

After his two-year stint at American International, Larrañaga was reunited with Holland at the University of Virginia in April 1979. An assistant coach under Holland at UVA for seven seasons from 1979-86, he helped the Cavaliers reach the NCAA Final Four on two occasions (1981 and 1984), finish in the top five of the AP and UPI polls and average more than 24 victories per season. The Cavaliers were 169-62, won three regular-season Atlantic Coast Conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances in that span. Virginia also made a pair of NIT appearances, winning the NIT Championship in 1980. Larrañaga was on the staff during the careers of three-time National Player of the Year Ralph Sampson and NBA first-round draft choice Olden Polynice.

A 1971 graduate of Providence College with a degree in economics, Larrañaga was a four-year letterman for the Friars. As the team captain in his senior season, he led Providence to a 20-8 record and an NIT appearance. He graduated as the school's fifth all-time leading scorer with 1,258 points and was selected in the sixth round of the draft by the Detroit Pistons of the National Basketball Association. He was the team's top scorer as a sophomore and junior and was named New England's Division I Sophomore of the Year in 1969. He was inducted into the Providence College Hall of Fame in 1991.

Larrañaga and his wife, Liz, have two sons and four grandchildren. Their son, Jay, played for his father at Bowling Green, was the head coach of the NBDL's Erie Bayhawks and is now an assistant coach with the Los Angeles Clippers. Jon was a member of his father's George Mason teams from 1999-2003, earning first team Academic All-America honors for NCAA Division I-AAA schools.

## LARRAÑAGA YEAR-BY-YEAR
