THE GAME

- Coming off a 38-31 loss last time out vs. Louisville, the Hurricanes wrap up their second regular season under the direction of head coach **Mario Cristobal** on Fri., November 24 with a road showdown against Boston College. Kickoff for the game is set for 12 p.m. from Alumni Stadium.
- The game will be broadcast on **ABC** with Matt Barrie (pxp), Dan Mullen (color) & Harry Lyles, Jr. (sideline) on the call. Joe Zagacki (pxp) & Don Bailey, Jr. (color) are in the **560 WQAM** booth for the 22nd season. **Americanradio 1260 AM** will also broadcast Friday's regular season finale.

THE SERIES

- Miami leads the all-time series against Boston College by a commanding 24-6 margin; the programs were once BIG EAST foes before joining the ACC.
- Boston College has won three of the last four matchups overall dating to 2007; Miami last won in Chestnut Hill, Mass., in September 2012, a 41-32 win.
- The Hurricanes carry an 8-4 advantage in games played on the road in the series. Miami won 15 in a row overall over BC from 1985 through 2006.

THE HURRICANES

- Miami wraps up the Year 2 regular season of the **Mario Cristobal** Era on Fri., Nov. 24 when it travels to Boston College. Kickoff is set for 12 p.m. on ABC.
- UM is coming off a 38-31 loss to Louisville last time out at Hard Rock Stadium on Nov. 18. WR **Xavier Restrepo** had a career-high 193 yards in the loss.
- Miami had possession of the ball in the red zone with less than two minutes remaining down one score, but the Cardinals stopped UM on 4th and Goal.
- Restrepo was named ACC Receiver of the Week for his game against UofL; he leads the Hurricanes in both receptions (68) and receiving yards (876).
- RB **Mark Fletcher, Jr.**, has posted 100-yard outings in two of the last three games; he had a career-high 126 yards with two touchdowns last time out.
- Another freshman - DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.** - ranks first among defensive lineman in sacks with 6.5 and is tied for sixth in the ACC in the category.
- Miami is looking for its second top-25 win of the season Saturday; the Canes picked up an impressive win over #23/#22 Texas A&M, 48-33, on Sept. 9.
- Cristobal, a double alum of the University, was named the 26th head coach in program history by school president Dr. Julio Frenk on Dec. 6, 2021.
- Cristobal returned home after spending the previous four seasons as head coach at Oregon, where he won two Pac-12 titles and captured a Rose Bowl.
- Cristobal is regarded as one of the nations top recruiters, and in his first recruiting cycle as Miami head coach, the Hurricanes signed the best class in program history according to the 247Sports Composite; it was the top-ranked class in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the top class in the state.
- The second-year Miami head coach hired **Shannon Dawson** from the University of Houston as the team's new offensive coordinator and **Lance Guidry** from Marshall as the team's new defensive coordinator entering 2023. In total, there are new faces in seven of 10 assistant coach roles; in addition to Dawson and Guidry, Cristobal hired **Derek Nicholson** (from Louisville) to coach linebackers, **Tim Harris, Jr.**, (UCF) to coach running backs, **Kevin Beard** (Toledo) to coach wide receivers and elevated both **Jason Taylor** (defensive line) and **Cody Woodiel** (tight ends) from analyst roles.
- After a breakout season where he earned All-America honors, **Kam Kinchens** was named to the watch list for nearly every major defensive award, including the Bednarik Award, the Nagurski Trophy and the Thorpe Award. He was also named a Preseason All-American by the Associated Press.
- TE **Elijah Arroyo** (Mackey Award), K **Andy Borregales** (Lou Groza Award), OL **Javion Cohen** (Outland Trophy), OL **Matt Lee** (Rimington Award) and DL **Leonard Taylor** (Bednarik) were also among those recognized with preseason watch list selections for major awards entering 2023.
- The Canes feature a 2023 transfer portal class that ranked among the best in FBS; it includes starters OL **Javion Cohen** (Alabama), **Matt Lee** (UCF) and LB **Francisco Mauigoa** (Washington State), DB **Jaden Davis** (Oklahoma) and others like DB **Davonte Brown** (UCF) and RB **Ajay Allen** (Nebraska).

QUICK HITS

CANES WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT BC

- Following a 38-31 loss to a top-10 Louisville side last time out at Hard Rock Stadium, Miami wraps up its second regular season under **Mario Cristobal** on Nov. 24 with a road showdown at Boston College.
- The Hurricanes carry a commanding 24-6 lead in the all-time series against the Eagles, but have dropped three of the last four matchups overall dating to 2007.
- Cristobal finished 2-0 against BC during his playing days; Miami topped the Eagles, 42-12, in Miami in 1990 and he also helped No. 1-ranked UM to a 19-14 victory in 1991.

ACC RECEIVER OF THE WEEK: RESTREPO

- WR **Xavier Restrepo** was recognized as ACC Receiver of the Week after another impressive performance - this one last time out vs. Louisville, where he compiled a career-high 193 yards on eight catches.
- With his performance last week against the Cardinals, Restrepo moved into third place in single-season receptions with 68. Restrepo trails only Charleston Rambo (79, 2021) and Leonard Hankerson (72, 2010) in the category.
- UM is one of just 11 FBS teams to have three players with 500 receiving yards.

BAIN DOMINATING IN FRESHMAN SEASON

- One of the biggest reasons for Miami's strong defense in 2023 has been the dominance of freshman DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.**, who was named ACC Defensive Lineman of the Week for the second straight week on Oct. 30.
- Bain leads Miami in sacks (6.5) and is tied for sixth in the ACC in the category.
- Bain was named ACC DL of the Week and ACC Rookie of the Week on Oct. 23. He was named a Shaun Alexander Freshman of the Year semifinalist on Oct. 31.
- The freshman standout, who was a top-ranked recruit, has an older brother on staff who serves as a graduate assistant (Reggie).

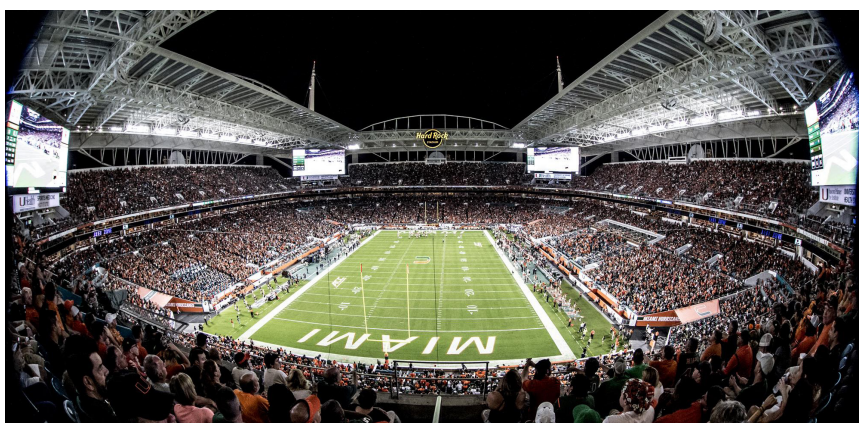

LB Francisco Mauigoa ranks No. 15 in the nation and No. 3 in the ACC with an average of 1.4 tackles for loss per contest so far this year; he leads the Hurricanes with 15 tackles for loss this season.

Miami is one of just 9 teams in FBS to have started the same five players on the offensive line in all of its games this season; the Hurricanes are the only such team in the ACC.

In a Nov. 11 game at FSU, Miami managed its fifth occurrence of allowing 60 or fewer net rushing yards in 2023 - tied for the most such games in the FBS this season, along with only two other teams: Air Force and Nebraska.

115

Mark Fletcher, Jr. rushed for 115 yards in the first start of his Miami career at NC State; it marked the first 100-yard game by a true freshman running back at Miami since Joe Yearby did so in 2014 vs. North Carolina (104 yards).

150

In Miami's game against FSU, Jacolby George became the third Hurricane this century to record at least 150 receiving yards and multiple receiving touchdowns on five or fewer receptions in a game, joining Phillip Dorsett (2014 vs. Arkansas State) and Santana Moss (2000 vs. Virginia Tech).

HURRICANES WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT BOSTON COLLEGE NOV. 24

- Miami wraps up its second regular season under the direction of head coach **Mario Cristobal** on Fri., Nov. 24 on the road at Boston College. Kickoff is set for 12 p.m. from Alumni Stadium in Chestnut Hill.
- Coming off a 38-31 loss against Louisville last time out, Miami is looking for a victory over the Eagles in its first trip to Boston since 2018. The Hurricanes' last win over BC came in 2012 - a 41-32, Week 1 win.
- The Hurricanes lead the all-time series with the Eagles by a dominant 24-6 margin, including an 8-4 mark in road games. Boston College has won three of the last four matchups between the two teams.
- Cristobal played the Eagles twice during his playing days, and the Hurricanes won both games - a 42-12 decision by No. 3 Miami in 1990 and a 19-14 win by the No. 1-ranked Hurricanes on the road in 1991.
- Joining Cristobal on the sidelines in 2023 are seven new faces in full-time assistant coach roles, including both coordinators - offensive coordinator **Shannon Dawson** from the University of Houston and defensive coordinator **Lance Guidry** from Marshall - who are both in their first seasons at The U.
- Miami's game vs. the Eagles is also slated for broadcast on 560 WQAM and americaradio 1260 AM.

LAST TIME OUT: MIAMI RALLIES, FALLS TO #9 LOUISVILLE LATE AT HOME

- QB **Tyler Van Dyke** returned to the lineup and had an impressive outing, throwing for 327 yards on 24-for-39 passing with one touchdown and no interceptions in Miami's 38-31 loss to Louisville Nov. 18.
- 193 of those yards came on connections with WR **Xavier Restrepo**, who was named ACC Receiver of the Week for his performance. RB **Mark Fletcher, Jr.** had a career-high 126 rush yards with two TDs.
- DB **Kam Kinchens** finished with eight total tackles and his team-leading fifth interception, which was his 11th career pick. Kinchens became the first player to record 10 career picks since Sean Taylor.
- Miami outgained Louisville, 486-470, and totaled an impressive 7.5 yards per play in the loss to UofL.

GUIDRY'S UNIT IMPRESSING IN YEAR 1 AS UM DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

- **Lance Guidry**, who was named defensive coordinator at Miami in February 2023, spent the previous two seasons as the defensive coordinator and safeties coach at Marshall University in 2021 and 2022.
- Guidry has made his impact felt in his first season as the defensive coordinator in Coral Gables. The Hurricanes rank No. 28 in FBS in total defense (326.8 yards per game), No. 8 in FBS in team sacks (3.00), No. 13 in FBS in tackles for loss per game (7.3) and No. 25 in first downs on defense (191).
- The Canes are one of just 30 teams in all of FBS allowing fewer than 330.0 yards per game in 2023.
- The Hurricanes allowed the Seminoles to record just 57 net rushing yards on Nov. 11, their fifth time holding their opponent to 60 or fewer net rushing yards this season. At the time, it was tied for the most such games in the FBS this season, along with only two other teams: Air Force and Nebraska.
- Miami had held its opponents under 100 rushing yards its first five games of the season - a streak that ended at North Carolina Oct. 14. It was the Hurricanes' longest such streak to begin a year since 2006.

JOE MOORE-RECOGNIZED OL ONE OF 9 TO HAVE STARTED SAME FIVE

- One of the most important components to Miami's season has been the impressive play of its offensive line. Miami has started LT **Jalen Rivers**, LG **Javion Cohen**, C **Matt Lee**, RG **Anez Cooper** and RT **Francis Mauigoa** for all 11 of its games, and the group has been pivotal to UM's success so far.
- The group was recognized for its outstanding play when it was selected to the midseason honor roll for the Joe Moore Award, which annually honors the top-performing offensive unit in college football.
- Entering Week 13, the Hurricanes were one of only nine FBS groups to have started the same five OL.
- Miami's entire interior line (Cohen, Lee, Cooper) was named to the PFF Team of the Week on Oct. 30.
- In a win vs. Clemson, the group had perhaps its best performance yet. With a freshman QB making his first start, the group did not allow a sack and helped total 211 rushing yards against an elite defense.
- Cooper was named ACC Co-Offensive Lineman of the Week as well as Outland Trophy National Player of the Week after a dominant game vs. Texas A&M, where he graded out as Miami's top lineman.
- Lee was named a candidate for the Rimington Trophy, honoring the top center, after a standout career at UCF. Cohen transferred from Alabama and was named an Outland Trophy candidate.

HURRICANES HAVE STARTED UP TO FIVE FROM TALENTED FROSH CLASS

- Miami's 2023 recruiting class included 15 players ranked in the ESPN 300, including one of the top five, two in the top 20 and six in the top 100. The Hurricanes signed two players who were consensus "five-star" players by every service - Miami had three five-star signees in the last eight classes total.
- An impressive five members of that group started on the road at #4/#4 Florida State: DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.** DB **Damari Brown**, RB **Mark Fletcher, Jr.**, OL **Francis Mauigoa** and QB **Emory Williams**.
- Mauigoa has started all 11 games at right tackle, while four freshmen started last time vs. Louisville.

GEORGE ENJOYING BREAKOUT YEAR, #3 IN ACC IN RECEIVING YARDS

- One of Miami's top performers on offense this season has been WR **Jacolby George**, who has blossomed into one of the conference's best performers in his first year as a full-time starter.
- George totaled 313 yards in his first two seasons (2021, 2022) but has a 762 yards in 2023 - second-most on UM and third-most in the ACC. He also leads Miami in touchdown receptions (7) this year.
- The Lauderhill, Fla., native has been recognized as ACC Receiver of the Week twice this year, following games vs. Texas A&M and Florida State. In his game against FSU, he became the third UM player this century to record at least 150 receiving yards and multiple receiving TDs on five or fewer catches in a game, joining Phillip Dorsett (2014 vs. Arkansas State) and Santana Moss (2000 vs. Virginia Tech).
- Entering Miami's Sept. 9 matchup with Texas A&M, George had just one career touchdown catch in two-plus seasons. He had three alone vs A&M, becoming the first Cane to have three touchdown grabs in the same game since WR **Leonard Hankerson** did so against at Clemson on Oct. 2, 2010.
- George is one of five players in the ACC to have at least seven touchdown catches entering Week 13.
- George put together only the fourth game of three receiving touchdowns by an ACC player this year.

NEW FACES AROUND IN 2023, BOTH ON THE FIELD AND ON SIDELINES

- Among the many storylines of the offseason was the revamping of the Hurricanes roster entering Year 2 under **Mario Cristobal** - both on the sideline with assistant coaches and on the field with players.
- Cristobal's first full recruiting class was the best-ranked class in program history according to the 247Sports Composite; UM's class was the top-rated group in both the ACC and in the state of Florida.
- The Hurricanes also brought in several transfers who started UM's first eight games; OL **Javion Cohen** (Alabama), OL **Matt Lee** (UCF) and LB **Francisco Mauigoa** (Wazzu) are included in the group.
- In total, the Hurricanes have 40 scholarship players who were not on the team in 2022, including a recruiting class featuring 24 true freshman, headlined by five-star offensive lineman **Francis Mauigoa**.
- The Hurricanes new look coaching staff includes seven faces who were not on the full-time staff as assistants a season ago; offensive coordinator **Shannon Dawson**, defensive coordinator **Lance Guidry**, wide receivers coach **Kevin Beard**, running backs coach **Tim Harris, Jr.**, defensive line coach **Jason Taylor**, linebackers coach **Derek Nicholson** and tight ends coach **Cody Woodiel**. Taylor and Woodiel spent the 2022 season as analysts on the Hurricanes staff, while both Beard and Harris are UM alumni.

BAIN SHINING IN YEAR 1, IS FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR SEMIFINALIST

- One of Miami's most impressive breakout players of the season has been true freshman DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.** Bain was named ACC Defensive Lineman of the Week and Rookie of the Week on Oct. 23 after a dominant game vs. Clemson. He repeated as ACC DL of the Week honoree on Oct. 30.
- Bain was named a semifinalist for the Shaun Alexander National Freshman of the Year Award.
- A Miami native, Bain is tied for UM lead s and is tied for sixth in the ACC with 6.5 sacks. He's second on the team in tackles for loss (8.5) and has totaled 35 tackles, which is tops among defensive linemen.
- In a 2OT win over Clemson, Bain had the best performance of his young career - eight tackles, two sacks and one forced fumble. Bain was also named 247Sports True Freshman of the Week and hauled in Shaun Alexander Award Freshman of the Week recognition for his dominant game vs. Clemson.
- He outdid himself against Virginia, finishing with 2.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and seven tackles.
- According to PFF, Bain has more credited quarterback pressures this year (41) than many of the players considered to be the top defensive line prospects in college football ahead of the 2024 NFL Draft; there are only 33 players in all of FBS that have been credited with at least 40 pressures by PFF.
- Bain's older brother, Reggie, is a graduate assistant coach working with the offensive line on UM staff.

MAUIGOA DELIVERING DOMINANT YEAR IN MIDDLE OF MIAMI DEFENSE

- Linebacker **Francisco "Kiko" Mauigoa** has been one of UM's best performers since arriving after spending the first two seasons of his career at Washington State. Mauigoa has started all 11 games.
- Mauigoa ranks second on the team in total tackles with 61 and leads the Hurricanes with 15 tackles for loss. He also is tied for the team lead with 6.5 sacks, and has one interception and two forced fumbles.
- Mauigoa ranks third in the ACC in total tackles for loss and also ranks No. 15 in FBS in the category.

DAWSON'S OFFENSE RANKS NO. 26 IN FBS IN YARDS PER PLAY AT 6.46

- Shannon Dawson**, who was named offensive coordinator / quarterbacks coach at Miami in February 2023, spent the past four seasons at the University of Houston (2019-2022) before joining The U.
- Miami is No. 26 in FBS in yards per play at 6.46. Against FBS competition, UM is one of 36 in the nation averaging 6.0 yards per play (6.1). Miami ranked No. 104 in FBS last season in yards per play.
- Miami rushed for 211 yards in a 2OT win over Clemson on Oct. 21, marking only the 30th time a Dabo Swinney-led Tigers defense had surrendered 200 or more rushing yards in more than 200 games.
- Among other categories where Dawson's work has been clear: Miami ranks No. 16 in FBS and No. 2 in the ACC in completion percentage (65.0), and No. 32 in FBS and No. 5 in ACC in total offense (432.9). Miami is averaging than 65+ more yards per game of offense compared to last year's average (367.1).
- In Dawson's three seasons as quarterbacks coach with the Cougars (2020-22), Houston quarterbacks combined to throw 87 touchdown passes (13th nationally) behind a 65.3 completion percentage (19th) and 10,008 passing yards (21st). Dawson tutored signal caller Clayton Tune to a record-setting career. In 2022, Tune set the American Athletic Conference single-season TD passes record (40).
- Dawson's Cougars ranked eighth nationally in passing offense (314.0) in 2022, while Houston wide receiver Nathaniel Dell led the nation in receiving touchdowns (17) and receiving yards (1,398).
- Other impressive numbers: Houston ranked 15th nationally in scoring offense (35.6), 22nd in first downs offense (314), 23rd in passing offense (271.6) and 25th in red zone offense (.891) in 2022.

"FOURTH QUARTER PROGRAM" EFFECT: UM AMONG TOP IN 4Q SCORING

- When Mario Cristobal arrived to Miami in 2021, one of his first hires was strength & conditioning coordinator **Aaron Feld**. The duo's "fourth quarter" spring workout program has become a staple.
- In games involving only FBS teams across the country, the Hurricanes rank No. 22 in the nation in fourth quarter scoring at 8.4 points per game in 2023. Through its first two games in wins over the Aggies and the RedHawks, Miami outscored its opponents by a 31-7 margin in the final frame.

RESTREPO EMERGING AS GO-TO WIDE RECEIVER IN AIR RAID OFFENSE

- While Miami's offense has impressed under OC Shannon Dawson, WR **Xavier Restrepo** has emerged as one of the nation's top wide receivers this season. He leads the Hurricanes with 68 receptions - including a career-high 12 catches in a start against Georgia Tech and 11 more vs. North Carolina. Restrepo ranks No. 21 in FBS in receptions per game (6.2) and tied for No. 22 in total receptions (68).
- In UM's game with Louisville, Restrepo (193 yards) recorded his fourth game of the season with at least 120 receiving yards. He became the only Hurricane over the past 25 years to record three such games within the first five games of a year - he also managed to do so vs. Texas A&M, Temple and GT.
- GT was the first game to have 10 catches since Mike Harley had 13 vs. Duke on Nov. 27, 2021. Restrepo is only the third Cane in the last five years to have 10 in a game, joining Harley and Charleston Rambo.
- Restrepo was named ACC Receiver of the Week on Mon., Nov. 20 for his performance vs. Louisville.
- Restrepo, who also paces the Hurricanes in receiving yards with 876, struggled through an injury-marred 2022 where he caught only 21 passes for 240 yards total, seeing action in just seven games.
- Restrepo and former roommate **Tyler Van Dyke** have a special connection; Restrepo learned how to play golf based on TVD's love for the sport, and the duo is ultra competitive in everything they do.
- The fourth-year junior surpassed the 1,000 career yard mark at Miami vs. Georgia Tech- he has 114 career catches for 1,501 yards with nine touchdowns. He has started all 11 games.

KINCHENS JOINS ELITE COMPANY, HAD 11TH CAREER PICK VS. LOUISVILLE

- DB **Kam Kinchens** became only the 12th player in Miami Football history to reach double-digit interceptions for a career when he recorded a pick in Miami's 20-6 loss at NC State in Raleigh on Nov. 4.
- He had his 11th career interception last time out vs. Louisville; he is one of only eight active FBS players with at least 10 career interceptions and is the only junior to crack the list - all seven others are seniors.
- Kinchens is the first Hurricane since the iconic Sean Taylor (2001-03) to record at least 10 picks in a career. Taylor finished his career with 14. Before Sean Taylor reached 10, the previous player to reach the plateau was Ed Reed, who had 21 interceptions from 1998-2001. 21 still represents Miami's career record.

FLETCHER ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK, HAS CAREER GAME VS LOUISVILLE

- Running back **Mark Fletcher, Jr.** delivered a strong showing in the first start of his Miami career at NC State on Nov. 4. He rushed for a career-best 115 yards on a career-high 23 carries in Raleigh, N.C.
- For his efforts, Fletcher was announced as ACC Rookie of the Week by the conference on Nov. 7.
- Fletcher delivered another dominant outing last time out vs. Louisville: 17 carries, 126 yards and 2 TDs.
- Fletcher recorded 115 rushing yards, 5.0 yards per rush and three receptions vs. the Wolfpack. The last UM freshman to match or surpass those numbers was Duke Johnson in 2012 at BC (135, 19.3, three).
- It marked the first 100-yard game by a true freshman at UM since Joe Yearby in 2014 vs. UNC (104).

BORREGALES LOOKING TO CARRY ON FAMILY'S GROZA LEGACY AT UM

- Junior K **Andy Borregales** has delivered another dominant season for the Hurricanes in 2023. Ranked as a preseason candidate for the Lou Groza Award, Borregales has tallied 54 career field goals on 64 attempts (84.4%), which ranks him as the fifth-most accurate among those with 50 attempts.
- Borregales was named ACC Specialist of the Week on Oct. 30 for a dominant game vs. Virginia. Borregales hit on three field goals of at least 45 yards - connecting from 47, 50 and 48 - and went 6-for-6 on touchbacks. He is the only kicker in 2023 with a game to have three field goals of at least 45 yards.
- Borregales, whose older brother Jose is the lone Lou Groza Award winner in Miami history (2020), is 20-for-23 on field goals this year. His three misses all came on attempts of 45 yards or longer.
- Borregales is one of 24 kickers in FBS with a 85%-or-better success rate this year - he is 15th in FBS (87.0%) in the category. He is one of only 12 kickers in the country with at least 20 made field goals.

BRASHARD ONE OF NATION'S MOST DANGEROUS, IS 2ND IN FBS IN KOR

- Though he has only had 18 returns in his 11 games, WR **Brashard Smith** has made them count, ranking second in the nation in kickoff return average averaging 30.2 yards per return so far this year.
- Smith's 98-yard kickoff return TD vs. Texas A&M was his first kickoff return for a touchdown of his career.
- Smith had an 80-yard run that resulted in a touchdown in Miami's 20T win over Clemson on Oct. 21.
- The junior speedster ranks No. 1 on Miami in all-purpose yards this season, including a season-high 168 at North Carolina. He totaled 150 yards in Miami's 20T win vs. Clemson and 66 against NC State.

BACK-TO-BACK OVERTIME WS A RARITY IN COLLEGE FOOTBALL, AT UM

- Miami won back-to-back games in overtime this season, emerging victorious over Clemson in two overtimes on Oct. 21 and beating Virginia in OT on Oct. 28. It marked the first time in the history of Miami where the Canes played two overtime games in the same season - let alone back-to-back.
- UM became the first team since Georgia Southern in 2019 to win overtime games in back-to-back outings. UM was the first Power-5 team to do it since Northwestern won three such games in 2017.

UM DOMINANT VS. CLEMSON IN TRENCHES: RUSHED >200, ALLOWED <50

- Trailing 17-7 in the fourth quarter, the Hurricanes orchestrated an impressive comeback to top visiting Clemson, 28-20, in 2OT on Oct. 21. It was UM's first overtime win since a 4OT win at Virginia in 2022.
- The Hurricanes held Clemson to just 31 rushing yards on 34 attempts, while Miami gained 211 on 38 attempts (5.6 yard average). A suffocating defense also turned the Tigers over three times in the win.
- Clemson allowed 200 rushing yards for just the 30th time under the direction of Dabo Swinney.
- DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.** led the defensive front with eight total tackles, two sacks and one forced fumble. He was named ACC Defensive Lineman of the Week and ACC Rookie of the Week for his efforts.
- Starting in place of QB Tyler Van Dyke, QB **Emory Williams** delivered an impressive second half to help direct the comeback effort. Williams finished 24-for-33 for 151 yards with one touchdown.
- WR **Brashard Smith** had an 80-yard run that resulted in a TD, while RB **Ajay Allen** had 54 yards and the decisive touchdown in the second overtime period. WR **Xavier Restrepo** had seven catches.
- After Allen's touchdown run, Clemson featured a 1st & Goal on the 2-yard line in the second overtime but could not capitalize. LB **Corey Flagg, Jr.**, came up with the game-ending tackle on 4th and Goal.

- Miami announced that the Hurricanes football program would retire legendary quarterback Gino Torretta's No. 13 jersey. The jersey retirement ceremony took place at halftime vs. Louisville.
- The consensus first-team All-American capped an incredible 1992 season by becoming the second Hurricane to win the Heisman Trophy, while also earning the Maxwell Award, the Davey O'Brien Award, the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award, the Walter Camp Player of the Year, the Chevrolet Offensive Player of the Year, the Toyota Leadership Award and the Hitachi/CFA Scholar Athlete of Year Award.
- Two football players – WR Michael Redding III and DL Chantz Williams – currently wear No. 13 and will have a commemorative patch on their jerseys honoring Torretta. Miami's other retired jerseys are No. 10 (George Mira), No. 14 (Vinny Testaverde), No. 42 (Jim Dooley) and No. 89 (Ted Hendricks).

ONE OF THE BEST FBS DUOS: KINCHEMS + WILLIAMS A TALENTED PAIR

- Two of Miami's closest teammates on and off the field are two of its best players in safety pairing **Kam Kinchens** and **James Williams**. The two third-year players make up a highly talented duo.
- Williams delivered a dominant outing in UM's win over Virginia totaling a team-high and career-high 13 tackles in Miami's overtime win over Virginia. He leads the Hurricanes with 60 total tackles this season.
- Kinchens was similarly dominant against the Cavaliers; the standout was named ACC Defensive Back of the Week after recording the second pick-six of his career. Kinchens returned the pick 29 yards for a TD.
- Kinchens recorded the 10th pick of his career at NC State - just the 12th UM player to reach the mark.
- Kinchens, an All-American a season ago, was named to the All-ACC First Team in 2022 after having 59 total tackles and a team-high six interceptions. He is a member of UM's leadership council.
- Kinchens average interceptions-per-game mark (0.30) is the fourth-best career mark in all of FBS.
- The Miami native is one of only 11 players in all of FBS to have recorded 9 career interceptions.
- Another impactful player in his own right, the 6-foot-5 Williams made 10 starts and ranked second on the team with 58 tackles a season ago. Both players are South Florida natives and best friends.

BROTHERLY LOVE IN CORAL GABLES, SEVERAL WITH UM FAMILY TIES

- The Miami Hurricanes will feature a number of family ties on the sideline this fall across the roster.
- Newcomer OL **Francis Mauigoa** and older brother LB **Francisco Mauigoa** will feature prominently for Miami this season. Another set of newcomers have lined up on the same side of the ball, in freshman DB **Damari Brown** and junior DB **Davonte Brown**. The elder Mauigoa arrived from Washington State via the transfer portal, as did the elder Brown, who came to Miami from UCF. Both arrived in January.
- Two sets of twins populate the freshmen ranks, as well; Miami natives WR **Robby Washington** and LB **Bobby Washington, Jr.**, as well as QB **Riply Luna** and WR **Kolby Luna**, who are from Idaho.
- The older brother of freshman DL **Rueben Bain, Jr.**, one of the top-ranked freshman defensive lineman, is offensive graduate assistant **Reggie Bain**. In addition, the nephew of head coach **Mario Cristobal** - **Luis Cristobal, Jr.** - transferred to Miami from Georgia State prior to the season.

CANES HADN'T STARTED WITH THREE IN A ROW AT HOME SINCE 2013

- The Hurricanes had not started the season with a 3-0 mark at home since 2013. Coincidentally, during that early stretch, they also played a ranked SEC team (No. 12 Florida) and won in Week 2.

HOME SWEET HOME OPENERS: UM CONTINUES RUN OF SUCCESS AT HRS

- The Miami Hurricanes opened their 16th season at world-class Hard Rock Stadium on Sept. 1 vs. Miami-Ohio with a 38-3 win; UM holds a 16-0 all-time mark in home openers at the stadium, having outscored opponents 727-122 for an average margin of victory of 37.8 points in those 16 games.
- The Hurricanes have not lost a home opener since 2006, when they fell to Florida State 13-10 at the Orange Bowl on Sept. 4, 2006. Miami has won 17 straight home openers since - each one since 2007.
- Since joining the ACC prior to the 2004 season, Miami has played a conference opponent in only three of its 20 home openers: Florida State twice (in 2004 and 2006) and Georgia Tech once (2009).
- In the modern era of Miami Hurricanes football (since 1979), UM has opened the season at home 19 times and is 17-2 in those games. The Hurricanes are 33-12 in regular season openers dating to 1979.

UM SIGNING CLASS, RANKED AS THE BEST IN HISTORY, MAKES DEBUT

- Miami's 2023 recruiting class included 15 players ranked in the ESPN 300, including one of the top five, two in the top 20 and six in the top 100. The Canes signed two players who were considered consensus "five-star" players by every recruiting service - UM had three five-star signees in the last eight classes.
- 15 players in the class made their debut, headlined by **Francis Mauigoa**, who started at right tackle.
- Mauigoa** (#7) and **Samson Okunlola** (#18) represent two of the top 20 players that Miami has ever signed since 247Sports began their rankings in the year 2000. The Hurricanes signed five players who earned All-American Bowl invitations and five players who were Under-Armour All-Americans.
- 15 of Miami's freshmen joined the program for the spring and competed in spring practice.

THREE SELECTED IN DRAFT, MIAMI'S NFL STREAK CONTINUES IN 2023

- The selections of Miami defensive back Tyrique Stevenson (Chicago Bears, second round), tight end Will Mallory (Indianapolis Colts, fifth) and DJ Ivey (Cincinnati Bengals, seventh) extended the Hurricanes' streak of having at least one player picked in every NFL Draft since 1975; the fourth-longest FBS streak.

MIAMI PLACES THREE ON PRESEASON ALL-ACC FOOTBALL TEAM

- Among Miami's preseason honorees were DB **Kam Kinchens**, OL **Javion Cohen** and K **Andy Borregales**, who were all selected to the All-ACC Preseason Team in a poll of conference media in August 2023.

TVD HAS COMPILED PROLIFIC MIAMI CAREER, REBOUNDED VS. LOUISVILLE

- QB **Tyler Van Dyke** put together an ACC Rookie of the Year campaign at Miami in 2021. Van Dyke's 2022 season was marred by injury, forcing him to miss significant action during the second half of the year. He missed Miami's last game vs. Clemson Oct. 21 but returned in the Hurricanes' OT win over Virginia.
- Van Dyke rebounded last time out vs. Louisville, throwing for more than 300 yards with one touchdown.
- Van Dyke struggled in Miami's win against UVA, throwing for a season-low 163 yards with two picks.
- In Miami's win against Bethune-Cookman, Van Dyke became the first Hurricane to record multiple pass touchdowns, a rush touchdown and complete 80 percent of his passes in a single game.
- over the past 25 seasons. He finished 19-for-23 for 247 yards with two touchdowns and no picks.
- Van Dyke entered Week 4 ranked 10th on UM's career completions list with 419. He's now No. 6 with 556, having passed Craig Erickson (420), Ryan Clement (427), Bernie Kosar (463) & Kyle Wright (478).
- Van Dyke's five touchdown passes vs. Texas A&M marked a new career high. The performance was TVD's eighth career start with multiple TDs and zero picks. He had his ninth such start vs. Bethune.
- Van Dyke became the third Miami Hurricane to win ACC Rookie of the Year and ACC Offensive Rookie of the Year honors in 2021, joining QB Brad Kaaya (2014) and RB Duke Johnson (2012) to do so.
- Van Dyke has throw multiple interceptions in a game just seven times in his 26 career starts at The U.
- Van Dyke took over starting duties three games into the season in 2021 and ended the year with 2,931 yards, 25 passing touchdowns and just six interceptions. He completed 62% of passes that season.

MARIO CRISTOBAL

HEAD COACH | SECOND SEASON AT MIAMI (12TH OVERALL) | 11-12 | 72-71

Mario Cristobal has returned home to Miami.

Cristobal, who helped lead the University of Miami to two national championships in 1989 and 1991 as a standout offensive lineman, was named the University's 26th football head coach on December 6, 2021.

One of college football's most highly regarded coaches, Cristobal returned to his alma mater after leading the University of Oregon to three straight Pac-12 Conference championship game appearances and two Pac-12 titles. He is the only coach in the nation whose team has played in a Power Five conference championship game in each of the past three seasons.

"We are incredibly excited to welcome Mario, his wife, Jessica, and their sons Mario Mateo and Rocco home to Miami," UM President Julio Frenk said. "Mario's legacy as a student-athlete at the U is well established. And the standard for competitive excellence that he and his teammates helped establish is one to which we continue to aspire. Our selection, however, was not one based in nostalgia for a proud past, but rather in a bold vision for a promising future."

"The characteristics that helped Mario excel as a national championship-winning player—drive, determination, and discipline—continue to propel his success as a coach. In Mario we have found a head coach who shares our belief in providing student-athletes with the very best opportunities to succeed on and off the field, and our commitment to winning at the highest level."

"My family and I are excited to return home to the University of Miami, which has been so instrumental in shaping me as a person, player, and coach," Cristobal said. "This program has an unparalleled tradition and an exciting future ahead of it. I can't wait to compete for championships and help mold our student-athletes into leaders on and off the field who will make our University, our community, and our loyal fan base proud."

Cristobal brings more than 20 years of FBS coaching experience to Coral Gables, including 10 as a head coach. He compiled a 35-13 record at Oregon, leading the Ducks to consecutive Pac-12 titles in 2019 and 2020. Oregon advanced to three straight conference championship games from 2019 to 2021 and earned bowl-game appearances in each of Cristobal's seasons in Eugene, highlighted by a Rose Bowl victory that capped a 12-win season and No. 5 ranking in the final Associated Press and AFCA Coaches polls in 2019. Cristobal was named the Associated Press Pac-12 Coach of the Year for his efforts that season.

Over Cristobal's first three seasons in Eugene, Oregon players earned 44 all-conference selections and 14 players were selected in the NFL Draft, including first-round selections in each of the past three drafts. With the selections of Kayvon Thibodeaux (2022), Penei Sewell (2021) and Justin Herbert (2020), Cristobal is one of only two active head coaches to produce top-10 picks in each of the last three drafts.

During his tenure as both an assistant and head coach at Oregon, two players—Noah Sewell and Thibodeaux—earned Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year honors, and three players—Thibodeaux, Penei Sewell, and Tyrell Crosby—earned the Morris Trophy, awarded to the Pac-12's best offensive and defensive linemen.

Cristobal served as Oregon's co-offensive coordinator, run-game coordinator, and offensive line coach during the 2017 season before being elevated to head coach.

Cristobal's national title-winning pedigree isn't limited to his time as a player. At Alabama, where he served as assistant head coach, offensive line coach, and recruiting coordinator, he helped lead the Crimson Tide to the national championship in 2015 and a runner-up finish the following season.

During his four years in Tuscaloosa, from 2013 to 2016, five Alabama offensive linemen were selected in the NFL Draft and, with Cristobal's tutelage, the 2015 offensive line unit won the inaugural Joe Moore Award, given to the most outstanding offensive line unit in the nation.

Considered one of the country's elite recruiters and evaluators of talent, Cristobal, during his tenures at both Alabama and Oregon, helped assemble national top-15 recruiting classes eight straight years, with seven of those classes rated in the top 10. The 2018 class at Alabama produced three NFL first-round draft picks. At Oregon, he constructed the Pac-12's top-rated recruiting classes in 2019, 2020, and 2021.

Cristobal's move to Miami brings his coaching career full circle. A son of South Florida who played prep football at nearby Christopher Columbus High School, he launched his coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Miami from 1998 to 2000 under head coach Butch Davis. He served as an assistant coach at Rutgers from 2001 to 2003 and then returned to Miami as an assistant coach from 2004 to 2006 under head coach Larry Coker.

In 2007, Cristobal was named head coach at Florida International University, becoming the first Cuban American head coach in FBS history. He inherited a struggling FIU program that had been winless the year before his arrival and, in just his fourth season, led it to the Sun Belt Conference title and a bowl-game victory. That season, 2010, he was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year. In total, he coached six seasons at FIU, from 2007 to 2012.

Cristobal, who played his Hurricanes career under coaches Jimmy Johnson and Dennis Erickson, was an All-Big East selection in 1992. He is a double-alumnus of the University of Miami, earning a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree from the University. Cristobal was born in Miami on Sept. 24, 1970. He and his wife, Jessica, married in June 2006 and are the parents of two sons, Mario Mateo and Rocco.
