QUICK HITS

ALL ABOUT BALANCE

The Hurricanes are the only team in the nation with three players averaging 10.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game, while shooting 50 percent from the field. Those players are Wooga Poplar (17.5 ppg, 5.4 rpg, 53.2%), Norchad Omier (16.7 ppg, 9.8 rpg, 59.5%) and Matthew Cleveland (14.9 ppg, 5.0 rpg, 58.3%).

OH MY, OMIER

Norchad Omier is just 21 points away from 1,500 career points. Upon reaching that milestone, Omier will join an elite club as there are currently only two active Division I men's players with 1,500-plus points and 1,000-plus rebounds - Armando Bacot (UNC) and Baylor Scheierman (Creighton). Omier ranks second among active Division I players in career boards at 1,097.

THE EXTRA PASS

Miami dished 26 assists on 38 made field goals against Stonehill, marking just the second time since 2010 that Miami has totaled 25-plus assists. The other occurrence came on Jan. 21, 2018 when the Hurricanes also tallied 26 assists in an 86-81 win over NC State.

GEORGE IN A GROOVE

Over the last five games, freshman Kyshawn George has been the dominant from distance, connecting on 57.9 percent of his 3-point shots, trailing only Nijel Pack (.615; 8-of-13). This is a marked improvement from the first six games of the season when George was shooting 23.1 percent (3-of-13) from 3-point range.

THE NUMBERS

THE MATCHUP

• The Hurricanes are set to play their final game of 2023 on Friday when they host the North Florida Ospreys for a non-conference matchup. Tipoff in Coral Gables is set for 6 p.m. and the game will air on ACC Network with Doug Sherman and Cory Alexander on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on 790 WAXY or RadioMundo.

• Miami and North Florida have met just six times before in program history, with the Hurricanes coming out on top in all six contests. Five of the six games have taken place at the Watsco Center, while one occurred in Jacksonville. In those six games, Miami is outscoring North Florida by an average of 27.5 points per contest. Most recently, the Hurricanes defeated the Ospreys, 77-59, at the Watsco Center on Nov. 29, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT

• Miami defeated Stonehill, 97-59, on Dec. 21 before taking a short break for the holidays. All five starters scored in double-figures for the third time this season. Freshman Kyshawn George got his first career start, replacing an injured Nijel Pack.

• Fourth-year junior Norchad Omier tallied his fifth double-double of the season with 20 points and 17 rebounds, while junior Wooga Poplar scored 20-plus points (24) for the fourth time this season.

SCOUTING THE OSPREYS

• North Florida enters Friday's contest with an 7-7 record and are coming off back-to-back losses to Power 5 teams in Florida State and Georgia. Prior to those two games, the Ospreys were on a three-game winning streak.

• North Florida is led in scoring by Chaz Lanier at 16.2 points per game, while Dorian James leads the Ospreys on the boards, averaging 5.9 rebounds per contest.

ELITE COMPANY

• Forward Norchad Omier had a night against Stonehill, recording 20 points and 17 rebounds against the Skyhawks. Omier's 17 rebounds ties his game-high for most in a Miami uniform (career high is 26 with Arkansas State).

• Omier is one of 38 Division I players to tally 20 points and 15 rebounds in a game this season. Even more impressive is Omier posted those numbers in just 24 minutes of action, the fewest of all 38 players and one of just seven players sub-30 minutes. When increasing the rebound number to 17, that list dwindles to just 13 Division I players including Omier.

CRACKIN' 90

• The Hurricanes have eclipsed the 90-point mark four times this year, marking the 26th season a Miami team has scored 90-plus points four times in a season.

• Having reached the 90-point mark five times last year, the Hurricanes have tallied four or more 90-point games in back-to-back years for the first time since 2006-08. The record for number of 90-point games in a season by a Miami team is 16, set back in 1988-89.

OFF THE BENCH

• Sophomore AJ Casey has been a dominant rebounder off the bench the last few games, averaging 5.0 boards per contest over the last four outings.

• Casey tallied a career-high seven rebounds against both LIU and La Salle. He also tied his career high in scoring last game, pouring in eight points vs. Stonehill.

CLOSING OUT NON-CON

• The Hurricanes have won their last 19 final non-conference games of the season.

• The last time Miami dropped its last game before conference play was Jan. 7, 2004, an 89-64 loss at No. 12/13 North Carolina.

THREE-POINT DOMINANCE

• The Hurricanes connected on 15 shots from beyond the arc against Stonehill, the most threes made by a Miami team since Dec. 21, 2019 when the Hurricanes knocked down 18 3-pointers against Coppin State.

• Miami ranks sixth among Division I teams, first in the ACC, in 3-point percentage this season, posting a .408 percent clip from distance as a team. Junior Wooga Poplar paces the team with a 50.8 shooting percentage from three, which ranks second in the nation.

COACH LEGEND

• With the retirement of longtime coach Cliff Ellis on Dec. 13, Coach Larrañaga now ranks first among active Division I coaches in career games coached at 1,219. Only one other coach, Greg Kampe (Oakland), has also coached 1,200-plus Division I games (1,213).

• Larrañaga is on the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame ballot for the second straight season in 2024. Larrañaga was inducted into the University of Miami Sports Hall of Fame in the spring of 2023.

• Also on the Naismith Hall of Fame ballot is Larrañaga's high school coach and idol, Jack Curran.

HOME SWEET HOME

• The Hurricanes are 148-49 (.750) at the Watsco Center during Jim Larrañaga's tenure. Prior to Coach L's arrival, the Hurricanes were 95-44 (.683) there. Overall, Miami is 241-93 (.720) at the Watsco Center, which opened as the Miami Convocation Center 1/4/03.

BAHAMAS CHAMPS

• The Hurricanes won their 18th regular season tournament/multi-team event (MTE) this season, taking home the Baha Mar Hoops Bahamas Championship title. Miami's last MTE team title came in 2015 when the Hurricanes won the Puerto Rico TipOff in San Juan, Puerto Rico.

• Nijel Pack was named the Tournament MVP after averaging 22.0 points per game on and shooting 47.1 percent from 3-point range. Pack broke the tournament record for total points (44) in the tournament and single-game scoring (28 vs. K-State). He was the first Hurricane to earn an MTE MVP honor since Kamari Murphy in 2016 (Hoophall Miami Invitational MVP).

• Wooga Poplar joined Pack on the Bahamas Championship All-Tournament Team after averaging 14.0 points and 8.5 rebounds.

BIG-TIME BENZ

• Bensley Joseph was just one block shy of the elusive 5x5 vs. UCF (11/10), recording 15 points, 5 rebounds, 5 assists, 5 steals and 4 blocks.

• He is just one of three Division I players (Chris Singleton, Syracuse, 2010; Michael Carter-Williams, FSU, 2008) to put up those numbers in the last 14 years.

In his 12 seasons at the University of Miami, head coach Jim Larrañaga has led the Hurricanes to six NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16. He has guided the Hurricanes to their first Elite Eight (2022), first Final Four (2023), first ACC Tournament title (2013) and first two ACC regular season crowns (2013 and 2023). Larrañaga has been named the Associated Press, Naismith, USBWA and Henry Iba National Coach of the Year, twice was both the ACC and USBWA District Coach of the Year and was the 2013 NABC District Coach of the Year.

The winningest coach in program history, Larrañaga has posted five 25-win seasons at UM – the only Miami coach to do so even once – and seven in his career. He also has recorded eight 20-win campaigns at Miami and 14 in his career. In conference action, the Hurricanes have won nine or more league games in eight of 12 seasons, while prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami had never won more than eight ACC games in a season. Larrañaga has helped the Hurricanes to 30 postseason victories, including 11 in the NCAA Tournament (six appearances), 13 in the ACC Tournament (13) and five in the NIT (two). He ranks top-30 all-time among Division I coaches with 725 victories, including eighth among active coaches. In 2023, Larrañaga was both inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum and named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee.

Miami's 69 total road wins in the past 12 seasons are fourth-most among ACC teams during Larrañaga's tenure and its 114 total victories away from home also place fourth. During that same stretch, the Hurricanes are fifth in overall ACC wins (120), as well as fourth in both ACC road victories (48) and ACC Tournament triumphs (13), plus sixth in ACC home wins (72). In the six years prior to Larrañaga's arrival, when the ACC had only 12 teams, Miami was tied for ninth in ACC victories (36) and won just 10 total ACC road games. In nine of Larrañaga's 12 years, the team has finished higher in the ACC final standings than it was picked in the preseason poll, including placing multiple spots higher on seven occasions.

The Hurricanes have a combined 16 wins over Duke (8-9) and North Carolina (8-10) under Larrañaga, tied for the second-most of any team during his 11-year tenure, after going 4-31 versus those two programs before his arrival. Eight of those victories are by double digits and seven are on the road, the former the most of any team during that stretch and the latter tied for the most. Miami's 27-point win over the Blue Devils on Jan. 23, 2013, is the third-largest ever against the AP No. 1 team in the nation. It is one 31 victories over a top-25 foe under Larrañaga, including 13—five of which came in the past two seasons, 2021-22 and 2022-23—versus a top-10 opponent.

Miami has seen unprecedented fan interest in the program under Larrañaga. In 2017-18, for the third straight season, the Hurricanes sold out their season-ticket allotment at the Watsco Center. The 2015-16 campaign marked the first time in UM history that any team sold out of season tickets. Across the last two seasons, 2021-22 and 2022-23, Miami recorded four of the five highest single-game student attendance marks in program history.

From 2017-19, Miami was one of two ACC programs, alongside Duke, to have a player selected in each NBA Draft. Four total Hurricanes were picked in that span, including Lonnie Walker IV going No. 18 in 2018.

During the most recent campaign, 2022-23, Larrañaga guided Miami to its best year ever. The Hurricanes finished 29-8 (15-5 ACC), shared the ACC regular season title and earned their first Final Four appearance. Miami set or tied program records for overall, ACC, regular season (24), home (16), top-25 (seven), top-10 (three) and top-five (two) victories. The team ended the year third in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll, good for its best finish ever.

Seeded No. 5 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes knocked off top-seeded and No. 2/1-ranked Houston, 89-75, and second-seeded and No. 5/7-ranked Texas, 88-81, in a three-day span in Kansas City, Mo., to clinch their Final Four bid. They also knocked off seven teams with a combined 23 NCAA titles (including one vacated) during the 2022-23 campaign, including an eight-point road victory at North Carolina, a 22-point home win over Duke and a 16-point triumph over Indiana in the NCAA Tournament. The team lost by more than seven points just twice all year.

Larrañaga earned multiple significant achievements during the historic season. First, on Nov. 19, 2022, he led Miami to a 74-64 victory over his alma mater, Providence, in Uncasville, Conn., to become just the 35th coach with DI experience to reach 700 wins, including only the fourth to do so while in the ACC. On Dec. 21, 2022, he was named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee. Following the season, on May 4, 2023, he was inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum.

Numerous Hurricanes claimed major awards during the season, as well. Isaiah Wong became Miami's second ACC Player of the Year and sixth All-America, garnering NABC third-team distinction. He was also a finalist for the John R. Wooden Award and the Jerry West Award, among many other accomplishments. Jordan Miller received Second Team All-ACC status, while Norchad Omier picked up third-team plaudits. Nijel Pack won NCAA Tournament Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player honors, while Miller and Wong both tallied All-Tournament Team status.

The 2022-23 success followed another tremendous season the year before, as Miami, picked No. 12 in the ACC preseason poll, went 26-11 (14-6 ACC). Seeded No. 10 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes rattled off three straight victories to make the Elite Eight for the first time, including throttling second-seeded and No. 8/7 ranked-Auburn, 79-61, in the Round of 32, en route to finishing co-No. 16 in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll.

Larrañaga set the program record with his 221st victory at The U on March 2, 2022, at Boston College, just weeks after a Feb. 9, 2022, triumph over Georgia Tech made him the first coach in NCAA history with 100 league wins at three DI schools and/or in three DI conferences. Kameron McGusty turned in one of the best years in program history, claiming First Team All-ACC, NABC First Team All-District 2, ACC All-Tournament First Team, NCAA Tournament All-Midwest Region and Senior CLASS Award finalist accolades.

In 2017-18, Miami played in its fourth NCAA Tournament in a six-year span, claiming the No. 6 seed in the South Region. The Hurricanes tied for third in the ACC and finished the season with a 22-10 mark, including an 11-7 record in conference play. The Hurricanes were nationally ranked for 15 weeks, reaching as high as No. 6 in the polls.

Freshman Lonnie Walker IV was named Honorable Mention All-ACC, becoming the first freshman all-conference honoree in program history. He also was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team. Miami earned road wins over then-No. 12 Minnesota and then-No. 9 North Carolina, the fourth straight year and the sixth time in Larrañaga's first seven seasons that the Hurricanes defeated two or more top-15 teams.

In 2016-17, Miami went 21-12 overall and claimed the No. 8 seed in the Midwest Region. It defeated three ranked teams, including two in the top 10. Davon Reed won the Skip Prosser Award and Larrañaga registered his 600th all-time win with a 72-46 triumph at



Pittsburgh on Jan. 14, 2017.

The 2015-16 Hurricanes played their way into the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 for the second time in four seasons, and just the third time in school history.

In 2012-13, Larrañaga helped Miami to a No. 2 national ranking by both the AP and USA TODAY and a No. 2 seed in the NCAA tournament. At the time, he was the 10th coach in the last 10 years to lead two top-10 programs, as Miami was No. 2 on Feb. 18, 2013, and George Mason was No. 8 in the final Top 25 poll in 2006.

Individually, Shane Larkin earned the ACC Player of the Year and Lute Olson National Player of the Year awards, as well as All-American status and finalist nods for the Bob Cousy, John Wooden and James Naismith player of the year honors before declaring early for the 2013 NBA Draft. Larkin was also the ACC Tournament MVP, on the ACC All-Defensive Team and a Defensive All-American. Durand Scott was the ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

Larrañaga came to Miami after serving as the head coach at George Mason for 14 seasons. He guided the program to five NCAA Tournament appearances (1999, 2001, 2006, 2008, 2011), including an unprecedented run to the 2006 Final Four that captured the nation's attention, as the Patriots defeated Michigan State, North Carolina, Wichita State and Connecticut along the way. Following that run, Larrañaga was selected the 2006 Clair Bee National Coach of the Year.

Larrañaga built the George Mason program into a perennial contender in the highly-regarded Colonial Athletic Association, winning more games than any other coach in program and conference history (273) en route to three conference titles (1999, 2001, 2008).

In 2006, Larrañaga became the first coach at a mid-major school to take his team to the Final Four in 27 years and earned the CAA's first NCAA tournament at-large berth in 20 years. Along the way, he led Mason to a school record in wins, its first-ever national ranking, its first-ever appearance in the Top 10 and its first wins over Top 10 teams.

Larrañaga served as the head coach at Bowling Green for 11 seasons (1986-1997) and at Division II American International for two seasons (1977-79).

At Bowling Green, he made an immediate impact in his first season. In 1986-87, the Falcons were the nation's most improved team under a first-year head coach that took over a program with a losing record, posting a 15-14 record for an eight-game improvement over the previous season. Larrañaga went on to record a 170-144 mark in 11 years at Bowling Green, earning 1997 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading Bowling Green to a 22-10 record, a conference regular season co-championship and a berth in the NIT. The 22 victories were the most by a Bowling Green team in 47 years and the 13 conference wins were the second-highest total in BGSU history.

Larrañaga's 170 victories at Bowling Green ranked second all-time on the Falcons' coaching list and he was only the second coach to record consecutive postseason appearances. Larrañaga led his squad to NIT berths in 1990 (18-11) and again in 1991 (17-13), the first time the Falcons enjoyed back-to-back postseason appearances since the early '60s. Bowling Green won better than 60 percent of its games in Larrañaga's last four years, recording a 70-44 mark during that stretch. The Falcons finished fourth or better in the MAC in five of Larrañaga's 11 seasons and he is among the winningest coaches in MAC history.

Larrañaga received his first head coaching position in 1977 when he was named to the post at American International, a Division II program in Springfield, Mass. Taking over a team that had suffered through five consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, Larrañaga turned AIC into a winning program in his first year and compiled a 28-25 mark in two seasons.

Larrañaga's first coaching opportunity came at Davidson College from 1971-76, serving as an assistant coach to Terry Holland. Davidson captured three Southern Conference regular-season championships and an NIT berth in his five years there, and he compiled a 47-12 record doubling as the freshman team coach. In 1976, he left Davidson and spent one season as player-coach for the Geronemo Basketball Club in Belgium.

After his two-year stint at American International, Larrañaga was reunited with Holland at the University of Virginia in April 1979. An assistant coach under Holland at UVA for seven seasons from 1979-86, he helped the Cavaliers reach the NCAA Final Four on two occasions (1981 and 1984), finish in the top five of the AP and UPI polls and average more than 24 victories per season. The Cavaliers were 169-62, won three regular-season Atlantic Coast Conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances in that span. Virginia also made a pair of NIT appearances, winning the NIT Championship in 1980. Larrañaga was on the staff during the careers of three-time National Player of the Year Ralph Sampson and NBA first-round draft choice Olden Polynice.

A 1971 graduate of Providence College with a degree in economics, Larrañaga was a four-year letterman for the Friars. As the team captain in his senior season, he led Providence to a 20-8 record and an NIT appearance. He graduated as the school's fifth all-time leading scorer with 1,258 points and was selected in the sixth round of the draft by the Detroit Pistons of the National Basketball Association. He was the team's top scorer as a sophomore and junior and was named New England's Division I Sophomore of the Year in 1969. He was inducted into the Providence College Hall of Fame in 1991.

Larrañaga and his wife, Liz, have two sons and four grandchildren. Their son, Jay, played for his father at Bowling Green, was the head coach of the NBDL's Erie Bayhawks and is now an assistant coach with the Los Angeles Clippers. Jon was a member of his father's George Mason teams from 1999-2003, earning first team Academic All-America honors for NCAA Division I-AAA schools.
