## KEY STORYLINES

### LAST TIME

- **SECOND HALF SURGE:** The Demon Deacons showed a spirited fight in the third and fourth quarters, outscoring the Tigers 34-23 in the final 20 minutes. Wake Forest limited Clemson 6-of-20 from the field including 0-of-6 from three-point range and 11 of the Tigers' second half points came at the free throw line.
- **ON THE DEFENSIVE END:** In total Wake Forest forced 20 turnovers on the night, tying the second-most this season with the only other higher total coming against BYU during the North Shore Showcase. Additionally, the 20 turnovers are the highest total forced in ACC play both this season and during the Gebbia era.
- **ALYSSA SHINES:** Offensively, Wake Forest was led by Alexandria Scruggs. Despite having early foul trouble, she finished the night with a team-high 14 points on 7-of-10 field goals.

### GEBBIA ERA YEAR ONE

- In just her first season, Gebbia had a host of accomplishments:
- Winningest first-year head coach in program history
- 17 wins tied the most since the 2011-12 season
- Talled the most wins against ACC opponents by a first-year head coach
- Wins over four NCAA Tournament teams including wins over two Elite Eight teams
- Grabbed 12 wins at home, the fourth-highest total in program history
- Finished second in program history with 227 threes made
- Ended the season ranked fourth in program history with 123 blocks
- Held ACC opponents at home to just 19.2 percent shooting from three
- Limited five of nine ACC teams at home to one or less three-pointer made
- Increased the team's assist percentage by nearly 20 percent

### SERIES HISTORY

- **ALL-TIME VS. MIAMI:** Wake Forest currently owns a 13-17 record against Miami, dating back to 1983.
- **LAST TIME AGAINST THE HURRICANES:** Despite being led by strong performances from their fifth-year guards, Wake Forest dropped a 77-47 decision on the road at Miami on January 7, 2024. Defensively, the Demon Deacons forced 12 turnovers. Offensively, the Demon Deacons recorded 12 assists on 17 made baskets (70.6 percent) against Miami. Kaia Harrison had a strong game at point guard, posting a team-high five assists while also posting nine points in the game. Additionally, Alexandria Scruggs notched her first-career double-double.
- **A WIN WOULD:** Mark the Demon Deacons' first ACC win of the 2023-24 campaign.

## STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Over the course of the season, the Demon Deacons have navigated one of the toughest schedules in the country as the Deacs currently sit at No. 4 in the Average Opponent NET Rank metric in the country. This includes seven games against NET top-50 teams and 14 teams in the NET top-100:

- Additionally since the start of conference play, all but one team that Wake Forest has played was either ranked or receiving votes in the AP Poll.
- The strong schedule has seen Wake Forest rise 13 spots overall in the NET rankings since the start of conference play.

## EFFICIENT MALAYA

- Malaya Cowles had another efficient showing, posting a team-high eight points and finishing 4-of-7 from the field.
- She continued her impressive play shooting percentage at home against Notre Dame, going 6-of-7 from the field.
- Cowles holds a .675 shooting percentage (52-of-77) while inside LJV Coliseum this season.
- Her single-season field goal percentage is one of the highest in program history, ranking sixth:

## ELISE CONTINUES TO GROW

- Junior guard Elise Williams continued her impressive run at the free throw line, knocking down 2-of-2 attempts at the stripe. She has now made her last 10 free throws, dating back to the Syracuse game on Thursday, Jan. 11. Additionally, Williams is shooting a blistering 90.9 percent from the line in conference play with her only two misses coming against Syracuse.
- Since the start of ACC play, she leads the Deacs with 11.9 points per game. Williams is averaging a career-best 83.3 percent from the stripe (45-of-54) this season. She is now ranked ninth in program history in free throw percentage.
- Williams did a bit of everything to finish with nine points, five rebounds (team-high), five assists (team-high) and two steals (team-high) against Notre Dame.
- She recorded her third-career double-double as she notched 14 points and 10 rebounds in addition to seven assists against Boston College. It marked the first double-double by a Demon Deacon since Demearea Hinds against Morgan State last season on March 16, 2023. Additionally, it was just the third 14-10-7 game in the Her Hoops Stats era (2009-10) by a Wake Forest player and first since Dearica Hamby against Pitt on March 5, 2014.
- Williams scored a career-high 29 points against No. 13 Virginia Tech, shooting 10-of-18 from the floor.
- Williams appeared in all 34 games last season which tied the most games played in a single-season in program history. She led the team in steals per game (1.5) and assists per game (2.9). Additionally, Williams is the Demon Deacons' leading returning scorer as she tallied a career-best 10.3 points per contest a year ago.
- Last season, Williams tallied 16 points against Louisville in the ACC Tournament. Of note, Williams tallied double-digit points in nine-consecutive games this season during ACC play last season.

- Against Georgia Tech, Elise Williams finished the game as the Deacs' high scorer, totaling 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting while also converting 3-of-3 free throws.
- Additionally, the Raleigh, N.C., native had a well-rounded game for the Deacs in the win over Rhode Island as she led the team in rebounding (6) and assists (5).
- The junior guard ended the conference opener against Virginia with a new career high on the glass, posting nine rebounds against the Cavaliers. In addition to the rebounding effort, Williams also finished in double figures in the score column, tallying 10 points in the loss, a team best. The junior was nearly perfect at the line, going 7-of-8 from the charity stripe which was also a team-high and career-best.
- In her first full season at Wake Forest in 2021-22, Williams was a key to the Deacs success last season contributing in nearly every area.
  - She led the team in assists (87), steals (51) while ranking second for the Deacs in scoring (9.5 PPG), three-point makes (28) and blocks (13) in 2021-22.

## SCRUGGS REMAINS CONSISTENT

- Offensively, Wake Forest was led by an inspiring performance from graduate guard Alexandria Scruggs, finishing the night with a team-high 14 points on 7-of-10 field goals while also collecting three rebounds against Clemson.
- This is the sixth time in the last 10 games she has reached double-digit points and the seventh time overall this season.
- Over the last two games, Scruggs has been 10-of-14 from the field (71.4 pct.).
- The graduate student made her 137th appearance in a Wake Forest uniform, adding to her program-record that was set six games ago against No. 13 Virginia Tech.

## FROM THE STRIPE

- Through 20 games this season, Wake Forest has seen a massive uptick in free throw shooting percentage, going from 66.0 percent (343-of-520) last season to 72.6 percent (204-of-281) this season.
- On Sunday, the team went 10-of-14 from the charity stripe (71.4 percent).
- This is the sixth time in the last seven games the Demon Deacons have shot 70 percent or better.

## LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

- Defensively, the Demon Deacons forced double-digit turnovers for the 30th time in the last 31 games, with the lone game coming against Syracuse on Jan. 11. The 30 game stretch goes back to January of 2022. In total, the Deacs forced 20 turnovers by Clemson. This included nine steals from five different players.
- The 20 turnovers are the highest total forced in ACC play both this season and during the Gebbia era as well as tied for the second-highest total this season, marking the most since forcing 25 in the opening game of the North Shore Showcase against BYU.
- Wake Forest posted seven blocks in the game against Marshall, the most this season and most since the game against Florida State last season in the ACC Tournament. Conley led the effort with three blocks, tying the highest total by any Demon Deacon this season.
- The Demon Deacons forced nine turnovers against Syracuse and 12 turnovers against Miami. Additionally, the Deacs forced 17 turnovers against Virginia Tech, the second-most by the Hokies this season.
- Against Villanova, the Demon Deacons turned the Wildcats over a season-high 10 times in the game as Villanova came into the contest second in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Prior to that, Wake Forest forced 19 Saint Louis turnovers, the second-most the Billikens had committed in a single game to that point in the season and it resulted in 20 points on the other end for the Demon Deacons.
- In the Deacs' game against BYU, they forced 26 turnovers, marking the most since January 22, 2017 against Georgia Tech when the Demon Deacons also forced 26 turnovers in the game. Additionally, it was the first time since December 18 and 21, 2017 against Charlotte and College

of Charleston that Wake Forest had produced 20 or more opponent turnovers in back-to-back games. It marked the first time since March 16, 2017 (Washington State) that a Power-5 team had forced BYU into 26 or more turnovers.

- In 34 games last season, the Demon Deacons did a stellar job of holding their opponents down in shooting and scoring. The Deacs held their opponents to an average of 60.1 points allowed per game, ranking 71st nationally and fifth in the ACC in the category.

## TOP-25 SIGNING CLASS

- The Wake Forest women's basketball team announced the addition of three players during National Signing Day, marking the first official signing class for head coach Megan Gebbia.
- In Madisyn Jordan, Makaela Quimby and Rylie Theuerkauf, the Demon Deacons signed some of the best talent in the country. This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class. - Additionally, ESPN ranked the Demon Deacons class as one of the top-25 in the country.
- F Madisyn Jordan ranked as the No. 67 player nationally according to the latest ESPNW rankings, making her the highest-ranked signee since Raegyn Conley at No. 60 in 2021. Jordan garnered All-State and All-District honors during all four of her high school seasons at Panther Creek and led her team to a N.C. High School Athletic Association 4A State Championship victory as a senior. The sharpshooter led all of 4A in North Carolina for 3-point field goals.
- G Mak Quimby rated as high as the top 30 in the Blue Star rankings and has been one of the higher ranked players in the class throughout her high school career. Quimby led her high school team to the Geico Nationals Semifinals as a senior. Additionally, she has played at the highest level of AAU throughout her high school career.
- G Rylie Theuerkauf is an elite scorer and ranked as the No. 85 player in the nation by ESPNW and additionally is the No. 29 guard in the country. She finished her career with 2,482 points in her high school career at Tenafly HS. Theuerkauf posted 28.5 points per game during her senior season while grabbing 8.3 rebounds per game, averaged 29.2 points per game as a junior, leading the state in that category and posted 36.4 points per game as a sophomore, ranking second in nation according to

MaxPreps and her 38.2 points per 32 also ranked second in country MaxPreps.

## TEAMWORK

- The Demon Deacons recorded 16 assists on 23 made baskets (69.6 percent) versus the Tigers.
- Wake Forest has had 10 or more assists on 16 separate occasions this season.
- This season, the Deacs have assisted 254 of 433 made field goals (58.7 percent). This matches the same percentage from last season and ranks in the 72nd percentile.
- Under head coach Megan Gebbia, the Demon Deacons saw a huge increase in number of assists and percentage of assists on made baskets last season. Wake Forest ranked in the 80th percentile country, assisting on 59.1 percent of made baskets versus 2021-22 where their 45.0 percent of assists on made baskets ranked in the 4th percentile in the country.

## WAKE FOREST INVESTMENT IN BASKETBALL

- Over the last five years, Wake Forest has invested over \$27 million in basketball facilities. The latest investment was the \$7.2 million project for the Dr. Carol Guth and Chris Paul Family women's and men's clubhouses that were completed in September of 2022.
- Both clubhouses feature over 6,000 square feet of space, 18 expansive player lockers with built-in ventilation, wireless charging station for electronics, RGB LED lighting and 43" digital screens above each locker.
  - The players lounge in each clubhouse has three separate TV/multimedia areas with comfortable seating for rest, relaxation and a space for the student-athletes. Additionally, there is a nutrition area in this space with a community table for team meals.
  - Each Clubhouse features state-of-the-art sports medicine and performance elements, including recovery pods and hydrotherapy, as well as showers and bathrooms.
  - Wake Forest basketball student-athletes can enjoy an outdoor heated covered patio with a view of the beautiful Reynolda Campus and Kentner Stadium.

## YEAR TWO IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia enters her second season as the head coach of the Wake Forest women's basketball program in 2023-24 after an impressive debut season at the helm.

In just her first season, Gebbia had a host of accomplishments:

- Winningest first-year head coach in program history
- 17 wins tied the most since the 2011-12 season
- Talled the most wins against ACC opponents by a first-year head coach
- Wins over four NCAA Tournament teams including wins over two Elite Eight teams
- Grabbed 12 wins at home, the fourth-highest total in program history
- Finished second in program history with 227 threes made
- Ended the season ranked fourth in program history with 123 blocks
- Held ACC opponents at home to just 19.2 percent shooting from three
- Limited five of nine ACC teams at home to one or less three-pointers made
- Increased the team's assist percentage by nearly 20 percent
- Signed a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW
  - This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

Gebbia made an impact in her first season as the Deacs grabbed their most wins since the 2011-12 season and led the Demon Deacons to a memorable three-day run at the ACC Tournament. During their three days in Greensboro, Wake Forest had the second-largest halftime comeback in ACC Tournament history, erasing an 18-point halftime deficit to defeat Florida State. It was one of a number of big wins during the first season of the Gebbia era. The Deacs claimed a key road win in the final year of the ACC/Big Ten, defeating Minnesota in late November.

In the final week of January, the Demon Deacons recorded a pair of wins over eventual Elite Eight teams, taking down Louisville, the first win over the Cardinals in program history, and Miami. Both victories highlighted 12 total wins at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum, the fourth-highest total in program history.

In the first season of the Gebbia era, Jewel Spear had one of the best scoring seasons by any player in program history, finishing the 2022-23 season with 546 points, the sixth-highest total by a Demon Deacon. En route to garnering All-ACC honors for the second-consecutive season, Spear had 11 20-plus point games including 30-plus points in wins over Coastal Carolina and Louisville.

Spear finished the season with the second-highest three-point total in program history, racking up 93 threes during the season. As a team, Wake Forest had their second-highest total of threes in program history as the motion-style offense of Gebbia produced 227 threes on the season.

The Deacs also got the job done on the defensive side of the ball, blocking 123 shots during the season which ranked fourth in program history and finished the season ranked in the top 100 nationally. Wake Forest also ranked in the top 70 nationally in points per game allowed and in the top 60 nationally in three-point defense.

On the recruiting side, Gebbia signed top talent for her first class, inking a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW. It also was the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

## Welcome to the Gebbia Era

Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Eagles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wente and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a life-long dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball."

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by The Frederick News-Post. She played college basketball at Towson University from 1990 to 1994.

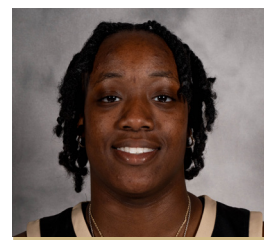

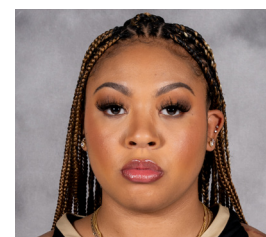
