OUICK HITS

KEEP IT ROLLIN'

Miami is off to a 8-0 start for the second time under head coach Katie Meier. The Canes have held teams below 50 points in half of the games this season.

ONE OF 18

Miami is one of 18 unbeaten programs across NCAA Division I. Additionally, the Canes are one of two ACC programs with an unblemished record as well.

RESPECT WIN IN STARKVEGAS

The Nov. 29 win at Mississippi marked Miami's firstever road win against a ranked SEC team in regular season play in program history. It was also its first regular season non-conference ranked road win since defeating Ohio State in 2016.

BENCH MOB

Miami ranks first in the conference in bench points per game at 31.2 and 15th in the nation in that category. Every active Hurricane has scored in five of the eight games.

LEADERS. NOT FOLLOWERS

Miami has been in the lead for over 250 minutes this season, while opponents have only held the lead for just over 45-combined minutes through eight games.

DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORERS

The Canes have combined for 29 double-digit scoring performances. Interestingly, Miami has yet to have a 20-point scorer during its 8-0 start.

Miami ranks 1st in the ACC in 1st scoring defense, holding teams to just 52.9 points per game.

Head coach Katie Meier reached 350 win No. 350 as the head coach at UM Dec. 3 vs. NJIT.

Miami ranks first in the ACC and 39.3 19th across DI in three-point percentage at 39.3 %

Jaida Patrick scored 16 combined 16 points in each of the last two first quarters.

Miami's best quarter offensively has come in the 4th. The Canes have scored 177 in the last frame.

LAST TIME OUT

• CORAL GABLES, Fla. – Miami (8-0) got off to a hot start, held off DePaul's late push and used five double-digit scoring performances to defeat the Blue Demons (5-5), 75-70, Friday, Dec. 8.

SCOUTING THE BEARS

- Baylor enters as one of the nation's undefeated teams, coming in with a perfect 8-0 record that includes a pair of wins against Power Five foes.
- The Bears' most notable win was a victory against No. 4 Utah, as well as a 20-point drubbing of Oregon.
- · Baylor was tabbed 19th in the preseason Associated Press Top 25 poll.
- Aijha Blackwell was named to the Cheryl Miller Preseason Watch List. Dre'Una Edwards and Darianna Littlepage-Buggs were also selected to the 2024 Katrina McClain Award Preseason Watch List.

STEADY AS IT GOES

• Junior Jacksonville native Jasmyne Roberts has tallied double-digit scoring efforts in six of her last 8 games this season. She has gone for performances of at least 12 points and seven boards in each of her last three games.

BIG-TIME BENCH

- Having a deep roster has become a staple of a Katie Meier-coached team and the 2023-24 roster is no different. All 10 Hurricanes are averaging at least 12 minutes played per game.
- Miami's bench leads the ACC in scoring, averaging 31.2 points per game. That mark is good for 16th nationally.

SEASON 19 LOADING...

- In her 19th season at the helm of the Hurricanes, head coach Katie Meier has carved her name into the Miami record books. With 351 career victories at The U, Meier is the Hurricanes' all-time winningest coach men's or women's basketball.
- She coached Miami to its first ever Elite Eight in 2023, advancing to the first Sweet Sixteen of her career along the way.
- Meier ranks 50th among active Division I head coaches in career victories at 427 and is one of four ACC coaches to reach the 400-career-victory mark.

DYNAMIC DUO

- Miami returns just two of five starters from a season ago in juniors Jasmyne Roberts and Ja'Leah Williams.
- Roberts was the star of Miami's NCAA Tournament run, averaging 19.0 points and 7.3 rebounds in four tournament games to earn a spot on the Greenville 2 All-Region team. She eclipsed the 20-point mark in back-to-back games, including setting a new career high in scoring with 26 points against Villanova.

THE 2023-24 SLATE

- The Hurricanes will face 10 NCAA Tournament teams from a season ago in 2023-24, including Louisville and Virginia Tech who advanced to the Elite Eight and Final Four, respectively.
- Eighteen of Miami's 25 opponents in 2023-24 finished in the NET Top 100 at the conclusion of last

season and 13 posted 20-win seasons. Seven of the Hurricanes' opponents sit in the Associated Press Preseason Top-25.

TERRIFIC TRANSFERS

- Miami brought in four transfers in the offseason Shayeann Day-Wilson, Lemyah Hylton, Jaida Patrick and Ally Stedman. Two of the four, Day-Wilson and Patrick, are familiar faces among the ACC as they both spent their first two collegiate seasons at Duke.
- Patrick most recently played for the Columbia Lions, averaging 12.5 points and 4.8 rebounds as a senior and earning All-Ivy Second Team honors. Day-Wilson was the ACC Freshman of the Year in 2021-22 and averaged 10.2 points and 3.1 assists per game at Duke.
- Hylton joins the Hurricanes after playing for Arizona in 2022-23, where she saw action in 15 games as a freshman. Stedman spent two seasons at Pepperdine, earning WCC All-Freshman Team in 2021-22 and All-WCC Honorable Mention in 2022-23.

OH CANADA

- Over one-third of the Hurricanes' 2023-24 roster hails from the Great White North, mainly from the Toronto area. Juniors Shayeann Day-Wilson and Latasha Lattimore reunited this season at Miami as they were high school teammates in Canada.
- Lemyah Hylton calls Mississauga, Ontario home, while Lashae Dwyer is also from Toronto. All four have represented Canada at various national team events.

DRIVE TO '25

- Head coach Katie Meier signed the ninth-ranked recruiting class in the nation as announced Nov. 8, the highest in her career according to espnW early recruiting class rankings. The 2024 class is made of a trio of guards in Ahnay Adams, Leah Harmon and Simone Pelish.
- Adams is a two-time New Hampshire Gatorade Player of the Year and the No. 37 overall player. Harmon

DRAFTED TO THE W

- Graduate student Destiny Harden became the seventh Hurricane in program history selected to the WNBA after getting drafted No. 27 overall (third round) by the Phoenix Mercury. She was one of three ACC players drafted and the firstever selection by the Mercury.
- Harden joins the likes of Beatrice Mompremier (2020), Adrienne Motley (2017), Shenise Johnson (2012), Riquna Williams (2012), Tamara James (2006) and Octavia Blue (1998).

HOME SWEET HOME

- Miami holds a 542-212 (.719) all-time record at home and, since the inception of the program, has only finished the season with a losing home record four times.
- The Hurricanes have been particularly good at defending their home court under head coach Katie Meier, totaling a 235-89 (.725) record at home since she took over in 2005-06.

Over the last 18 years, the name Katie Meier has become synonymous with Miami women's basketball.

As the head coach of the Miami women's basketball team, Meier has amassed 11 20-win seasons and coached the team to 13 postseason appearances, including 10 straight from 2009-2019. She is the all-time winningest basketball coach – men's or women's – at Miami with 351 career victories.

Through the 2022-23 campaign, Meier boasts a career record of 419-269 and holds a 343-224 mark during her time heading up the Miami program.

A Historic Run

In 2022-23, Meier and the Hurricanes made history, earning the program's first ever Elite Eight berth in the NCAA Tournament.

The run began in thrilling fashion as Miami mounted a 17-point halftime comeback against ninth-seeded Oklahoma State in the first round, the sixth-largest halftime comeback in NCAA Tournament history, to defeat the Cowgirls, 62-61.

The Hurricanes followed that with one of the biggest upsets of the tournament, defeating top-seeded Indiana on their home court, 70-68, to earn the first Sweet Sixteen berth of Meier's tenure.

In true Cinderella fashion, Miami then withstood a 20-point comeback by fourth-seeded Villanova in the Sweet Sixteen to earn a trip to the Elite Eight, defeating the Wildcats, 70-65.

Miami's historic run came to an end in the Elite Eight when they fell to eventual national champion, LSU, 54-42.

Honors and Accolades

Meier has been recognized for her coaching success numerous times throughout her career.

She was a co-recipient of the 2013 USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award following a 9-0 record and gold medal at the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship and was inducted into the University of Miami Sports Hall of Fame in 2017.

At the conclusion of the 2010-11 season, Meier was named the Associated Press National Coach of the Year – sharing the award with Connecticut's Geno Auriemma and Stanford's Tara VanDerveer. That season, she led the Hurricanes to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2004, coached the Hurricanes to their first NCAA Tournament win since 1993 and was named ACC Coach of the Year.

In 2002, Meier was named to the ACC's 50th Anniversary Team and in 2006, she named an ACC Legend at the 2006 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament.

All About the Players

Meier has developed Miami into a program committed to its players and those student-athletes have flourished over the last 18 years.

Five All-Americans have emerged under Meier's tutelage: Tamara James (2006), Shenise Johnson (2011, 2012), Riguna Williams (2011, 2012), Adrienne Motley (2016) and Beatrice Mompremier (2019, 2020).

Six Hurricanes have been drafted into the WNBA following their time at Miami under Meier's tutelage, most recently being Destiny Harden who was selected 27th overall by the Phoenix Mercury in the 2023 WNBA Draft. James, Johnson, Mompremier, Motley and Williams were all also selected to the WNBA.

In total, Meier has coached 25 players that have gone on to play professionally, whether that is in the WNBA or overseas.

Under Meier's direction, 16 players have earned All-ACC Team postseason accolades, including Shenise Johnson who was named ACC Player of the Year in 2011. Five Hurricanes have been tabbed to the ACC All-Defensive Team and five rookies have made an appearance on the ACC All-Freshman Team. Emese Hof ('18), earned the first ACC Most Improved Player for Miami in program history.

Meier's players have also excelled in the classroom as 17 players have earned a spot on the ACC All-Academic team, with four players earning multi-year bids. Additionally, Miami has placed someone on the ACC Honor Roll in all 18 of Meier's seasons as head coach.

Milestone Moments

Miami made it's 10th NCAA Tournament appearance under Meier in 2022, besting South Florida in the first round. The win over the Bulls marked Meier's 400th career win as a head coach

At the 2022 ACC Tournament, Miami made a historic run all the way to the ACC Championship Game – the first finals appearance in program history. The Hurricanes defeated a pair of top-25 teams in No. 4 Louisville and No. 20 Notre Dame en route to the finals.

On Nov. 9, 2021, Meier became the all-time winningest basketball coach – men's or women's – at Miami, passing Hurricane legend Ferne Labati (303).

Miami's trip to the 2019 NCAA Tournament marked the 10th consecutive postseason appearance for the program, including the eighth trip to the NCAA Tournament in nine years.

In 2015-16, Meier led Miami to a 24-9 record to tie for the fifth-most wins in a season in program history. The Hurricanes beat both Duke and North Carolina in the same year for the first time in program history, with the victory at North Carolina being the 200th of Meier's tenure at Miami.

During the 2011-12 season, Meier coached the Hurricanes to their highest ranking in program history at No. 5. Miami went undefeated at home for the second consecutive season, pushing the home win streak to 40 games.

The Hurricanes entered the 2010-11 season picked eighth in the Preseason ACC Poll and exceeded all outside expectations, posting a perfect 20-0 record inside the BankUnited Center. Miami finished conference play with a 12-2 record, earning their first regular season conference title since joining the league in 2004.

Shenise Johnson was named to four different All-America squads and became the second player in program history to be named the conference player of the year (Frances Savage – BIG EAST – 1992).

Hired April 19, 2005, Meier was appointed head coach of the Miami women's basketball team by then-Miami AD Paul Dee, signifying the beginning of a new era.

Prior to Miami

Meier got her start as a head coach at Charlotte, where she recorded an impressive four-year tenure. The 49ers made the postseason in three of her four years including the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance since...Following a successful 2002-03 season, Meier was named Conference USA Coach of the Year.

Prior to Charlotte, Meier did stints at Tulane (1994-2001) and UNC Asheville (1993-94).

Establishing Her Legacy as a Player

Meier's success as a coach is a direct reflection of her playing career as a standout at Duke University. A four-year letter winner for the Blue Devils under head coach Debbie Leonard from 1986-90, Meier's name is scattered throughout the Duke record books.

She earned ACC Rookie of the Year and Basketball Yearbook Freshman All-America honors in 1986 and was named a Kodak WBCA District 2 All-American in 1990.

In 2002, Meier was honored by Duke for her efforts as a player when she was named to the inaugural induction class in the Blue Devils' Hall of Honor.

Meier's success on the court was only outdone by her accomplishments in the classroom. She was named to the Dean's List from 1986-88. In 1988 she also earned GTE Academic All-America Second Team honors.

After receiving a bachelor's degree in English literature with cum laude honors in 1989, Meier went on to earn a master's degree in teaching English from Duke in 1990.

Following her career at Duke, Meier moved overseas to play three seasons with BBC Mini-Flat Waregem in Belgium from 1990-93. There, she helped lead her team to three First Division regular season titles and one Belgian Cup Championship. While in Belgium, Meier also spent time teaching classes of conversational English while coaching teams of 15- to 17-year-olds.

A native of Wheaton, Ill., Meier graduated from Wheaton Central High School in 1985 and in October 2009 was inducted into her high school's athletic hall of fame.
