2023-24 SEASON

NOTRE DAME vs MIAMI

A series that has gone back and forth over the years and is completely even heading into Saturday's matchup. The two sides are tied 13-13 all-time = split evenly in home (6-6), away (6-6) and neutral (1-1). Though, the Irish are 7-6 against Miami since joining the ACC.

In fact, over the last 13 games, the average margin of victory has been 9.5 points.

The last encounter -> a 76-65 loss in South Bend. The Irish were up one at the half and only trailed 51-49 with 12 minutes remaining before succumbing to the final score.

The last time in Miami -> a 68-64 ND victory. The Irish got a big 23-point, 11-rebound performance from Paul Atkinson Jr. and utilized a key 22-6 scoring run in the second half.

10 YEARS IN THE ACC

Saturday not only marks the first ACC game of the season but also the 10-year anniversary of Notre Dame hoops joining the league.

In 2015, Notre Dame produced a program record 32-6 and defeated Miami, Duke and North Carolina in Greensboro to claim

the 2015 ACC Tournament championship. Since, the Irish made an ACC Tournament semifinal appearance in 2016 and title-game appearance in 2017.

HITTING THE MARK(US)

Everyone is starting to take notice of freshman point guard Markus Burton. To help you get more acquainted, read up on the following stats:

- His 16.3 ppg leads all ACC freshmen and ranks 5th nationally amongst DI freshmen.
- Overall his scoring average ranks 15th in the ACC.
- Burton has started his career with five straight games in double figures before the streak ended with 8 points at South Carolina.
- Burton picked up his second game of 20 or more points against Oklahoma St on Nov. 17. The following is a list of the most 20-point games by an Irish freshman: Adrian Dantley (13 in '73-74), Troy Murphy (10 in '98-99) and David Rivers (10 in '84-85).

THAT'S IRISH BASKETBALL

There was a lot to be happy with after the 75-55 win over UMES on Nov. 22. For starters, the ball was moving quickly and efficiently on the offensive end as Notre Dame posted a season best 18 assists on 28

made field goals.

The ball movement then directly led to better looks from three, as the Irish hit double-digit treys for the first time this season - 13 to be exact. What was also great to see was nine different Irish recorded a made three.

"We've put a huge emphasis on it," Shrewsberry said. "Guys are doing it. I thought we passed up average or OK shots for great shots. We need to be this kind of team."

Next, the defense was stifling, allowing just 55 points - a season best for ND.

Burton continued to impress with season highs in rebounds (6), assists (5) and steals (3). He recorded his first 5-5-5 stat-sheet stuffer game after earning 12 points as well.

Lastly, welcome to the lineup Kebba Njie. The sophomore returned from injury and made his Irish debut with a solid seven points and four rebounds.

"Every little thing that happens is just more and more belief," Shrewsberry said. "More and more belief in what we're doing, how we're playing, what we're talking about."

Quotables from South Carolina

"Who is going to be our go to guy. Who's our guy we can turn to to get a bucket when tough times happen. That's what we're searching for. Until we find that, things will keep happening like this. When things get tough, we have to trust the system and stay with it."

"We are only going to get better and better. I still believe in our guys. I will roll with them anywhere. We are mainly rolling with freshmen and sophomores. We gave ourselves a chance and let off the rope for a bit in the 2nd half."

"These trips are only going to help us. Going here, to Miami and to Marquette. They are going to make us tough and you are going to hate to see us on your schedule towards the end of the season."

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3 rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

CLUTCH DOWN THE STRETCH

Speaking of Burton, he was clutch down the stretch in the win over Oklahoma State. As previously mentioned, he scored

10 points in the second half and then six in overtime.

Burton has really found another gear in the second half. The OKST game was his second double-digit scoring effort in a second half - he previously recorded 18 in the 2nd half vs. Niagara.

All-in-all, he's totaled 53 2nd half points this season, which equates to a 8.8 points average.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.
- Burton's 29 points is the 2nd highest from a DI freshman this season (only behind Harvard's Malik Mack's 32).

ROPED INTO A (SCORING) SITUATION

During the preseason when a media member pointed out that not a single member of the roster averaged more than five points per game a year ago, Coach Shrewsberry simply replied, 'Well we are going to score more than 12 points per game. Players will step up.' One of those people making the most of his opportunity - Julian Roper II.

The Northwestern transfer has started all six games and averaging the third most points with 8.5 per game. He leads the team in rebounds (5.3) and steals (1.0).

Over the last 3 games he's 5-for-9 from three and averaging 9.3 points.

He has tied his career high of 12 points twice

this season, with the most recent one being in the win over Oklahoma State.

FRESHMAN FOUNDATION

A little over a month into the job, Coach Shrewsberry had himself a top-30 ranked incoming freshmen class - Carey Booth, Logan Imes and Braeden Shrewsberry - all flipped from their Penn State commits. Then add in Mr. Indiana Basketball Markus Burton, who kept his commitment to Notre Dame. That brought the 2023 class to four signees which ranked 23rd in the country according to 247Sports.com.

Furthermore, cementing the bond amongst the freshmen class, there was an Indiana connection amongst most of them:

-- Imes and Shrewsberry played together throughout all four of their high school years with the Indiana Elite.

-- Imes and Burton were teammates on the 2023 Indiana All-Stars squad

CLEAN SLATE

Notre Dame only returns 35 points from a season ago, which equates to 1.6% of scoring returning. The table on the bottom page 11 displays the Division I schools returning the least amount of points ahead of the 2023-24 season.

MR INDIANA BASKETBALL

On April 20, 2023, now freshman point guard Markus Burton, was named Mr. Indiana Basketball. It marked the third time in program history in which a future Notre Dame player took home the honor. The two former winners were Chris Thomas in 2001 and Luke Zeller in 2005.

Burton averaged a state-best 30.3 points per game, along with 5.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.6 steals. Burton also secured the school single season scoring record by pouring in 909 points as a senior.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir

Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte, North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward from Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Mohammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame."

SHREWS QUOTABLES

Shrewsberry said the focus has been installing a system and forming an identity which will be what he called a defensive DNA and heavy in fundamentals. "I told them I don't coach effort. Effort is non-negotiable. But I don't have to coach effort with these guys. They're competing and getting after it. That groundwork of who and what we want to be has been laid."

"Everybody's a little more comfortable in our system and what we're doing. So now we're playing off more instincts where we are a little bit behind because we're thinking (in the first year). That changes for everybody. That time period is different for everybody. Some guys pick it up after

a month, some guys pick it up after five months. For us, we're trying to win. We're going to prepare to win every single time, we're going to come in and fight you every single time. Like I said, this will be the easiest time for you to get us, but we don't bow down to anybody and there is no tomorrow. Everything we're doing is for right now."

HOMETOWN HOMAGE

There had been the youth camps at Notre Dame, myriad Fighting Irish men's basketball games and a blossoming relationship with Demetrius Jackson – a name synonymous with Irish hoops success a decade ago.

And, then, there had been the fandom of another national college basketball power – about the only time the local kid from La Porte, Indiana, had found his way inside Purcell Pavilion for Notre Dame basketball.

Today, freshman point guard Markus Burton and redshirt-sophomore J.R. Konieczny are homegrown products at the foundational stage of first-year Notre Dame Glenn & Stacey Murphy head coach Micah Shrewsberry's program rebuild.

Though different in their paths to play beneath the fabled Golden Dome, both Burton and Konieczny embrace this moment to help reassert Irish basketball and fashion an example for area youth who may also foster dreams of wearing Irish green.

"It was sort of unreal for me, because I liked Notre Dame a lot, and it was basically a dream school for me, my hometown and a no-brainer," said Burton, who capped his record-shattering prep career at Penn High School with the coveted Indiana Mr. Basketball award – just the third Irish signee all-time to procure the accolade. "Blake Wesley and J.R. Konieczny, I was a really big fan of theirs too."

Initially, the rangy, 6-foot-7 Konieczny – a second-team Indiana All-State selection who had finished fifth in Mr. Basketball balloting in 2021 – had not envisioned a

gilded path to Notre Dame.

"It just all felt super surreal," Konieczny, who sat out the 2022-23 season to hone his all-around game and ensure his overall health, said. "The whole recruitment process was super stressful for me, and then when I committed to Notre Dame, it was a huge weight off my shoulders. I had never really expected myself to be at Notre Dame, but then the stars aligned."

As Burton transitions through the early months of his collegiate career and Konieczny begins in earnest the hardwood portion of his Notre Dame journey, they are mindful of this moment together – in their own career arcs and in a historic dawn of a new era of Irish basketball under Shrewsberry, also a Hoosier State native with basketball bona fides spanning the NCAA to the NBA.

"We talk about it a lot, but I mean right now, we kind of just have fun with it," said Burton of his conversations with Konieczny about the chance to be a hometown beacon of Notre Dame basketball. "We talk about how blessed we are to be able to go to Notre Dame and play basketball here, to have this opportunity."

"It's really fun. Coach Shrewsberry is a really good coach, loves his players and teaches us what need to do. A lot of us adapted really well, and I feel like once we get playing and people see how hard we play, we're going to show people how hard we work and take pride in everyday practice. It's going to be really fun."

A new era of Notre Dame basketball; a foundation formed in its community.

"We always have a good sense of what it means to rep the city and the area and rep Notre Dame and our hometown," Konieczny said. "We've been doing it for quite some years,; Markus being Mr. Basketball, had a great high school career that let people know who he was. I think it means a lot to both of us. We're going to do everything we can to win and see Notre Dame fans happy and South Bend fans happy and just everyone in this community."

"We're going to work our butts off no matter what's going on; every guy on our team has that dog in him. And I think that really stands to what we're trying to do."

1st Season at Notre Dame
3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level

An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

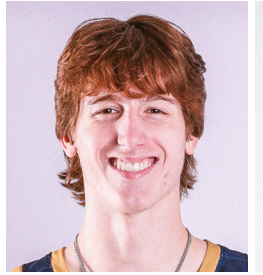
