- Olivia Babcock recorded a match-high 14 kills, hitting .462 while Stafford notched 11 kills on a .400 hitting clip
- This match marked the 10th straight season Coach Dan Fisher has led his squad to 20 wins. 9/8- vs. #24 Marquette - 17 kills, 10 digs

#### VVG IS BACK!

SENIOR SWEEP

- The 2022 AVCA Second Team All-American has announced that she will return next season for her final year of eligibility.
- Vazquez Gomez is currently second in digs and aces and third in kills.
- She has totaled 749 kills, 719 digs, 76 aces and 74 assists.

#### **GRITTY PANTHERS**

- The Panthers are currently second in the nation in opponent hitting percentage, holding teams to an average .133.
- The combination of Pitt's block and backcourt defense has been tough to stop this season, and it has held 11 opponents to less than a .100 hitting percentage.

### **DUAL THREAT**

- Emma Monks and Chiamaka Nwokolo impress defensively, but they are currently top 15 in the nation in hitting efficiency.
- Nwokolo sits at fifth with a .456 clip while Monks is 11th with a .421 percentage.

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

- The Pitt Panthers are currently first in the nation in blocks per set (3.11).
- Chiamaka Nwokolo, Rachel Jepsen, Olivia Babcock and Emma Monks have all registered at least six blocks in a match so far this season.
- Emma Monks is currently fifth in the nation in blocks per set (1.54) while Chiamaka Nwokolo is 16th with 1.40 blocks per set.
- Monks recorded a career-high 11 blocks in the sweep over Virginia Tech.

#### **OFFENSIVE PROWESS**

- The Panthers have been dangerous offensively as of late and are currently first in the nation in hitting percentage (.315).
- They lead reigning Big Ten Champion Wisconsin and Pac 12 Champion Stanford.

In ten seasons under head coach Dan Fisher, Pitt volleyball has risen to unprecedented success, garnering three consecutive ACC Championship titles (2017, 2018, 2019), the program's first three NCAA Elite Eight appearances (2020, 2021, 2022) and the university's first NCAA Division I Women's Final Four appearances (2021, 2022).

In short: Fisher knows how to win.

Combining the last four seasons (2018-22), Pitt has won more matches than any other NCAA Division I women's volleyball program with 109 victories.

In January 2021, Fisher signed a contract extension that ensures his leadership of the Panthers through at least the 2027 season, as announced by Director of Athletics Heather Lyke.

On the horizon for the Pitt volleyball program is the Victory Heights initiative, a series of state-of-the-art athletics projects that will provide Pitt student-athletes with national-caliber competition, training and sports performance and medicine facilities. Announced in 2020, the plan includes a new 3,500-seat arena for the volleyball, gymnastics and wrestling programs. The volleyball team will also have its own in-house practice facility.

"For us to have our own practice facility and a competition facility, is an absolute game-changer for volleyball," Fisher said at the unveiling. "The training environment is going to be better, having everything in the same spot...this means that we're going from a good experience to a great experience."

A two-time ACC and American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach Region of the Year (2017, 2018), Fisher has elevated the Panthers to new heights. He has guided the team to the NCAA Tournament more than any coach in program history (2016-21). He was instrumental in Pitt's bid to host NCAA Volleyball Tournament matches at Petersen Events Center (2018, 2019, 2021), and led the Panthers to their highest postseason seed in program history at No. 3 in 2021. Most recently, Fisher guided Pitt to its longest NCAA Tournament run in program history, reaching Final Four for the first time after defeating No. 6 seed Purdue in the Regional Final.

Just eight months earlier, the Panthers secured one of the biggest wins in program history after upsetting No. 3 seed Minnesota in the 2020 NCAA Regional Semifinal, played in April 2021 in Omaha, Neb.

An accomplished coach at every level of the game, Fisher's coaching résumé includes an NAIA National Championship at Concordia (2012) with two national title match appearances (2011, 2012). Additionally, he earned a gold medal with Team USA at the 2015 Pan Am Games. Over the last 20 years his involvement with USA Volleyball has been extensive, ranging from his time as a player (2000, 2001), to an assistant coach (2006, 2007, 2012) to a head coach (2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021).
